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Breakin' It Down

- Florida's 25 combined NCAA Championships entries are the fourth-most nationally.
- UF's 13 entries on the women's side are the seventh-most in the country, while its 12 entries on the men's side are tied for the fourth-most nationally.
- The Gator men boast nine entries in the sprints, hurdles, and relays, which is the third-highest total of any team.
- UF's women are the only team in the country with at least three entries in both the throws and jumps.

Top Three, Top Three, Top Three

- Florida's men have finished third or higher at each of the last seven NCAA Outdoor Championships, which is the fifth-longest streak in history.
- Another top-three finish this year would tie UTEP (1975-82) for the fourth-longest run in NCAA Outdoor Championships history.

SEC Outdoor Championships Rewind

- Florida won four SEC titles, as **Anders Eriksson** (hammer throw), **Eric Futch** (400-meter hurdles), **Kyra Jefferson** (100 meters), and its women's 4x400 relay team were all crowned champions.
- Eriksson became just the second true freshman since 2006 to win the title, and was named the SEC Outdoor Co-Freshman Field Athlete of the Year.

Elite Stable of Quarter-Milers

- Florida is just the third Division I women's team since 2002 (Florida, 2015; Texas, 2014) boasting four 400 meters runners--**Sharrika Barnett**, **Claudia Francis**, **Kyra Jefferson**, **Robin Reynolds**--with times faster than 52.55 seconds prior to the NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- Those four Gators already ran 3:26.28, the 12th-fastest 4x400 relay time in collegiate history, earlier this year at the Pepsi Florida Relays (April 2).
- Even without Jefferson, the trio of Barnett, Francis, and Reynolds combined with **Taylor Sharpe** to win the 4x400 relay title at this year's SEC Outdoor Championships and advance to Eugene via the NCAA East Preliminary.
- Last year's UF team featured four such runners and won both the SEC and NCAA titles in the 4x400 relay.
- Texas' 2014 group saw three of its four sub-52.30 runners race for its NCAA title-winning 4x400 relay team, which ran the second-fastest time in collegiate history (3:24.21).
- Florida is just the fourth team since 2002 featuring three men--**Kunle Fasasi**, **Najee Glass**, **Arman Hall**--with 400 meters times under 45.50 prior to the NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- UF's 2014 team also featured three such runners, with **Arman Hall** (45.19), **Hugh Graham Jr.** (45.29), and **Najee Glass** (45.40) all posting sub-45.50 times.

School Record-Breaking Conversion

- **Claudia Francis**, transitioned from the 800 meters to the 400-meter hurdles this season, running the 400 meters the entire indoor season and once outdoors to aid the conversion.
- In what was her seventh collegiate 400-meter hurdles race, Francis broke UF's school record and ran 55.55 seconds to take sixth place at the NCAA East Preliminary.
- Since 2002, Francis and Bulgaria's **Vania Stambolova** are the only two women in the world to run faster than 2:03.00 (800 meters), 51.60 (400 meters), and 56.15 (400-meter hurdles) at any point in their careers.
- Among collegians, Francis is one of two women this year (Jaide Stepter, USC) and only the third Division I woman since 2002 to break 55.60 seconds in the 400-meter hurdles and 51.60 seconds in the 400 meters during the same outdoor campaign.

Historic Triple Jump Title Run

- Florida has won each of the last six men's outdoor triple jump national titles, which is tied for the longest streak in any event at either NCAA Championship, regardless of gender.
- The only streaks equal to UF's run of triple jump national titles are:
 - ◊ UCLA, men's outdoor 4x400 relay (1969-74)
 - ◊ UTEP, men's indoor mile (1977-82)
 - ◊ UTEP, men's outdoor 10,000 meters (1978-83)
 - ◊ Villanova, women's outdoor 3,000 meters (1987-92)
 - ◊ LSU, women's outdoor 4x100 relay (1992-97)

Rare Pair

- **Eric Futch** and **TJ Holmes** are just the seventh pair of Division I teammates since 2002 to run the 400-meter hurdles in less than 49.75 seconds prior to NCAA Outdoors.
- Futch and Holmes are the only UF duo to accomplish the feat during that span.
- Futch and Holmes are one of two pairs of teammates at this year's NCAA Championships, and are the first UF tandem since 2004 and fifth UF duo since 1998 to qualify.
- Futch and Holmes could become the third UF duo since 1983 and just the 15th pair of teammates since 1983 to advance to the NCAA Championships 400-meter hurdles final.

