THE FIRST PITCH

► The No. 1-ranked Gator softball team (11-0) will begin a five-day, five-game road trip to California this week at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Palm Springs, Calif. Florida will play two games on Thursday and Friday and one game on Saturday. Highlights of the weekend include matchups with No. 10/11 UCLA and No. 8/9 Washington, who received one first-place vote in the most recent USA Softball/ESPN.com weekly poll.

QUICK HITS

- The Gators have won their first 11 games by a combined margin of 90-4, including eight shutouts and eight mercy-rule victories.
- Florida enters this week as one of nine teams in NCAA Division I softball who are undefeated.
- Although UF's offense is averaging over eight runs per game, which ranks 11th in the country, it's Florida's pitching and defense that have carried the torch thus far in 2016. Florida has allowed just four runs and committed only one error through 11 games.
- The Gators currently sport the best fielding percentage (.996) and the second best earned run average in the nation (0.45). For comparison through 11 games last season, Florida had committed 10 errors in its first 11 contests and had a fielding percentage of .961. UF went on to record its best fielding percentage (.981) and committed just 33 errors which were both school records.
- Florida has not committed an error in 60 straight innings entering the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic.
- Offensively, UF sits second in the country in on-base percentage (.517), 11th in scoring (8.18) and 13th in batting average (.368).
- Florida's top three run producers (Amanda Lorenz - 12, Janell Wheaton - 13, Taylore Fuller - 12) have combined for more RBI's (37) this season than the number of hits (31) the Gator pitching staff has allowed.
- Lorenz (20) and Wheaton (18) have as many total bases combined as UF's opponents (38).
- In addition to leading UF in all these categories, rookie Amanda Lorenz ranks 19th in batting average (.571), 11th in walks (11), seventh in runs (18) and eighth in on base percentage (.692) in the nation.
- Against Omaha this past weekend, Lorenz became the first Gator since Michelle Moultrie on Feb. 19, 2012 to steal 3 bases in a game.
- With a three-hit performance this past Sunday against Jacksonville State, Kelsey Stewart now has 300 hits in her career. The Wichita, Kan. native already holds the UF record and is currently the NCAA active leader by more than 50 hits.
- UF hitters have struck out 18 times on the year; each of the Gators' three pitchers has 20+ strikeouts (Aleshia Ocasio - 32, Delanie Gourley - 30, Kelly Barnhill - 20).
- Gourley is one of 11 pitchers in the country to carry a 0.00 earned run average and the junior currently ranks seventh in the nation strikeouts per game (11.1).

SETTING THE STAGE: MARY NUTTER COLLEGIATE CLASSIC

- Florida's road trip to the Golden State will represent a homecoming for 11 members of the Gator Softball family, as nine UF players hail from California and Head Coach Tim Walton and assistant coach Jennifer Rocha each attended junior college in California.
- The Gators are a combined 18-18 all-time against their weekend opponents. Florida went 3-0 against NC State during the regular season last year and last saw Washington in its 2014 NCAA Super Regional matchup.

Florida Heads West for Annual California Trip

The No. 1-ranked Gator softball team (11-0) will play five games in three days out in Palm Springs, Calif., this week at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic. Florida will play two games on Thursday and Friday and one game on Saturday.

Florida will face UCLA, NC State, Washington, Nebraska and finishes its trip against Utah on Saturday morning. Highlights of the weekend include matchups with No. 10/11 UCLA and No. 8/9 Washington, who received one first-place vote in the most recent USA Softball/ESPN.com weekly poll.

The Gators are a combined 18-18 all-time against their weekend opponents. Florida went 3-0 against NC State during the regular season last year and last saw Washington in its 2014 NCAA Super Regional matchup.

Since Head Coach Tim Walton took the helm at Florida prior to the 2006 season, Florida has played at least five regular season games in California every year except his inaugural season as a Gator and in 2014. Overall, UF is 38-8 when playing regular season games in The Golden State. In addition, UF is 23-2 in such contests since 2011.

Washington and UCLA have combined for three of UF's defeats during its trips out west and the Gators will face each of these teams this week.

