#### THE FIRST PITCH

► The No. 1-ranked Gator Softball team (4-0) returns to Katie Seashole Pressly Stadium on Wednesday for its first regular-season home game since capturing the 2015 national championship. Florida will host Jacksonville in a doubleheader beginning at 5 p.m.

► Both contests will be broadcast on SEC Network+ as Adam Schick will have the call with former Gator Kelsey Horton providing analysis. Florida posted a 15-2 record overall and a 12-0 mark at home last season when appearing on SEC Network+, which debuted a season ago.

#### QUICK HITS

► Florida earned four victories on the season's opening weekend at the USF Wilson-DeMarini Tournament in Tampa. The Gators outscored their first four opponents 38-1, including an 8-0 (5 innings) run-rule win on Saturday over then No. 2 Michigan.

► Following opening weekend, UF is still ranked first in the ESPN/USA Today preseason polls. Last season, Florida became the first team since Arizona in 2007 to be ranked No. 1 in the first and last polls of the year.

► Head Coach Tim Walton has used the same starting lineup in three of Florida's four games this season.

► Janell Wheaton is off to a fast start in 2016, hitting .500 with one home run and nine RBI. The long ball she hit against USF on Sunday was just the second of her career.

► Following the weekend, Wheaton's RBI total ranked her tied for third in the Southeastern Conference.

► Taylore Fuller is getting on base at a clip of .800. The senior has recorded five walks and been hit by three pitches. Overall, she's hitting .571 with four runs scored and four RBI.

► Rookie Amanda Lorenz is the third and final member of the Florida softball team to be hitting .500 or better after opening weekend. The Moorpark, Calif. native is 5 for 10 on the season with five RBI, one double and an SEC-leading nine runs scored.

► As a team, Florida ranks fourth in the league in hitting (.376), third in on-base percentage (.543) and fifth in runs scored (38), despite run-ruling all its opponents this past weekend.

► Despite being in the middle of the pack offensively, UF is the best defensive team in the conference. Florida ranks fourth in the league in hitting (.376), third in on-base percentage (.543) and fifth in runs scored (38), despite run-ruling all its opponents this past weekend.

► Florida shut out and run-ruled its first three opponents for the first time since 2012.

► UF became the first defending NCAA Champion to shut out its first three opponents since 1992, when Arizona shut out its first seven foes.

► The Gators are ranked at or near the top in every major pitching category and Florida is by far the best defensive team with its .989 fielding percentage and just one error allowed through its first four games

► Florida enters Wednesday's doubleheader with a streak of 18 innings without allowing an error.

#### SETTING THE STAGE: JACKSONVILLE

► Florida puts its perfect record against the Dolphins on the line on Wednesday evening, as the Gators are 14-0 all-time against Jacksonville, including an 11-0 mark under Tim Walton.

► UF has run-ruled JU five times, including three of its last five meetings.

► The Orange and Blue are 21-1 against in-state opponents since the start of 2014.

### Florida Hosts Jacksonville in Home Opener

The University of Florida softball team hosts Jacksonville on Wednesday, Feb. 17 at 5 p.m. for a doubleheader. The Gators and Dolphins have played at least once every season since 2004 and UF currently holds a perfect 14-0 record against JU.

In addition, Florida is 11-0 mark under Tim Walton.

In those 14 matchups, UF has run-ruled JU five times and has achieved that acclaim in three of its last five meetings.

The Orange and Blue are 21-1 against in-state opponents since the start of 2014.

Wednesday's doubleheader is the first of seven midweek contests for the Gators this season. In 2015, Florida was 7-0 in such games.

In Florida's last matchup with the Dolphins on Feb. 11, 2015, UF beat JU in Jacksonville, 16-1. In that game, nine different Gators had a hit and UF jumped out to a 9-0 lead with nine runs in the second inning, adding four in the third and three in the fourth before JU got on the board in its second-to-last at-bat.

