Reigning Champs

- Florida's men won the program's eighth SEC Indoor Championships crown in 2015
- The Gators are eyeing consecutive indoor SEC titles for only the third time in program history (1975-96, 1987-88)

Chasing No. 9

- Florida's women are seeking the program's ninth victory at the SEC Indoor Championships, with its most recent title coming in 2014.
- The Gators have won three of the last six SEC Indoor Championships, nabbing titles in 2010, 2012 and 2014.

It's Not Preseason Anymore

- Florida's men were ranked No. 1, while its women checked in at No. 6 in the USTFCCCA Preseason National Team Computer Rankings. Since then, the Gators dropped to No. 10 on the men's side and jumped to No. 3 on the women's side.

Elite Quarter-Milers Trio

- Florida is just the second women's team since 2000 (Texas, 2015) boasting three 400 meters runners--**Claudia Francis**, **Kyra Jefferson**, **Robin Reynolds**-- with times faster than 52.40 seconds before the NCAA Indoor Championships.
- Last year's Texas 4x400-meter relay team won the national title and clocked the sixth-fastest time in collegiate history.

Repeaters?

- Senior sprinter **Kyra Jefferson** would be the seventh woman in history to win back-to-back 200 meters titles at the SEC Indoor Championships.
- Senior sprinter **Najee Glass** would be the fifth man in history to win consecutive 400 meters titles at the SEC Indoor Championships. Two of the previous men to do it--Tyrone Kemp (1989-90), Jimmie Hackley (1997-98)--were Gators.
- Senior middle distance runner **Ryan Schnulle** could become the sixth man in history and the first since Alabama's Peter Etot (2003-04) to win a second consecutive SEC Indoor Championships 800 meters title.
- If either Schnulle or junior middle distance runner **Andres Arroyo** wins the 800 meters, it would be Florida's third title in the event over the last four seasons. Only four programs (Tennessee, 1992-94; Arkansas, 1998-2000; Auburn, 2003-04, 2006; LSU 2007-08, 2010) have won three indoor 800 meters crowns in a four-year span.
- Sophomore jumper **KeAndre Bates** could become the sixth man since 2002 to post top-five finishes in both horizontal jumps at consecutive SEC Indoor Championships.

Rarified Air

- Sprinter **Ryan Clark** is just the fourth Division I true freshman since 2000 to run faster than 6.65 in the 60 meters and 20.94 in the indoor 200 meters.
- The other three to accomplish that feat are Florida State's Walter Dix (2005) and Trentavis Friday (2015) and Tennessee's Justin Gatlin (2001). Dix went on to win two silver medals at the 2011 IAAF World Championships and two bronze medals at the 2008 Olympics--all in the 100 and 200 meters. Gatlin eventually amassed 12 medals, including five golds, at the Olympics, IAAF World Championships, and World Indoor Championships. Friday turned professional in November 2015.
- Clark also joined **John Capel** (1999) as the only other freshman in program history to post such times. Capel was a 2000 Olympian, won gold medals in the 200 meters and 4x100-meter relay at the 2003 IAAF World Championships, and took bronze in the 200 meters at the 2005 IAAF World Championships.

Quite A Debut

- In only her third collegiate attempt, **Yanis David** became the fifth Division I true freshman since 2000 to post a triple jump mark of 13.50 meters.
- The other four to do it are: Georgia's Ketura Orji (2015), Florida State's Kimberly Williams (2008), Stanford's Erica McLain (2005), and Miami (Fla.)'s Tabia Charles (2004). Aside from Orji, last year's outdoor national champion and indoor national runner-up finisher, each member of that group went on to compete at the Olympics and/or multiple World Championships following their collegiate careers.

Historic Double Duty

- Senior sprinter **Claudia Francis** is the only woman since at least 2002 to finish the 400 meters in less than 53 seconds and the 800 meters in less than 2:06 prior to the NCAA Indoor Championships.
- Francis is also the only woman in school history to crack the All-Time Indoor Top 10 in both the 400 meters and 800 meters.

It's Been A While

- If redshirt sophomore pole vaulter **Aaron Owens** can clear his personal record of 5.21 meters, it would be the best clearance by a Gator at the SEC Indoor Championships since **Chip Heuser** (5.25m) and **Paul Condron** (5.32m) both hit that mark in 2004.
- If two of Florida's three pole vaulters can clear 5.00 meters, it would be fourth time UF's done that since 2000. The Gators last accomplished that in 2008, when three vaulters cleared that height--which was the only time Florida's accomplished that since 2000.
- Florida is seeking its first top-five finish in the men's pole vault at SEC Indoor Championships since **Mike Morrison** took fourth place in 2008.

KeAndre Bates, Christian Taylor, Same Sentence

- By finishing fifth in the long jump and triple jump at the 2015 SEC Indoor Championships, **KeAndre Bates** joined Florida alum **Christian Taylor** and Arkansas' Tarik Batchelor as the only freshmen since 2000 to post top-five finishes in both horizontal jumps.
- Taylor, a two-time world champion and 2012 Olympic gold medalist in the triple jump, and Batchelor both accomplished the feat in 2009.

