Syracuse Flies to Florida State

The Orange seek a second consecutive ACC road-game triumph when the squad plays at Florida State on Feb. 8.

The Syracuse-Florida State Series

- ✓ Syracuse owns a 9-6 advantage in the all-time series with Florida State.
- ✓ Florida has captured five of the last eight meetings with the Orange.
- ✓ In the most recent encounter between the two rivals, Syracuse defeated Florida State, 96-57, in last March's ACC Tournament.

Syracuse Notes

- ✓ The Orange stopped a three-game losing streak by winning at Boston College on Feb. 4, 77-68.
- ✓ Senior center **Jesse Edwards** topped 20 points for the fourth time this season by contributing 27 against the Eagles.
- ✓ Freshman guard **Judah Mintz** leads the ACC in steals average (2.1 spg.).
- ✓ Syracuse's starting backcourt of senior **Joseph Girard III** and **Mintz** rank third in ACC pairings in scoring average (34.02).

Florida State Notes

- ✓ The Seminoles won at Louisville on Feb. 4, 81-78.
- ✓ After beginning the campaign by losing nine of its first 10, FSU has evenly split the last 14 outings.
- ✓ Sophomore guard **Matthew Cleveland** leads FSU in scoring (14.2 ppg.) and rebounding (7.7 rpg.) averages.
- ✓ Junior guard **Darin Green, Jr.** ranks second in scoring (14.0 rpg.).

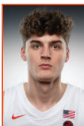

- ✓ **Judah Mintz** had a game-high 20 points and **Jesse Edwards** contributed 14 points and seven rebounds.
- ✓ **Jan. 28:** Virginia Tech hit 11 of its 13 3-pointers in the first half and went on to defeat Syracuse, 85-70.
- ✓ **Judah Mintz** led the Orange with 21 points, **Justin Taylor** had 12 and **Malik Brown** contributed 11 points and six rebounds in his first career start.
- ✓ **Jan. 24:** North Carolina scored the last six points of the game to secure a 72-68 victory against Syracuse.
- ✓ **Joseph Girard III** had 18 points, **Judah Mintz** 17 and **Chris Bell** 15 for the Orange.
- ✓ **Jan. 21:** Syracuse used a 17-0, first-half run to build an unsurmountable margin and the result was an 80-63 win at Georgia Tech.
- ✓ **Joseph Girard III** had a game-high 28 points and seven assists. **Malik Brown** added a season-best 18 points.
- ✓ **Jan. 17:** The Orange battled #17/16 Miami to the wire before losing, 82-78. SU led by 11 in the second half but could not hold on.
- ✓ **Jesse Edwards** had a career-high 25 points and added 11 rebounds. **Joseph Girard III** contributed 21 points.

- ✓ **Jan. 14:** Syracuse rallied from a 12-point, second-half deficit to defeat Notre Dame, 78-73. **Judah Mintz** scored seven of his 14 points in the last seven minutes.
- ✓ **Chris Bell** had a career-best 17 points and **Jesse Edwards** totaled 13 points and 15 rebounds. **Malik Brown** added a season-high 15 points and seven rebounds.
- ✓ **Jan. 11:** **Joseph Girard III** (24 points) led five players in double digits and the Orange defeated Virginia Tech, 82-72.
- ✓ **Malik Brown** posted his first collegiate double-double (11 points, career-high 12 rebounds) and **Jesse Edwards** totaled 13 points, nine rebounds and six assists.

Boeheim, Pearl First Two Men's Basketball Stars on Ring Of Honor

Jim Boeheim and Dwayne "Pearl" Washington -- two of the most prominent names in Syracuse history -- were formally recognized as members of the Syracuse University Athletics Ring of Honor in the JMA Wireless Dome on Dec. 10. The ceremony was held at halftime of the Georgetown game..

Boeheim has been associated with the Syracuse program since enrolling at the school in 1962. He began as a walk-on player and by his senior season he was a captain on an NCAA Tournament team.

Boeheim's coaching career started at his alma mater, as a graduate assistant coach for Roy Danforth in 1969. Boeheim was promoted to an assistant coach and in 1976 was hired to be the head coach.

Boeheim is in his 47th season at the Orange helm. He is the winningest active coach in Division I. Boeheim also ranks second in NCAA Tournament appearances (35 seasons) and 20-win seasons (34) and is fourth in NCAA Tournament victories (57).

He has guided the Orange into the NCAA Final Four five times and led Syracuse to the 2003 NCAA Championship.

In 2005, Boeheim was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and received the John R. Wooden "Legends of Coaching" Award the following April.

2003 NCAA CHAMPIONS

A standout point guard on three of head coach Jim Boeheim's teams of the mid-1980s, Washington established a lasting legacy during a collegiate career in which he tallied 1,490 career points, a total that still ranks 27th on the school's list. He led the Orange in assists and steal in all three of his seasons and ranks fourth in career assists and fifth in career steals.

He helped the Orange earn NCAA Tournament berths each year. Washington received All-America recognition in all three seasons. He was a consensus All-America following his third year, which included second team United Press International and third team Association Press laurels. He was named first team All-BIG EAST Conference three times and was the 1984 BIG EAST Freshman of the Year. He earned BIG EAST Conference Tournament Most Valuable Player in 1986.

After foregoing his final collegiate year of eligibility to enter the NBA Draft, Washington was the 13th overall selection by the New Jersey Nets. Following two campaigns with the Nets, he was selected by Miami in the 1988 Expansion Draft and spent one season with the Heat.