Always Be Qualifying

- Florida's men boast three individual 400 meters qualifiers at the NCAA Championships for the fourth year since 2000, tied with LSU for the most times during that span:
 - ◊ Florida (4) - 2016, 2014, 2013, 2005
 - ◊ LSU (4) - 2016, 2012, 2006, 2001
 - ◊ Texas A&M (3) - 2014, 2011, 2010
 - ◊ Arizona State / Baylor / Mississippi State / USC (1) - 2003 / 2007 / 2010 / 2012

ALL The Throws

- Florida's women are just the eighth team since 2002 to have at least one NCAA Outdoor Championships qualifier in each of the four throwing events, with Oregon (2014) being the only other team since 2007 to accomplish the feat.
- Prior to this year, UF's women hadn't qualified for multiple throwing events since 2011, and hadn't qualified for three different throwing events since 2004.

That Relay Combo Though...

- The Gators are looking to join Texas (1998-99) and Florida State (1983-84) as the only groups to sweep both sprint relays at consecutive NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- At last year's NCAA Outdoor Championships, Florida became the first team since Texas (2005) to sweep both the 4x100 and 4x400 relay national titles.
- Florida has never won consecutive national titles in the women's 4x100 or 4x400 relays, as last year was its first and second title, respectively, in those events.
- Florida's women are the fifth Division I team since 2002 to break 43 seconds in the 4x100 relay and 3:28.00 in the 4x400 relay prior to the NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- Of the four other teams to do it, only the 2004 LSU Tigers and 2015 Gators swept both relays at the NCAA Outdoor Championships.



NEWS & NOTES

Youth: Best Served With A Hammer

- Freshman hammer thrower **Anders Eriksson** could become the fifth Gator and first UF freshman to score with a top-eight finish at the NCAA Championships since 1966.
- Eriksson only needed four meets to break UF's hammer throw record by 16 inches, with his record-breaking mark of 71.14 meters coming at the Virginia Challenge on April 23.
- Eriksson's 71.14-meter toss is the fourth-best by any Division I freshman since at least 2002, and he's the eighth SEC thrower to eclipse 71 meters prior to NCAA Outdoors.

Following In Their Footsteps

- Sophomore **KeAndre Bates** is just the fifth Division I underclassman since 2010, and the third UF underclassman since 2000 (**Marquis Dendy**, 2012; **Christian Taylor**, 2010) to qualify for the NCAA Championships in both the long jump and triple jump.
- Bates is also only the 11th Division I man since 2002 to long jump 7.95-plus meters and triple jump 16.15-plus meters prior to NCAA Outdoors, joining USC's **Allen Sims** (2003) as the only other underclassman to do so during that span.
- Four of the 11 men to accomplish the feat are Gators, with Bates (2016), **Marquis Dendy** (2015), **Will Claye** (2011), and **Christian Taylor** (2010-11) leaping to those marks.

Next Up In The Gators' Quarter-Mile Stable

- Kunle Fasasi** is just the seventh Gators freshman since 2002 to qualify for the 400 meters at the NCAA Outdoor Championships, joining the likes of **Arman Hall** and **Najee Glass** (2013), **Tony McQuay** (2010), **Calvin Smith** (2007), **Bernard Middleton** (2005), and **Reggie Witherspoon** (2004).
- Fasasi could join **Arman Hall** (3rd in 2013), **Calvin Smith** (7th in 2007), **Tyrone Kemp** (2nd in 1989), and **Beaufort Brown** (7th in 1972) as the only Gators to score with a top-eight finish in the 400 meters at the NCAA Championships since the 440-yard dash was discontinued in 1952.
- Fasasi is one of two SEC freshmen since 2010 and only the sixth SEC frosh since 2002 to run 45.43 or faster in the 400 meters prior to the NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- Among Gators since 2002, only **Tony McQuay** (45.37 in 2010) and **Christian Taylor** (45.34 in 2009) ran faster as freshmen prior to NCAA Outdoors.

