TALLAHASSEE, Fla. - In a matchup between two of the top five teams in the ACC standings, the No. 4 Florida State baseball team hosts Wake Forest from April 4-6 at Dick Howser Stadium in Tallahassee, Florida.

The series begins on the ACC Network on Friday, April 4, at 8 p.m. ET, followed by a 4 p.m. contest on Saturday, April 5. Sunday's finale is at 1 p.m.

Tickets are available for Sunday's game at Seminoles.com/Tickets or by calling the FSU ticket office at 850-644-1830. Friday and Saturday are sold out, but fans can purchase tickets on SeatGeek. Limited tickets for FSU students remain available, and admission is free for FSU students with their I.D. at the Haggard Plaza right field gate.

Friday is a whiteout, and fans are encouraged to wear white to cheer on the Seminoles. There will be an FSU shirt giveaway for early-arriving fans. Saturday is the team's Military Appreciation Game. Sunday is First Responders Day, where first responders can receive discounted tickets by contacting the FSU ticket office. Additionally, at every Sunday regular-season home game in 2025, Kids Club members and youth wearing their little league jerseys will be admitted free, and kids 12 and under will be allowed to run the bases postgame.

A trio of Florida State left-handers will face three Wake Forest rightys this weekend. Two junior square off in the opener, with FSU's Jamie Arnold (3-1, 3.07 ERA) against WF's Luke Schmolke (3-0, 2.14 ERA). Saturday will see the Seminoles' redshirt junior Joey Volini (7-0, 1.25 ERA) toe the rubber against the Demon Deacons' junior Logan Lunceford (4-2, 4.36 ERA). The finale will see two sophomores get the ball, in Florida State's Wes Mendes (4-0, 2.83 ERA) against Wake Forest's Blake Morningstar (3-0, 2.29 ERA).

Florida State is 24-4 overall, 17-2 at home, 6-2 on the road and 1-0 at a neutral site. FSU leads the ACC with a 7-2 record, its best since a 7-1 start in 2016. The team has won its first three ACC series for the first time since 2022, with two road series wins in the first three not coming since 2012. The Seminoles have won three in a row and five of their last six, including an 11-10 victory on Tuesday vs. Jacksonville.



GAME NOTES

NATIONALLY-RANKED SEMINOLES

The Seminoles are ranked in the top six in every major poll for a fifth consecutive week, including at No. 4 in the D1Baseball top-25. They also are No. 4 in the NCBWA and Coaches polls and No. 6 according to Baseball America, Perfect Game and The Athletic. College Baseball Central has FSU at No. 4.

NOLES BY THE NUMBERS

- » FSU has scored 252 runs on 328 hits with a .331 batting average, 58 home runs, 125 walks and 37 stolen bases. The pitching staff owns a 3.92 ERA with 105 earned runs allowed in 241.0 innings with 185 hits, 315 strikeouts and 121 walks.
- » Junior infielder Alex Lodise leads the team with a .463 batting average, 56 hits, 37 RBI, 10 doubles and 103 total bases and is second with 11 home runs. Junior outfielder Max Williams paces the squad with 14 home runs and is second with 33 RBI. Junior outfielder Gage Harrelson has nine stolen bases and is second with a .378 average and 45 hits.
- » On the mound, junior lefty Joey Volini is 7-0 with a 1.25 ERA, 63 strikeouts and nine walks in 43.1 innings. Among relievers, sophomore righty Chris Knier has a 2.25 ERA with 20 strikeouts and four runs on 10 hits in 16.0 innings.

LAST TIME OUT: DH SWEEP FOR SERIES WIN

- » Florida State erased two early-inning deficits to beat Jacksonville 11-10 on Tuesday night. In their return home after a season-long seven game roadtrip, the Seminoles rallied from down 5-0 in the first inning to lead 6-5 after two. The Dolphins answered to retake a 7-6 advantage, but FSU responded right back with a three-run fourth and added two in the seventh before halting a two-run comeback attempt in the ninth.
- » Williams hit two home runs and redshirt freshman designated hitter James Hankerson Jr. homered for the second time in as many games, the first two blasts of his career while making his first two starts. With the victory, Florida State improves to 137-42 all-time against Jacksonville. FSU has won six in a row in the in-state series and two this year with one more meeting set for May 6 at Howser.

