Last Serve with the Cardinal

The Gators dropped a heartbreaker in February as the Cardinal dealt the Gators' their second loss of the 2016 season. After claiming the doubles point on courts two and three, Florida got wins from Morgan and Danilina, but the Cardinal took four singles matches on courts 1-4 with the deciding court coming down to Kuhlman on four who fell in three sets to Hardebeck.

A Familiar NCAA Foe

No two teams are more familiar with one another in the NCAA Tournament than Stanford and Florida. With a combined 23 NCAA titles between the two programs, Florida is 3-10 against Stanford in the NCAA Tournament with the two teams never meeting before the semifinals. The last time the Gators defeated the Cardinal in the NCAA Tournament was in 2011 when UF won the program's fifth NCAA Title.

Florida as the No. 2 Seed

UF was selected as the No. 2 overall seed in this year's NCAA Tournament. This is the eighth time UF has been the No. 2 seed. Florida is now 33-3 with three NCAA titles and one runner-up finish in program history as the No. 2 seed.

UF vs. the Field

UF played 16 of its 23 matches this season against teams that were selected for the NCAA Tournament field of 64 and posted a 14-2 record against those clubs.

Chasing 1,000 Wins

The Florida women's tennis program currently sits at 998 wins in program history since its inception in 1971.

Florida at the SEC Tournament

- Florida is 73-9 in SEC Tournament play, losing six times to Georgia and once to Ole Miss, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt. coming to Texas A&M in the 2014 quarterfinal round.
- The Gators have won the tournament title 20 times out of 29 appearances.
- They have advanced to the final round 25 times in the event's 29-year history.

SEC Tournament Champions

The Florida Gators grabbed the program's 20th SEC Tournament Title on April 24 after defeating LSU, Auburn and Georgia in Baton Rouge, La. The title is the 10th under the leadership of head coach Roland Thorngvist.

Florida in the SEC: Undefeated

The Gators were a perfect 13-0 in SEC play with a 4-0 sweep of Tennessee on April 17. The season sweep was the program's 24th time running the table on conference foes and sixth of Roland Thornqvist's tenure.

SEC Champions!

With their sweep of Georgia on April 15, Florida clinched the program's 29th regular season SEC Championship and 11th for head coach Roland Thornqvist.

Big Moment Bri

Senior Brianna Morgan has won big matches in her career and 2016 has been no different. The Gator clinched the SEC Regular Season Title and the SEC Tournament Title both over a Top-5 Georgia Bulldog team on court three.

The Streak

Florida has won 158 straight dual matches at the Ring Tennis Complex, dating back to the 2005 season. The run is good for the longest active win streak at the Division I level.

Four, Five and Six

The bottom half of the Florida lineup has been stellar in SEC singles play with a combined record of 37-2.

Five Gators have played in those three positions.

100 Career Singles Victories

With her three-set win over Stanford's Caroline Lampl on Sunday, Feb. 28, senior Brianna Morgan reached 100 career singles victories in the orange and blue.

44th Season

The 2015-16 season will be the 44th year UF has sponsored a varsity women's tennis team. The Orange and Blue enter the year with an overall record of 975-142.

Season Opening Success

After the Gators' 6-1 win over USF, Florida has not dropped a season opening dual match in 31 years. The last time UF fell in a season opener was on Feb. 1, 1985 at Miami.

Sunshine State Streak

UF is currently on a 25 dual match win streak against in-state rivals. Florida is an impressive 203-33 against Sunshine State opponents

UF vs. SEC Opponents

Since beginning play in the Southeastern Conference in 1979-80, the Gators are 390-20 all-time against SEC opponents.

NCAA First and Second Rounds at the Ring

UF will host Georgia State, South Carolina State and Syracuse in this year's NCAA First and Second Rounds at the Ring Tennis Complex May 13 and 14.

SEC Coach of the Year... Again

Head Coach Roland Thornqvist was named the SEC Coach of the Year by league coaches. The honor was Thornqvist's fifth during his 16-year tenure at UF.

Back-to-Back SEC Player of the Year

Sophomore Brooke Austin garnered her second SEC Player of the Year nod, in as many years. The No. 4-ranked singles player in the nation is just the third player in league history to win the award in back-to-back seasons.