That second inning scoring explosion was started by then-senior Bailey Castro with a leadoff home run to left. Following the senior's homer, UF had singles from Taylore Fuller, Kayli Kvistad, and Taylor Schwarz, while three Gators reached on a pair of walks and a fielder's choice. The Orange and Blue ultimately sent 13 batters to the plate during the inning, as then-senior Lauren Haeger helped her own cause with a double and Castro (single), Fuller (double), Kvistad (double) all followed with run-scoring hits before a flyout to center ended the inning.

That frame created an insurmountable lead for the Gators.

In the circle, then-senior Lauren Haeger extended her personal scoreless streak to 12.0 innings, and helped her own cause with a single, a double, two runs scored and three RBI.

#### Last Time Out

The University of Florida softball team completed a sweep of its four games at the USF Wilson-DeMarini Tournament this past Sunday with wins over Virginia Tech and USF. Florida run-ruled the Hokies, 8-0 (6 innings), and Bulls, 11-1 (5 innings).

UF outscored its four Tampa opponents 38-1, while mercy-ruling all of them. In addition, Florida shut out and run-ruled its first three opponents for the first time since 2012.

The Gators became the first defending NCAA Champion to shut out its first three opponents since 1992, when Arizona shutout its first seven foes.

Aleshia Ocasio (1-0) tossed a three-hit six-inning shutout against Va. Tech in the opening game. The sophomore notched seven strikeouts and walked just one. She faced just 12 batters through the first four innings, but allowed three hits in the final two frames.

In the nightcap, freshman Kelly Barnhill and junior Delanie Gourley (2-0) combined for seven punch outs while allowing just one run on two hits.

Offensively, freshman Amanda Lorenz led the way as she was 2 for 3 with a double, three runs scored and three RBI vs. the Hokies. Against the Bulls, sophomore Janell Wheaton went 3 for 3 with five RBI, one run scored and hit her second-career home run.

Since 2010, UF is now 28-1 when playing in Tampa/Clearwater during the season's first week-end (only loss: Feb. 13, 2010, 3-0 vs. Georgia Tech).

#### 2015 Season Review

UF went 60-7 in 2015, taking the Southeastern Conference title as well as their second-straight NCAA crown. UF reached the 60-win plateau for just the third time in school history and posted its third-highest win percentage (.895).

In 2015, the Gators ranked first nationally in winning percentage, tied for first in wins, first in fielding percentage (.981), fourth in ERA (1.63), 11th in on-base percentage (.438), 22nd in scoring (6.55 runs per game), 29th in slugging percentage (.514) and 32nd in home runs per game (1.19). Defensively, Florida's .981 fielding percentage was the best mark in school history, eclipsing the .979 mark set in 2013. The Gators committed just 33 errors in 67 games, seven fewer than any previous UF squad.

**Preseason National Prominence**

Coming off the program's second straight national championship, UF opened the 2016 season as the No. 1-ranked squad in the country, according to the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball polls.

Entering his 11th season, Head Coach Tim Walton has the nation's preseason No. 1 team for the third time and second year in a row. Prior to last season, the Gators opened atop the rankings in 2009 following their record-setting 70-win campaign in 2008.

In the most recent set of polls, Florida received all but one first place vote.

**Trio of Gators Named to Preseason All-SEC Team**

UF was well-represented on the preseason All-SEC with seniors Kirsti Merritt, Aubree Munro and Kelsey Stewart all making the list. Stewart is making her third consecutive appearance on the preseason team, while Merritt and Munro are making their debut.

UF and AU led all schools with three selections each. UA and LSU have two representatives apiece on the squad, while Georgia, Kentucky, South Carolina and Tennessee each had one player named to the team. The list is comprised of two sophomores, one junior and 11 seniors.

**Gator Duo Named to USA Softball Top 50 Watch List**

Florida seniors Aubree Munro and Kelsey Stewart were named to the Top 50 "Watch List" for the 2016 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year. Eight athletes, including Munro and Stewart, on the Top 50 "Watch List" will compete as a member of the 2016 USA Softball Women's National Team this summer. A season ago, Lauren Haeger became the first Gator to receive the award, which is considered the most prestigious honor in Division I women's softball.

