THE FIRST PITCH

▶ The No. 1-ranked Gator Softball team (16-0) begins an eight-game homestand this weekend with six games at the Aquafina Invitational. Florida will play Illinois State and FIU twice and have a single game against South Alabama and Florida A&M. The Redbirds, Panthers, Jaguars and Rattlers also will play a total of seven additional games during the tournament.

QUICK HITS

- ▶ The Gators have won their first 16 games by a combined margin of 109-8, including 10 shutouts and nine mercy-rule victories.
- ▶ UF enters this week as one of three teams (UTA, Harvard) in NCAA Division I softball who are undefeated.
- ▶ Although UF's offense is averaging 6.81 runs per game, which ranks 29th in the country, it's Florida's pitching and defense that have carried the torch thus far in 2016. Florida has allowed just eight runs and committed only five errors through 16 games.
- ▶ The Gators currently sport the third-best fielding percentage (.987) and the top earned run average in the nation (0.52). For comparison through 16 games last season, Florida had committed 13 errors and had a fielding percentage of .966. UF went on to record its best fielding percentage (.981) and committed just 33 errors which were both school records.
- ▶ Florida has not committed an error in 10 consecutive innings entering the Aquafina Invitational. UF's error against NC State last weekend snapped its longest streak of the season, 72 innings.
- ▶ The Gators still have yet to allow an opponent to steal a base this season.
- ▶ Offensively, UF sits third in the country in on-base percentage (.495), 29th in scoring (6.81) and 15th in batting average (.363).
- ▶ Amanda Lorenz (19), Janell Wheaton (18) and Kelsey Stewart (17) have combined for more hits (55) this season than the number of hits (50) the Gator pitching staff has allowed.
- ▶ In addition to leading UF in all these categories, rookie Amanda Lorenz ranks 32nd in batting average (.500), seventh in walks (19), 19th in runs (21) and fifth in on base percentage (.667) in the nation.
- ▶ Janell Wheaton hit two homers against No. 8 Washington last week to propel the UF to a 3-1 win. Both were solo shots in the fourth and sixth innings, with the first tying the game and the second giving UF a 2-1 lead.
- ▶ Kelsey Stewart paced the Gators at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic last weekend as she hit .556 (10 for 18) with one triple, one RBI and five runs scored. The Wichita, Kan. native now has 310 hits in her career, which makes her the NCAA active leader by more then 50 hits.
- ▶ UF hitters have struck out 39 times on the year; each of the Gators' three pitchers has 39+ strikeouts (Aleshia Ocasio 41, Delanie Gourley 39, Kelly Barnhill 42).
- ▶ Gourley has the fifth-best ERA in the nation (0.24) and Barnhill ranks 18th in the strikeouts per game (9.9).

SETTING THE STAGE: AQUAFINA INVITATIONAL

- ▶ Florida holds a combined record of 29-5 against Florida A&M (12-0), FIU (11-3), Illinois State (5-2) and South Alabama (1-0). UF faced ISU on opening day this season at the USF Wilson-DeMarini Tournament in Tampa, where the Gators downed the Redbirds 11-0 in five innings.
- ▶ Since Head Coach Tim Walton took the helm at Florida prior to the 2006 season, Florida has played at least five regular season games in a UF-hosted tournament. Overall, UF is 71-5 when playing in its own tournament. In addition, UF is 57-0 in such contests since 2008.

No. 1 Florida Hosts Aquafina Invitational

The No. 1-ranked Gator Softball team (16-0) begins an eight-game homestand this weekend with six games at the Aquafina Invitational. Florida will play Illinois State and FIU twice and have a single game against South Alabama and Florida A&M. The Redbirds, Panthers, Jaguars and Rattlers also will play a total of seven additional games during the tournament.

Florida holds a combined record of 29-5 against Florida A&M (12-0), FIU (11-3), Illinois State (5-2) and South Alabama (1-0). UF faced ISU on opening day this season at the USF Wilson-DeMarini Tournament in Tampa, where the Gators downed the Redbirds 11-0 in five innings.

