PALADIN POINTS

PALADINS OPEN FOUR-GAME ROAD TRIP ON SATURDAY

Furman, receiving votes in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and ranked No. 15 in College Insider's mid-major top 25, opens a challenging four-game road swing on Saturday when it travels to face Charleston Southern (1-5) at Buccaneer Fieldhouse in Charleston, S.C. The Paladins hold a 10-7 lead in 17 previous meetings in the series versus the Buccaneers, including a 91-47 victory in the most recent meeting on November 12, 2019, in Charleston. Furman has won four of the last five meetings in the series. Following Saturday's tilt versus CSU, Furman travels to Las Vegas, Nev., to face Seattle in the Vegas Showdown at T-Mobile Arena on Tuesday night before taking on top-ranked Kansas at Allen Fieldhouse on November 30. The road trip concludes with a visit to Fort Myers, Fla., to battle FGCU.

FURMAN ROUTS OGLETHORPE, 124-48

Furman improved to 5-0 on the season with a 124-48 victory over NCAA Division III Oglethorpe Wednesday night at historic Parker Gymnasium on the campus of Legacy Early College in downtown Greenville, S.C. Senior PJay Smith Jr. connected on 9-of-10 three-point attempts in just 14 minutes of play to pace the Paladins with 29 points while freshman Mason Smith added a career-high 20 points.

NOTES FROM WEDNESDAY'S WIN

- Furman's 5-0 start is its best since beginning the 2018-19 season at 12-0 en route to earning a No. 23 ranking in the

AP Top 25.

- Wednesday's 124 points represent the ninth highest points total ever for a Paladin team.
 - Furman's 124 points and 76-point margin of victory rank as the highest point total and winning margin for a Paladin squad since topping Virginia Intermont 126-33 on December 29, 2004, at Timmons Arena.

- Smith's nine three-point baskets were the third most in a single game by a Paladin and his 90% performance behind the arc was the best in school history on seven or more attempts.

- The Paladins' 34 assists matched a school record, which was set in a 118-66 win over North Greenville on November 9, 2021.

"THREE-JAY" SMITH STAYS HOT

Point guard PJay Smith Jr. has averaged 23.3 points, 4.3 rebounds, 4.0 assists, and 2.8 steals per game while shooting 60% behind the arc in his first four games of the season. Smith has netted 29 points in back-to-back games to lead Furman to victories over Tulane (75-67) and Oglethorpe (124-48). His 5.25 three-point makes per game lead the nation and the senior has claimed both Southern Conference Player of the Week awards this season.

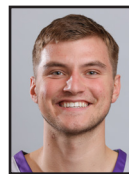

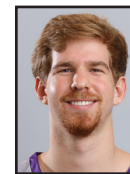

TAKING FURMAN HOOPS AROUND GREENVILLE

Since the 1950's, Furman has hosted home games at several locations throughout the city, including Textile Hall, Greenville Memorial Auditorium, Lay Physical Activities Center on campus, Timmons Arena, Greenville High School, and Bon Secours Wellness Arena. Parker Gymnasium was added to that list on November 20 as the Paladins downed Oglethorpe, 124-48, in the historic venue on the campus of Legacy Early College. Furman will add another venue to the list next month when they host Montreat at David Field House on the Bob Jones University campus. Timmons Arena, Furman's basketball home since 1997, is undergoing a \$40 million renovation that will turn the facility into one of the top mid-major venues in the country. The project is set to be completed prior to the 2025-26 season.

SMITH LEADS PALADINS PAST TULANE, 75-67

PJay Smith Jr. poured in a season-high 29 points on 6-of-11 shooting from three-point range and Furman never trailed en route to a 75-67 victory over the Tulane Green Wave on November 15 at Bon Secours Wellness Arena. The Paladins opened the game on a 17-7 run and used a 17-7 spurt midway through the second half to hold off Tulane as Furman improved to 4-0 for the first time to start a season since the 2020-21 campaign. Graduate transfer Nick Anderson added 19 points and redshirt-sophomore Davis Molnar pulled down a career-best 10 rebounds.

NOTES FROM THE WIN AT THE WELL

- Nick Anderson and PJay Smith combined for 48 points on 11-of-21 shooting behind the three-point arc against the Green Wave. The pair also accounted for six assists.