SCOUTING THE DEMON DEACONS

- » Wake Forest is 21-9 on the season, 16-5 at home, 4-4 on the road and 1-0 at a neutral site. The Demon Deacons are 7-5 and tied for fourth in the ACC after a trio of losses at home to Virginia Tech. WF opened ACC play with sweeps of Notre Dame and Miami before a series loss at No. 7 Clemson and the sweep by Virginia Tech. With a 2-2 record against top-25 opponents, Wake Forest comes to Tallahassee after a 13-1 win over High Point on Tuesday night.
- » The Demon Deacons are ranked No. 18 in the latest Baseball America rankings, No. 23 in the Coaches Poll and No. 24 according to Perfect Game.
- » Kade Lewis leads the team with a .447 batting average, 46 hits and 10 home runs. Marek Houston also has 10 homers and boasts 43 RBI with 45 hits. Chris Levonas owns a 2.03 ERA in five starts and 13.1 innings, while Logan Lunceford's 58 strikeouts paces the team.

SERIES HISTORY VS. WAKE FOREST

- » Florida State is 97-38 all-time against Wake Forest, including 51-16 at home, 32-16 in Winston-Salem and 14-6 at a neutral site. The two teams met four times in 2024, with WF taking two-of-three in Winston-Salem before FSU notched a 9-6 win in the ACC Championship. The series is an even 5-5 since 2022, with neither team winning more than two in a row.
- » Last year from April 19-20, FSU suffered a 5-4 loss in the opener, as WF erased a 3-1 deficit with the help of two in the eighth. Williams had three hits to highlight Florida State's current players in the contest. It was a doubleheader the next day that began with a 10-9, walk-off loss. The Seminoles won the nightcap 9-6 behind a three-run ninth inning. Lodise had three hits, an RBI and two runs scored in the victory and Connor Hults picked up the win. On May 25, a 9-6 win sent Florida State to the ACC Championship Game as the Garnet and Gold erased a 3-0 deficit. Williams had another three hits and four RBI and Drew Faurot notched two hits and two RBI while John Abraham earned the win with 2.0 scoreless innings in relief.

LODISE, VOLINI EARN ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

- » SS Alex Lodise and LHP Joey Volini were named the ACC Player and Pitcher of the Week on March 31.
- » Lodise also was named Perfect Game's National Player of the Week and the Brooks Wallace Award Player of the Week by the College Baseball Foundation.
- » The duo are FSU's first ACC weekly award recipients in 2025, and they both receive the weekly honor for the first time in their careers.
- » The Seminoles are the first team to sweep the weekly awards since the 2023 season, and they earn the ACC sweep for the first time as a program since 2011.
- » In four games from March 25-30, Lodise hit .500 (10-for-20) with 10 hits, eight RBI, four home runs and a 1.300 slugging percentage. He hit for his first career cycle, and FSU's first since 2019, on March 25 against Florida in Jacksonville with a walk-off grand slam to complete the feat in the 8-4 win. At Notre Dame from March 28-30, Lodise hit three more home runs and notched four RBI on six hits.
- » Volini threw his second consecutive seven-inning complete game in FSU's 4-2 win at Notre Dame on Sunday. He struck out a career-high-tying seven batters and held ND to two runs on four hits with two walks.
- » Lodise was named to the All-ACC Academic Team and the ACC Academic Honor Roll last season. This is his second career Player of the Week award, after he also collected ASUN Player of the Week accolades as a freshman in 2023 at North Florida. In his first season at Florida State, Volini earned his first weekly honor in any conference.

