## FLORIDA WELCOMES SUNSHINE STATE FOE FGCU TO RAISE CURTAIN ON 2016 SEASON

Kevin O'Sullivan begins his ninth season at the helm as consensus No. 1 Florida opens its 2016 campaign by hosting Florida Gulf Coast University of the Atlantic Sun Conference in a weekend series. The Gators will be starting their 56-game regular season at McKethan Stadium for the 16th consecutive season and the 28th time in 30 years.

## QUICK HITS ABOUT THE GATORS

- Florida returns 18 letterwinners from last year's squad, including six position starters - 1B **Peter Alonso**, SS **Dalton Guthrie** (played second base last season), OF **Ryan Larson**, OF **Buddy Reed**, C/DH **Mike Rivera** and C/DH **JJ Schwarz**. Of the club's 12 newcomers, 11 are freshmen and one is a junior college transfer (RHP **Nick Horvath** from Santa Fe College).
- UF will be replacing departed starters of **Harrison Bader** (third-round pick of the St. Louis Cardinals), SS **Richie Martin** (first-round pick of the Oakland Athletics) and 3B **Josh Tobias** (10th-round pick of the Philadelphia Phillies).
- The Orange and Blue's entire weekend rotation returns in the form of junior RHP **Logan Shore** (11-6, 2.72 in 2015), junior LHP **A.J. Puk** (9-4, 3.81) and sophomore RHP **Alex Faedo** (6-1, 3.23), while junior RHP **Dane Dunning** (5-2, 4.03) drew 14 starts last year.
- The Gators have made the NCAA Tournament every year of **Kevin O'Sullivan's** tenure, the longest stretch in school history.
- Last year, the Gators (52-18) advanced to the NCAA College World Series for the fourth time in six seasons and were one victory shy of the CWS Finals.
- Florida made the CWS for the ninth time in school history (1988, 1991, 1996, 1998, 2005, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2015).
- UF reached the 50-win plateau for the second time in O'Sullivan's tenure and for the fourth time in school history. Its 52 wins were the second-highest total for the program (53 in 2011).
- The Gators have been a national seed in six of the past seven seasons (No. 8 in 2009, No. 3 in 2010, No. 2 in 2011, No. 1 in 2012, No. 2 in 2014, No. 4 in 2015) – the most national seeds in the country in that span.
- Florida set a school record with a .984 fielding percentage, the second-best clip in NCAA history.
- For the first time in school history, the Orange and Blue ended the seasons for Sunshine State rivals Miami and Florida State in NCAA play.
- The Gators overpowered the Hurricanes twice in Omaha, by scores of 15-3 and 10-2, and swept the NCAA Gainesville Super Regional over the Seminoles, 13-5 and 11-4.
- UF claimed its fourth Super Regional title in five appearances under Coach O'Sullivan and its first since 2012 with the sweep of the Seminoles.
- Florida was 12-3 (.800) in the postseason, going 8-2 (.800) in the NCAA Tournament and 4-1 (.800) at the SEC Tournament.
- The Gators made their 31st NCAA Tournament appearance and swept through the NCAA Gainesville Regional at McKethan Stadium by knocking off Florida A&M (19-0), USF (8-2) and Florida Atlantic (2-1).
- Florida brought home its seventh SEC Tournament Championship with a 7-3 victory over No. 9 Vanderbilt at the Hoover Met in late May.

## SERIES NUGGETS

After the Gators had captured six of the seven previous meetings with FGCU, the Eagles notched a three-game sweep at McKethan Stadium between Feb. 22-24 in the second weekend series of 2013. UF notched a 5-3 victory in Fort Myers on April 16, 2013, before the teams split a pair of contests in Gainesville in 2014 (2-1 FGCU on Feb. 27; 4-0 UF on March 1). The Orange & Blue posted a 7-1 win in Fort Myers on April 15, 2014.

