Breakin' It Down

- Florida's 46 combined NCAA Championships Preliminary entries are tied for the ninth-most nationally.
- UF's 25 entries on the women's side are tied for the seventh-most in the country, while its 21 entries on the men's side are tied for the 11th-most nationally.
- The Gators men boast 13 entries in the sprints/hurdles events, which are tied with Arkansas and LSU for the most nationally.
- Florida's women are one of six teams in the country (Alabama, Colorado State, Kentucky, Minnesota, Nebraska) with at least four entries in the sprint/hurdles, jumps, and throws categories.

Rankings Watch

- Florida's men enter the NCAA Championships East Preliminary ranked No. 3 in the USTFCCCA's National Team Computer Rankings, while the women travel to Jacksonville ranked No. 9.
- Counting relays only once, UF's men boast 12 times or marks that rank 14th or higher on the NCAA Division I outdoor descending order list.
- Under the same criteria, Florida's women own 14 times or marks that rank inside the top 20 of the NCAA Division I outdoor descending order list.

Top Three, Top Three, Top Three

- Florida's men have finished third or higher at each of the last seven NCAA Outdoor Championships, which is the fifth-longest streak in history.
- Another top-three finish this year would tie UTEP (1975-82) for the fourthlongest run in NCAA Outdoor Championships history.

SEC Outdoor Championships Rewind

- Florida won four SEC titles, as Anders Eriksson (hammer throw), Eric Futch (400-meter hurdles), Kyra Jefferson (100 meters), and its women's 4x400 relay team were all crowned champions.
- Moreover, Eriksson became just the second true freshman since 2006 to win the SEC hammer throw title
- Jefferson joined *Michelle Freeman* (1992) as the only other Gator in history to win the SEC 100 meters crown.

Elite Stable of Quarter-Milers

- Florida is just the third Division I women's team since 2002 (Florida, 2015: Texas, 2014) boasting four 400 meters runners--Sharrika Barnett, Claudia Francis, Kyra Jefferson, Robin Reynolds--with times faster than 53 seconds prior to the NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- Those four Gators already ran 3:26.28, the 10th-fastest 4x400 relay time in collegiate history, earlier this year at the Pepsi Florida Relays (April 2).
- Even without Jefferson, the trio of Barnett, Francis, and Reynolds combined with **Taylor Sharpe** to win the 4x400 relay title at this year's SEC Outdoor Championships.
- Last year's UF team featured four such runners and won both the SEC and NCAA titles in the 4x400 relav.
- Texas' 2014 group actually featured five sub-53-second 400 meters runers, and three of them ran on the NCAA title-winning 4x400 relay team that logged the second-fastest time in collegiate history (3:24.21).
- Florida is just the fifth team since 2002 featuring three men--Kunle Fasasi, Najee Glass, Arman Hall--with 400 meters times under 45.60 prior to the NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- Of the other four teams to accomplish the feat, two of them were UF trios, as the 2010 and 2014 Gators featured three such runners.

NEWS & NOTES

Collegiate History, World-Class Company

- Sprinter Kyra Jefferson is first woman in history to break 11.20 seconds in the 100 meters, 22.25 seconds in the 200 meters, and 51.51 seconds in the 400 meters as a collleigan.
- The only women in the world since 2002 to accomplish the same feat at any point in their careers are four-time Olympic gold medalists Allyson Felix and Sanya Richards-Ross, 2015 World Championships silver medalist Shaunae Miller, 2008 Olympic silver medalist Kim Gevaert, and 2004 Olympic gold medalist Sherone Simpson.
- Although the IAAF's records are incomplete or not readily available prior to 2002, threetime world champion *Marion Jones* also broke all those times by 1998.

Quite The Conversion

- Claudia Francis, transitioned from the 800 meters to the 400-meter hurdles this season, running the 400 meters the entire indoor season and once outdoors to aid the conversion.
- Since 2002, Francis and Bulgaria's Vania Stambolova are the only two women in the
 world to run faster than 2:03.00 (800 meters), 51.60 (400 meters), and 56.15 (400-meter
 hurdles) at any point in their careers.
- Among collegians, Francis is one of two women this year (Jaide Stepter, USC) and only the fourth Division I woman since 2002 to break 56.40 seconds in the 400-meter hurdles and 51.60 seconds in the 400 meters during the same outdoor campaign.

That Relay Combo Though...

- Florida's women are just the fifth Division I team since 2002 to break 43 seconds in the 4x100 relay and 3:28.00 in the 4x400 relay prior to the NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- The other teams to accomplish the feat were the 2015 Gators, 2004 LSU Tigers, and the 2011 and 2013 Texas A&M Aggies.
- Of those teams, only the 2004 LSU Tigers and 2015 Gators went on to sweep both relays at the NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- At last year's NCAA Outdoor Championships, Florida became the first team since Texas (2005) to sweep both the 4x100 and 4x400 relay national titles.
- This year, the Gators will look to join Texas (1998-99) and Florida State (1983-84) as the only groups to sweep both sprint relays at consecutive NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- Florida has never won consecutive national titles in the women's 4x100 or 4x400 relays, as last year was its first and second title, respectively, in those events.