- PJay Smith's 29 points marked the most he has scored in 36 appearances as a Paladin. He netted 32 points against Auburn-Montgomery on February 4, 2023, while playing for Lee University.

- With his first basket versus Tulane, Smith surpassed 1,000 career points.

- After scoring nine points and grabbing nine boards at Tulane last season, Davis Molnar posted six points and a career-high 10 rebounds this season versus Tulane.

FURMAN ADDS FIVE IN NOVEMBER SIGNING PERIOD

Head coach Bob Richey announced the additions of Cole Bowser (Woodbridge, Va, Dematha Catholic), Abijah Franklin (Simpsonville, S.C./Wren), Collin O'Neal (Old Hickory, Tenn./Montgomery Bell), Owen Ritger (Atlanta, Ga./Marist), and Alex Wilkins (Mattapan, Mass./Brooks) to the Furman roster for the 2025-26 season on the opening day of the November signing period on Wednesday, November 13. Bowser, a 6-foot-6 wing, is the brother of current Paladin Cooper Bowser. Franklin, a 6-foot-5 guard, earned AAA South Carolina Player of the Year honors as a junior at Wren High School. O'Neal, a 6-foot-4 guard, garnered DII-AA All-State honors in Tennessee. Ritger, a 6-foot-9 forward, was named GHSA Preseason AAAA All-State and the No. 4 power forward in Georgia entering the 2024-25 season. Wilkins ranked as one of the top guards in New England entering his senior season.

RICHEY ADDS TO THE FURMAN FAMILY

Furman's five signees weren't the only additions to the Paladin family during the month of November. Head coach Bob Richey's wife, Jessica, gave birth to a seven-pound, 10-ounce baby girl, Francis "Francie" Elizabeth Richey, on November 8. Coach Richey missed Furman's victory at Belmont due to his daughter's birth earlier in the day. Associate head coach Chad Warner, a former head coach at Flagler, led the Paladins in Nashville.

JOHNSTON KEYS WIN OVER JACKSONVILLE, 78-69

Junior Charles Johnston netted a season-high 25 points on 8-of-9 shooting from the floor and 5-for-5 at the line as Furman rallied from a halftime deficit to down Jacksonville, 78-69, on November 11 at the Well. The Paladins trailed 41-37 early in the second half before scoring 14 straight points and holding the Dolphins scoreless for nearly seven minutes to grab the lead. PJay Smith finished with 14 points, six boards, and six assists while Tom House added 13 points. Garrett Hien notched his second career double-double with 11 points and a career-high 14 rebounds.

GARRETT HIEN ENJOYING SOLID START TO YEAR NO. 5

Garrett Hien's fifth season with the Paladins is off to a solid start, highlighted by his 11-point, 14-rebound performance in a 78-69 win over Jacksonville. After struggling for much of last season, the Charlotte, N.C., native has significantly upped his scoring and rebounding production during the opening weeks of the season while also rediscovering his touch from behind the three-point arc.

THREE-POINTER PROPELS PALADINS PAST BELMONT, 76-74

PJay Smith Jr., playing less than 15 miles from his hometown of LaVergne, Tenn., connected on a three-pointer with 2.3 seconds remaining to lift Furman to a dramatic 76-74 victory over the Missouri Valley Conference's Belmont Bruins on November 8 at the Curb Event Center in Nashville, Tenn. The senior, playing in his first game of the season after missing the opener due to injury, netted a team-high 21 points, including the final five for the Paladins. Furman led by

nine in the second half before Belmont used a 15-3 run to take the lead. The Bruins extended their advantage as many as six points down the stretch. Smith, who was named SoCon Player of the Week for his performance in Nashville, scored on a driving layup with 22 seconds left to trim the Belmont lead to one point and after the Bruins missed the front end of a one-and-one opportunity, the guard drained a triple from the top of the key to secure the win, Furman's third straight versus Belmont.