**Kevin O'Sullivan** is 9-5 (.643) against the Eagles, 6-5 (.545) in Gainesville and 3-0 (1.000) in Fort Myers.

## LAST MEETING IN GAINESVILLE

Right-handers **Karsten Whitson** and **Aaron Rhodes** combined on a three-hit shutout as the Gators blanked FGCU, 4-0, on March 1, 2013. Whitson allowed only a first-inning single over five innings, his longest outing of the season, to earn his first victory since June 10, 2012, in the Gators' NCAA Super Regional victory over NC State that clinched a berth in the College World Series. Rhodes registered then-career-highs in innings pitched (4.0) and strikeouts (4) to collect his first career save as UF posted its second shutout of the campaign (4-0 on Feb. 14 versus Maryland).

A trio of players, **Peter Alonso** (2-for-4), **Josh Tobias** (2-for-3) and **Casey Turgeon** (2-for-4) had multiple-hit efforts as part of a 10-hit offensive attack.

#### QUICK REVIEW

Florida went 52-18 last season, reached the College World Series for the fourth time in the past six years and ranked third in the final polls after becoming the only program in the country to earn a top-eight national seed for NCAA play for the sixth time in seven years.

The Gators claimed the Southeastern Conference Tournament and swept through the Gainesville Regionals and Super Regionals held at McKethan Stadium.

After winning consecutive elimination games over No. 8 Miami (10-2) and Virginia (10-5) at TD Ameritrade Park Omaha, Florida was on the short end of a 5-4 score to the eventual national champion Cavaliers. UVa went on to defeat Vanderbilt in the best-of-three CWS Championship Finals.

#### DIFFERENT UNIFORMS, SAME DESTINATION

Ninth-year skipper Kevin O'Sullivan brought a team to Omaha for the fourth time as a head coach (2010-12, 2015). As an assistant under Jack Leggett at Clemson, O'Sullivan served on staffs that made the 2000, 2002 and 2006 tournaments. In 2012, he passed Joe Arnold (1988, 1991) and Andy Lopez (1996, 1998) for the most CWS trips by Gator head coaches.

#### HAS GRABBED THE RING

Kevin O'Sullivan's third SEC Championship in 2014 matched the school record held by Dave Fuller (1948-75). O'Sullivan also guided the Gators to back-to-back titles in 2010-11, while Fuller directed UF to league crowns in 1952, 1956 and 1962.

**DRAWING THE START**

Junior Logan Shore will be on the mound for the Gators to begin the season for the second year in a row. In a team-high

19 starts, the right-hander was 11-6 with a 2.72 ERA and had 84 strikeouts in a team-high 112.1 innings.

The Coon Rapids, Minn., native captured all five of his postseason starts and had 24 strikeouts and five walks in 29.2 innings, with a 2.43 ERA. Shore downed No. 8 Miami (FL) (5.0 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 6 K, 0 BB) and Virginia (6.1 IP, 8 H, 4 R, 4 K, 2 BB) in Omaha.

#### PUK GETS THE NOD

Junior A.J. Puk will take the mound against the Eagles on Saturday. The left-hander made 17 appearances last year, 14 of which were starts, and was 9-4 with a 3.81 ERA.

With a team-leading 104 strikeouts in 78 innings, Puk became the first Gator to reach the century mark in punch-outs since Bryan Augenstein totaled 105 in 2007. He ranked fifth in the SEC in strikeouts and held opposing hitters to a .210 batting average, fourth-lowest in the league.

#### PUK ENJOYED THE 'SECOND SEASON'

A.J. Puk enjoyed a tremendous postseason, compiling a 1.54 ERA in four starts, with a 2-1 record and 30 strikeouts in 23.1 innings. He was the hard-luck loser against Virginia in the teams' first meeting at the NCAA College World Series, a 1-0 Gator setback, but fired seven shutout innings and retired the final 14 batters he faced in an 8-2 victory over USF during the NCAA Gainesville Regional, later earning All-Tournament recognition.

