## PALADIN POINTS

- Furman will be playing its first road game of the 2021-22 season on Friday evening with a 7 p.m. tipoff against Louisville on ACC Network Extra.
- The Paladins and Cardinals are meeting for the fifth time in program history with Louisville having won each of the past four matchups.
- The teams have not met since the 2002-03 season when Louisville won by a score of 104-63 on November 22, 2002.
- Furman opened its 2021-22 season on Tuesday with a 118-66 victory at home over North Greenville.
- The Paladins eclipsed the 100-point plateau in a season opener for the first time since defeating Bob Jones, 102-48, on November 6, 2018.
- Furman set two school records in the North Greenville victory with 34 assists and 22 3-pointers. The Paladins surpassed the old assist record of 33 against South Carolina State on December 21, 2020 in a 118-52 win. Furman had previously made 21 3-pointers in a game three times with the last coming in the victory over South Carolina State.
- Alex Hunter and Mike Bothwell poured in a game-high 22 points apiece in the North Greenville victory.
- Jalen Slawson scored a career-high 19 points against North Greenville on 8-of-11 shooting.
- Five different Paladins scored in double figures in Hunter, Bothwell, Slawson, Conley Garrison and JP Pegues.

- Playing in their first games at Furman, Garrison and Pegues recorded 14 and 10 points, respectively. Garrison added a game-high six assists and Pegues posted five.
- Marcus Foster grabbed a career-high seven rebounds versus North Greenville.
- In total, the Paladins had 10 players record a point against North Greenville.
- Furman announced its 2022-23 signing class on Tuesday with the additions of Ben VanderWal (Elmurst, Ill.) and Davis Molnar (Fayetteville, N.C.). VanderWal is ranked No. 8 among his recruiting class in Illinois by the Chicago Sun Times entering the 2021-22 season and rated the No. 21 prospect in Illinois by Prep Hoops. Molnar led Terry Sanford High School to a 3A All-American Conference championship as a junior while averaging 16.8 points, 10.8 rebounds, 6.4 assists, 2.4 steals and 1.6 blocks per game.
- Furman is coming off a 2020-21 season in which it posted a 16-9 record and finished third in the Southern Conference with a 10-5 mark. The Paladins spent the entire regular season ranked in the College Inside Mid-Major Top 25, concluded the season a league-best No. 75 in the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) Rankings, a SoCon-best No. 92 in the Pomeroy Ratings and No. 90 in the RPI.
- Furman continues to boast one of the best home court advantages in all of college basketball. Since the beginning

of the 2015-16 campaign, Furman sports a 75-12 record at Timmons Arena and 44-6 Southern Conference mark. With their victory against North Greenville on November 9, the Paladins have won 24 of their last 25 games at Timmons, 21 consecutive non-conference games on campus, 23 of the last 24 non-conference contests at Timmons and 40 of the last 43 regular season games in the facility overall.

- Furman was projected to finish in second place by both the Southern Conference men's basketball coaches and media for the 2021-22 season. The Paladins received two first-place votes in the coaches poll and three in the media. Furman is picked behind Chattanooga in both preseason polls. Guards Alex Hunter and Mike Bothwell were selected to the preseason All-SoCon team.

-Three Paladins earned postseason honors from the SoCon following the 2020-21 season with Mike Bothwell and Noah Gurley both receiving second team All-SoCon accolades and Clay Mounce third team. Bothwell averaged 15.8 points per game and ranked third in the league in free throw percentage, fifth in steals per game and sixth in field goal percentage. Gurley averaged 14.8 points and 5.7 rebounds per game, and finished in the top-15 for the SoCon in scoring, rebounding, field goal percentage and blocked shots per game. Mounce contributed 13.7 points and 6.3 rebounds per game while ranking in the top-15 for the SoCon in points and rebounds per game.

-Furman led the Southern Conference in field goal percentage during the 2020-21 season finishing at 48.7 percent (730-of-1499), and both assists and steals at 16.6 and 8.2 per game, respectively.

-Fifth year guard Alex Hunter topped the SoCon in assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.68.

-The Paladins' had a SoCon-best .700 field goal percentage and .600 3-point field goal percentage on December 21, 2020 during a 118-52 victory over South Carolina State at Timmons Arena.

-ESPN Upstate, the top-ranked sports talk show station in the Greenville-Spartanburg market, will serve as Furman's flagship station for the second consecutive year. The two-year agreement, which began in 2020-21, will make Paladin football and men's basketball games available over ESPN Upstate's four powerhouse stations: 97.7 FM/1330 AM in Greenville and 97.1 FM/950 AM in Spartanburg. "Voice of the Paladins" Dan Scott will call all of the action once again this season.