In addition to the tough competition out west, Florida's road trip to the Golden State will represent a homecoming for 11 members of the Gator Softball family, as nine UF players hail from California and Head Coach Tim Walton and assistant coach Jennifer Rocha each attended junior college in California.

Between last weekend's trip to Orlando and this week's trip to California, UF is in the midst of its longest road swing of the season.

Florida excelled in neutral-site games in 2015, posting an 18-2 mark. Florida's lone two losses came against Tennessee in the SEC Tournament and in Game 2 of the Women's College World Series Championship Series against Michigan, before UF beat the Wolverines in Game 3 to claim its second-straight NCAA Championship.

UF is 8-0 in neutral site contests this season thus far.

Florida vs. Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic Opponents

UCLA

Series History: After being routed by UCLA, 16-3, in six innings in the opening game of the 2010 Women's College World Series, the Gators had a chance at redemption in the 2011 NCAA Regional in Gainesville. UF took advantage and eliminated the Bruins by defeating them in two out of three games. Overall, the two schools are knotted up at 4-4 all time.

2016 Bruins: UCLA is off to a 7-3 start with both losses coming against Texas A&M, LSU and Notre Dame. The Bruins are led by Selina Ta'amilo in the circle and Mysha Sataraka at the plate. Ta'amilo is 6-1 on the season with a 2.12 ERA and 46 strikeouts in 39.2 innings pitched. Meanwhile, Sataraka hit .542 with three home runs, 12 RBI and seven runs scored. The Bruins were projected to finish second in the Pac-12 preseason poll.

NC State

Series History: After Florida dropped it's first two contests against the Wolfpack, UF has now won five straight in its all-time series, including three wins last season. NC State came down to Gainesville a year ago and Florida beat them by a combined score of 9-3.

2016 Wolfpack: NC State is just 5-4 but has recorded wins over Kansas, Nebraska and Wisconsin during this young season. The Wolfpack are led by Courtney Mirabella in the circle and Tyler Ross at the plate. Mirabella is 3-2 on the season with a 3.39 ERA and 50 strikeouts in 41.1 innings pitched. Meanwhile, Ross hit .367 with four home runs, 12 RBI and 10 runs scored. NC State was projected to finish third in the ACC preseason poll.

Washington

Series History: Florida is 5-10 all time against Washington but most recently defeated them in the 2014 NCAA Super Regional on its way to the Gators first-ever NCAA Championship. Although Florida is 48-8 all-time on its west coast trips during the Tim Walton era, Washington is the only team to defeat UF twice during that span.

2016 Huskies: Washington is just 9-1 this season and surrendered its first loss of the season against Texas A&M. The Huskies are led by Tara Alvelo in the circle and Courtney Gano at the plate. UW was projected to finish fourth in the Pac-12 preseason poll.

Nebraska

Series History: UF is 2-1 all time against Nebraska, but the school's last meeting was the longest game in UF history. The contest was an epic WCWS elimination game that took a school-record 15 innings and featured seven ties, seven lead changes and two Florida runs in the top of the 15th inning for Florida to solidify a 9-8 victory over Nebraska, Skipping ahead to the 15th, then-freshman Taylore Fuller reached on an error, allowing a pair of Gators to score what turned out to be the decisive runs.

2016 Huskers: Nebraska is 8-1 on the season and suffered its lone loss of the season to NC State last weekend. The Huskers are led by Cassie McClure in the circle and MJ Knighten at the plate. McClure is 4-1 on the season with a 1.81 ERA and 23 strikeouts in 19.1 innings pitched. Meanwhile, Knighten is hitting .545 with six home runs, 16 RBI and 12 runs scored.

Utah

Series History: Florida is 2-1 all time against Utah, however these two teams have met just one time since 2000.

2016 Utes: Utah is 8-3 on the season and suffered its three losses to Kentucky, Fresno State and Notre Dame. The Utes are led by Miranda Viramontes in the circle and Delilah Pacheco at the plate. Viramontes is 4-0 on the season with a 0.00 ERA and 16 strikeouts in 15.0 innings pitched. Meanwhile, Pacheco is hitting .429 with five RBI and 10 runs scored.