#### READY TO GO

Sophomore right-hander Alex Faedo is set to start on Sunday for the Orange and Blue. Over 19 appearances, including 12 starts, Faedo was 6-1 with a 3.23 ERA. He worked his way into the Gators' weekend rotation by mid-season and finished third on the squad with 59 strikeouts in 61.1 innings.

The Tampa native drew three starts in UF's postseason run and was 2-0 with a 1.98 ERA, highlighted by wins over Miami (FL) and Florida Atlantic. He registered a career-high seven strikeouts over five innings and limited the Hurricanes to one earned run in Omaha as the Gators eliminated their Sunshine State rivals. Faedo picked up the victory in the NCAA Gainesville Regional against Florida Atlantic by holding the Owls to one run and three hits over a career-high six innings

### WHAT'S IN STORE FOR HIS SOPHOMORE YEAR?

**JJ Schwarz** was named the Louisville Slugger Co-2015 Freshman Player of the Year and the NCBWA Freshman Hitter of the Year, achieved All-American status from the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABC), Baseball America, D1Baseball, the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) and Perfect Game and was a consensus Freshman All-American.

He finished with a .332 batting average and led the Gators in RBI (73), homers (18), doubles (16), sacrifice flies (6) and slugging percentage (.629). During the Gators' postseason, Schwarz hit a team-best .491 (28-for-57), with 23 runs, 19 RBI, five doubles and four homers.

He was selected as the Most Valuable Player of the SEC Tournament and the Most Outstanding Player of the NCAA Gainesville Regional. During the SEC Tournament, he hit .526 (10-for-19), with six RBI, five runs and three doubles, as Florida won its seventh SEC Tournament in program history.

### BULLPEN WAS VERY EFFECTIVE SHUTTING IT DOWN

Florida was 45-3 (.938) leading after six innings, 44-2 (.957) when ahead after seven innings and was 47-1 (.979) when leading after eight innings. The lone blemish after eight innings came in the Gators' first contest at the SEC Tournament, when Arkansas tallied three runs in the ninth to earn a 7-6 victory.

### FIFTY WAS NIFTY

At 52-18, Florida reached the 50-win plateau for the fourth time, having hit the mark in 1991 (51-21), 1996 (50-18) and 2011 (53-19). The squad finished one win short of matching the single-season school mark for victories.

### RIGHT TIME FOR A HOT STREAK

After dropping a ninth-inning heartbreaker to No. 24 Arkansas at the SEC Tournament, the Gators put together a season-long winning streak of 10 games from May 21-June 15, posting seven victories over ranked teams.

In 15 postseason contests, Florida hit .317 (168-for-530), with a 2.54 ERA and a .981 fielding percentage and outscored its opponents by a 128-41 margin.

### RAIDING THE COOKIE JAR

More active on the basepaths, the Gators passed 2014's total of 57 stolen bases, as the squad was 80-for-112 (.714). **Richie Martin** was 20-for-28 (.714) and **Buddy Reed** was 18-for-26 (.692).

Before last season, the last Florida player with 20 thefts in a campaign was **Matt den Dekker** in 2010, when he had 23.

### TRIGGERING THE OFFENSE

**Harrison Bader** (.297, 66 RBI, 17 HR) and **JJ Schwarz** (.332, 73 RBI, 18 HR) combined for 139 RBI and 35 homers last season.

### POWER RETURNED

Florida totaled 26 home runs in 63 games in 2014 and had 66 through 70 outings in 2015 after hitting six homers at the NCAA College World Series and 16 during the postseason.

**JJ Schwarz** (18) clubbed two homers in Game 2 of the NCAA Gainesville Super Regional against Florida State to eclipse the school record for homers by a freshman (**Austin Maddox**, 17 in 2010). With 17 big flies, **Harrison Bader** surpassed his season total of two from last year by the fifth game in 2015.

