Jeff Poppell enters his second season at Florida in 2017-18. Poppell, beginning his 25th season of coaching this fall, most recently served four years as the head coach for Gulliver Preparatory School and the Gulliver Swim Club. In his first season with the Gators, Poppell helped the men's team win their fifth-consecutive SEC Championship and second consecutive third place finish at NAAs. He also tutored 11 of the women's swimmers and two divers into qualifying for the NCAA Championships. Of those 13 that competed, 11 will return to the team this season.

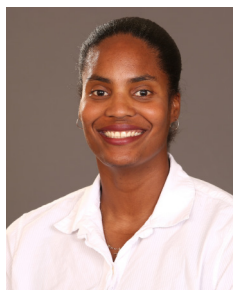

**ASSISTANT COACH | STEVE JUNGBLUTH**

Steve Jungbluth is in his eighth season with the Orange and Blue working with the sprinters. Most recently in 2016-17, Jungbluth helped the Gators take another step forward. Behind three national titles from the NCAA Co-Swimmer of the Year Caeleb Dressel and one from Mark Szaraneck, the Gators claimed a third-place finish. In SEC competition, Florida brought home its fifth-straight Southeastern Conference Championship on the men's side.

**ASSISTANT COACH | LEAH STANCIL**

A 12-time NCAA All-American at Florida, two-time Olympian and a four-time national record holder for her native country, Barbados, Stancil's impact has been felt in both the men's and women's teams during her ten seasons on the coaching staff. In 2017, Stancil helped the Gators take another step forward as the Florida men finished in third place at the NCAA Championships.

**THE SCENE**

The #4/18 Gators are on the road for the first time this season, taking on the Alabama Crimson Tide at the Alabama Aquatics Center. Diving will begin at 10:30 a.m. EST, followed by swimming at 3 p.m. The last time Florida faced off against the Crimson Tide in a dual meet was the 2013-14 season. Both Gator teams came out of the dual meet victorious, with the women winning 179-113. The men held the 169-123 advantage over the Crimson Tide.

Dalton Goss, Blake Manganiello and Enzo Martinez-Scarpe were the only three members on the team the last time these two schools faced off, but all three were redshirting, so they did not compete.

**GATORS IN THE RANKINGS**

Both Florida teams are ranked in the CSCAA Preseason Top 25 Poll. After finishing third in the NCAA Championships last season, the men are ranked fourth in the nation, just three points behind third-ranked Stanford. The UF women are ranked 18th in the first poll of the year after returning 11 of the 13 student-athletes that competed at NAAs.

**LAST TIME OUT**

The No. 4 Florida men split a double-dual meet with No. 2 Texas and No. 6 Indiana. The Gators defeated Texas, 258-171, but fell to Indiana, 242-187.

Caeleb Dressel led the way with two individual wins over the weekend in the 50 free (one win in Friday's race, the other in Saturday's). Blake Manganiello (1,000 free), Khader Baqlah (500 free) and Jan Switkowski (200 fly) were the other first-place finishes for the Gators.

The Gators registered 17 B-cut times throughout the weekend and 23 individual top-3 finishes, as well as four top-3 finishes in the relays.

Alex Farrow and Dalton Goss competed on the boards for Florida, with Goss placing seventh in the 3-meter (289.55) and Farrow leading the two in the 1-meter (seventh, 257.10).

The No. 18 Florida women fell to both No. 3 Texas and No. 10 Indiana over the weekend.

The Gator women finished the weekend with six B-cut times and seven individual top-3 finishes. Kelly Fertel (100 free, 400 IM) and Taylor Ault (500 and 1,000 free) both recorded two second-place finishes, while Hannah Burns also added her name to that list with a second-place finish in the 200 IM. The women registered four top-3 finishes with their relays.

Brooke Madden recorded two top-3 finishes over the weekend, notching zone-qualifying scores on both the 1-meter (292.00) and the 3-meter boards (311.95) in the process.

**LOOKING AHEAD**

The Gators face Georgia in a dual meet on Friday at 10 a.m. The diving session for the meet will take place Thursday at 6 p.m. The first 200

students to the event on Friday will receive a pink breast cancer awareness T-shirt.

The last time these squads faced off, Georgia's men defeated Florida, 178-122. The Bulldogs also held the 164-125 advantage over the Gator women last season.

**SWIMMING TOWARDS POSTSEASON**

Through the first two meets of the season, eight men have recorded 17 B-cut times, while four women have registered six of their own. Jan Switkowski leads the way with four NCAA qualifying marks (100 free, 200 free, 200 fly, 200 IM) and Caeleb Dressel (50 free, 100 free, 100 fly) and Maxime Rooney (100 free, 200 free, 200 back) are right behind him with three apiece. Mark Szaranek and Grant Sanders both recorded B-cut times in the 200 IM and 400 IM at the Texas/Indiana meet. Khader Baqlah (200 free), Michael Taylor (100 back) and Stanley Wu (100 breast) also each recorded a qualifying time against Texas and Indiana.