Last Time Out

UF defeated Jacksonville State, 10-0 (5 innings), last Sunday in Florida's final game of the Diamond 9 Citrus Classic. Senior Kelsey Stewart led the Gators with a home run, double two RBI and three runs scored in the game.

The long ball and pair of RBI were Stewart's first of the season.

In the circle, sophomore Aleshia Ocasio threw the first four shutout innings for Florida before junior Delanie Gourley tossed a scoreless fifth. The duo combined for seven strikeouts, while walking only one Gamecock hitter.

No Hits For You

In game one, Ocasio recorded the 16th no hitter in Florida history and the first since her teammate Delanie Gourley threw one in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Florida A&M (May, 16).

A hit batter in the first and a walk in the fourth were the only base runners allowed. In addition, Ocasio's no-no was the first in a home opener in program history.

History Repeated

After Aleshia Ocasio no-hit Jacksonville in game one and Kelly Barnhill one-hit the Dolphins in game two of a doubleheader on Feb. 17, they became the first set of Florida teammates to throw a no hitter and one hitter back to back since Stacey Nelson and Stephanie Brombacher accomplished the feat on Feb. 13, 2009 against Texas Tech and Coastal Carolina.

Runs Rule

UF has now outscored its opponents this season, 90-4. Last year, UF had a plus-77 run differential (87-10) through 11 games. UF has earned run-rule wins in eight of its 12 contests in 2016.

California Dreaming

Coach Walton, a native of Cerritos, Calif., is not the only Gator who's from the west coast, as seven of the 19 members of the softball team – senior Aubree Munro (Brea), juniors Delanie Gourley (Lakeside) and Justine McLean (Rancho Cucamonga), sophomores Nicole DeWitt (Garden Grove) and Janell Wheaton (San Dimas), and freshmen Amanda Lorenz (Moorpark) and Sophia Reynoso (Palmdale) – all hail from California. In addition, assistant coach Jennifer Rocha grew up and attended junior college in the Golden State.

Preseason National Prominence

Coming off the program's second straight national championship, UF opened the 2016 season as the No. 1-ranked squad in the country, according to the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball polls.

Entering his 11th season, Head Coach Tim Walton has the nation's preseason No. 1 team for the third time and second year in a row. Prior to last season, the Gators opened atop the rankings in 2009 following their record-setting 70-win campaign in 2008.

In the most recent set of polls, Florida received all but one first place vote.

Trio of Gators Named to Preseason All-SEC Team

UF was well-represented on the preseason All-SEC with seniors Kirsti Merritt, Aubree Munro and Kelsey Stewart all making the list. Stewart is making her third consecutive appearance on the preseason team, while Merritt and Munro are making their debut. UF and AU led all schools

with three selections each. UA and LSU have two representatives apiece on the squad, while Georgia, Kentucky, South Carolina and Tennessee each had one player named to the team. The list is comprised of two sophomores, one junior and 11 seniors.

Gator Duo Named to USA Softball Top 50 Watch List

Florida seniors Aubree Munro and Kelsey Stewart were named to the Top 50 "Watch List" for the 2016 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year. Eight athletes, including Munro and Stewart, on the Top 50 "Watch List" will compete as a member of the 2016 USA Softball Women's National Team this summer. A season ago, Lauren Haeger became the first Gator to receive the award, which is considered the most prestigious honor in Division I women's softball.

Best of the Best (SEC Preseason Predictions)

The defending SEC Champion Gators have been picked by a vote of the league's head coaches as the preseason favorite for 2016. Florida received 10 first-place votes from the SEC's 13 head coaches, who were not allowed to vote for their own teams. The Gators will look to win their second-straight SEC regular season crown in 2016, a feat UF last achieved in 2008 and 2009. In its history, Florida owns five regular-season SEC crowns (1998, 2008, '09, '13, '15) and three conference tournament championships ('08, '09, '13).