### WHEN YOU GET KNOCKED DOWN...

Twenty-one of the Gators' 52 wins last season came when they were behind, including three victories over No. 8 Miami and two over No. 8 Vanderbilt, and they overcame 3-0 deficits to upend FAU (2/24), Stony Brook (2/28), Vanderbilt (5/9) and Auburn (5/15). Trailing 6-5 with two out in the eighth on March 24, UF scored three times in that frame and tacked on an insurance run to down Stetson, 9-6. The Gators were down, 4-3, to Alabama in

the seventh on March 28 before **Jeremy Vasquez** tied the game with a two-out homer. Florida scored three in the eighth to secure a 7-4 win. UF rebounded from a 2-0 deficit to South Carolina on April 11 for a 12-5 win and reeled off 10 unanswered runs on April 26 against Kentucky. UF trailed Georgia, 3-2, on May 3 before rallying for a 7-4 win, came from behind twice the last two weekends of the regular season to beat Vanderbilt and Auburn, trailed No. 1 LSU before posting a 2-1 triumph in the semifinals of the SEC Tournament, was down 1-0 to Florida Atlantic before a 2-1 win in the NCAA Gainesville Regional final and spotted Florida State two runs in the first inning before an 11-4 triumph in the second game of the NCAA Gainesville Super Regional. Although Miami plated the opening run in Omaha, the Gators rode an 11-run fourth inning to a 15-3 victory over the Hurricanes and rebounded from a 1-0 deficit to Virginia in the second meeting for a 10-5 win.

### FLORIDA IN SUPER REGIONALS

The Gators earned their seventh Super Regional berth in school history and the fifth under **Kevin O'Sullivan**. UF is 10-5 (.667) and has claimed five titles in Supers.

### TURNSTILES WERE CLICKING

Florida set a two-game series record by drawing 11,481 fans during the NCAA Gainesville Super Regional. Five of the top-10 Gator Baseball home crowds have come when the Gators have played Florida State.

### HOSTING THE PARTY

Last season marked the 13th time that McKethan Stadium has hosted NCAA Regional action and the sixth time in the past seven years. The Gators have gone on to the College World Series from Gainesville on eight occasions: 1991, 1996, 1998, 2005, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2015.

### PROTECTING THE HOUSE

Florida improved to 45-12 (.789) on its own turf during NCAA play. Head coach **Kevin O'Sullivan** is 23-5 (.821) in NCAA play at home, 15-2 (.882) in Regionals and 8-3 (.727) in Super Regionals.

### SUNSHINE STATE VENUES ARE COMMON

Considering past history, it wasn't much of a surprise that the Gators began the NCAA Tourney in their home state. In its 31 Regional appearances, UF has been placed at sites within Florida 24 times (Gainesville-13, Coral Gables-7, Tallahassee-4). The squad has also traveled to North Carolina (1958, 1960, 1962), Minnesota (1977), Texas (2000), Oklahoma (2004) and Indiana (2013).

### ANOTHER VISIT TO THE DANCE

The 21st head baseball coach in school history, **Kevin O'Sullivan** was the seventh individual to take Florida to Regionals and is the only one to take the Gators to Regionals every season.

nement Championship in school history, first since 2011.

**TO THE VICTORS WENT THE SPOILS**

Catcher/designated hitter **JJ Schwarz**, who went 2-for-5 with a run scored versus Vanderbilt, was chosen as the Most Valuable Player of the SEC Tourney after batting .526 (10-for-19) over the five games, with six RBI, five runs and three doubles. He joined Gator winners **Rich Bombard** (Pitcher, 1982), **Brian Reimsnyder** (Outfielder, 1988), **Herbert Perry** (Designated Hitter, 1991), **Brian Purvis** (Outfielder, 1991) and **Daniel Pigott** (Outfielder, 2011).

Other members of the All-Tourney Team from the Orange and Blue included first baseman **Peter Alonso**, right-hander **Taylor Lewis**, left-hander **A.J. Puk** and outfielder **Buddy Reed**.

**QUICK START CERTAINLY HELPED**

**Harrison Bader** led off the SEC Tournament Championship game with a homer to left field, jump-starting the Gators' 7-3 victory over Vanderbilt.

