GAME NOTES

NOLES WIN SEASON SERIES WITH NO. 6 UF

- » No. 17 Florida State beat No. 6 Florida, 14-3 in eight innings, Tuesday at 121 Financial Ballpark in Jacksonville.
- » FSU also beat the Gators 12-8 in Gainesville to secure its first regular-season series win against the Gators since 2015.
- » Tied 3-3 after the first inning, FSU outscored the Gators 11-0 over the final seven innings. The FSU bullpen allowed just one hit in that span.
- » Daniel Cantu and Drew Fautrot combined for five hits, three home runs and 10 RBI in the game.
- » FSU's 14 runs were the Noles most vs. Florida since 2008; the 11-run victory was the largest since 2004.

19-0 START SECOND-BEST IN FSU HISTORY

- » Florida State was the last unbeaten team in the country, pushing its record to 19-0 before a loss at No. 3 Clemson on March 23.
- » The 19-0 start was the second-best in school history (23-0 start in 2007).
- » Dating to last year, FSU was on a 21-game winning streak, tied for the fifth-longest in program history:

EARLY SEASON STREAKING

- » Florida State scored at least 7 runs in the first 16 games of the season, the longest streak in school history (previous high was 12, in March 1986 and March 1996).
- » The Seminoles had at least one player record 3+ hits in the first 16 games of the season.
- » FSU hit a home run in 13 consecutive games, tied for the third-longest streak in program history:

- » Florida State went six consecutive games without an error, tied for the longest error-free streak in school history:

3B CAM SMITH

- » After being named the top pro prospect in the Cape Cod League over the summer, Smith is one of the hottest names for the 2024 MLB Draft.
- » Smith is third in the country with 1.91 hits per game and fifth with 44 hits. He is hitting .444, 10th in the nation.
- » Smith tied a career high with 4 hits against USF (2/27), including his first home run of 2024. His HR was the front end of a back-to-back with James Tibbs III.
- » Smith hit an inside-the-park home run vs. Michigan State (3/2), the first for a Nole since 2011.

- » Smith added three runs against JU, including the go-ahead run in the 9th inning after a leadoff double, FSU's only extra-base hit. FSU scored three runs in the frame to beat the Dolphins, 7-4.
- » Smith scored a season-high 4 runs against FGCU (3/6) and hit his 3rd home run of the year.
- » Smith had a career-high 20-game hitting streak end vs. Notre Dame:

- » His 33-game on-base streak is the longest career streak for any active Seminole.
- » In 2023, Smith hit 12 home runs, the most for a Seminole since 2004. He also added five triples, the first Seminole since Dylan Busby in 2016 with at least five triples and 10 home runs in a season.

3-HIT GAMES

- » Led by Cam Smith's 8, Florida State had at least one batter with 3+ hits in the first 16 games of the season.
- » FSU has had a player earn three hits 31 times this year: Smith, 8 (1 4-hit game); James Tibbs, 5 (1 4-hit game); Drew Fautrot and Daniel Cantu, 4 each; McGwire Holbrook, Marco Dinges and Jaxson West, 2 each; Alex Lodise, 2 (1 4-hit game); and Jaime Ferrer and Max Williams, 1 each.

1-0 WINNERS

- » Florida State beat Stetson, 1-0, on March 19. It was FSU's first 1-0 victory since beating Arkansas in the 2019 College World Series.
- » The Noles already have four shutouts on the season, fourth in the country and most in the ACC.
- » Last season, FSU recorded just one shutout.

NOLES AMONG BEST IN STRIKEOUTS

- » Through six weeks, Florida State is 2nd in the country with 12.8 strikeouts per nine innings.
- » On Opening Day against Butler, FSU struck out 22 Bulldog hitters, the second-most in a 9-inning game in program history and tied for the fourth-most overall:

- » FSU's 22 strikeouts are tied for the second-most in a 9-inning game this season.