Doubling Down

- If both **Yanis David** and sophomore **Darrielle McQueen** score in both horizontal jumps, it would mark only the fourth time since 2002 two teammates scored in the long jump and triple jump at the SEC Indoor Championships.

That 1-2 Finish Though

- Andres Arroyo** and senior **Ryan Schnulle** became just the third pair of teammates to win and take runner-up honors in the men's 800 meters at the SEC Indoor Championships.
- The only other duos to accomplish the feat are LSU's Richard Jones and Sadiki White in 2010, and LSU's Elkana Kosgei and Jamaal James in 2008, with both those occurrences coming at the Randal Tyson Track Center.

In 2015, Marquis Dendy became the first Florida Gator to win The Bowerman, track and field's highest individual honor and the sport's equivalent to college football's Heisman Trophy.

Florida's other two The Bowerman finalists since the award's inception in 2009 are Christian Taylor (2011) and Tony McQuay (2012).

This watch list is trimmed to 10 semifinalists after the NCAA Outdoor Championships, followed by an announcement of three finalists roughly two weeks later.

The Bowerman is presented annually by the USTFCCA to the most outstanding male and female collegiate track and field athletes in the nation. The award is named after Bill Bowerman, legendary former track and field and cross country coach of the Oregon Ducks and co-founder of NIKE.

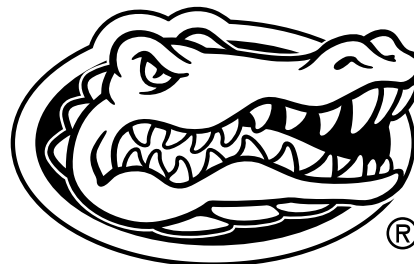

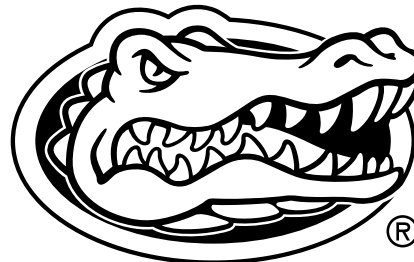

- Originally from Jamaica, Barnett moved to the United States just weeks before the start of her freshman year of high school. She said trying out for Oak Ridge High School's cross country and track teams, with the latter being coached by a fellow Jamaican and former University of Georgia sprinter, Odeika Bent, allowed her to become more comfortable in the U.S.

JIMMY CLARK & EDDIE GARCIA (men's distance)

- The distance duo have been roommates the past three years, have birthdays one day apart, and hail neighboring Jacksonville, Fla. counties. Shortly after Eddie committed to Florida, Jimmy, not knowing his future teammate had already chosen the Gators, called Garcia in an attempt to recruit him.

CLAUDIA FRANCIS (women's sprints)

- Transferred to Florida from Oregon in the summer of 2014 following the departure of older sister, Phyllis Francis, a five-time individual NCAA Champion and collegiate indoor 400 meters record holder who went on to earn a silver medal at the 2015 IAAF World Championships as a member of the United States' 4x400-meter relay team.
- Claudia wanted a fresh start and to get back closer to home, with one perk being in the same time zone as her parents.
- Francis was primarily an 800 meters runner in her first season at Florida (2015), but made transitioned to the 400 meters indoors to prepare to run the 400-meter hurdles during the outdoor season.

YANICK HART (men's hurdles)

- A product of the renowned track and field program at Wolmer's Boys School in Jamaica. While Yanick has a mom and dad, he was raised by another guardian in Jamaica, as his parents did not have the means to support him. To this day, he still keeps in touch with her, as she now lives in Miami.

KYRA JEFFERSON (women's sprints)

- While Kyra was raised by her mother in Detroit, her father, Thomas Jefferson, was a world-class sprinter who won the bronze medal in the 200 meters at the 1984 Olympic Games in Los Angeles. He now resides in Atlanta. Additionally, Jefferson's mother, Michele Watkins, was a seven-time All-American and member of two 1985 NCAA Championship-winning relay teams in her track career at LSU.

DARRIELLE McQUEEN (women's jumps)

- Darrielle's father, Darrell, passed away the week of the 2015 NCAA Outdoor Championships after a three-month battle with cancer. Her dad's final wish was for Darrielle to compete that week, which she did, taking 12th place in the long jump.

SHAYLA SANDERS (women's sprints)

- Shayla was a sixth-grade cheerleader when her father first pushed her to attend a track tryout.
- Sanders suffered a stress fracture in her back prior to her freshman outdoor season, which forced her to wear a back brace for 12 weeks and redshirt.

TAYLOR TUBBS (women's distance)

- By her sophomore year, Tubbs became a TA for economics courses at UF. Tubbs trained overseas in the Netherlands this past summer as part of a study abroad program.

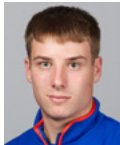