Since dropping last season's series opener to the Commodores, UF has claimed the last three meetings between the Eastern Division rivals.

**Josh Tobias** made his first start at second base since March 26, 2013 (vs. Florida State in Jacksonville) and was 2-for-4 with an RBI and a walk, raising his on-base streak to 22 games.

**RIVERA TO THE RESCUE, LEWIS CAGED THE TIGERS**

Catcher/designated hitter **Mike Rivera** snapped a 1-1 tie with a leadoff homer in the ninth and **Taylor Lewis** finished off a 4.1-inning stint in which he permitted one hit and zero runs to the 14 batters he faced as the Gators edged No. 1 LSU in the SEC Tournament semifinals.

**Kevin O'Sullivan** improved to 5-1 (.833) against top-ranked squads.

**SOMETHING TO PONDER...**

The Gators' run to the crown in Hoover marked the sixth

time last season that Florida lost game one of a weekend set and posted wins to emerge victorious (UF had defeated Tennessee, Alabama, Georgia, Vanderbilt and Auburn by 2-1 series margins).

**SEC SHOWINGS**

With a 19-11 (.633) league record, UF defeated Tennessee twice on the opening SEC weekend at McKethan Stadium (L, W, W), was on the short end of a 2-1 series at Ole Miss (L, L, W), claimed two of three games with Alabama at home (L, W, W) fell twice at Missouri (W, L, L), swept No. 21 South Carolina at home, claimed all three games at Mississippi State, lost a pair of games at home to Kentucky (L, L, W), rallied to win the series at Georgia (L, W, W) and rebounded to down No. 8 Vanderbilt (L, W, W) and Auburn (L, W, W).

**CONFERENCE SERIES BREAKDOWN**

Florida had a 3-7 (.300) mark in Game 1, a 7-3 (.700) record in Game 2 and a 9-1 (.900) record in Game 3 of its SEC series.

The Gators were 4-1 (.800) in home series, defeating Tennessee, Alabama, South Carolina and Auburn and falling to Kentucky, and were 3-2 (.600) in their road series, losing at Ole Miss and Missouri before sweeping Mississippi State and defeating Georgia and No. 8 Vanderbilt.

**WALKING THE FINE LINE**

Florida was 10-6 (.625) in one-run games last year, including a pair of triumphs over No. 8 Miami (4-3, 2-1) and a 1-0 shutout of Stony Brook. The Gators fell to No. 9 UCF on March 3, 4-3, and edged Fairfield, 8-7, on March 10. UF dropped a 4-3 decision to No. 13 Florida State on April 14, nipped Mississippi State, 2-1, on April 18, edged Bethune-Cookman, 2-1, on April 21, fell to Kentucky on April 25, 7-6, downed Georgia, 3-2, on May 2, and nipped Auburn, 4-3. A 7-6 setback to Arkansas was followed by a 2-1 win over No. 1 LSU in the SEC Tourney semifinals. In the Regional final, the Gators nipped No. 21 Florida Atlantic, 2-1. Both of its losses in Omaha came at the hands of eventual national champion Virginia (1-0 and 5-4).

The Gators improved to 1-2 (.333) in extra innings by downing No. 8 Vanderbilt, 9-7, in 10 innings on May 9. UF had previously

dropped both of its extra-inning contests last year, 12-9 in 10 innings to Alabama on March 27 and 4-3 in 12 innings to No. 13 Florida State on April 14.

#### PUT UP BIG NUMBERS

Over 63 games in 2014, the Gators reached double-digits five times, the last during a 13-3 victory at Alabama on May 4. UF totaled 10 or more runs 20 times in 70 games in 2015 (22-3 over URI on 2/14; 13-3 at USF on 2/18; 10-8 vs. FAU on 2/24; 14-3 over Stony Brook on 2/28; 10-2 over UCF on 3/4; 14-8 over FSU on 3/17; 22-2 over Stetson on 4/7; 14-3, 12-5, 12-2 against South Carolina from 4/10-4/12; 10-5 at Mississippi State on 4/19; 10-1 vs. Kentucky on April 26; 11-2 vs. Auburn on 5/21; 10-0 vs. Arkansas on 5/22; 19-0 over Florida A&M on 5/29; 13-5 and 11-4 over Florida State on 6/5-6/6; 15-3 and 10-2 over Miami (FL) on 6/13 and 6/17 and 10-5 over Virginia on 6/19).