BATS EXPLODE vs. FGCU

- » Florida State set season-highs with 18 hits and 4 home runs against FGCU (3/6). FSU beat the Eagles, 19-3, one run shy of the season-high run total (20-7 win vs. Western Carolina).
- » Jaime Ferrer hit a grand slam - the first of his career - and Marco Dinges followed with his first home run as a Seminole.
- » Through 23 games, FSU has five grand slams and three back-to-back home runs. Last year, FSU had just one of each.

GAME NOTES

- » Freshman Andrew Duncan earned his first career hit; freshman Cal Fisher had a career-best two RBI; and freshman Matty Davis earned his second hit of the year.

SP JAMIE ARNOLD

- » Sophomore Jamie Arnold leads the country with a 0.52 ERA, allowing two earned runs in a team-high 34.2 innings.
- » Arnold is 5-0 in 6 starts this season. He earned a no-decision at Clemson after allowing one run with nine strikeouts in 7.0 innings.
- » Arnold is third nationally in wins and seventh with 53 strikeouts. He has a pair of double-digit K games this season - 11 vs. Western Carolina and a career-high 12 vs. Notre Dame.
- » Arnold began the season with 24.1 innings without allowing an earned run.
- » Arnold was named the ACC Pitcher of the Week after his outing against Western Carolina (2/24).
- » He added 6.0 shutout innings vs. Michigan State (3/2).
- » Arnold has faced 14 batters this year with a runner on third base; opponents are 0-for-13 with 6 strikeouts, 6 groundouts, a fly out and an HBP.

STOLEN BASES

- » Through 23 games, Florida State is 31-for-33 on stolen base attempts.
- » FSU had just 31 stolen bases over 54 games in 2023.
- » Florida State had seven stolen bases Sunday against Butler (2/18), its most in a game since 2016.
- » From 2017-2023, FSU's most stolen bases in a game was four. The Noles had at least four stolen bases in their first three games of 2024 and had four in the second inning alone Sunday against Butler.
- » DeAmez Ross and Jordan Williams lead FSU at a perfect 6-for-6 on the basepaths.

OF JAMES TIBBS III

- » James Tibbs III leads FSU with 10 home runs this year, including a pair of grand slams. His 38 RBI also lead the team and his .402 batting average is second.
- » Tibbs hit a pair of home runs in the finale at No. 3 Clemson (3/24), his third multi-HR game of the season.
- » Tibbs is the first Seminole since Mike McGee (2009-11) with 10+ home runs in three straight seasons.
- » Tibbs had multiple home runs in consecutive games against Western Carolina (2/25) and USF (2/27), his second and third career multi-HR games.
- » Before teammate Cam Smith did it last season against NC State and North Florida, the last Seminole with back-to-back multi-HR games was Buster Posey in 2008.
- » Tibbs' 37 career home runs are most on the team and t-26th nationally.

- » Tibbs and Smith hit back-to-back home runs against USF, the second B2B homers for FSU this year.
- » Tibbs hit a grand slam on Opening Day against Butler and against Western Carolina (2/25). Tibbs also set a career-high with 6 RBI against the Catamounts, most for a Nole in 2024.
- » Tibbs tied a career high with 4 hits vs. Illinois (3/2), including a 419' home run.
- » Tibbs drew a season-high 3 walks against FGCU (3/6) and reached safely in FSU's first 18 games this year and 24 straight dating to last year.
- » He hit a double and triple vs. New Orleans (3/8), his second career triple.

RHP CAM LEITER

- » Sophomore Cam Leiter made his Florida State debut on Opening Day, earning the win with 13 strikeouts over 5.0 innings, one hit allowed and two walks.
- » Leiter's 13 strikeouts are the most for a Seminole on Opening Day in over 60 years and tied for the second-most for a Seminole in their FSU debut:

