DUKE COMMUNICATIONS

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NEED TO KNOW

- » After a 10-day break for the holidays, No. 17 Duke hosts Florida State at Cameron Indoor Stadium for a New Years Eve matinee.
- » The Blue Devils are unblemished at Cameron Indoor Stadium this season where they are allowing just 54.8 points per game and winning by an average margin of 25 points.
- » Duke has won six of the last seven in the series versus Florida State and leads the all-time series 42-11, including 23-2 at Cameron Indoor Stadium. The teams split last year.
- » With an emphasis on defense and rebounding under first-year head coach **Jon Scheyer**, Duke is second nationally in offensive rebounding by grabbing 38.9 percent of its misses.
- » The Blue Devils are top 50 nationally in total rebounds per game (39.9, 38th), offensive rebounds per game (13.7, 13th), rebound margin (+9.5, 11th), scoring defense (60.4, 23rd) and scoring margin (12.5, 49th) -- leading the ACC in rebound margin and offensive rebounds.
- » Duke has held 12 of 13 opponents to below their season scoring average -- six to its season low for points, including Iowa (21 points below) and Xavier (20 below).
- » Four-time ACC Rookie of the Week **Kyle Filipowski** (right) leads Duke in scoring (14.4), rebounds (8.9) and steals (1.4). The versatile 7-footer is the nation's best power conference freshman in rebounding and leads all NCAA freshmen with his six double-doubles.
- » Filipowski opened his career by scoring in double-figures in each of the first 12 games.
- » Before the Blue Devils' next game -- Jan. 4 at NC State -- Duke will have played just twice over a 24-day period. The light late-December schedule comes on the heels of playing 12 games over the season's first 34 days -- no power conference team played more.
- » Duke's grueling opening stretch -- with no more than three days between any game and nearly 8,000 miles of travel -- came against a schedule ranked 10th toughest nationally (fifth toughest by a power conference team). Duke's past opponents are a combined 101-47 (.682).
- » The deep and balanced Blue Devils have seen six different players lead the team in scoring over the last seven games, including a career-high 15 by freshman **Dariq Whitehead** vs. UMES and 17 by sophomore **Jaylen Blakes** at Wake Forest.

- » FSU head coach Leonard Hamilton is the winningest active coach in ACC wins (regular season and tournament) and ranks fifth all-time behind Mike Krzyzewski, Dean Smith, Roy Williams and Gary Williams.

Scheyer In First Season as Head Coach

- » Former Duke All-American and two-time team captain **Jon Scheyer** is the 20th head coach in Duke's storied basketball history. He was named to the position on June 4, 2021, succeeding Hall of Famer **Mike Krzyzewski**, who announced in June 2021 his plan to retire from coaching following the 2021-22 season.
- » The 35-year-old Scheyer is among the youngest head coaches in Division-I men's basketball, and the youngest at a power conference institution. He was named to *The Athletic's* 40 Under 40 in college sports in 2022, and was previously touted as one of the best assistant coaches in college basketball.
- » He has vast experience on the Duke bench, having served on Krzyzewski's staff since the 2013-14 season. His previous roles with the Blue Devils include special assistant, assistant coach and the previous three years as associate head coach.
- » As a player, Scheyer sparked the Blue Devils to two ACC championships and the 2010 NCAA title as a player from 2007-10. Over his previous nine years on the coaching staff, he helped Duke compile a 245-71 (.775) record, a national championship (2015), two Final Fours (2015, 2022) and two ACC Tournament crowns (2017, 2019).
- » The Northbrook, Ill., native has been integral in the recruiting and development of several young Duke stars since joining the staff, and landed the nation's No. 1-ranked recruiting class for the 2022-23 campaign. Duke announced its five-man 2023-24 class this week, which includes five top-50 players and is currently ranked as the No. 2 class by ESPN and 247Sports.
- » Duke has signed a top-three recruiting class per ESPN in every season since Scheyer joined the staff, including the No. 1 class five times in 10 seasons (2014, 2015, 2017, 2018, 2022).
- » Among Scheyer's personnel moves in June were the hiring of **Jai Lucas** as an assistant coach and the promotion of **Amile Jefferson** to assistant coach. Scheyer also added **Mike Schrage** as special assistant to the head coach and **Rachel Baker** as general manager.