Since Head Coach Tim Walton took the helm at Florida prior to the 2006 season. Florida has played at least five regular season games in a UF-hosted tournament. Overall, UF is 71-5 when playing in its own tournament. In addition, UF is 57-0 in such contests since 2008.

Florida's five losses in 2006 and 2007 were to NC State (2x), Michigan, DePaul and Seton Hall.

Florida is 24-1 against in-state opponents since the start of the 2014 season and has won 14 straight regular season home games entering this weekend.

Florida vs. Aquafina Invitational Opponents **Illinois State**

Series History: Florida is 5-2 all-time against Illinois State and winners of five straight. These two squads have played four times in the last two seasons, and Florida has won those contests by a combined score of 26-3. Prior to 2012, the Gators only saw ISU twice in 2007, falling 1-0 both times.

2016 Redbirds: ISU is off to a 3-11 start with its wins coming against Virginia Tech. Memphis and Montana. The Redbirds are led by Sarah Finck in the circle and Jordan De Los Reyes at the plate. Finck is 3-6 on the season with a 4.17 ERA and 21 strikeouts in 43.2 innings pitched. Meanwhile, De Los Reyes is hitting .348 with four home runs, 10 RBI and six runs scored.

Series History: After Florida dropped it's two of three contests against the Panthers, UF has now won 10 of its past 11 in the all-time series, including five straight. The Gators and FIU last met in 2012, when they played a weekend series that ended in a Florida sweep by a combined score of 23-5.

2016 Panthers: FIU is 11-5 and has recorded wins over two Big 10 teams, Illinois (10-8) and Indiana (5-2). The Panthers are led by Abby Summers in the circle and Stephanie Texeira at the plate. Summers is 5-1 on the season with a 0.84 ERA and 23 strikeouts in 33.1 innings pitched. Meanwhile, Texeira is hitting .538 with seven home runs, 23 RBI and 13 runs scored.

South Alabama

Series History: Florida and South Alabama's only meeting came in 2009 when the Gators downed the Jaguars 13-0 in Gainesville. In that contest, Francesca Enea hit a grand slam and finished with a career-high-tying five RBI to lead Florida to victory.

2016 Jaguars: South Alabama is 8-6 this season and has defeated the University of Alabama at Birmingham, the only common opponent between the two schools. The Jaquars are led by Devin Brown in the circle and Emily Messer at the plate. Brown is 4-4 on the season with a 1.54 ERA and 82 strikeouts in 50.0 innings pitched. Meanwhile, Messer is hitting .529 with three doubles, two triples, eight RBI and 14 runs scored.

Series History: UF is 12-0 all time against the Rattlers and 3-0 in the last two seasons. Florida and Florida A&M last met in the 2015 NCAA Regional when now-sophomore Aleshia Ocasio tied a school record with 17 strikeouts.

2016 Rattlers: Florida A&M is 5-6 on the season and recorded two of its wins against UConn last week. The Rattlers are led by Kenya Pereira in the circle and Amber Fullwood at the plate. Pereira is 3-2 on the season with a 3.97 ERA and 26 strikeouts in 37.0 innings pitched. Meanwhile, Burse is hitting .400 with two home runs, four RBI and three runs scored.

Last Time Out

UF defeated Utah 1-0 on Saturday to complete a perfect five-game road trip in California. Sophomore right-hander Aleshia Ocasio (5-0) earned the win after she allowed just one hit to go along with six strikeouts and no walks over six innings. The St. Cloud. Fla. native retired 18 straight Utah hitters after allowing a single to start the game.

Offensively, Florida had runners on in each of the first five innings, including two in third and two in the fourth, before the Gators finally broke through in the fifth.

During that inning, sophomore Nicole DeWitt and freshman Amanda Lorenz reached on a

single and walk to put runners at first and second with one out. As she has all weekend, sophomore Janell Wheaton came through with an RBI single to right field scoring DeWitt from second.