RICHEY HELPS PALADINS REACH NEW HEIGHTS

The Paladins have experienced unprecedented success under the direction of head coach Bob Richey, posting a 161-71 overall record and 88-35 Southern Conference mark since the 40-year-old took over the program following Niko Medved's departure in 2017. After going 23-10 and finishing third in the SoCon at 13-5 in his first season, Furman knocked off Final Four participant Loyola Chicago, stunned defending national champion Villanova, made the school's first appearance in the Associated Press Top 25, and fashioned a then school-record 25 wins in 2018-19. The record-breaking season ended with Furman hosting Wichita State in the first round of the NIT. In 2019-20, Furman again won 25 games, routed Loyola Chicago at Timmons Arena, and notched a school-record 15 SoCon victories en route to a second place finish. The 2020-21 Paladins spent the entire regular season ranked in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25, concluded the season a league-best No. 75 in the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) Rankings, and posted a SoCon-best No. 92 in the Pomeroy Ratings. The 2021-22 Paladins went 22-12, ended ACC foe Louisville's 59-game November winning streak at the KFC Yum! Center, and reached the SoCon finals for the first time since 2015. In 2022-23, Furman posted a school-record 28 victories, captured the SoCon regular season title, claimed its first SoCon Tournament title and NCAA berth since 1980, and downed nationally-ranked Virginia for the school's first NCAA Tournament win since 1974. Now in his seventh season as Furman's head coach, Richey's .694 winning percentage ranks in the top 25 among active Division I head coaches.

WELCOME TO THE WELL

Bon Secours Wellness Arena, which has hosted the Paladins 21 times since its opening in 1998, will serve as the Paladins' primary homecourt during the 2024-25 season while Timmons Arena, Furman's on-campus facility, undergoes a \$40 million renovation project that is on track to be completed prior to the start the 2025-26 season. Furman has won six straight regular season games at the Well and eight of its last nine games in the facility, which has hosted the NCAA men's and women's tournaments along with the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in recent years.

Furman's victory over Samford on January 24, 2024, marked head coach Bob Richey's 150th win as Paladin head coach. Richey ranks second in wins at Furman behind Lyles Alley and is the fastest to reach 150 wins. The basketball team was dubbed "Paladins" by a Greenville sportswriter in the 1930s. By vote of the student body, all Furman athletic teams became the "Paladins" on September 15, 1961. A Paladin is a knight on a horse and the recognized mascot of Furman University's athletic teams.

FURMAN BLITZES CIU ON OPENING NIGHT, 104-46

Furman opened its 112th season of men's basketball with a 104-46 rout of NAIA member Columbia International on November 4 at Bon Secours Wellness Arena. The Paladins connected on 12 three-pointers in the opening 20 minutes to race out to a 58-15 halftime lead and played all 13 players who dressed en route to the victory. Junior Tom House paced the Paladins with 21 points while redshirt-freshman Tommy Humphries added 15. Furman shot 63.5% from the field, including 61.9% from three-point range.

NOTES FROM OPENING NIGHT

- The victory over Columbia International marked the Paladins' eighth consecutive season-opening win.
- The 58-point margin of victory was the largest for the Paladins since downing South Carolina State 118-52 on December 21, 2020.
- The 104 points scored by the Paladins were the most since netting 110 in a 117-110 double overtime loss at Tulane last season.
- Tom House, who joined the Paladins in the offseason following two seasons at Florida State, poured in a career-high 21 points. His previous high of nine came as a Seminole last season versus Stetson and Kennesaw State.

- In addition to House's career day, Tommy Humphries (15), Ed-drin Bronson (10), and Mason Smith (11) each reached double figures in their Paladin debuts.

HUGHEY SHINES IN SEASON OPENER

Senior Tyrese Hughey came off the bench to notch his second career double-double with 11 points and 12 rebounds as Furman routed Columbia International 104-46 in the regular season opener on November 4. Hughey's only previous double-double came on November 17, 2022, when he totaled 15 points and 11 rebounds in a loss to Penn State at the Charleston Classic.

No. 11 AUBURN TOPS FURMAN IN CHARITY EXHIBITION

All-American candidate Johni Broome paced five Tigers in double figures with 18 points and added a game-high 14 rebounds to steer No. 11 Auburn to an 83-62 victory over the Paladins in a charity exhibition game on October 27, at the Well. The Tigers ended the first half on a 10-2 run to erase a 27-26 Furman lead and shot over 57% from the floor in the second half to pull away from the Paladins. Nick Anderson, a graduate transfer from Barry University, paced the Paladins with 19 points while junior Ben VanderWal netted 14 points and grabbed a team-high six rebounds. Cal State Monterey Bay transfer Charles Johnston, a 6-foot-11 junior, reached double figures with 12 points for the Paladins. Furman shot 36.2% from the field in the loss. Proceeds from the exhibition went to benefit the Friends of Cleveland Park and the City of Greenville's park restoration projects.