Young Gators, Bright Futures

- Sophomore **Lloydricia Cameron** is one of three women this year and only the eighth Division I underclassman since 2002 to post a shot put of 17.05-plus meters and discus throw of 55.10-plus meters prior to NCAA Outdoors.
- Freshman **Yanis David** is the only Gator and one of 11 Division I freshmen since 2002 to qualify for the NCAA Outdoor Championships in both the long jump and triple jump.
- Sophomore **Darrielle McQueen** is the fifth SEC underclassman and 17th Division I underclassman since 2002 to long jump 6.35-plus meters and triple jump 13.30-plus meters prior to NCAA Outdoors.
- Of those 17 underclassmen to accomplish the feat during that span, McQueen and **Shara Proctor**, now the British long jump national record holder, are the only Gators.
- This past indoor season, **Ryan Clark** became just the fourth Division I true freshman since 2000 to run faster than 6.65 in the 60 meters and 20.94 in the 200 meters.
- The other three to accomplish that feat are Florida State's **Walter Dix** (2005) and **Trentavis Friday** (2015), and Tennessee's **Justin Gatlin** (2001).
- Outdoors, Clark joins a group of 17 Division I freshmen since 2002--which includes the likes of **Trayvon Bromell**, **Walter Dix**, and former Gator **Willie Perry**--to break 10.30 seconds in the 100 meters and 20.60 seconds in the 200 meters.
- Ryan Clark** also joined **Terrell Wilks** (2008) as the only other UF freshman since 2002 to qualify for the 100 meters at the NCAA Championships.
- UF 4x100 relay runners **Ryan Clark** and **Michael Timpson Jr.** are just the second pair of true freshmen teammates since 2003 to both break 10.40 seconds in the 100 meters and 21 seconds in the 200 meters prior to the NCAA Championships.

It's Been A While

- Junior **Taylor Tubbs** is the first Gator since 2009 (**Genevieve LaCaze**) to qualify for the 5,000 meters at the NCAA Outdoor Championships.
- Tubbs also joined **Rebecca Lowe** (2008) and LaCaze, who's now an Olympic steeplechaser for Australia, as the only other Gators since 2002 to qualify for the event at NCAA Outdoors.

What If...

- If **Darrielle McQueen** and **Yanis David** both score in the long jump, they will be the fourth pair of teammates since 2002 to score in the event at NCAA Outdoors.
- The only other duos to accomplish the feat during that span are:
 - ◇ Jenna Prandini and Jasmine Todd (Oregon) - 2015
 - ◇ Keturah Orji and Chanice Porter (Georgia) - 2015
 - ◇ Francine Simpson and Andrea Geubelle (Kansas) - 2012
- If **Claudia Francis** scores in the women's 400-meter hurdles, it will mark the seventh time in school history a Gator scored with a top-eight finish at NCAA Outdoors.
- The only other Gators to ever score in the event are:
 - ◇ Ugonna Ndu (2013) - 5th place
 - ◇ Dorchelle Webster (1990) - 4th place
 - ◇ Piper Bressant (1985) - 7th place
 - ◇ Piper Bressant (1984) - 4th place
 - ◇ Chris Crowther (1984) - 8th place
 - ◇ Piper Bressant (1983) - 7th place

Going 60 To 110, Real Quick

- Yanick Hart** joined **Eddie Lovett** (2011-14), **Kallinka Pitt** (2009), and **Josh Walker** (2003-05) as the only other Gators since 1999 to qualify for the NCAA Championships in the 60-meter hurdles (indoor) and 110-meter hurdles (outdoor) in the same year.

Collegiate History, World-Class Company

- Sprinter **Kyra Jefferson** is first woman in history to break 11.20 seconds in the 100 meters, 22.25 seconds in the 200 meters, and 51.51 seconds in the 400 meters as a colleigan.
- The only women in the world since 2002 to accomplish the same feat at any point in their careers are four-time Olympic gold medalists **Allyson Felix** and **Sanya Richards-Ross**, 2015 World Championships silver medalist **Shaunae Miller**, 2008 Olympic silver medalist **Kim Gevaert**, and 2004 Olympic gold medalist **Sherone Simpson**.
- Although the IAAF's records are incomplete or not readily available prior to 2002, three-time world champion **Marion Jones** also broke all those times by 1998.