Blue Devils Allowing 60.4 Points -- Second in ACC, 23rd Nationally in Scoring Defense

- » Duke is second in the ACC and 23rd nationally in scoring defense, yielding just 60.4 points per game. Ten of the first 13 opponents have been held to less than 70 points, while seven have failed to score more than 60.
- » Duke has held 12 of the 13 opponents to below their season scoring average -- six scored their season low for points, including holding Iowa to a season-low 62 (21 points below its average) and Xavier to 64 (20 points below its average).
- » Duke's strong defensive numbers come against a schedule rated 46th-toughest versus opponent offensives (per KenPom) -- Four of Duke's last seven games came against teams ranked top-10 in KenPom offensive efficiency -- Ohio State (fourth), Purdue (sixth), Xavier (eighth) and Iowa (10th).
- » Seven opponents this season have failed to top 30 percent from behind the arch, as Duke ranks 23rd nationally in three-point defense (.278).

Duke's Depth Emerging

- » Of the nine primary players in Duke's rotation, eight are averaging 5.0+ points per game and nine are averaging 2.0+ rebounds per game this season.
- » Six different players have led the team in scoring over the last seven games -- after Kyle Filipowski was the leading scorer in five of the first six.
- » Sophomore **Jaylen Blakes'** career-high 17 points off the bench at Wake Forest marked the first time in his career he led Duke in scoring, freshman **Dariq Whitehead's** career-high 15 points came in his first career start on Dec. 10 vs. Maryland Eastern Shore -- a game in which Duke started five freshmen for the first time in program history.
- » Highly-rated freshmen **Dereck Lively II** also missed much of the preseason with a calf injury. He had 11 points and five rebounds against Ohio State and has blocked multiple shots in six consecutive games, including three against Boston College and a career-high five vs. UMES.
- » Duke was without both Lively and Whitehead (illnesses) at Wake Forest. Graduate **Ryan Young** stepped into the starting lineup and finished a rebound shy of a double-double with 10 points and nine rebounds -- hitting 5-of-6 from the field.

A Season for Charity

- » Duke is 14th nationally and second in the ACC in free throw percentage, hitting .779 from the charity stripe. The Blue Devils have seven games this season shooting .800+ at the free throw line -- each of the seven have come over the last 11. Individually, eight different Blue Devils are converting .750+ at the line.
- » Duke has hit 70 of its last 84 free throws (.833) over its last five games, and has hit .804 (152-of-189) over the last 11 games.
- » Freshman **Tyrese Proctor** leads the team at .889, hitting 24-of-27 this season after having a streak of 17 consecutive made free throws snapped vs. Iowa.
- » Graduate **Jacob Grandison** has made each of his seven attempts this season, while graduate **Ryan Young** enters the FSU game having made 12 consecutive free throws.
- » In the last five minutes of games, Duke is 31-of-37 (.838), with Grandison (6-of-6) and freshmen **Kyle Filipowski** (6-of-7) leading the team.

Tough Early Schedule for Young Blue Devils

- » The Blue Devils did not shy away from a difficult early schedule in Coach Scheyer's first season, with his team of 11 newcomers and seven freshmen.
- » No power conference team played more games over the season's first 34 days than Duke's 12.
- » Duke's grueling opening stretch -- with no more than three days between any game and nearly 8,000 miles of travel -- came against a schedule the currently ranks 10th toughest nationally (fifth toughest by a power conference team). Duke's past opponents are a combined 101-47 (.682).
- » Duke has faced three AP Top 25 teams through its first 13 games and battled No. 5-ranked Houston on the road in a closed scrimmage on Oct. 29.
- » Five Duke opponents -- and four of the past seven -- have come against teams ranked top 30 overall in KenPom (Kansas, Purdue, Ohio State, Iowa, Xavier). Of those five, OSU (rated fourth), Purdue (sixth), Xavier (eighth) and Iowa (10th) are top-10 in offensive efficiency.
- » The win over Iowa capped a stretch of six consecutive power conference opponents for Duke, as the Blue Devils went 5-1 in that stretch.

