Last Serve with the Bears

Florida defeated Cal on May 19, 2013, 4-2 in the NCAA Quarterfinals. The victory gave the Gators their fourth consecutive trip to the NCAA Final Four. Current senior Brianna Morgan was part of the victory, getting a doubles win at No. 3 and started the match at No. 4 singles.

UF vs. No. 1 Opponents

Since the beginning of women's collegiate tennis rankings, UF is 9-8 in matches against No. 1 ranked opponents. The Gators' last contest against a No. 1 team was a 4-1 win against Georgia on May 17, 2014 in the NCAA Quarterfinals.

A Month of Tough Opponents

The month of February has provided a gauntlet of ranked opponent for UF. The Gators will face five Top-30 opponents in a four-week period that includes USC (4), Baylor (29), Clemson (20), California (1) and Stanford (16).

UF vs. Pac-12 Opponents

The Orange and Blue are 72-38 against Pac-12 opponents. UF has already defeated one highly-ranked Pac-12 opponent this season by defeating then-No. 4 USC, 7-0 on Feb. 7

Dealing in Doubles

Florida has three doubles pairings in the latest ITA Individual Rankings, all in the Top-50. The Gators have not dropped a doubles point in the 2016 season. UF was 19-0 when taking the doubles point in 2015.

The Streak

Florida has won 151 straight dual matches at the Ring Tennis Complex, dating back to the 2005 season. The run is good for the longest active win streak at the Division I level.

Florida vs. Top-5 Opponents

Since the beginning of the collegiate tennis team rankings in 1987, the Orange and Blue have an all-time record of 115-51, when competing against Top-5 opponents. UF was 1-2 against Top-5 teams last year, defeating Georgia, but falling to UNC and Vanderbilt.

44th Season

The 2015-16 season will be the 44th year UF has sponsored a varsity women's tennis team. The Orange and Blue enter the year with an overall record of 975-142.

Season Opening Success

After the Gators' 6-1 win over USF, Florida has not dropped a season opening dual match in 31 years. The last time UF fell in a season opener was on Feb. 1, 1985 at Miami.

Sunshine State Streak

UF is currently on a 25 dual match win streak against in-state rivals. Florida is an impressive 203-33 against Sunshine State opponents

Home Sweet Home

The Orange and Blue are an outstanding 482-25 at the Ring Tennis Complex, including a 14-0 record at home in 2015. UF has produced 27 undefeated home seasons.

New Season, New Gator

In July, the Florida Gators added Russia native Anna Danilina to the squad. The 5-11 sophomore brings a wealth of experience to the team after competing on the junior and professional circuits.

Back in the Orange and Blue

UF returns seven members from the 2014-15 squad that reached the NCAA Quarterfinals, including three All-Americans in Brooke Austin, Kourtney Keegan and Josie Kuhlman. Spencer Liang, Brianna Morgan, Peggy Porter and Belinda Woolcock are also back to build upon the 2015 season.

2015 Fall Recap

Junior Belinda Woolcock posted a stellar 15-3 singles record during the fall campaign, including two semifinal berths in the USTA/ITA Southeast Regional and the National Indoor Championships. The Gator also worked through three qualifying matches in the ITA All-American to eventually reach the main draw singles quarterfinals.

Dick Vitale Clay Court Classic

Newcomer Anna Danilina and Brianna Morgan took home the doubles title at the Dick Vitale Clay Court Classic with four match victories. Danilina and Morgan compiled a 13-3 doubles record during the fall.

By the ITA's Numbers

The ITA Preseason Rankings have UF at No. 3 in the nation behind Vanderbilt and USC. The Gators currently have seven singles players and four doubles pairings in the individual rankings. Florida is one of four programs with two players (Woolcock: 3, Austin 11) ranked in the Top-15 and the ONLY program in the nation with two doubles teams (Austin/Keegan: 5, Kuhlman/Woolcock:15) in the Top-15.

ITA Southeast Regional: All the Gator Doubles

UF returned to Gainesville early on the ITA Southeast Regional weekend after sweeping the doubles competition. The Gators would hold all four positions in the semifinals. Kuhlman and Woolcock would edge out teammates Austin and Keegan, 3-6, 6-0, 14-12.