2B DREW FAUROT + SS ALEX LODISE

- » Tallahassee native Drew Fautot was 8-for-11 with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 6 runs scored and 7 RBI against Western Carolina (2/23-25).
- » Fautot is 5th nationally with 13 doubles after hitting a pair at Florida (3/12) and one vs. Stetson (3/19).
- » Fautot is hitting .337 with three home runs after a pair against No. 6 Florida (3/26). He set a career-high with five RBI against the Gators after hitting FSU's fifth grand slam of the season.
- » His 13 doubles are 4 more than his freshman total over 58 games.
- » His single against Michigan State extended his hitting-streak to a career-best 8 games.
- » Fautot set the UCF freshman home run record with 15 in 2023. A Florida High product, Fautot is the son of Adam Fautot, an FSU baseball player from 1995-96.
- » Alex Lodise hit a home run in three consecutive games (WMU, FGCU, UNO) and is hitting .268.
- » Lodise set a season high with four hits, three runs and three RBI vs. New Orleans (3/8). He had three hits and a pair of runs against FGCU (3/6).
- » Like Fautot, Lodise also set the freshman HR record at his last school, hitting 16 at North Florida last year.
- » Lodise tied a career-high with 3 RBI at Florida (3/12). Lodise added his fifth HR of the year at Clemson (3/24).
- » Lodise and Fautot have started all 23 games up the middle for the Noles in 2024.

1B DANIEL CANTU

- » Redshirt senior Daniel Cantu has started all 23 games at first base. He is hitting .388 and is 3rd on the team with a .485 on-base percentage.
- » Against Florida this season, Cantu is 6-for-7 with three doubles, a home run, three walks and seven RBI.
- » Cantu tied a career high with 5 RBI vs. No. 6 Florida (3/26), including his second HR of the year. He added a pair of doubles in FSU's 14-3 win.
- » Cantu was 3-for-3 with 2 walks at Florida (3/12), his second 3-hit game at FSU.
- » Cantu scored 3 runs vs. New Orleans.

OF JAIME FERRER

- » Jaime Ferrer is second on the team with nine home runs after hitting a bomb in four straight games (WMU, FGCU, UNO 2x).
- » He added two home runs in the doubleheader at No. 3 Clemson (3/23), including his second grand slam of the year. His three hits in game two against the Tigers were a season high.
- » Ferrer has 25 career home runs. He has reached base safely in all 23 games this season and 29 straight dating to last year, a career high.
- » Three players had four-game HR stretches in 2021 (Mat Nelson, Logan Lacey, Elijah Cabell). Before that, no Seminole had done it since 2015.
- » Ferrer hit his first career grand slam against FGCU (3/6). His 5 RBI against the Eagles was a career high.
- » Ferrer hit .324 with a team-high 22 doubles and 73 hits in 2023. He had a 20-game hitting streak from March 4 to April 6 last season, FSU's longest since 2011 and the 17th-longest in program history.
- » Ferrer has started all 133 games in his Seminole career.

OF DeAMEZ ROSS

- » DeAmez Ross is hitting .298 this year. He is reaching base at a .405 rate and already has six sacrifices (two sac bunts, four sac flies).
- » Ross' 22-game on-base streak ended vs. New Orleans (3/8), but he did have two sac flies in the game.
- » Ross was 4-for-8 with five runs scored and an RBI against Butler opening weekend.
- » Ross' three runs on Opening Day vs. Butler tied a career high. He also scored three runs against Illinois (3/2) and FGCU (3/6).
- » Ross hit his second career triple and first of the season against USF (2/27).
- » Ross drew three walks against Illinois and reached safely in 5 of 6 plate appearances (2-for-3 batting).
- » Ross had a 15-game hitting streak end against Western Carolina, the 7th-longest streak at FSU over the last 10 seasons.

PLATOON AT CATCHER

- » McGwire Holbrook had his best game as a Seminole against Butler (2/18), finishing 3-for-3 with a two-run double and three-run home run.
- » His home run was the eighth of his career and his first as a Seminole; his three runs and five RBI were career-bests.
- » Holbrook added his second 3-hit game of the year against Michigan State (3/2).