Duke is No. 2 in Offensive Rebounding Percentage; Top 40 in Overall Rebounding

- » Duke has been among the nation's best rebounding teams this season, ranking second nationally in offensive rebounding percentage (38.9).
- » The team ranks top 40 nationally in total rebounds per game (39.9, 38th), offensive rebounds per game (13.7, 13th) and rebound margin (+9.5, 11th).
- » Duke leads the ACC in both offensive rebounding and rebound margin.
- » The Blue Devils have out-rebounded 10 of their first 13 opponents, including eight by double-digit margins. Duke opened the season with a double-digit rebound margin in each of the first six games -- the program record for longest such streak (at any point in a season). Duke had five-game streaks in 2017-18, 1998-98, in 1962-63 and 1960-61.
- » Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Duke is 41-5 when out-rebounding its opponent.
- » Offensive rebounding has been a significant strength, with Duke totaling 20+ on the offensive glass three times already -- the Blue Devils hadn't had more than 19 offensive boards in any game over each of the last two seasons.
- » Individually, freshman **Kyle Filipowski** is 40th nationally in rebounds per game (8.9) and leads all power conference freshmen. Graduate **Ryan Young** is 38th nationally in offensive rebounds (3.2) and is ranked No. 17 nationally in KenPom in offensive rebound percentage (16.9).

Filipowski: ACC's First to Open Season with Four Consecutive Rookie of the Week Honors

- » Freshman **Kyle Filipowski**, already a four-time ACC Rookie of the Week honoree, scored in double figures in each of the first 12 games of his college career and is leading the Blue Devils in scoring (14.4), rebounding (8.9) and steals (1.4).
- » He is tied for 11th nationally and leads all Division-I freshmen with his six double-doubles.
- » In ACC history, Filipowski's four straight Rookie of the Week selections are topped only by Duke's **Jabari Parker**, who won it five consecutive weeks in 2013-14. Filipowski is the ACC's first player to open a season with four straight Rookie of the Week honors. Over the last 10 seasons (since 2013-14), Duke has had an ACC Rookie of the Week in 78 of a possible 160 weeks (48.8%). Twenty-two different Blue Devils have won the award at least once in that time.
- » Duke leads the ACC in all-time Rookie of the Week picks with 150 -- by 54 over North Carolina (96) and 64 over Georgia Tech (86).
- » Not your typical back-to-the-basket big man, the 7-foot Filipowski's 18 steals lead the team, his 14 made three-pointers are second most on the team. Thirteen of Filip's 18 steals have come over Duke's last seven games, including a career-high four vs. Xavier and three vs. both Ohio State and UMES.

DUKE GAME NOTES

Sellout Streak at Cameron Indoor Nearing 500 Games

- » Duke has sold out 497 consecutive games at Cameron Indoor Stadium. The last time Duke did not have a sellout at home was on Nov. 16, 1990, against Boston College.
- » The sellout figure is the longest current streak (by time) in either men's college basketball or the NBA.
- » Duke's record at Cameron during the sellout streak is 451-46.

The Blue Devils Have Won Nearly 85% of Games at Cameron Indoor Stadium

- » Duke has posted an all-time record of 937-171 (.846) at Cameron Indoor, that included a 572-76 (.883) record under Coach K.
- » Duke has won more games at its current home venue than any team in college basketball.
- » Now in its 84th season as the home of the Blue Devils, Duke has averaged 11.1 wins since the venue opened January 6, 1940 -- a 36-27 win over Princeton.
- » The Blue Devils have 18 undefeated home seasons.