Junior Delanie Gourley relieved Ocasio and tossed a clean seventh to preserve the win and earn her first save of the season and the eighth of her career.

A Month to Remember

Florida went undefeated in February (16-0) for the only the third time in school history. During their first month of the season Florida outscored its opponents 109-8 and recorded nine run-rule victories. UF's 2011, 2014 and 2015 teams were the only others in program history to accomplish this feat.

No Hits For You

In game one, Ocasio recorded the 16th no hitter in Florida history and the first since her teammate Delanie Gourley threw one in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Florida A&M (May, 16).

A hit batter in the first and a walk in the fourth were the only base runners allowed. In addition, Ocasio's no-no was the first in a home opener in program history.

History Repeated

After Aleshia Ocasio no-hit Jacksonville in game one and Kelly Barnhill one-hit the Dolphins in game two of a doubleheader on Feb. 17, they became the first set of Florida teammates to throw a no hitter and one hitter back to back since Stacey Nelson and Stephanie Brombacher accomplished the feat on Feb. 13, 2009 against Texas Tech and Coastal Carolina.

Strikeout City

Kelly Barnhill recorded a career-high and Florida season-high 14 strikeouts against NC State. Her 14 strikeouts were tied for the seventh most in Florida history. The Marietta, Ga., native became the third UF freshman pitcher to have a double-digit strikeout game in as many years and the fifth in the past six season (Ocasio – 2015; Gourley – 2014; Haeger – 2012; Rogers – 2011).

Runs Rule

UF has now outscored its opponents this season, 109-8. Last year, UF had a plus-121 run differential (139-18) through 16 games. UF has earned run-rule wins in nine of its 16 contests in 2016.

Neutral Success

Florida completed the tournament portion of its schedule with a perfect 13-0 record against teams on a neutral field. This marks the second season in a row that UF has completed an unblemished regular season in neutral site contests. The next time Florida will play a neutral field game will be in Starkville, Miss. at the SEC Tournament in early May.

Preseason National Prominence

Coming off the program's second straight national championship, UF opened the 2016 season as the No. 1-ranked squad in the country, according to the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball polls.

Entering his 11th season, Head Coach Tim Walton has the nation's preseason No. 1 team for the third time and second year in a row. Prior to last season, the Gators opened atop the rankings in 2009 following their record-setting 70-win campaign in 2008.

In the most recent set of polls, Florida received all but one first place vote.

Trio of Gators Named to Preseason All-SEC Team

UF was well-represented on the preseason All-SEC with seniors Kirsti Merritt, Aubree Munro and Kelsey Stewart all making the list. Stewart is making her third consecutive appearance on the preseason team, while Merritt and Munro are making their debut. UF and AU led all schools with three selections each. UA and LSU have two representatives apiece on the squad, while Georgia, Kentucky, South Carolina and Tennessee each had one player named to the team. The list is comprised of two sophomores, one junior and 11 seniors.

Gator Duo Named to USA Softball Top 50 Watch List

Florida seniors Aubree Munro and Kelsey Stewart were named to the Top 50 "Watch List" for the 2016 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year. Eight athletes, including Munro and Stewart, on the Top 50 "Watch List" will compete as a member of the 2016 USA Softball Women's National Team this summer. A season ago, Lauren Haeger became the first Gator to receive the award, which is considered the most prestigious honor in Division I women's softball.

Best of the Best (SEC Preseason Predictions)

The defending SEC Champion Gators have been picked by a vote of the league's head coaches as the preseason favorite for 2016. Florida received 10 first-place votes from the SEC's 13 head coaches, who were not allowed to vote for their own teams. The Gators will look to win their second-straight SEC regular season crown in 2016, a feat UF last achieved in 2008 and 2009.