- » Alabama transfer Jaxson West has started 11 games and is hitting .368 (14-for-38) with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 12 RBI and 16 runs.
- » West hit a two-out, three-run double in the first inning against USF (2/27). His 3 RBI were a career high and his 6 RBI on the year top his output from 20 games at Alabama.
- » West added another 3-run double to break a 7-7 tie vs. Illinois (3/2).
- » West has thrown out two base-runners on the season; opponents are 5-for-7 on the basepaths vs. FSU this year.

SP CONNER WHITTAKER

- » Junior Conner Whittaker got the starting call for FSU's first three midweek games. He is 3-0 with a 4.97 ERA.
- » Against FGCU (3/6), Whittaker allowed home runs to the first two batters of the game before retiring 15 consecutive hitters. The Noles beat the Eagles, 19-3.
- » Whittaker tied a career-high with 9 strikeouts against the Eagles.
- » He allowed 2 runs and struck out 8 batters in 6.0 innings against USF (2/27).
- » Making his first weekend start of the year, Whittaker improved to 3-0 with a victory against Notre Dame.

WILLIAMS, DINGES SHINE WHEN CALLED

- » DH Marco Dinges is hitting .294 with six home runs over 19 starts. He hit two home runs at No. 3 Clemson (3/23-24).
- » A transfer from Tallahassee CC, Dinges hit three homers vs. FGCU (3/6) and New Orleans (3/8 & 3/10). He added a fourth against Notre Dame.
- » Dinges was 2-for-4 with a solo home run, an RBI single and two sacrifice flies against FGCU. He entered the game with 3 RBI on the season and the HR was his first as a Nole.
- » Dinges leads the nation with 6 sacrifice flies on the season. He had a 10-game hitting streak end against the Irish.
- » OF Max Williams leads FSU with three triples. He hit a home run in his first at-bat as a Seminole vs. Butler on Opening Day and another at No. 3 Clemson (3/23).
- » Williams hit an RBI triple vs. Western Michigan (3/3) to give FSU the lead, one of his career-high 3 hits. He scored a career-high 3 runs vs. Illinois (3/2).
- » Williams is 14th nationally in triples.

MORE PITCHING NOTES

- » Andrew Armstrong is 2-0 with wins against Western Michigan (3/3) and New Orleans (3/9). He has a 19-3 K-to-BB ratio.
- » All four of Florida State's pitchers on Opening Day against Butler were making their Florida State debut, including three arms out of the bullpen: Carson Dorsey, Hudson Rowan and Matt Sauser.
- » Led by Dorsey's five strikeouts in 2.0 innings, the trio combined to allow just three hits and two walks with nine strikeouts in 4.0 innings.
- » Rowan has 15 strikeouts in just 7.1 innings pitched; he struck out the side in his only inning vs. FGCU (3/6).
- » Rowan also struck out the side at No. 8 Florida (3/12) in his only inning of work.
- » Brady Louck (vs. Stetson) and Matt Sauser (vs. Western Michigan) are the only freshmen - pitchers or position players - to start for FSU this year.

- » Redshirt junior Connor Hults, redshirt senior Noah Short and Louck also made their FSU debuts against Butler (2/18).
- » Hults is a transfer from the State College of Florida after pitching two years at Jacksonville; Short pitched four seasons at West Virginia, setting the Mountaineers all-time appearance record for a pitcher, with 76.
- » Short earned his first win as a Seminole against Western Carolina (2/25).
- » All four of Louck's outs at No. 8 Florida (3/12) were via strikeout.
- » Ben Barrett has thrown 3.0+ innings in all 3 appearances this year.
- » Barrett's save against USF was the first of his career; he earned his first career win vs. Illinois, with 3.2 shutout innings to end the game.
- » Yoel Tejada Jr. struck out 2 in 2.0 innings against FGCU (3/6) in his first relief outing at FSU.
- » Brennen Oxford set career highs with 4.0 innings pitched and 6 strikeouts against Western Michigan (3/3).

- Jarrett was named the 2009 Conference USA Assistant Coach of the Year when the Pirates led the country with 814 hits and were top 20 in runs, doubles, home runs, slugging percentage and batting average.