-The Paladins have experienced unprecedented success under the direction of head coach Bob Richey. The Paladins have posted an 90-34 overall record and 51-18 Southern Conference mark in the last three-plus years. After going 23-10 and finishing third in the SoCon at 13-5 in Richey's first season, Furman knocked off Final Four participant Loyola Chicago, stunned defending national champion Villanova, made the school's first appearance in the Associated Press Top 25 and fashioned a school-record 25 wins in 2018-19. The record-breaking season ended with Furman hosting AAC member Wichita State in the first round of the NIT. In 2019-20, Furman matched its school record win total with 25, routed Loyola Chicago at Timmons Arena and notched a school-record 15 SoCon victories en route to a second place finish. Last season, the Paladins spent the entire regular season ranked in the College Inside Mid-Major Top 25, concluded the season a league-best No. 75 in the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) Rankings, a SoCon-best No. 92 in the Pomeroy Ratings and No. 90 in the RPI. Now in his fifth season as Furman's head coach, Richey has compiled an 90-34 mark since taking over the reigns of the Paladin program and his .717 winning percentage ranks in the top 10 among active Division I head coaches. Richey has been named among the top coaches under 40 by ESPN and CBS Sports. Stadium Basketball Insider Jeff Goodman also ranked Paladin assistant coaches Tim Johnson and Jimmie Williams among the top five assistants in the Southern Conference.

### ORIGIN OF THE PALADIN

Furman University athletic teams were known by different names until the 1961 school year. The baseball team was "Hornets," the football team "Hurricane," and the basketball team "Paladins."

The basketball team was dubbed "Paladins" by a Greenville sportswriter in the 1930s. By vote of the student body, all Furman athletic teams became the "Paladins" on September 15, 1961. A Paladin is a knight on a horse and the recognized mascot of Furman University's athletic teams.

## Head Coach Bob Richey



Bob Richey is in fifth season as head coach of the Furman men's basketball team and 11th overall with the program.

During his time at the helm of the program, Richey has guided the Paladins to an 90-34 overall record and 51-18 mark in Southern Conference play. The Paladins have posted back-to-back 25-win seasons and claimed four straight 20-win seasons for the first time in school history. His .717 winning percentage ranks in the top 10 among

active Division I head coaches.

Furman concluded the 2020-21 season at 16-9 overall and 10-5 in the SoCon, securing the program's sixth consecutive winning record and sixth straight top three finish in the league standings. The Paladins, who spent the entire regular season ranked in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25, concluded the season a league-best No. 75 in the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) Rankings, a SoCon-best No. 92 in the Pomeroy Ratings and No. 90 in the RPI.

Fifth-year senior Clay Mounce garnered third team All-SoCon honors and NABC All-District accolades after contributing 13.8 points and a team-best 6.3 rebounds per game. Mounce joined Furman greats Bruce Evans, Jonathan Moore, Matt Rafferty, Karim Souchu and Derek Waugh as one of only six players in school history to post at least 1,200 points, 600 rebounds, 150 assists and 100 steals in a career as a Paladin.

Joining Mounce in receiving postseason honors were Mike Bothwell and Noah Gurley, who were named second team All-SoCon. Bothwell also earned NABC All-District 21 Second Team honors.

Richey guided the Paladins to a 25-7 overall record and 15-3 Southern Conference mark in 2019-20 as the Paladins posted a school-record for victories for a second consecutive season. Furman finished the season at No. 74 in the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) Rankings and No. 81 in the Pomeroy Ratings. Jordan Lyons, a College Insider Mid-Major All-American, earned first team All-SoCon honors while Mounce and Gurley received third team all-league accolades. Lyons finished his Furman career as the winningest player in school history with 96 victories.

Under his leadership, the 2018-19 Paladins reached new heights with a school-record 25 wins, including victories over defending national champion and eighth-ranked Villanova and 2018 NCAA Final Four participant Loyola Chicago. Furman

finished the season with a 25-8 overall record, 13-5 league mark and earned the school's first trip to the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) since 1991.

Rafferty, who paced the country in win shares and defensive win shares, finished the season as the only player in the SoCon to rank in the top 10 in points (17.5ppg), rebounds (9.0rpg), assists (4.3apg), steals (2.5spg), blocks (1.1bpg) and field goal percentage (61.5%). The first team All-SoCon selection also ranked among the league leaders in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1) and free throw percentage (76.7%).

Lyons earned third team All-SoCon honors after a standout season that included a 54-point performance and NCAA record-tying 15 three-point baskets versus North Greenville. Gurley garnered SoCon All-Freshman honors.

In his first season as head coach in 2017-18, Richey guided the Paladins to a school record-tying 23-win season that included a then school-record 22 regular season victories. Under his leadership, Furman placed three players on All-Southern Conference teams and the 2018 senior class finished their careers with 76 wins, now third best in school history.