#### SETTING THE TONE

Florida scored in the first inning of 24 contests and held a 59-31 scoring edge in the opening stanza. UF scored 33 runs in the first inning in 2014. The Gators were 23-1 (.958) when scoring in the opening frame and were 36-4 (.900) when scoring first.

#### MADE THE LEAP IN YEAR TWO

**Buddy Reed** (.305) hit .244 in 60 games during his freshman season and surpassed his previous season highs in runs (51-26) and RBI (47-6) compared to his rookie campaign. Reed's two-run triple against Georgia opened the scoring on May 3, he went 2-for-4 with an RBI double and an RBI single versus USF on May 5 and was 4-for-10 (.400) at Vanderbilt with a three-run jack in game three. Reed was named to the SEC's All-Defensive Team.

#### TAKE YOUR BASE

Led by 16 from **Richie Martin**, 12 from **Josh Tobias** and 10 from **Harrison Bader**, the Gators were hit 75 times last season, including seven in the Regional opener by Florida A&M, three to Martin.

#### O'SULLIVAN IN SEASON OPENERS

**Kevin O'Sullivan** is 7-1 (.875) as a head coach in season debuts.

He enjoyed a successful start to his head coaching career on Feb. 22, 2008, with a 10-7 victory over Siena. The Gators rallied from deficits of 5-0 and 6-5 and snapped a 6-6 tie in the sixth with a two-run triple by **Brandon McArthur**. **Josh Adams** later added a two-out, two-run single in the frame as the hosts sent 10 batters to the plate. Making the first relief appearance of his career, righty **Billy Bullock** limited the Saints to one run and three hits over six innings and equaled his personal best of six strikeouts to pick up the win.

Behind a seven-inning stint and a career-high seven strikeouts by right-hander **Patrick Keating**, UF enjoyed a successful 2009 debut with a 6-3 victory over eighth-ranked Louisville on Feb. 20. Bullock closed the game with a pair of scoreless innings to notch his first career save. Holding a slim 4-3 lead in the seventh, the Gators tacked on two insurance runs to capture their opener. Adams went 2-for-4 with a run, while McArthur roped a two-run triple into right center field.

On Feb. 19, 2010, Adams powered Florida to a 6-2 victory over USF by going 3-for-3 with four RBI, a pair of home runs and a double. In his collegiate debut, **Austin Maddox** went 2-for-4 and blasted a two-run homer on the first swing of his Gator career. Making his return to the lineup after missing the '09 campaign, right-hander **Tommy Toledo** scattered three hits, registered four strikeouts and allowed an unearned run in 3.1 innings.

**Brian Johnson** fired six scoreless innings and poked a pair of doubles as the Gators raised the curtain on the 2011 campaign with a 7-2 victory over USF in front of 5,157 fans at McKethan Stadium on Feb. 18. Johnson faced the minimum of 18 batters, yielded two singles, registered six strikeouts and retired the final 10 Bulls he encountered. He was supported by a Gator offense that totaled 13 hits, tallied three runs in the third and four more in the fifth. **Preston Tucker** went 3-for-5 with three RBI, highlighted by a two-run homer in the fifth, while **Nolan Fontana** (4-for-5) collected a career-high four hits and scored twice.