**Best of the Best (SEC Preseason Predictions)**

The defending SEC Champion Gators have been picked by a vote of the league's head coaches as the preseason favorite for 2016. Florida received 10 first-place votes from the SEC's 13 head coaches, who were not allowed to vote for their own teams.

The Gators will look to win their second-straight SEC regular season crown in 2016, a feat UF last achieved in 2008 and 2009. In its history, Florida owns five regular-season SEC crowns (1998, 2008, '09, '13, '15) and three conference tournament championships ('08, '09, '13).

**Back For More**

Florida's senior class, top to bottom, has been one of the most successful classes in school history, boasting a 177-28 record (51-20 SEC) through three seasons at Florida. The Gator seniors were a part of two NCAA Championships (2014, 2015) and two SEC Championships (2013, 2014). The class boasts one All-American and two NFCA Academic All-Americans. Taylore Fuller has hit eight grand slams, which ranks third in NCAA history. Outfielder Kirsti Merritt is a two-time NFCA All-Southeast Region honoree and became the first freshman to ever be named the SEC Tournament MVP in 2013. Aubree Munro is a two-time WCWS All-Tournament Team selection and is regarded as perhaps the best defensive catcher in program history. Last season, Munro did not make an error in 354 chances behind the plate. Taylor Schwarz, another defensive stud for the Gators, enters this season ranked tied for fifth in career fielding percentage (.933) in Gator annals. UF's final senior is a two-time NFCA All-American and last season's SEC Player of the Year, Kelsey Stewart, who enters this season already first in Gator history for hits (293), triples (27) and steals (98) after three seasons.

Florida's senior class is trying to catch UF's 2011 class which boasted a 238-33 mark during their four years.

**Player Rankings**

Kelsey Stewart continues to rewrite Florida's record books. She owns three single season offensive records and appears in 11 top-10 offensive career lists. The Stewart three single season records are 102 hits (2014), 11 triples (2015) and 36 stolen bases (2013 & '14).

### 2016 Season Notes

Georgia, Kentucky and Missouri will be the three SEC schools that UF will not face during the regular season. All Florida's home games (minus the Aquafina Invitational) will be broadcast on either the SEC Network+ or on one of the ESPN Family of Networks.

The longest home stand for the Gators is eight games (April 13-24). The longest road trip for the Gators is five games (Feb. 25-27) when the Gators head to Palm Springs, Calif. for the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic.

UF enters the season ranked first in the ESPN/USA Today preseason polls for the second consecutive year. Last season, Florida became the first team since Arizona in 2007 to be ranked No. 1 in the first and last polls of the year.

Florida shutout and run-ruled its first three opponents for the first time since 2012.

Florida became the first defending NCAA Champion to shut out its first three opponents since 1992, when Arizona shutout its first seven foes.

The seniors to freshmen are such a big age difference, so there's a meshing period you have to go through. Our older players have been very welcoming from the beginning, but with that welcoming come expectations that you have to bring it every day." -- Tim Walton*

Tim Walton has brought Florida softball to the pinnacle of success in his 10-plus years at the helm of the Gators squad. Under Walton's tutelage, Florida became the first Southeastern Conference institution in history to earn four consecutive Women's College World Series berths (2008-11). The Orange and Blue have earned a total of seven WCWS berths since Walton's arrival, with four championship series appearances and the program's first and second national titles in 2014 and 2015.

Walton reached a career milestone when he earned career win No. 600 in just his 12th season as a head coach in 2014. Coming in his 774th game as a head coach, the Gators used an 8-0 mercy-rule victory at SEC rival Texas A&M to complete a three-game sweep on Easter Sunday, making Walton the fastest active head coach in the Southeastern Conference to reach 600 lifetime victories.

Walton has a 556-121 record at the head of the Gator program and a 679-185 (.785) career record in 13 seasons as a head coach. Florida has seven 50-win and three 60-win seasons in program history, all under Walton.