MIDSEASON AWARDS AND RECOGNITION

- * Midseason stats listed thru 27 games on March 31
- » LHP Jamie Arnold, LHP Wes Mendes and LHP Joey Volini were named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List on April 3.
 - » SS Alex Lodise was named the Midseason Player of the Year by Perfect Game and the Midseason Top Player by D1Baseball on April 2. He earned Midseason First Team All-America honors from both outlets. Lodise also was tabbed the No. 3-ranked shortstop by D1Baseball after starting the year at No. 27.
 - » Lodise led the NCAA with 54 hits and 101 total bases, and was 4th with a .466 avg., 7th with a .871 slugging pct. and 22nd with 11 home runs.
 - » Volini earned Midseason First Team All-America distinction by D1Baseball and Perfect Game. He moved up to No. 10, from No. 48 in the preseason, on D1Baseball's list of top starters.
 - » In 43.1 innings, Volini led the country with seven wins and was top-25 in complete games (2nd, 2), ERA (4th, 1.25), WHIP (6th, 0.81), strikeouts (7th, 63), strikeout-to-walk ratio (17th, 7.00) and strikeouts per nine innings (23rd, 13.08).
 - » Volini is 7-0 in seven starts in 2025. He is FSU's first starter to achieve that feat since Michael Hyde went 8-0 in eight starts in 2008.
 - » Arnold collected Midseason Second Team All-America accolades by PG and is No. 3 on D1Baseball's midseason starting pitchers list.
 - » Arnold is 3-1 with a 3.07 ERA, 38 strikeouts, 11 walks and 10 earned runs on 19 hits in 29.1 inn.
 - » RF Max Williams moved up to 16, from 29 in the preseason, on D1Baseball's outfielders rankings.
 - » RHP Maison Martinez entered D1Baseball's list of top relief pitchers at No. 25 after being unranked to start the season.
 - » Mendes is 4-0 with a 2.83 ERA, 52 strikeouts, 13 walks and 11 earned runs on 26 hits in 35.0 inn.

SUCCESSFUL ACC SERIES

- » Florida State is 7-2 in the ACC with three series wins, including two on the road.
- » FSU has won its first three ACC series for the first time since 2022, and will look to win four in a row for the first time since 2015 and 2016.
- » The Seminoles' 7-2 record is their best since a 7-1 start in 2016 and a 7-2 mark in 2015.
- » The 2016 ACC season began with a 3-0 sweep of Georgia Tech, a 2-1 series win at Pitt, 1-0 weekends vs. NC State and at Boston College and a 2-1 series vs. Louisville.
- » 2015 opened with a 3-0 sweep of Boston College and 2-1 series wins vs. Wake Forest, at Virginia and vs. Virginia Tech.
- » The last time FSU was 7-2 or better to start an ACC season with two road weekends was a 8-1 start to 2012, with 3-0 sweeps at Duke and vs. Virginia before a 2-1 series at Wake Forest.

HOT START FOR THE RECORD BOOK

- » Florida State opened the season 15-0, tied for the fourth-longest season-opening win streak in team history. The Seminoles were one of two unbeaten teams left in the country before they suffered their first loss.
- » For the first time in program history, FSU started back-to-back seasons at 13-0 or better, with this year's 15-0 start going along with 2024's 19-0 open. Florida State had two back-to-back years of 12-0 starts or better before the current two-year run eclipsed that, in 2007-08 and 2018-19.
- » Florida State was 15-0 for the fifth time in school history. The record start is 23-0 to begin to the 2007 campaign, followed by last year's 19-0. The 2013 team opened on a 16-0 run while the 1975 club's 15-0 mark was matched.

A GRAND, WALK-OFF CYCLE

- » SS Alex Lodise hit a walk-off grand slam to beat Florida on March 25 in Jacksonville, 8-4. The grand slam completed the cycle for Lodise, who doubled in the first, singled in the third and tripled in the seventh.
- » Lodise is believed to be the first player in baseball history at at least the collegiate or professional level to complete a cycle with a walk-off grand slam.
- » It was FSU's first walk-off homer since 2022 and the first walk-off win against Florida since 2015.
- » Lodise registered the 10th cycle in Florida State history and the first since 2019.