2016 FLORIDA NEWS AND NOTES

In its history, Florida owns five regular-season SEC crowns (1998, 2008, '09, '13, '15) and three conference tournament championships ('08, '09, '13).

Back For More

Florida's senior class has been one of the most successful groups in school history, boasting a 189-28 record (51-20 SEC) at Florida. In addition, UF's senior class is now an astonishing 87-12 at home. The Gator seniors were a part of two NCAA Championships (2014, 2015) and two SEC Championships (2013, 2014). The class boasts one All-American and two NFCA Academic All-Americans. Taylore Fuller has hit eight grand slams, which ranks third in NCAA history. Outfielder Kirsti Merritt is a two-time NFCA All-Southeast Region honoree and became the first freshman to ever be named the SEC Tournament MVP in 2013. Aubree Munro is a two-time WCWS All-Tournament Team selection and is regarded as perhaps the best defensive catcher in program history. Last season, Munro did not made an error in 354 chances behind the plate. Taylor Schwarz enters this season ranked tied for fifth in career fielding percentage (.993) in Gator annals. UF's final senior is a two-time NFCA All-American and last season's SEC Player of the Year, Kelsey Stewart, who entered this season already first in Gator history for hits, triples and steals.

Florida's senior class is trying to catch UF's 2011 class which boasted a 238-33 mark during their four years.

Player Rankings

Kelsey Stewart continues to rewrite Florida's record books. She owns three single season offensive records and appears in 11 top-10 offensive career lists. Stewart's three single-season records are 102 hits (2014), 11 triples (2015) and 36 stolen bases (2013 & '14).

Taylore Fuller is ranked third in NCAA history in career grand slams with eight and second in UF lore. Gator Great Francesca Enea notched nine and Michigan senior Sierra Romero has the most all-time with eleven.

Taylor Schwarz has turned 61 double plays in her career, which is the most in school history passing Melissa Zick (60).

2016 Season Notes

Georgia, Kentucky, Missouri and South Carolina will be the four SEC schools that UF will not face during the regular season. All Florida's home games (minus the Aquafina Invitational) will be broadcast on either the SEC Network+ or on one of the ESPN Family of Networks.

The longest home stand for the Gators is eight games (April 13-24). The longest road trip for the Gators is five games (Feb. 25-27) when the Gators went to Palm Springs, Calif. for the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic.

UF entered the season ranked first in the ESPN/USA Today preseason polls for the second consecutive year. Last season, Florida became the first team since Arizona in 2007 to be ranked No. 1 in the first and last polls of the year.

Florida's 6-0 win against Jacksonville in game one of a doubleheader ended a streak of four straight run-rule victories to begin the 2016 campaign, which was the longest such streak to start a season in program history. In addition, Florida shut out and run-ruled its first three opponents for the first time since 2012. Florida became the first defending NCAA Champion to shut out its first three opponents since 1992, when Arizona shutout its first seven foes.

"When you're a highly successful program, it's about blending of competitive spirits and friendships, and getting the younger players to buy into the legacies left from class to class. The seniors to freshmen are such a big age difference, so there's a meshing period you have to go through. Our older players have been very welcoming from the beginning, but with that welcoming come expectations that you have to bring it every day." -- Tim Walton

Tim Walton has brought Florida softball to the pinnacle of success in his 10-plus years at the helm of the Gators squad. Under Walton's tutelage, Florida became the first Southeastern Conference institution in history to earn four consecutive Women's College World Series berths (2008-11). The Orange and Blue have earned a total of seven WCWS berths since Walton's arrival, with four championship series appearances and the program's first and second national titles in 2014 and 2015.

Walton reached a career milestone when he earned career win No. 600 in just his 12th season as a head coach in 2014. Coming in his 774th game as a head coach, the Gators used an 8-0 mercy-rule victory at SEC rival Texas A&M to complete a three-game sweep on Easter Sunday, making Walton the fastest active head coach in the Southeastern Conference to reach 600 lifetime victories.