In his 10 years at Florida, Walton has led the Orange and Blue to countless school and SEC records, and his squads have earned numerous firsts for the Gator softball program. In 2011, UF advanced to an unprecedented fourth straight Women's College World Series, including its second trip to the Championship Series. Working as a four-time SEC Coach of the Year, Walton has led the Gators to four SEC regular-season and three conference tournament titles. UF has made the NCAA Tournament every year of his tenure, hosted Regionals all 10 times and played host to NCAA Super Regionals seven times from 2008-15. Florida reached the pinnacle of college softball in 2014, capturing the national championship with a two-game sweep of Southeastern Conference rival Alabama in the finals. This past season in 2015, Walton and his squad won the program's second-straight national title, defeating Michigan two games to one in the final of the WCWS.

In the 34-year history of the WCWS, 12 different teams have claimed the national title. Florida joined UCLA (2003, 2004 / 1988, 1989, 1990 / 1984, 1985) and Arizona (2006, 2007 / 1996, 1997 / 1993, 1994) as the only three programs to claim NCAA titles in consecutive years.

On the softball diamond, Walton has tutored 14 Florida student-athletes to 29 NFCA All-America honors, 19 players to 44 NFCA All-Southeast Region honors, has produced 15 WCWS All-Tournament team selections (including three Most Outstanding Players), coached 19 Gator athletes to 41 All-SEC honors and racked up 17 SEC All-Tournament team honors, including three MVPs, three SEC Pitchers of the Year and four SEC Players of the Year. Most recently, Gators Kelsey Stewart and Lauren Haeger won the conference's Player and Pitcher of the Year awards in 2015, becoming UF's fourth and third honorees in program history. Additionally, Haeger brought home the 2015 Honda Sports Award, designating her as the nation's top collegiate female athlete in the sport of softball. Haeger was the second Gator to receive the Honda Award, as Kelsey Bruder was UF's first recipient in 2011. Shortly after Bruder claimed that honor, she was awarded the NCAA Today's Top VIII Award as one of the top eight NCAA athletes in the country during the 2010-11 school year.

Under Walton's direction, the Florida coaching staff has earned NFCA Southeast Regional Coaching Staff of the Year honors four times and the team was one of Easton's Teams of the Year in 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011.

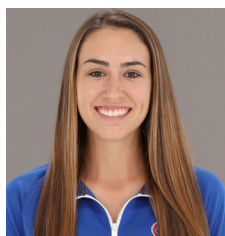
In 2015, Walton and his staff were named the NFCA Division I National Coaching Staff of the Year, the first time in school history Florida has earned this accolade.

Under Walton's watch, the Gators have shattered over 300 University of Florida records since 2006. His 2008 squad recorded an NCAA-record 70 wins and posted the best SEC record in league history at 27-1. The Orange and Blue shattered its own SEC single-season walks record with 332 in 2013, while the Gators boasted a .981 fielding percentage in 2015 committing a program-record low 33 errors during the season. Florida's 2011 squad downed eight SEC records, including four team season records for runs (508), RBI (479) and walks (322), while extending its standing single-season homers record to 124. The 2012 Gator squad set the league record for slugging percentage (.627), while the 2009 Gators became only the second team to ever register a perfect conference road record (13-0).

After winning the program's first national championship in 2014, the Gators followed that by becoming just the third program in NCAA history to win back-to-back softball titles in 2015. In the 34-year history of the WCWS, 12 different teams have claimed the national title and Florida joined UCLA (2003, 2004 / 1988, 1989, 1990 / 1984, 1985) and Arizona (2006, 2007 / 1996, 1997 / 1993, 1994) as the only three programs to claim NCAA titles in consecutive years.

This season seniors Kelsey Stewart, Taylore Fuller, Kirsti Merritt, Aubree Munro and Taylor Schwarz are the elders of a squad that will start the season No. 1 and seek to join UCLA (1988-90) as the only programs to win three straight national titles.

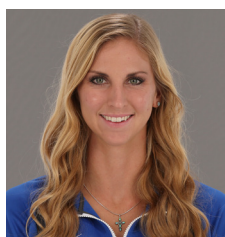