GAME NOTES

STEALING BASES

- » FSU stole eight bases on February 16 against James Madison, the most since also swiping eight bags against LeMoyné on May 2, 2010.
- » Prior to this year, Florida State had seven steals last year against Butler on February 18.
- » From 2017-2023, FSU's most stolen bases in a game was four.
- » The record in a single game is 11, achieved three times (1957, 1986, 1994), and the Seminoles have stolen 10 bases seven times and nine seven times, most recently on April 2, 2008 against Jacksonville.
- » Florida State was 68-for-78 on stolen base attempts in 2024 after just 31 steals in 2023.

SIX PRO NOLES SET FOR MLB SEASON

- » Six former Florida State players have been named to their respective teams' Opening Day rosters: Tyler Holton with the Tigers, Cal Raleigh with the Mariners, Cole Sands with the Twins, Cam Smith with the Astros, Taylor Walls with the Rays and Luke Weaver with the Yankees. Additionally, Kevin Cash returns as the manager of the Tampa Bay Rays.
- » Smith makes his major league debut with the Astros 284 days after his final game as a Seminole, on June 16, 2024, at the College World Series. He is the third-quickest position player to make it from the minors to an MLB Opening Day Roster and the 19th to do it with fewer than 100 games played in the minors. Smith is the 81st MLB player in FSU history.

ACC WEEK 3: DH SWEEP FOR SERIES WIN

- » FSU secured its third series win in ACC play and has won all seven series to begin the 2025 campaign after two victories at Notre Dame from March 28-30. The Seminoles dropped the opener before taking both games of a doubleheader two days later.
- » The series began with a 16-9 loss on March 28. The Seminoles scored nine runs on 13 hits with two errors while the Fighting Irish scored 16 runs on 15 hits with one error. Florida State hit six home runs in the defeat, the third consecutive ACC series opener FSU hit four or more and tied for the most on the season along with a similar six-homer outburst at Miami.
- » Rain forced a doubleheader on Sunday, and Volini threw his second consecutive seven-inning complete game in a 4-2 win in the opener. In seven innings, he allowed just two runs on four hits with a career-high-tying 11 strikeouts. Volini improved to 7-0 in seven starts this season and is the first Seminole starter to achieve the feat since Michael Hyde posted an 8-0 start in his first eight games in 2008. Harrelson hit his third home run of the season for a seventh-inning insurance run as part of a one-hit, two-RBI day.
- » In the finale, FSU completed the doubleheader sweep with a 17-9 victory, aided by five home runs, including the first career long ball for redshirt freshman designated hitter James Hankerson Jr. FSU scored five in the first, seven in the second and two in the third to highlight the offensive showing. Along with his first home run, Hankerson Jr. had two hits, six RBI and three runs scored, all collegiate bests. He entered the day with one career hit in five at-bats. A trio of juniors also homered, as Lodise hit two and third baseman Carter McCulley and Williams hit one in the win. Knier earned his first career win and did not allow a run on two hits with a strikeout and a walk in 1.2 innings.

ACC WEEK 2: RIVALRY WEEKEND WIN

- » The Seminoles earned a series win at Miami from March 20-22, the team's sixth consecutive series win to begin the year. It was their second in ACC play and their first overall on the road. FSU improved to 164-137-4 all-time against Miami, with a 5-1 record in the last two years.
- » A complete game by LHP Joey Volini and a team-high six home runs powered FSU to a 14-1 win a seven-inning opener on Thursday night. SS Alex Lodise and C Hunter Carns both hit two home runs as Volini turned in Florida State's first complete game of any length since 2018. He allowed one run, a solo homer to lead off the third, on just two hits, with nine strikeouts and one walk with 79 pitches thrown. Lodise's two homers were part of a four-hit, five RBI day.
- » FSU's late rally came up short in a 9-6 loss on Friday night. The Seminoles scored four runs on seven hits in the final two innings and sent the tying run to the plate in the ninth with one out, but it was not enough. The late scores came after UM led 4-2 after three innings and 8-2 after five. It was the team's first conference loss in 2025, and they were the last ACC team to drop a game in league play. It also was FSU's first loss away from home and first weekend defeat. Florida State lost for the first time when scoring first and scoring in the first inning.
- » In Saturday night's finale, a seven-run fourth inning and 5.0 shutout innings by relievers helped Florida State to a series-clinching, 10-6 victory. A seven-run fourth inning turned a 3-2 deficit into a 9-3 lead, and the bullpen, led by RHP Peyton Prescott, gave up just two hits with eight strikeouts in the final 5.0 innings to secure the win. In a season-long 4.0 innings, Prescott allowed just two hits with a season-high seven strikeouts and two walks. RF Gage Harrelson and CF Max Williams both had two hits, three RBIs and a run scored to lead the way. Williams homered in the eighth inning.