Roach Shinning In Bright Lights

- » Junior captain **Jeremy Roach** has been at his best in big moments, with both of his 20-point scoring efforts this season coming in wins over Iowa (22) at Madison Square Garden and Xavier (21) in Portland's Moda Center. Roach's 12.8 points per game average this season would be a career best, but the guard has upped his average to 13.5 points in games versus power conference teams, including the 20-point games, 16 vs. Kansas, 14 vs. Purdue and 13 vs. Oregon State.
- » Carrying the momentum from his emergence in leading Duke to last year's Final Four, Roach was named to the NCAA West Region All-Tournament Team after averaging 11.8 points in five NCAA Tournament games -- up from his 8.6 season scoring average.
- » Roach, who missed the UMES game with a toe injury, enters the FSU game two points shy of his 700th career point.
- » In his career, Duke is 7-0 when Roach hits three or more three-point field goals in a game (2-0 this season).

Blue Devils Out-Dunking Teams 45-18

- » Duke has opened the season out-dunking the opposition 45-18, led by **Dereck Lively II**'s 18 and **Mark Mitchell**'s 15 slams.
- » Lively is 21-of-35 from the field to start the year with 18 of his first 21 career field goals being dunks.

Duke's Three-Point Streak

- » Duke has connected on at least one three-pointer in 1,166 straight games, the second-longest streak nationally.
- » It has been more than 30 years since Duke was held without a three-point field goal -- Dec. 30, 1989, versus Hawai'i.

Aussie Proctor Coming On

- » Freshman guard **Tyrese Proctor** was originally committed to Duke's 2023 class, but made the decision to reclassify for this season in June 2022.
- » The five-star guard, who hails from Sydney, Australia, is one of 14 known foreign-born Blue Devils, including one of three from Australia (**Jack White**, who played from 2016-20, and **Kyrie Irving**, who played in 2011).
- » Over his last six games, Proctor is averaging 11.0 points and shooting .449 from the field, .304 from three-point range and has led Duke twice in scoring in that span (vs. Purdue 16; vs. UMES, 15). Proctor's first seven games, he averaged 5.4 points, and shot .245 from the field and .179 from three-point range.
- » The freshman is Duke's best free throw shooter this season, hitting 24-of-27 (.889), including a streak of 17 consecutive snapped vs. Iowa.
- » Proctor became Duke's first Aussie-born player to post a double-double with 13 points, 10 rebounds and four assists vs. Delaware

Five on Preseason Positional Awards: Duke Lone Program with Player on Each

- » The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame has announced its preseason watch lists for national positional awards, with five Blue Devils earning recognition:
 - Jeremy Roach** -- Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year
 - Tyrese Proctor** -- Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year
 - Dariq Whitehead** -- Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year
 - Kyle Filipowski** -- Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year
 - Dereck Lively II** -- Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year
- » Duke was the only team nationally to have at least one player on each of the five positional lists.
- » Last season, **Wendell Moore Jr.**, was named the winner of the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year award.

Current Freshman Class Ranked No. 1 Nationally; Next Year's Class Ranked No. 2 -- Duke's Ninth and 10th Consecutive Top-3 Class

- » In the first class recruited and signed by Scheyer, Duke's freshman class was ranked No. 1 in ESPN's 2022-23 class rankings.
- » Duke announced the signing of Scheyer's second class this week, which is on pace to finish No. 2 in ESPN's 2023-24 class rankings.
- » The current class is led by ESPN's overall top two players -- **Dereck Lively II** and **Dariq Whitehead** and was boosted even more when five-star guard **Tyrese Proctor** reclassified.
- » The class includes three McDonald's All-Americans (Lively, Mitchell, Whitehead), three named the Gatorade Player of the Year in their state (Lively, Schutt, Whitehead) and three that participated in the Jordan Brand All-Star Game (Filipowski, Lively, Whitehead).
- » Next season's five-man class has each of the five ranked in 247Sports' top 25, with four in the top 20, led by the No. 5 overall player in forward **Mackenzie Mgbako** (pronounced "em-BAH-ko"). Three of the signees are ranked as the overall No. 1 player in their respective state - forward **Sean Stewart** (Florida), **Caleb Foster** (California) and **TJ Power** (Massachusetts).