Devin Sibley earned first team All-SoCon honors, while Rafferty and Daniel Fowler garnered second team all-league accolades. The Paladins ranked second in the SoCon averaging 79.4 points per game and were third in scoring defense at 68.5 points per contest. Furman posted a 13-3 home record at Timmons Arena, including a 7-2 mark against SoCon opposition.

A native of Florence, S.C., Richey, who served six seasons as a member of the Paladin coaching staff before moving into the head coaching role, helped Furman to a school record-tying 23 total victories and 14 Southern Conference wins in 2017, while the program earned a share of its first Southern Conference regular season championship in 21 years and a trip the Collegelinsider.com (CIT) Postseason Tournament semifinals. The 2016-17 Paladins, who also won a school record 12 road games, notched back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time since 1974-75, and captured postseason victories in consecutive seasons for the first time in school history.



Richey, who has served as position coach for the Paladins' guards since joining the Furman staff prior to the 2011-12 campaign, has recruited and developed back-to-back Southern Conference Players of the Year. Stephen Croone, who finished his Furman career with 1,936 points, earned consensus SoCon Player of the Year honors in 2016 before joining the NBDL's Sioux Falls SkyForce for the 2016-17 season. Sibley followed Croone by earning 2017 SoCon Player of the Year honors, first team All-SoCon accolades, and first team NABC All-District laurels. Sibley was joined on both the All-SoCon squad and NABC All-District Team by fellow Richey recruit Kris Acox, who capped his career with 1,051 points and ranked among the SoCon's top rebounders over two seasons.

In 2016, Richey played a key role in Furman's return to the postseason as the Paladins fashioned a 19-16 overall record, finished third in the SoCon with an 11-7 mark, and advanced to the second round of the CIT with a buzzer-beating victory over Louisiana Monroe at Timmons Arena in first round action. Furman won a school record 14 home games, including 11 in a row, while Croone earned player of the year and first team All-SoCon accolades.

The previous season, Richey helped lead the Paladins to their first Southern Conference Tournament finals appearance in 13 years as the Paladins downed No. 2 seed Chattanooga and No. 3 seed Mercer to advance to the league championship game.

Richey's recruits have garnered all-conference honors in 11 consecutive seasons, including Furman recruits Croone (2014, '15, '16 All-SoCon), Acox (2017 All-SoCon), and Sibley (2017 All-SoCon). He has also helped recruit six players over the last seven seasons who have garnered SoCon All-Freshman honors, including Sibley, who won 2015 SoCon Freshman of the Year accolades.

An associate head coach for Charleston Southern during the 2010-11 campaign, Richey helped the Buccaneers achieve their highest win total in 14 years in 2011. In five seasons as an assistant at CSU, he recruited five players who went on to garner All-Big South Conference honors, highlighted by the school's No. 2 all-time leading scorer Jamarco Warren and 2013 all-league performers Saah Nimley and Arlon Harper. Richey helped the Bucs improve their

conference record in each season, culminating with a squad that ranked in the top 50 nationally by averaging 74 points per game in his final season.

During his five years at Charleston Southern, Richey recruited five of the top 11 scorers in CSU history in Warren (1,968 points, 2nd all-time), Nimley (1,866 points, 3rd all-time), Harper (1,633 points, 5th all-time), Kelvin Martin (1,483 points, 8th all-time) and Jeremy Sexton (1,253 points, 11th all-time). Two of his recruits earned Big South Freshman of the Year honors in their rookie seasons, and he placed at least one player on the Big South All-Freshman squad in four consecutive seasons. Basketball analyst Jeff Goodman rated Richey as the No. 4 assistant coach in the Big South Conference in 2010, while Richey also ranked as the youngest coach on the list.

A graduate of Florence Christian School, Richey led his team to a 28-2 record and state championship his senior year. He was named the 3A State player of the year and currently holds seven school records at Florence Christian.

Richey graduated summa cum laude from North Greenville University in May of 2006 with a degree in business management. In April of 2007, he married the former Jessica Tingle and the couple have two children, Audrey Gabrielle and Robert McIntire "Mac".

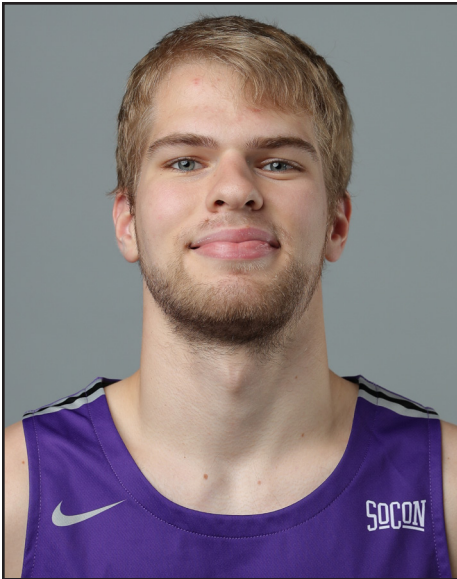
