OFFENSIVE LINEMEN CHECKLIST

HOW FURMAN RATES THE OFFENSIVE LINEMEN

Each offensive lineman's blocks during a game are rated and given a value of 0, 1, 2, 3, or 4. (0-zero; 1-poor; 2-good; 3-excellent; 4-perfect).

Each block is given points for the specific block (example - 3 points for each #3 block).

Then total the blocking points and divide by the total number plays to achieve the blocking rating.

In rating the offensive linemen, a 2.00 rating is an exceptional performance, with 1.80 serving as a winning performance.

Linemen achieving a winning performance or above are listed on the Offensive Linemen Checklist each week.

In figuring each player's blocking percentage, take the number of plays and subtract the number of #1 blocks and then divide that number by the total plays and you have the percentage.

those players achieving a winning performance (1.80) or better (2.00-exceptional performance) are listed below and the game in which the player earned the rating.

STOMBAUGH LEADS NATION IN PUNTING

Furman's Paul Stombaugh led the nation in punting in 1949. Stombaugh topped the country's punters with a 44.7 average per kick. He punted 57 times during the 1949 season for 2,250 total yards.

FURMAN'S 10,000th POINT

Kicker Keith Potter's 32-yard field goal with 2:47 remaining in the third quarter of the 1979 Appalachian State game at Serrine Stadium was the 10,000th point scored by Furman since 1902.

Brothal Cole, Steve Bishop and Mike Glenn became the first Paladins to each rush over 100-yards in a single game. They accomplished the feat in 1979 versus The Citadel in Charleston. Cole gained 137 yards on 14 attempts, with Bishop carrying 14 times for 101. Glenn rushed for 100 on 26 carries.

HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS OF FURMAN FOOTBALL

- 1889 Furman played Wofford College on December 14 in the first football game in South Carolina. The players had no uniforms, no positions and no rules. Wofford won the game 5-1. The two schools formulated their own rules before the game.
- 1892 Furman played South Carolina on Christmas Eve in Charleston. South Carolina won the game 44-0. Furman wore purple jerseys and went by the name of Mountaineers. Professor H. P. Young served as coach and also played in the game.
The origin of the Furman colors was discovered at an alumni meeting. James Andrew Tate of York, S.C., served on the committee to choose the Furman colors. Royal purple and white were selected.
- 1896 Furman and Clemson met on the football field for the first time with Clemson taking a 14-6 win.
- 1898 Furman formed an organized athletic association on February 21.
- 1902 Furman and South Carolina met again on the football field and this game is significant to University of South Carolina athletic history. Furman celebrated its victory by carrying above the heads of the Furman players a garnet and black rooster with plucked tail feathers. This promoted the name Gamecocks which was widespread by 1903. Furman was known as the Purple Fighters.
- 1903 Furman voted to abolish football.
- 1913 Furman revived football and W. C. Farmer was named coach.
- 1914 W. B. Bible named coach.
- 1915 Furman was defeated by Clemson 99-0, the worst defeat in the school's history. Midway through the season, Bible resigned and W. L. Laval was selected as coach.
- 1916 Furman's first recruited football player arrives on campus. He is Harold 'Speedy' Speer of Winston-Salem, N.C. Greenville citizens raised enough money to pay his tuition.
- 1919 Furman tied Clemson 7-7, in what was called at the time the greatest football game ever in Greenville. Manly Field is also dedicated this season. Furman won its first state championship.
- 1920 Furman defeated Clemson for the first time, 14-0. Furman team was now known as the Purple Hurricane. Furman won the state championship.
- 1921 Furman won its third straight state championship.

- 1922 Furman defeated the University of Florida, 7-6, on the road.
- 1923 Furman defeated the University of Virginia, 13-10. Manly Field was increased to 8,000 seats.
- 1924 Furman defeated Ole Miss, 7-2, but lost to Alabama, 20-0. Furman wins state championship.
- 1925 Furman wins fifth state title and second straight.
- 1926 Furman defeated Georgia in Athens, 14-7. Norwood Cleveland had wagered to walk from Athens to Greenville if Furman won. His trek took four days to complete. The Furman band met him on his arrival in Greenville. Furman makes it three in a row with state crown.
- 1927 Furman played in its first post-season game and defeated Miami, 38-7, in forerunner of Orange Bowl. Team goes 10-1, losing only to Georgia. Furman wins fourth straight state championship.
- 1928 T. B. Amis named coach.
- 1929 Furman defeats Erskine 19-6 in the first night game in South Carolina history before a Manly Field crowd of 5,000.
- 1932 A. P. 'Dizzy' McLeod named coach. Furman won its eighth state championship.
- 1936 Furman defeats Davidson 14-13 on Halloween afternoon in the first game in Sitrine Stadium. Furman retains its state title. Furman voted into Southern Conference. Bob King becomes Furman's first all-Southern Conference performer.
- 1939 Rhoten Shetley, team captain, named to Collyer's little all-America team.
- 1940 Largest single crowd at Sitrine Stadium for a Furman game was 19,300 to witness Clemson's 13-7 win over Furman.
- 1943 Football discontinued due to war.
Greenville Piedmont conducted a poll to select an all-time, all-star Furman team. The published results placed Bob King and Dan Wood at ends. Tackles were Trask McCarson and 'Daddy' Dorn. Guards were 'Hardrock' Smith and Jack Shivers. June Scott, Whitey Rawl, Dewey Proctor and Rhoten Shetley were selected as backs. Shetley was named captain. Second team members were Blackie Carter, Flucie Stewart, Dizzy McLeod, Hazel Gilstrap, Red Dobson, Gates Barker, Johnson Moore, Speedy Speer (captain), Bob Smith, Red Schneider and Lee Rhame.
- 1945 R. W. 'Bob' Smith named head coach for 1946.
- 1948 H. E. Smith named head coach.
- 1950 Bill Young named head coach. Ed Jasonek goes to Blue-Gray game.