FAMILIAR NAMES RETURN FOR PALADINS

Head coach Bob Richey returns nine players off last year's squad that posted a 17-16 overall record and 10-8 mark in Southern Conference play, including four who made at least 10 starts for the Paladins during the 2023-24 campaign. Leading the way are preseason All-Southern Conference selection Play Smith Jr. and fellow senior Garrett Hien. Smith, who joined the Paladins from Lee University prior to last season, averaged 10 points, 3.4 rebounds, and 1.9 assists per game in his first season at Furman while connecting on 36.3% on his three-point tries. Hien, one of the heroes of Furman's 2023 SoCon championship squad that toppled No. 4 seed Virginia in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament, contributed 6.8 points, 3.9 rebounds, and 2.3 assists per game a year ago while also making 23 starts. Juniors Ben VanderWal and Tyrese Hughey combined to make 30 starts in 2023-24 while averaging 5.9 and 4.9 points per game, respectively. The Paladins also welcome back sophomores Cooper Bowser and Davis Molnar, as well as, redshirt freshmen Eddrin Bronson and Tommy Humphries.

TRANSFERS HIGHLIGHT FURMAN NEWCOMERS FOR 2024-25

In addition to nine returnees, Furman has six new faces on its roster this season, including Barry University transfer Nick Anderson, Florida State transfer Tom House, Cal State Monterey Bay transfer Charles Johnston, and freshman Mason Smith. The Paladins also added a pair of walk-ons in former Porter-Gaud School standout Clyde Mauldin and former Virginia Tech offensive lineman Jayson Morgan. Anderson averaged 13.6 points per game and shot 43.2% from three-point range in his four seasons at Barry, where he was coached by former Paladin head coach Butch Estes. House, a native of Dayton, Fla., played in 53 games over two seasons at Florida State while scoring 78 points. The 6-foot-7 guard connected on 47.1% of his three-point tries as a sophomore last season with the Seminoles. Johnston posted 13 double-doubles as a sophomore at Cal State Monterey Bay while scoring 13 points per game and ranking fifth in NCAA Division II by averaging 10.7 rebounds per game.

Twelve of the Paladins' 16 home games will appear on ESPN+ with the January 29 contest against defending SoCon champion Samford set to air on CBS Sports Network. Furman will not stream its non-Division I games versus Columbia International, Oglethorpe, and Montreat.

SAYING GOODBYE TO A FURMAN LEGEND

For almost 70 years, the name Frank Selvy has been synonymous with Furman basketball. The consensus All-American, NBA all-star, and College Basketball Hall of Fame member passed away on August 13, 2024, at the age of 91. A native of Corbin, Ky., Selvy, nicknamed "The Corbin Comet," led the NCAA in scoring twice during his storied Paladin career (1952-54) and averaged 41.7 points per game his senior season, which included a NCAA Division I record 100-point performance in a 145-95 win over Newberry on Feb. 13, 1954, at Textile Hall in downtown Greenville. The 6-foot-3 guard averaged 32.5 points per game over his 78-game collegiate career and reached the 40-point plateau 22 times. Named Southern Conference Player of the Year for the 1952-53 season while competing against West Virginia, Virginia Tech, North Carolina, N.C. State, Duke, Wake Forest, Clemson, and South Carolina — many of whom would later leave the SoCon to form the Atlantic Coast Conference — Selvy collected the honor a second time as a senior en route to being tabbed 1954 United Press Player of the Year. He was a three-time All-America selection. Selvy, whose many NCAA scoring standards stood for years following his collegiate career, was the No. 1 draft pick by the Baltimore Bullets in 1954. He averaged 19.4 points per game his rookie year, was a two-time all-star, and went on the spend nine years in the NBA, including his final five seasons with the Minneapolis/Los Angeles Lakers, where

he played alongside Jerry West, Elgin Baylor, and Rod Hundley. Following his professional career, Selvy returned to his alma mater in 1966, succeeding Lyles Alley, his former coach, as the Paladins' mentor for four seasons. He is a member of seven halls of fame, including the South Carolina Athletic Hall of Fame (1960), Furman Athletics Hall of Fame (1981), Corbin High School Redhound Hall of Fame (1982), Kentucky Sports Hall of Fame (1994), Southern Conference Hall of Fame (2009), Kentucky High School Basketball Hall of Fame (2021), and National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame (2022). Furman's male athlete of the year award bears Selvy's name, and his jersey No. 28 is retired.