Back For More

Florida's senior class has been one of the most successful groups in school history, boasting a 184-28 record (51-20 SEC) through three seasons at Florida. In addition, UF's senior class is now an astonishing 87-12 at home. The Gator seniors were a part of two NCAA Championships (2014, 2015) and two SEC Championships (2013, 2014). The class boasts one All-American and two NFCA Academic All-Americans. Taylore Fuller has hit eight grand slams, which ranks third in NCAA history. Outfielder Kirsti Merritt is a two-time NFCA All-Southeast Region honoree and became the first freshman to ever be named the SEC Tournament MVP in 2013. Aubree Munro is a two-time WCWS All-Tournament Team selection and is regarded as perhaps the best defensive catcher in program history. Last season, Munro did not make an error in 354 chances behind the plate. Taylor Schwarz enters this season ranked tied for fifth in career fielding percentage (.993) in Gator annals. UF's final senior is a two-time NFCA All-American and last season's SEC Player of the Year, Kelsey Stewart, who enters this season already first in Gator history for hits (294), triples (27) and steals (98) after three seasons.

Florida's senior class is trying to catch UF's 2011 class which boasted a 238-33 mark during their four years.

Player Rankings

Kelsey Stewart continues to rewrite Florida's record books. She owns three single season offensive records and appears in 11 top-10 offensive career lists. Stewart's three single-season records are 102 hits (2014), 11 triples (2015) and 36 stolen bases (2013 & '14).

Kirsti Merritt holds the UF single-season record for getting hit by a pitch with 35 last season. For her career, Merritt sits atop the Florida record book with 57. The NCAA record is held by Mariah Gearhart (Oklahoma State) with 92 for her career.

Taylore Fuller is ranked third in NCAA history in career grand slams with eight and second in UF lore. Gator Great Francesca Enea notched nine and Michigan senior Sierra Romero has the most all-time with eleven.

Taylor Schwarz has turned 60 double plays in her career, which is tied for the school record with Melissa Zick.

2016 Season Notes

Georgia, Kentucky, Missouri and South Carolina will be the four SEC schools that UF will not face during the regular season. All Florida's home games (minus the Aquafina Invitational) will be broadcast on either the SEC Network+ or on one of the ESPN Family of Networks.

The longest home stand for the Gators is eight games (April 13-24). The longest road trip for the Gators is five games (Feb. 25-27) when the Gators head to Palm Springs, Calif. for the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic.

UF entered the season ranked first in the ESPN/USA Today preseason polls for the second consecutive year. Last season, Florida became the first team since Arizona in 2007 to be ranked No. 1 in the first and last polls of the year.

Florida's 6-0 win against Jacksonville in game one of a doubleheader ended a streak of four straight run-rule victories to begin the 2016 campaign, which was the longest such streak to start a season in program history. In addition, Florida shut out and run-ruled its first three opponents for the first time since 2012. Florida became the first defending NCAA Champion to shut out its first three opponents since 1992, when Arizona shutout its first seven foes.

"When you're a highly successful program, it's about blending of competitive spirits and friendships, and getting the younger players to buy into the legacies left from class to class. The seniors to freshmen are such a big age difference, so there's a meshing period you have to go through. Our older players have been very welcoming from the beginning, but with that welcoming come expectations that you have to bring it every day." -- Tim Walton

Tim Walton has brought Florida softball to the pinnacle of success in his 10-plus years at the helm of the Gators squad. Under Walton's tutelage, Florida became the first Southeastern Conference institution in history to earn four consecutive Women's College World Series berths (2008-11). The Orange and Blue have earned a total of seven WCWS berths since Walton's arrival, with four championship series appearances and the program's first and second national titles in 2014 and 2015.

Walton reached a career milestone when he earned career win No. 600 in just his 12th season as a head coach in 2014. Coming in his 774th game as a head coach, the Gators used an 8-0 mercy-rule victory at SEC rival Texas A&M to complete a three-game sweep on Easter Sunday, making Walton the fastest active head coach in the Southeastern Conference to reach 600 lifetime victories.