Before a then-Opening Night record crowd of 5,356 fans at McKethan Stadium on Feb. 17, 2012, the No. 1 Gators snapped a 3-3 tie with four runs in the seventh inning on its way to a

7-3 victory over No. 16 Cal State Fullerton. Tucker belted a game-tying solo homer in the sixth and provided the Gators with an insurance run with a sacrifice fly in the seventh, reliever **Steven Rodriguez** threw 2.1 scoreless innings and had three strikeouts to pick up the win, while **Taylor Gushue** clubbed a home run on his first collegiate swing.

On Feb. 15, 2013, Duke snapped a 2-2 tie with a pair of runs in the eighth inning to hand the 13th-ranked Gators a 4-3 setback in front of an Opening Night record crowd of 5,771 fans at McKethan Stadium. Mike Rosenfeld (3-for-5), who was a home run shy of hitting for the cycle, delivered an RBI triple off **Corey Stump** that put the visitors ahead. It was UF's first season-opening setback since 2007.

**Bobby Poyer** (5.1 IP), **Ryan Harris** (1.2 IP) and **Danny Young** (2.0 IP) combined on a three-hitter as the No. 20 Gators topped Maryland, 4-0, on Feb. 14, 2014, at McKethan Stadium. Poyer established a then-career high with five strikeouts and Young collected his first career save as the Orange and Blue kicked off the program's 100th season with its first shutout in a season opener since 2006 (10-0 over Cincinnati). **Richie Martin** was 2-for-4 with two runs, **Casey Turgeon** had a pair of hits and Gushue drove in a couple of runs.

**Logan Shore** hurled five scoreless innings on Feb. 13, 2015, as No. 5 Florida started the campaign with a 9-1 victory over Rhode Island at McKethan Stadium. The Gator pitching staff registered nine strikeouts with zero walks.

**Harrison Bader** (2-for-4, three RBI) opened the scoring with a two-out single up the middle in the first inning that brought home **Buddy Reed**, who had legged out an infield hit and taken second on a throwing error.

Bader belted a two-run homer to left field for a 7-0 cushion and **JJ Schwarz** had a double down the left-field line for his first career hit, took third on a single by **A.J. Puk** and came home on a sacrifice fly by **Mike Rivera**.

#### FLORIDA ON OPENING DAY

UF sports a 59-41-1 (.589) record in its previous 101 opening-day contests, including a 39-21-1 (.648) record at home. The Gators have claimed 26 of their last 34 lid-lifters and 19 of their last 24 season debuts in Gainesville.

Before the 4-3 loss to Duke in 2013, the last time Florida had dropped a season opener was a 5-3 setback to VMI on Feb. 9, 2007, and the team's other three home losses to start the year in the past two decades occurred in 2000 (Jacksonville, 13-11), 2001 (Miami (Fla.), 14-5) and in 2005 (Charleston Southern, 5-4 in 11 innings).

UF has started the year on its own turf in 18 of the past 19 seasons, with the lone exception a 12-6 victory at Hawaii on Jan. 20, 2000.

#### SIBLING GATORS

While **JJ Schwarz** is a sophomore catcher on the Gators, his sister **Taylor** is a senior first baseman on the back-to-back NCAA champion Gator softball team.

#### STAFF ADDITION

Former Gator **Josh Adams** is the team's student assistant coach this season. He finished his tenure in Gainesville as the school's all-time leader in games played (253) and games started (252), marks since passed by **Preston Tucker**.

Boasting a career average of .305, Adams departed with his name found throughout the school's career charts, as he is first in both double plays turned (152) and sacrifice bunts (27), tied for first in at bats with **Mark Ellis** (1996-99) (941), third in hits (287), third in assists (644), fifth in runs batted in (188) and total bases (437) and tied for sixth in doubles (51).

The Jacksonville native became just the fifth UF baseball player in school history to achieve All-SEC status in three different seasons, as he garnered first-team accolades in 2008 and 2009 before becoming a second-team recipient in 2011.

#### MAJOR LEAGUE GENES

**Dalton Guthrie**'s father, **Mark Guthrie**, went to LSU, where he played for legendary head coach **Skip Bertman** from 1984-87. The elder Guthrie earned All-SEC and Academic All-SEC and made