LISTER HIGHLIGHTS NEW FURMAN STAFF MEMBERS

Former Paladin guard Rett Lister, who was a part of 90 career victories during his four-year playing career, is one of five new members of the Furman coaching staff this season. CBS Sports Network will air Furman’s January 29 home contest versus Samford at the Well before featuring the Paladins at ETSU on February 2.

PALADINS EAGERLY AWAIT NEXT SEASON’S RETURN TO TIMMONS ARENA

A \$40 million Timmons Arena renovation project began immediately following last season’s home finale and is scheduled to be completed in the fall of 2025. The renovation, which will include a new seating bowl, premium suites, a hospitality deck, courtside seating, a VIP lounge, enhanced concessions, and new athletics office space, will turn Timmons into one of the premier arenas of its size in college basketball. Philanthropist and businessman Ravenel B. Curry III ‘63 provided a \$10 million cornerstone gift for the project, which broke ground following the 2023-24 season.

ASUN, SOCON ANNOUNCE SCHEDULING ALLIANCE

The ASUN and Southern Conference announced a two-year scheduling alliance this summer that will see each SoCon team play a pair of games against ASUN opposition. The Paladins will host Jacksonville and travel to Fort Myers, Fla., to play FGCU as part of this year’s ASUN-SoCon agreement. The alliance was created to help each league’s schools play meaningful games against a similar conference within its regional footprint.

Head Coach Bob Richey



Bob Richey is in his eighth season as head coach of the Furman men's basketball team and 14th overall with the program.

A finalist for both the 2023 Hugh Durham Coach of the Year Award and Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, Richey has helped propel the Paladins to national prominence with eight consecutive winning seasons, including the 2023 Southern Conference regular season title, the program's first SoCon Tournament title and NCAA Tournament berth since 1980, and its first tournament victory since 1974. In his seven seasons as head coach, the 2022-23 J. Lyles Alley

Furman Coach of the Year has guided the Paladins to a 161-71 overall record and 88-35 mark in Southern Conference play while posting a .694 winning percentage, which ranks in the top 25 among all active Division I head coaches.

Under Richey's leadership, Furman has won at least 25 games in three of the last six seasons and at least 22 victories in six of the last eight years. Furman's .690 overall winning percentage and .715 SoCon winning percentage over the past seven seasons both rank among the best in the SoCon during Richey's tenure.

The 2022-23 Paladins notched a school-record 28 victories, highlighted by an 88-79 triumph over Chattanooga in the SoCon Championship game and a 68-67 victory over No. 4 seed Virginia in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament in Orlando, Fla. Seniors Mike Bothwell and Jalen Slawson both garnered first team All-SoCon accolades for the second straight year and were named finalists for the Lou Henson Mid-Major Player of the Year Award. Slawson earned SoCon Player of the Year honors and was selected to play in the NABC Reese's College All-Star Game before being taken in the second round of the NBA Draft by the Sacramento Kings. Bothwell inked a free agent deal with the Cleveland Cavaliers in June.

In 2021-22 Richey led the Paladins to a 22-12 overall record and second place finish in the SoCon with a 12-6 worksheet. He guided Furman to a victory over ACC foe Louisville, its first SoCon Tournament finals appearance since 2015, and a No. 82 ranking in the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) Rankings.

Slawson and Bothwell earned first team all-conference honors, while Slawson was named SoCon Defensive Player of the Year. Senior Alex Hunter finished his career as Furman's all-time leader in three-point baskets.

Furman concluded the 2020-21 season at 16-9 overall and 10-5 in the SoCon, securing the program's sixth consecutive winning record and sixth straight top three finish in the league standings. The Paladins, who spent the entire regular season ranked in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25, concluded the season a league-best No. 75 in the NET Rankings, a SoCon-best No. 92 in the Pomeroy Ratings and No. 90 in the RPI.

Richey guided the Paladins to a 25-7 overall record and 15-3 Southern Conference mark in 2019-20 as the Paladins posted a school-record for victories for

a second consecutive season. Furman finished the season at No. 74 in the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) Rankings and No. 81 in the Pomeroy Ratings. Jordan Lyons, a College Insider Mid-Major All-American, earned first team All-SoCon honors while Mounce and Gurley received third team all-league accolades. Lyons finished his Furman career as the winningest player in school history with 96 victories.