Hannah Burns and Kelly Fertel each registered B-cut times in the 200 IM and 400 IM. Emma Ball (100 back) and Savanna Faulconer (400 IM) each recorded qualifying times as well.

**DIVING TOWARDS POSTSEASON**

Three divers recorded scores that qualified them for NCAA Zones in March at the All-Florida meet. Alex Farrow posted a score of 323.48 in the 3-meter for the men. Brooke Madden led the way for the women, qualifying in both the 1-meter (296.03) and the 3-meter (317.93), while Teya Syskakis recorded a score of 309.45.

**STRONG SENIOR CLASS**

The senior class consists of 13 swimmers and divers, with 10 on the men's side and three on the women's side. Those 10 men have racked up eight national championships and 51 All-America honors between them, with Caeleb Dressel leading the way with seven national championships and 21 All-America honors. On the women's side, the three seniors have collected four All-America honors between them and all have been named to the SEC Academic Honor Roll at least once in their four years.

**JUNIORS READY FOR SUCCESS**

Seven juniors on the roster for both the men's and women's teams means a plethora of experience for both squads. Two men and two women each competed in NAAs last season, with Ross Palazzo and Brennan Balogh helping the men to a third place finish. Hannah Burns and Sydney Sell competed for the women's side.

**SOPHOMORES SET FOR GOOD SEASON**

The sophomores are primed to have a breakout year for both the men's and women's teams. The women have 14 sophomores on the roster, while the men have 10 second-years. Last season, Maxime Rooney took home SEC Rookie of the Year honors and was joined by two classmates at NAAs (Khader Baqlah, Chandler Bray). All three earned All-Freshman SEC honors. On the women's

side, the team has four sophomores who participated in NAAs (Emma Ball, Kelly Fertel, Savanna Faulconer, Makayla Sargent), with Ball earning All-Freshman SEC honors.

**NEW FACES TO THE ROSTER**

The Gators added nine newcomers to both the women's and the men's teams entering the 2017-18 season. Each team's incoming class consists of eight freshmen and one transfer. Sophomore Grant Sanders comes to Gainesville from the University of Arizona, while sophomore Jillian Hatch transfers in from the University of Pacific. Five of the newcomers participated in either the Phillips 66 National Championships, US Open or World University Games.

**SUCCESSFUL SUMMER**

The Gators had a fantastic summer both at national and international competition. Florida had 23 swimmers compete in the Phillips 66 National Championships. Caeleb Dressel led the pack with five qualifications for the FINA World Championships, while alums Elizabeth Beisel and Conor Dwyer each earned a spot on Team USA as well.

11 Gators competed in the 17th FINA World Championships this summer, with Caeleb Dressel setting numerous records in the process, earning the Male Swimmer of the Championship Meet award. He tied Michael Phelps for the most gold medals at a World Championship (seven) and he became the first person to win three gold medals in one day. The senior set four American records, along with two world records during the week. His time in the 100m fly is the second fastest in history, only .04 seconds off Phelps' world record (2009) and he became the third fastest swimmer in the 50m free. Coach Troy served as an assistant coach for Team USA during competition.

32 Gators raced at this year's U.S. open championships and senior Andrew Brady led the way for them as he earned the High Point award for the men's side.

Five Gators competed at the WUGs this past August, with Maxime Rooney leading the way with three medals (two gold, one silver). Grant Sanders and Mitch D'Arrigo also claimed a silver medal in the men's 4x200m free relay, along with Rooney. Georgia Marris and Bayley Main each competed for Team New Zealand, while Coach Poppell served as an assistant coach for Team USA.

**STEPHEN O'CONNELL CENTER**

The multipurpose Stephen C. O'Connell Center, named for a former University of Florida president, features a main arena covering more than 3.6 acres and containing 292,000 square feet. In addition to the main arena, there is a practice court, two weight rooms, a natatorium, an indoor track, a private gymnastics arena, dance studio, martial arts studio and several classrooms.

**HEAD COACH GREGG TROY**

As head coach of the men's and women's swimming teams, Gregg Troy has created an atmosphere of consistency and excellence in his years at the helm. He has guided the Gators to 37 NCAA event titles, 168 SEC event titles, more than 400 SEC Academic Honor Roll selections and close to 1,000 All-American honors. Troy has tutored over 75 Olympians and has coached athletes to more than 155 U.S. and international records. Just this past summer, he was chosen as an assistant coach for Team USA at the FINA World Championships in Budapest, Hungary. He served as the 2012 USA Men's Olympic Swim Team head coach in London and in that same year he was inducted into the American Swimming Coaches Association Hall of Fame.
