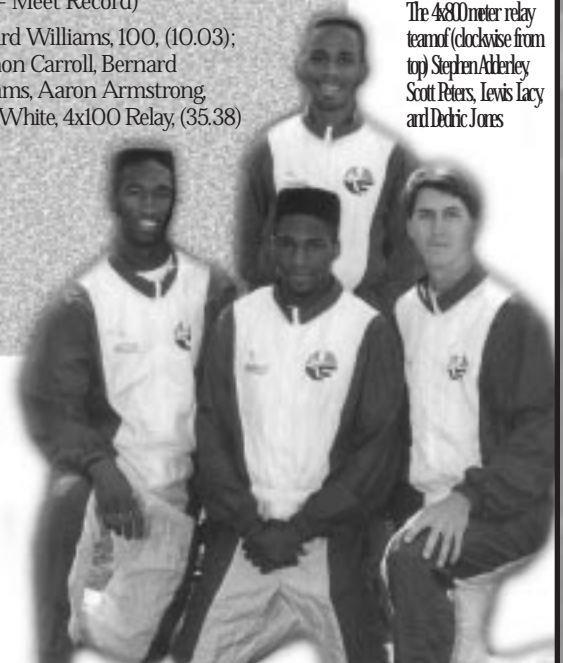

Gator Olympians

Since Ron Jourdan became the first UF Olympian by participating in the 1972 Games in Munich, the Florida track and field program has become a stepping stone to a host of international caliber athletes. In all a total of 16 Florida track and field athletes and one coach (Doug Brown) have represented eight different countries and the Orange and Blue.

Five Gator alumni traveled to Sydney, Australia for the 2000 Games with four making their Olympic debuts. Mark Everett was the lone veteran of the squad, competing in the 800 meters. Derek Trafas, a member of the Class of '96, was 10th in the finals of the javelin. He represented his native Poland. Gerald Clervil, a former walk-on to the UF track program, made the Haitian team in the 400 but did not advance out of the first round. John

Capel stumbled out of the blocks in the finals of the 200 and finished eighth with a time of 20.49. Bernard Williams, who won the 100 meters at the 2000 NCAA Championships, ran on the Gold Medal-winning 4x100-relay team for the United States. Williams ran the second leg for the team that ran 37.61.