Under his leadership, the 2018-19 Paladins reached new heights with a school-record 25 wins, including victories over defending national champion and eighth-ranked Villanova and 2018 NCAA Final Four participant Loyola Chicago. Furman finished the season with a 25-8 overall record, 13-5 league mark and earned the school's first trip to the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) since 1991.

Rafferty, who paced the country in win shares and defensive win shares, finished the season as the only player in the SoCon to rank in the top 10 in points (17.5ppg), rebounds (9.0rpg), assists (4.3apg), steals (2.5spg), blocks (1.1bpg) and field goal percentage (61.5%). The first team All-SoCon selection also ranked among the league leaders in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1) and free throw percentage (76.7%).

In his first season as head coach in 2017-18, Richey guided the Paladins to a school record-tying 23-win season that included a then school-record 22 regular season victories. Under his leadership, Furman placed three players on All-Southern Conference teams and the 2018 senior class finished their careers with 76 wins, now third best in school history.

A native of Florence, S.C., Richey, who served six seasons as a member of the Paladin coaching staff before moving into the head coaching role, helped Furman to a school record-tying 23 total victories and 14 Southern Conference wins in 2017, while the program earned a share of its first Southern Conference regular season championship in 21 years and a trip the CollegenInsider.com (CIT) Postseason Tournament semifinals. The 2016-17 Paladins, who also won a school record 12 road games, notched back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time since 1974-75, and captured postseason victories in consecutive seasons for the first time in school history.

Richey, who has served as position coach for the Paladins' guards since joining the Furman staff prior to the 2011-12 campaign, has recruited and developed back-to-back Southern Conference Players of the Year. Stephen Croone, who finished his Furman career with 1,936 points, earned consensus SoCon Player of the Year honors in 2016 before joining the NBDL's Sioux Falls SkyForce for the 2016-17 season. Sibley followed Croone by earning 2017 SoCon Player of the Year honors, first team All-SoCon



accolades, and first team NABC All-District laurels. Sibley was joined on both the All-SoCon squad and NABC All-District Team by fellow Richey recruit Kris Acox, who capped his career with 1,051 points and ranked among the SoCon's top rebounders over two seasons.

Richey's recruits have garnered all-conference honors in 11 consecutive seasons, including Furman recruits Croone (2014, '15, '16 All-SoCon), Acox (2017 All-SoCon), and Sibley (2017 All-SoCon). He has also helped recruit six players over the last seven seasons who have garnered SoCon All-Freshman honors, including Sibley, who won 2015 SoCon Freshman of the Year accolades.

An associate head coach for Charleston Southern during the 2010-11 campaign, Richey helped the Buccaneers achieve their highest win total in 14 years in 2011. In five seasons as an assistant at CSU, he recruited five players who went on to garner All-Big South Conference honors, highlighted by the school's No. 2 all-time leading scorer Jamarco Warren and 2013 all-league performers Saah Nimley and Arlon Harper. Richey helped the Bucs improve their conference record in each season, culminating with a squad that ranked in the top 50 nationally by averaging 74 points per game in his final season.

During his five years at Charleston Southern, Richey recruited five of the top 11 scorers in CSU history in Warren (1,968 points, 2nd all-time), Nimley (1,866 points, 3rd all-time), Harper (1,633 points, 5th all-time), Kelvin Martin (1,483 points, 8th all-time) and Jeremy Sexton (1,253 points, 11th all-time). Two of his recruits earned Big South Freshman of the Year honors in their rookie seasons, and he placed at least one player on the Big South All-Freshman squad in four consecutive seasons. Basketball analyst Jeff Goodman rated Richey as the No. 4 assistant coach in the Big South Conference in 2010, while Richey also ranked as the youngest coach on the list.

A graduate of Florence Christian School, Richey led his team to a 28-2 record and state championship his senior year. He was named the 3A State player of the year and currently holds seven school records at Florence Christian.

Richey graduated summa cum laude from North Greenville University in May of 2006 with a degree in business management. In April of 2007, he married

the former Jessica Tingle and the couple have four children, Audrey Gabrielle, Robert McIntire "Mac", Jacks Berner, and Francis "Francie" Elizabeth.