On March 2, 1996, Washington's jersey was retired in a ceremony at the Dome. He was the third Syracuse player to receive the honor, following Dave Bing and Vic Hanson. Washington passed away in April 2016.

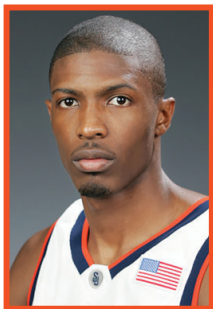

McNamara, Warrick To Have Jerseys Retired

Gerry McNamara and Hakim Warrick, two of the key players on Syracuse's 2003 NCAA Championship squad, are scheduled to have their jerseys retired at the JMA Wireless Dome on Saturday, March 4, 2023. A ceremony will be conducted at the Syracuse vs. Wake Forest game that closes out the Orange basketball regular season.

McNamara and Warrick currently sit next to each other on the Syracuse career points list, at fourth (2,099) and fifth (2,073). They represent two of the six Syracuse players who accumulated 2,000 points in their collegiate careers.

Warrick arrive at Syracuse one year before McNamara, in 2001. By the time his four seasons were up, Warrick had taken over the fourth spot in career rebounds (1,025) with the Orange. Some of his Warrick's other career highlights included:

McNamara joined the program in Warrick's sophomore season, 2002-03. He was an immediate starter on the team that won the 2003 NCAA Championship. McNamara played on four NCAA Tournament clubs at Syracuse. He is the all-time leader in season (107) and career (400) 3-point field goals, and career minutes played (4,799).

Warrick was selected 19th overall in the 2005 NBA Draft by Memphis. He spent four years with The Grizzlies before NBA stops with Milwaukee, Chicago, Phoenix, New Orleans and Charlotte.

McNamara played professionally in what is now the NBA G-League and overseas. He went to training camp with the Utah Jazz in 2008 but was the final player released. He opted to pursue a coaching career and was reunited with the Syracuse program.

The former teammates are now colleagues in the coaching ranks. McNamara is a long-time assistant coach on Jim Boeheim's Syracuse staff, while Warrick is a first-year assist to former Orange standout Jason Hart with the NBA G-League Ignite.

Syracuse's national championship team had a remarkable run. Unranked in the preseason, the Orange ended the campaign with a 30-5 overall record and an 81-78 victory in the title matchup with Kansas. The roster featured an interesting blend of players, including senior captain Kueth Duany, sophomore frontcourt standouts Craig Forth and Hakim Warrick, and dynamic freshmen Carmelo Anthony and Gerry McNamara. Junior center Jeremy McNeil and sophomore swingman Josh Pace emerged as key contributors off the bench.

2003 NCAA CHAMPIONS

51st Annual Hardwood Club Banquet Honors Hakim Warrick

The 51st annual Syracuse University Men's Basketball Hardwood Banquet, presented by Printing & Promotional Solutions, is scheduled for Sunday, March 5 at the OnCenter in Syracuse.

The Vic Hanson Medal of Excellence will be awarded to Hakim Warrick '05, who played on Syracuse's 2003 NCAA Championship team and went on to play in the NBA. The honor is bestowed on an individual or individuals who have ties to the men's basketball program and have made outstanding contributions to college basketball.

Warrick was a four-year starter at Syracuse. He is one of just six players who surpassed 2,000 career points and he still ranks fifth at Syracuse with 2,073 to his credit. Warrick led the Orange in scoring and rebounding average in 2003-04 (19.8 ppg., 8.6 rpg.) and 2004-05 (21.4 ppg., 8.6 rpg.).

He earned several BIG EAST Conference honors, starting with the 2002-03 Most Improved Player Award. He was a first-team, All-BIG EAST honoree as a junior and senior and was the conference's 2004-05 Player of the Year. Warrick received the 2004-05 Dave Gavitt Award (tournament MVP) after helping the Orange to the BIG EAST Tournament title.

Warrick was a 2005 NBA first-round pick by the Memphis Grizzlies. He played eight years in the NBA with stops at Memphis, Milwaukee, Chicago, Phoenix, New Orleans and Charlotte.

Hanson also played and coached football at his alma mater. He is the only individual who has been enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the College Football Hall of Fame.

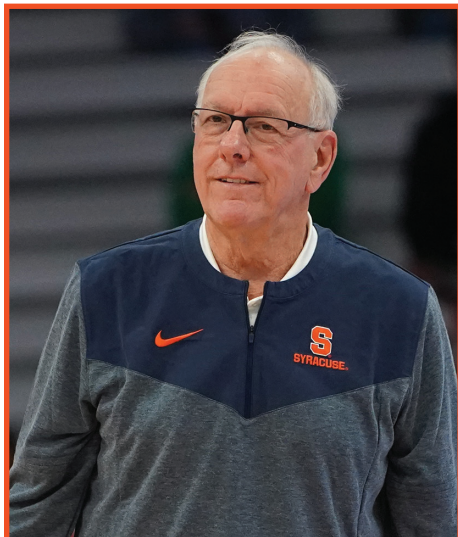

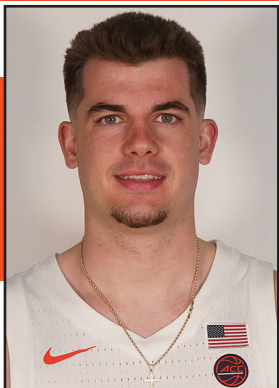