Entering 2016, Walton has a 556-121 record at the head of the Gator program and a 679-185 (.785) career record in 13 seasons as a head coach. Florida has seven 50-win and three 60-win seasons in program history, all under Walton.

In his 10 years at Florida, Walton has led the Orange and Blue to countless school and SEC records, and his squads have earned numerous firsts for the Gator softball program. In 2011, UF advanced to an unprecedented fourth straight Women's College World Series, including its second trip to the Championship Series. Working as a four-time SEC Coach of the Year, Walton has led the Gators to four SEC regular-season and three conference tournament titles. UF has made the NCAA Tournament every year of his tenure, hosted Regionals all 10 times and played host to NCAA Super Regionals seven times from 2008-15. Florida reached the pinnacle of college softball in 2014, capturing the national championship with a two-game sweep of Southeastern Conference rival Alabama in the finals. This past season in 2015, Walton and his squad won the program's second-straight national title, defeating Michigan two games to one in the final of the WCWS.

In the 34-year history of the WCWS, 12 different teams have claimed the national title. Florida joined UCLA (2003, 2004 / 1988, 1989, 1990 / 1984, 1985) and Arizona (2006, 2007 / 1996, 1997 / 1993, 1994) as the only three programs to claim NCAA titles in consecutive years.

On the softball diamond, Walton has tutored 14 Florida student-athletes to 29 NFCA All-America honors, 19 players to 44 NFCA All-Southeast Region honors, has produced 15 WCWS All-Tournament team selections (including three Most Outstanding Players), coached 19 Gator athletes to 41 All-SEC honors and racked up 17 SEC All-Tournament team honors, including three MVPs, three SEC Pitchers of the Year and four SEC Players of the Year. Most recently, Gators Kelsey Stewart and Lauren Haeger won the conference's Player and Pitcher of the Year awards in 2015, becoming UF's fourth and third honorees in program history. Additionally, Haeger brought home the 2015 Honda Sports Award, designating her as the nation's top collegiate female athlete in the sport of softball. Haeger was the second Gator to receive the Honda Award, as Kelsey Bruder was UF's first recipient in 2011. Shortly after Bruder claimed that honor, she was awarded the NCAA Today's Top VIII Award as one of the top eight NCAA athletes in the country during the 2010-11 school year.

Under Walton's direction, the Florida coaching staff has earned NFCA Southeast Regional Coaching Staff of the Year honors four times and the team was one of Easton's Teams of the Year in 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011.

In 2015, Walton and his staff were named the NFCA Division I National Coaching Staff of the Year, the first time in school history Florida has earned this accolade.

Under Walton's watch, the Gators have shattered over 300 University of Florida records since 2006. His 2008 squad recorded an NCAA-record 70 wins and posted the best SEC record in league history at 27-1. The Orange and Blue shattered its own SEC single-season wins record with 332 in 2013, while the Gators boasted a .981 fielding percentage in 2015 committing a program-record low 33 errors during the season. Florida's 2011 squad downed eight SEC records, including four team season records for runs (508), RBI (479) and walks (322), while extending its standing single-season homers record to 124. The 2012 Gator squad set the league record for slugging percentage (.627), while the 2009 Gators became only the second team to ever register a perfect conference road record (13-0).

After winning the program's first national championship in 2014, the Gators followed that by becoming just the third program in NCAA history to win back-to-back softball titles in 2015. In the 34-year history of the WCWS, 12 different teams have claimed the national title and Florida joined UCLA (2003, 2004 / 1988, 1989, 1990 / 1984, 1985) and Arizona (2006, 2007 / 1996, 1997 / 1993, 1994) as the only three programs to claim NCAA titles in consecutive years.

This season seniors Kelsey Stewart, Taylore Fuller, Kirsti Merritt, Aubree Munro and Taylor Schwarz are the elders of a squad that will start the season No. 1 and seek to join UCLA (1988-90) as the only programs to win three straight national titles.

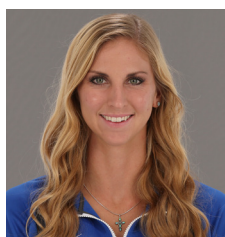