ACC WEEK 1: LIGHTS-OUT SWEEP

- » FSU began ACC play with a sweep of Boston College from March 14-15. In three games, Florida State outscored Boston College 28-4 and out-hit the visitors 40-13. The Seminoles hit nine home runs with another nine doubles with 12 walks. FSU's seven pitchers posted a 0.72 ERA with just two earned runs allowed and 35 strikeouts in 25.0 innings.
- » 2B Drew Fautot homered twice and LHP Joey Volini had another strong start as the Seminoles won the opener 8-2 on Friday. SS Alex Lodise and 1B Myles Bailey also hit home runs. In 6.0 innings, Volini gave up a run in 4.2 innings with eight strikeouts and two walks.
- » The teams played a doubleheader on Saturday, beginning with a 14-0 Florida State win. LHP Jamie Arnold had a strong return to the mound as the offense scored multiple runs in five of its six innings. Bailey homered again, as did RF Gage Harrelson, who had four hits and four RBI. Arnold didn't allow a run in 4.2 innings with eight strikeouts and just one hit allowed.
- » The Seminoles completed the sweep with a 6-2 win in Saturday's nightcap. FSU scored three in the first and never looked back, with the help of insurance runs in each of the last three innings. LHP Wes Mendes pitched a career-long 7.0+ innings and did not allow an earned run with eight strikeouts and no walks. CF Max Williams homered twice and had three hits and three RBI. Fautot also hit another home run in the win.

A LOOK BACK ON 2024

NOLES REACH 24th COLLEGE WORLD SERIES

- » For the 24th time in program history - and first since 2019 - Florida State ended the season in the College World Series after sweeping UConn in the Tallahassee Super Regional.
- » FSU opened its week in Omaha with a 12-11 loss to top-ranked Tennessee, followed by a 7-3 win over No. 12 Virginia and a 9-5 victory against No. 4 North Carolina. The team's CWS run ended with a 7-2 loss to Tennessee in the national semifinal.
- » OF Jaime Ferrer and C Jaxson West were named to the CWS All-Tournament Team.

FSU WINS SUPER REGIONAL

- » Florida State swept UConn in the Super Regional, with a 24-2 victory before a 10-8 12-inning win.
- » FSU has won a team-record six straight Super Regional games after sweeping Sam Houston State (2017), LSU (2019) and UConn (2024).
- » In the clincher vs. UConn, OF James Tibbs III hit three home runs, the most by a Nole since 2010.

SEMINOLES SWEEP TALLAHASSEE REGIONAL

- » FSU advanced to its 18th Super Regional - the most all-time - after beating (3) UCF twice and (4) Stetson in the Tallahassee Regional.
- » Starting pitcher Jamie Arnold was the Most Outstanding Player. FSU had seven players on the All-Region Team: Arnold, SP Carson Dorsey, C, Jaxson West, 1B Daniel Cantu, 3B Cam Smith, OF Jaime Ferrer and DH Marco Dinges.

NOLES BACK IN THE POSTSEASON

- » Florida State earned the No. 8 national seed in the NCAA Tournament and hosted a regional for the 36th time in program history.
- » FSU last hosted a regional in 2018, snapping the longest hosting drought in program history.
- » The Seminoles' 207 postseason wins and 60 regional appearances are both second-most all-time, behind only Texas (257 wins, 63 app.).