All-SEC Players

Five Gators received All-SEC honors in April. Brooke Austin and Belinda Woolcock earned places on the First Team All-SEC. Anna Danilina, Kourtney Keegan and Brianna Morgan each earned Second Team All-SEC honors.

Everyone Clinches

In the 2016 season, all eight Gator players have clinched one of the 18 wins Florida has secured this season.

Florida vs. Top-5 Opponents

Since the beginning of the collegiate tennis team rankings in 1987, the Orange and Blue have an all-time record of 118-52, when competing against Top-5 opponents. UF is 4-1 against those caliber teams this season

Clutch Kuhlman

Josie Kuhlman has clinched three matches for the Gators this season, all coming against Top-25 opponents: No. 5 Vanderbilt, No. 8 South Carolina and No. 25 Texas A&M.

Dealing in Doubles

The Gators have dropped the doubles point three times in 25 matches this season, the first being against Kentucky. Florida has four doubles pairings in the latest individual ITA Rankings.

Top-25 SEC Opponents

The SEC currently has nine teams in the Oracle/ITA Team Rankings, four more than any other conference in the nation.

SEC Play Opening Day

UF is 34-3 against Southeastern Conference opponents in SEC Play Openers since the 1979-80 season. The last loss came in 2009 against Kentucky in Lexington.

A Month of Tough Opponents

The month of February has provided a gauntlet of ranked opponent for UF. The Gators will face five Top-30 opponents in a four-week period that includes USC (4), Baylor (29), Clemson (20), California (1) and Stanford (16).

Reaching 200

The Orange and Blue are an astonishing 205-1 at the Ring Tennis Complex against Southeastern Conference opponents. The last SEC loss at home was on April 7, 2002 when No. 2 Georgia defeated No. 1 Florida, 4-3.

Gators in Top-10 Match Ups

Since the 1987 season, the Florida Gators are 165-56 in Top-10 matchups, including 4-1 this season with a two wins over No. 3/4 Georgia and a pair of wins over No. 4 USC and No. 8 South Carolina.

Home Sweet Home

The Orange and Blue are an outstanding 490-25 at the Ring Tennis Complex, including a 14-0 record at home in 2015. UF has produced 27 undefeated home seasons.

New Season, New Gator

In July, the Florida Gators added Russia native Anna Danilina to the squad. The 5-11 sophomore brings a wealth of experience to the team after competing on the junior and professional circuits.

Back in the Orange and Blue

UF returns seven members from the 2014-15 squad that reached the NCAA Quarterfinals, including three All-Americans in Brooke Austin, Kourtney Keegan and Josie Kuhlman. Spencer Liang, Brianna Morgan, Peggy Porter and Belinda Woolcock are also back to build upon the 2015 season.

2015 Fall Recap

Junior Belinda Woolcock posted a stellar 15-3 singles record during the fall campaign, including two semifinal berths in the USTA/ITA Southeast Regional and the National Indoor Championships. The Gator also worked through three qualifying matches in the ITA All-American to eventually reach the main draw singles quarterfinals.

Dick Vitale Clay Court Classic

Newcomer Anna Danilina and Brianna Morgan took home the doubles title at the Dick Vitale Clay Court Classic with four match victories. Danilina and Morgan compiled a 13-3 doubles record during the fall.

By the ITA's Numbers

The ITA Preseason Rankings have UF at No. 3 in the nation behind Vanderbilt and USC. The Gators currently have seven singles players and four doubles pairings in the individual rankings. Florida is one of four programs with two players (Woolcock: 3, Austin 11) ranked in the Top-15 and the ONLY program in the nation with two doubles teams (Austin/Keegan: 5, Kuhlman/Woolcock:15) in the Top-15.

ITA Southeast Regional: All the Gator Doubles

UF returned to Gainesville early on the ITA Southeast Regional weekend after sweeping the doubles competition. The Gators would hold all four positions in the semifinals. Kuhlman and Woolcock would edge out teammates Austin and Keegan, 3-6, 6-0, 2015-16 Honors, Awards, Milestones