- 1951 Furman grants exclusive rights to WFBC radio to broadcast home and away football games.
- 1954 Former Navy line coach Homer Hobbs named new Furman mentor.
- 1958 Bob King begins his first season as Furman head coach. University moves to its present location north of Greenville.
- 1961 By vote of the student body, Furman's nickname was officially chosen 'Paladins' on September 15. Dr. Francis Bonner made the presentation and revealed the university symbol — a knight on a white stallion. Furman defeated nationally ranked Memphis State, 7-6, in Memphis. King is named South Carolina coach of the year. Quarterback Billy Canty is chosen to play in the Senior Bowl. Paladins were invited to play in the Tangerine Bowl, but declined.
- 1963 Furman upsets Vanderbilt, 14-13, in Nashville. King named state coach of the year.
- 1965 Dr. Gordon Blackwell becomes Furman president.
- 1967 Robbie Hahn catches 53 passes to lead Southern Conference.
- 1970 King named Southern Conference Coach of the Year, the first time a Furman mentor has received the award. The Paladins finish with the best record since 1935. Steve Crislip leads conference in scoring.
- 1971 Crislip becomes first Furman running back to gain over 1,000 yards on the ground in a single season.
- 1973 Art Baker begins first season as head coach. Paladins recognized as Most Improved Team in the Nation by the Dunkel Rating.
- 1974 Furman finishes 13th in nation in total defense.
- 1976 Dr. John E. Johns becomes president of Furman. Paladins open season with 17-12 upset of North Carolina State, spoiling the late Bo Rein's college coaching debut. Furman hands East Carolina its only conference defeat, 17-10, knocking the Pirates out of a possible bowl game.
- 1977 Jeff Holcomb awarded an NCAA Post-Graduate scholarship.

1978 Furman wins its first Southern Conference title in Dick Sheridan's first year as head coach. ABC televises Furman Tenn-Chattanooga game from SIRRINE Stadium. Furman defeats The Citadel, 17-13, on a game-ending goal line stand to put the Paladins in a position to win the league crown. Three seniors sign free agent contracts with professional teams. Team ranks 7th in the nation in total offense and 14th in rushing and scoring. Sheridan named Southern Conference Coach of the Year.

1979 After losing first five games, the Paladins fight back to win five of the last six. Furman outscores Davidson, 63-55, setting a new NCAA mark for scoring by two teams in a single game.

1980 Trustees gave okay to go ahead with construction of on-campus football stadium. Furman wins its first outright Southern Conference championship, undefeated in seven league contests. Paladins played in their second ABC regionally-televised game, this time against Appalachian State at Boone, NC. Furman finished with a 9-1-1 record, the best since the 1927 team which ended with a 10-1 mark. Dick Sheridan named league and state coach of the year. Mike Glenn ran for 261 yards against Presbyterian and named Associated Press National Back of the Week. Paladins leave 45-year-old SIRRINE Stadium in style, defeating The Citadel 28-15 on Nov. 22.

1981 Furman wins second consecutive Southern Conference championship, and its third in four seasons. Paladins finish with 8-3 record for 30 wins in past four years, tying record at Furman. Bruce Gheesling is named to Associated Press third team All-America squad. Five other Paladins named to honorable mention All-America team. Stanford Jennings named Southern Conference Player of the Year and Dennis Williams takes Freshman of the Year honors in the league. In all, 11 Paladins named to first team all-conference. Charlie Anderson wins league Jacobs Blocking Trophy for second straight year and chosen to participate in Blue-Gray Classic. Anderson also receives NCAA Post-Graduate Scholarship. Furman is triumphant in opening game in Paladin Stadium, blanking East Tennessee State, 21-0. Stanford Jennings sets school season rushing mark with 1,168 yards, also breaking Furman scoring record with 76 points. Tim Tanguay kicks 11 consecutive field goals during the course of the season.
