Coach and Player Quotes

Florida State Head Coach, Chris Poole

Opening Statement...

"I'm proud of the girls for stepping up after that first set. I thought we started off pretty tight, I think that can often happen in an NCAA Tournament, just because of the expectation and anxiety of jumping in and knowing you've got everything on the line.

"For us it's just really important we continue to be consistent – whenever we're playing consistent we can play really well. When we're making unforced errors and not staying consistent the way we need to then that's where we really struggle. I was proud of the way the girls stepped up, and Cincinnati played an incredible match, they're a great team, that first set they really punched us, knocked us out, and it was important for us to get back up and fight and I thought the girls did that.

On playing new lineups and how the team adapted to them...

"We've had to make a lot of changes these last few weeks. Sometimes it'll just hit you at the end of the year, we've got a lot of walking wounded right now and with not everybody being able to play up to their fullest potential, you really just have to figure out what you need at a given time, and I felt like the girls have been open to that.

"We've been trying to work on a lot of different lineups during practice, and to make sure of whatever we need to use and we're ready to be able to do it, and I thought all the players stepped up well tonight. I think Hailey [Luke] stayed in some and got some key kills for us there at a crucial time, and [Milica Kubura] has carried us a lot all year. So it's good if you've got other players that are able to step up if somebody is a little bit off. I found that the girls found a way to win even when we weren't playing as well as we would hope we would."

On taking advantage of the points they won off of Cincinnati's rotations with Jordan Thompson in the backrow...

"She's a great player, so there were times where we were not able to slow her down as much as we wanted, certainly didn't stop her, but we found ways to be able to take advantage of other things. We've got a lot of different players that can step up at different times, and that's what we've seen through the season and that's what we were able to see tonight."



Florida State Outside Hitter, Katie Horton

On how they were able to come back in the fourth set...

"We were just trying to focus on us, keep our momentum going. We were a little bit down and we just needed a sideout, and not focus on them, just focus on us."

On her career high digs and putting the team on her back tonight...

"I was just trying to do my job, I know I was there to dig, pass, hit, whatever they needed me to do I was just trying to do."

Florida State Middle Blocker, Mara Green

On how they were able to come back in the fourth set...

"A lot of what we've been trying to focus on throughout the season is focusing more on our side and what we're doing on our side as opposed to what the other team is doing, because more often times than not as long as we're doing what we need to do then everything else will take care of itself."

On taking advantage of the points they won off of Cincinnati's rotations with Jordan Thompson in the backrow...

"I think it was really important to take advantage of those points, especially because she's also one of their key players when she's backrow. To take advantage of the time when she was backrow was something that we really focused on throughout practice during the week, and I thought we did a really good job of that during the match tonight."

Cincinnati Head Coach, Molly Alvey

Opening Statement...

"Definitely a well fought game. We played hard point-for-point through the entirety of the match, there were just a couple of lulls where we gave away too many points at a time but I thought overall a very competitive and well played volleyball match."

Takeaways from the match and moving forward to next season...

"Probably not just this match but a full season long effort from start to finish of where the development of the program was from the beginning of the season, the non-conference schedule we played, into the transformation of what the team looks like in-conference, what did we take from our non-conference schedule into our conference opponents...Our young team is no longer young now so they'll take a lot of learning lessons from this and our program only grows from this experience, for sure."

Cincinnati Sophomore Setter, Jade Tingelhoff

On what she learned in their first NCAA match...

"It was a great experience. Florida State is a really good volleyball team. I thought we played really well, I was proud of the team and how we competed. It's hard to lose but you have to take this and how well we did as an experience.