Entering 2016, Walton has a a 556-121 record at the head of the Gator program and a 679-185 (.785) career record in 13 seasons as a head coach. Florida has seven 50-win and three 60-win seasons in program history, all under Walton.

In his 10 years at Florida, Walton has led the Orange and Blue to countless school and SEC records, and his squads have earned numerous firsts for the Gator softball program. In 2011, UF advanced to an unprecedented fourth straight Women's College World Series, including its second trip to the Championship Series. Working as a four-time SEC Coach of the Year, Walton has led the Gators to four SEC regular-season and three conference tournament titles. UF has made the NCAA Tournament every year of his tenure, hosted Regionals all 10 times and played host to NCAA Super Regionals seven times from 2008-15. Florida reached the pinnacle of college softball in 2014, capturing the national championship with a two-game sweep of Southeastern Conference rival Alabama in the finals. This past season in 2015, Walton and his squad won the program's second-straight national title, defeating Michigan two games to one in the final of the WCWS.

In the 34-year history of the WCWS, 12 different teams have claimed the national title. Florida joined UCLA (2003, 2004 / 1988, 1989, 1990 / 1984, 1985) and Arizona (2006, 2007 / 1996, 1997 / 1993, 1994) as the only three programs to claim NCAA titles in consecutive years.

On the softball diamond, Walton has tutored 14 Florida student-athletes to 29 NFCA All-America honors, 19 players to 44 NFCA All-Southeast Region honors, has produced 15 WCWS All-Tournament team selections (including three Most Outstanding Players), coached 19 Gator athletes to 41 All-SEC honors and racked up 17 SEC All-Tournament team honors, including three MVPs, three SEC Pitchers of the Year and four SEC Players of the Year. Most recently, Gators Kelsey Stewart and Lauren Haeger won the conference's Player and Pitcher of the Year awards in 2015, becoming UF's fourth and third honorees in program history. Additionally, Haeger brought home the 2015 Honda Sports Award, designating her as the nation's top collegiate female athlete in the sport of softball. Haeger was the second Gator to receive the Honda Award, as Kelsey Bruder was UF's first recipient in 2011. Shortly after Bruder claimed that honor, she was awarded the NCAA Today's Top VIII Award as one of the top eight NCAA athletes in the country during the 2010-11 school year.

Under Walton's direction, the Florida coaching staff has earned NFCA Southeast Regional Coaching Staff of the Year honors four times and the team was one of Easton's Teams of the Year in 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011.

In 2015, Walton and his staff were name the NFCA Division I National Coaching Staff of the Year, the first time in school history Florida has earned this accolade.

Under Walton's watch, the Gators have shattered over 300 University of Florida records since 2006. His 2008 squad recorded an NCAA-record 70 wins and posted the best SEC record in league history at 27-1. The Orange and Blue shattered its own SEC single-season walks record with 332 in 2013, while the Gators boasted a .981 fielding percentage in 2015 committing a program-record low 33 errors during the season. Florida's 2011 squad downed eight SEC records, including four team season records for runs (508), RBI (479) and walks (322), while extending its standing single-season homers record to 124. The 2012 Gator squad set the league record for slugging percentage (.627), while the 2009 Gators became only the second team to ever register a perfect conference road record (13-0).

After winning the program's first national championship in 2014, the Gators followed that by becoming just the third program in NCAA history to win back-to-back softball titles in 2015. In the 34-year history of the WCWS, 12 different teams have claimed the national title and Florida joined UCLA (2003, 2004 / 1988, 1989, 1990 / 1984, 1985) and Arizona (2006, 2007 / 1996, 1997 / 1993, 1994) as the only three programs to claim NCAA titles in consecutive years.

This season seniors Kelsey Stewart, Taylore Fuller, Kirsti Merritt, Aubree Munro and Taylor Schwarz are the elders of a squad that will start the season No. 1 and seek to join UCLA (1988-90) as the only programs to win three straight national titles.
