Number One in Doubles


In the recent Oracle ITA Rankings, the senior tandem of Diego Hidalgo and Gordon Watson are the No. 1 doubles pair in the nation.

Sophomore Chase Perez-Blanco moved up 58 spots in the Feb. 23 rankings, up from No. 88, Chase now sits at No. 30. Junior Elliott Orkin jumped 27 spots into the singles Top-25 rankings. Orkin was ranked 49 in the preseason rankings and is currently No. 22.