After 27 Years, It Fell

- Yanis David** broke the 27-year-old CARIFTA Games U20 Division long jump record, posting a mark of 6.48 meters to bring home the gold medal this past March.

Dreaming of Rio

- A total of 11 current Gators have already hit either the U.S. Olympic Trials or Olympic Games standards in at least one event.
- Including current, and past Gators, there are 31 athletes who've qualified for either the U.S. Olympic Trials, which will in Eugene, Ore. from July 1-10, or the Olympic Games.

In 2015, Marquis Dendy became the first Florida Gator to win The Bowerman, track and field's highest individual honor and the sport's equivalent to college football's Heisman Trophy.

Florida's other two The Bowerman finalists since the award's inception in 2009 are Christian Taylor (2011) and Tony McQuay (2012).

This watch list is trimmed to 10 semifinalists after the NCAA Outdoor Championships, followed by an announcement of three finalists roughly two weeks later.

The Bowerman is presented annually by the USTFCCA to the most outstanding male and female collegiate track and field athletes in the nation. The award is named after Bill Bowerman, legendary former track and field and cross country coach for the University of Oregon and co-founder of NIKE.

FUN FACTS

KEANDRE BATES (men's jumps)

- A native of Temple, Texas, but moved to El Paso because his step father is in the Army. Attended all four years of HS in El Paso, where his triple jump developed and he acquired collegiate opportunities.

SHARRIKA BARNETT (women's relays)

- Originally from Jamaica, Barnett moved to the United States just weeks before the start of her freshman year of high school. She said trying out for Oak Ridge High School's cross country and track teams, with the latter being coached by a fellow Jamaican and former University of Georgia sprinter, Odeika Bent, allowed her to become more comfortable in the U.S.

JAYLA BOSTIC (women's hammer throw)

- Younger sister of Jon Bostic, who was an All-SEC linebacker for the Gators in 2012. Bostic plays professionally for the Detroit Lions.

CLAUDIA FRANCIS (women's hurdles/relays)

- Transferred to Florida from Oregon in the summer of 2014 following the departure of older sister, Phyllis Francis, a five-time individual NCAA Champion and collegiate indoor 400 meters record holder who went on to earn a silver medal at the 2015 IAAF World Championships as a member of the United States' 4x400-meter relay team.
- Claudia wanted a fresh start and to get back closer to home, with one perk being in the same time zone as her parents.
- Francis was primarily an 800 meters runner in her first season at Florida (2015), but made transitioned to the 400 meters indoors to prepare to run the 400-meter hurdles during the outdoor season.

YANICK HART (men's 110-meter hurdles)

- A product of the renowned track and field program at Wolmer's Boys School in Jamaica. While Yanick has a mom and dad, he was raised by another guardian in Jamaica, as his parents did not have the means to support him. To this day, he still keeps in touch with her, as she now lives in Miami.

KYRA JEFFERSON (women's sprints/relays)

- While Kyra was raised by her mother in Detroit, her father, Thomas Jefferson, was a world-class sprinter who won the bronze medal in the 200 meters at the 1984 Olympic Games in Los Angeles; he now resides in Atlanta. Additionally, Jefferson's mother, Michele Watkins, was a seven-time All-American and member of two 1985 NCAA Championship-winning relay teams in her track career at LSU.

DARRIELLE McQUEEN (women's jumps)

- Darrielle's father, Darrell, passed away the week of the 2015 NCAA Outdoor Championships after a three-month battle with cancer. Her dad's final wish was for Darrielle to compete that week, which she did, taking 12th place in the long jump.

SHAYLA SANDERS (women's sprints/relays)

- Shayla was a sixth-grade cheerleader when her father first pushed her to attend a track tryout.
- Sanders suffered a stress fracture in her back prior to her freshman outdoor season, which forced her to wear a back brace for 12 weeks and redshirt.

TAYLOR TUBBS (women's 5,000 meters)

- By her sophomore year, Tubbs became a TA for economics courses at UF.
- Graduated in only three years with a Bachelor's degree in both Economics and History.
- Currently enrolled in UF's sports management and international business master's programs.
- Tubbs trained overseas in the Netherlands this past summer as part of a study abroad program.