Historic Triple Jump Title Run

- Florida has won each of the last six men's outdoor triple jump national titles, which is tied
 for the longest streak in any event at either NCAA Championship, regardless of gender.
- The only streaks equal to UF's run of triple jump national titles are:
 - UCLA, men's outdoor 4x400 relay (1969-74)
 - ♦ UTEP, men's indoor mile (1977-82)
 - ♦ UTEP, men's outdoor 10,000 meters (1978-83)
 - ♦ Villanova, women's outdoor 3,000 meters (1987-92)
 - ♦ LSU, women's outdoor 4x100 relay (1992-97)

Rare Pairs

- Eric Futch and TJ Holmes are just the fifth pair of SEC teammates and 11th pair of Division I teammates since 2002 to both run the 400-meter hurdles in less than 50.00 seconds prior to NCAA Outdoors.
- Futch and Holmes join Kerron Clement and Dwight Ruff as the only other UF teammates
 to accomplish that feat during that span, with the latter duo doing so in 2004.
- Ryan Clark and Michael Timpson Jr. are just the second pair of true freshmen teammates since 2003 to both break 10.40 seconds in the 100 meters and 21 seconds in the 200 meters prior to the NCAA Championships.
- Florida State's Kendal Williams and Trentavis Friday accomplished the feat last year.



NEWS & NOTES

Youth Is Served

- Freshman Anders Eriksson only needed four meets to break UF's hammer throw record by 16 inches. Eriksson's record-breaking mark of 71.14 meters came at the Virginia Challenge on April 23.
- Eriksson's 71.14-meter toss is the fourth-best by any Division I freshman since at least 2002, and he's just the eighth SEC thrower to eclipse 71 meters prior to NCAA Outdoors.
- Sophomore KeAndre Bates joined UF alum and 2015 The Bowerman winner Marquis
 Dendy, Bryce Lamb (Texas Tech), and Allen Sims (USC) as the only underclassmen since
 2002 to long jump 7.95-plus meters and triple jump 16-plus meters prior to NCAA Outdoors.
- Sophomore Lloydricia Cameron is just the seventh Division I underclassman since 2002 to post a shot put of 17.05-plus meters and discus throw of 55.10-plus meters prior to NCAA Outdoors.
- Kunle Fasasi is one of two SEC freshmen since 2010 and only the fifth SEC frosh since 2002 to run 45.43 or faster in the 400 meters prior to the NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- Among Gators since 2002, only *Tony McQuay* (45.37 in 2010) and *Christian Taylor* (45.34 in 2009) ran faster as freshmen prior to NCAA Outdoors.
- Sophomore Darrielle McQueen is the fifth SEC underclassman and 16th Division I underclassman since 2002 to long jump 6.35-plus meters and triple jump 13.30-plus meters prior to NCAA Outdoors.
- Of those 16 underclassmen to accomplish the feat during that span, McQueen and Shara Proctor, now the British long jump national record holder, are the only Gators to do so.
- This past indoor season, Ryan Clark became just the fourth Division I true freshman since 2000 to run faster than 6.65 in the 60 meters and 20.94 in the 200 meters.
- The other three to accomplish that feat are Florida State's Walter Dix (2005) and Trentavis Friday (2015), and Tennessee's Justin Gatlin (2001).

After 27 Years, It Fell

- Yanis David broke the 27-year-old CARIFTA Games U20 Division long jump record, posting a mark of 6.48 meters to bring home the gold medal this past March.
- Had the jump been recorded in collegiate competition, it would lead all freshmen and be equal to the 14th-best mark in Division I this year.

Dreaming of Rio

- A total of 11 current Gators have already hit either the U.S. Olympic Trials or Olympic Games standards in at least one event.
- Including current, and past Gators, there are 31 athletes who've qualified for either the U.S. Olympic Trials, which will be held in Eugene, Ore. on July 1-10, or the Olympic Games.
- Andres Arroyo, a native of Puerto Rico, hit the Olympic standard in his first outdoor 800 meters race of the year, clocking in at 1:45.78, also the third-ranked time in program history.
- Since Puerto Rico does not have Olympic Trials, unless two of his countrymen beat his time, Arroyo will have the opportunity to compete at this year's Olympic Games in Rio.
- Earlier this year, Arroyo broke Mark Everett's 26-year-old school record in the indoor 800
 meters, crossing in 1:46.20 to take runner-up honors at the SEC Indoor Championships.

Fear the Javelin

- For the first time in program history, the Gators have three different women with a season-best javelin throw mark of at least 47.60 meters, as Marija Vucenovic (57.81m), Kike Oniwinde (50.94m), and Megan Reed (47.60m) have all reached that distance this year.
- Florida is now one of nine programs since 2002 to produce at least three javelin throwers who eclipsed 47.60 meters prior to the NCAA Championships in the same season.

In 2015, Marquis Dendy became the first Florida Gator to win The Bowerman, track and field's highest individual honor and the sport's equivalent to college football's Heisman Trophy.

Florida's other two The Bowerman finalists since the award's inception in 2009 are Christian Taylor (2011) and Tony McQuay (2012).

This watch list is trimmed to 10 semifinalists after the NCAA Outdoor Championships, followed by an announcement of three finalists roughly two weeks later.

The Bowerman is presented annually by the USTFCCCA to the most outstanding male and female collegiate track and field athletes in the nation. The award is named after Bill Bowerman, legendary former track and field and cross country coach for the University of Oregon and co-founder of NIKE.

JAYLA BOSTIC (women's hammer throw)

CLAUDIA FRANCIS (women's sprints/hurdles)
