SEC CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY:

The Gator men are looking for their sixth-straight SEC Championship and 39th in program history.

2017 SEC CHAMPIONSHIPS - MEN - 1ST PLACE

Florida's men won their fifth-straight SEC Championship last season, garnering 1,271.5 points. The Gators swept all five relays, which is the first time that feat had been achieved at the SEC Championships. Four Gators recorded individual wins en route to the victory, including three first place finishes by then-junior Caeleb Dressel.

The program's 38 SEC Championships ranks second amongst all sports in the history of the SEC (Kentucky basketball, 50).

SEC CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY:

The Gator women are looking for their 18th conference title and program's first championship since 2009.

2017 SEC CHAMPIONSHIPS - WOMEN - 7TH PLACE-

Florida's women placed seventh at last year's SEC Championships, recording 624 points. Then-senior Autumn Finke was the lone Gator woman to stand on the podium, earning a silver medal in the 1650 free. The young team gained valuable experience at last year's meet and looks to move forward at this season's meet.

THE SCENE

The #3/17 Gators are on the road for the 2018 SEC Championships at Texas A&M. The meet runs from Wednesday, Feb. 14 through Sunday, Feb. 18. The prelims will be at 11 a.m. EST each day and the finals will begin at 7 p.m. Diving prelims will begin at 11:30 a.m. on Wednesday, then at 2 p.m. from Thursday-Sunday.

The Gator men are looking for their sixth-straight SEC Championship and the 39th in program history, while the Florida women are looking for their 18th conference title and the first since the 2009 season.

The Gators have faced off in dual meets against each of the four teams competing.

The men have a 4-0 record against the field, having defeated Alabama 158-140, Georgia 179-121, Auburn 183-114 and Tennessee 178-122.

The women are 1-3 against the SEC teams they have faced this season, beating Alabama 166-134. The Gators fell to Georgia 182-118, Auburn 160.5-139.5 and Tennessee 184-116.

GATORS IN THE RANKINGS

Both Florida teams are ranked in the CSCAA Top 25 Poll. The Gator men moved up one spot, sitting at third in the nation, while the UF women are 17th. Both teams have been ranked in every CSCAA poll this season.

2017 SEC CHAMPIONSHIPS REWIND

Florida's men are looking to six-peat this season after winning their fifth-straight SEC Championship last season. The men totaled 1,271.5 points, defeating a field of nine other teams for the 38th SEC Championship in program history - the second most by any team in any SEC sport (Kentucky, 50).

The women placed seventh overall in a field of 12 teams, scoring 624 points. Florida's women are looking for the 18th Championship in program history and the first since 2009.

The Gator men swept all five relays, doing so for the first time in school history at the Championship meet. Caeleb Dressel won three individual titles at the meet, finishing first in the 50 free, 100 free and 100 fly. With those victories, as well as four relay wins, Dressel was named

SEC Swimmer of the Meet for the second-straight meet. Maxime Rooney also won an individual SEC Title, finishing first in the 200 free. The freshman was also a member of two of the Gators' winning relays (400 FR, 800 FR).

Then-senior Autumn Finke was the lone Gator woman to reach the podium, finishing second in the 1,650 free with a season-best time of 16:06.64.

The Gator men recorded 17 top-13 finishes (First place - nine; Second place - seven; Third place - 1). **Jan Switkowski** finished second in both the 100 and 200 fly events and recorded a third place finish in the 200 IM.

SEC HONORS

Stanley Wu earned the first SEC honor of his career on Tuesday, garnering SEC Swimmer of the Week, as the league announced Tuesday.

Wu recorded two first place finishes at the Auburn Invitational this past weekend, going up against three ranked teams in the process.

The Concord, Fla. native swept the breaststroke events, posting a B-cut time of 53.67 in the 100 breast and a B-cut of 1:58.07 in the 200 breast, both of which were season-best times for the junior.

Wu also finished third in the 200 IM final, recording a time of 1:48.67. He recorded a career-best time of 1:48.53 in the preliminary session of the event.

The junior rounded out his events by racing in the 100 fly, where he recorded a career-best time of 50.44 in the preliminary session.

Twenty Gators competed at the Auburn Invitational last weekend, finishing the weekend with seven individual wins and a relay victory. Junior **Stanley Wu** swept the breaststroke events, while freshman **Santiago Corredor** recorded first place finishes in the 500 free and 400 IM. Freshman **Jessica Rodriguez** recorded the best finish for the women, finishing third in the 400 IM.

UP NEXT

Florida hosts the Last Chance Meet in the O'Dome from Feb. 23-25. This is the final time for any Gators to set qualifying times for the NCAA meet. The women's meet will be held in Columbus, Ohio from March 14-17 and the men's meet will be held a week later in Minneapolis, Minn. (March 21-24).

STRONG SENIOR LEADERSHIP

The senior men have accounted for 51 individual wins and have 89 wins overall. **Jan Switkowski** leads the way with 30 wins (16 individual and 14 relay wins), while **Caeleb Dressel** follows behind with 29 wins (17 individual, 12 relays). **Ben Lawless** has eight individual wins of his own and **Mark Szaraneck** has five relay wins and six individual wins. **Blake Manganeillo** has two individual wins under his belt, **Enzo Martinez-Scarpe** has been a member of three relay wins and **Ben Kennedy** won his first relay at the Auburn Invitational. On the women's side, **Amelia Maughan** has recorded a two individual wins and three relay wins for the seniors.

JUNIORS SHOOTING FOR SUCCESS

Five Gator women have accounted for 13 individual wins, as well as six relay wins throughout this season. **Hannah Burns** leads the way with seven individual wins. **Sydney Sell** has four individual wins this season, while **Teya Syskakis** (3-meter) has recorded one individual win. **Georgia Marris** has recorded both an individual win, as well as two relay wins for the Gators. **Paige Scheriger** rounds out the junior women with four relay wins. **Stanley Wu**, **Bayley Main**, **Ross Palazzo**, **Christoph Margotti**, **Jack Szaraneck**, **Grady Heath** and **Viktor Toth** have picked up wins on the men's side. **Wu** has recorded three individual victories and three relay wins, while **Main** notched two individual victories. **Toth** has won both an individual event and a relay during this season. **Palazzo** pitched in a first place finish and **Heath** contributed a relay win as well as picking up two individual victories of his own. **Margotti** and **Szaraneck** round out the juniors with one relay win apiece.

SOPHOMORE SPEED

The sophomore class has been incredibly strong on the women's side through the season, accounting for 37 individual wins and 19 relay wins. **Sherridon Dressel** leads the way 12 wins overall (five individual, seven relay). **Savanna Faulconer** holds seven individual victories and one relay win, while **Emma Ball** has four relay wins and five individual first place finishes under her belt. **Kelly Fertel** has recorded five individual wins and two relay wins and **Brooke Madden** has claimed seven victories of her own on the boards. **Kelsey Dam-**

bacher has been a member of three winning relays and recorded one individual victory, while **Georgia Darwent** has two individual wins of her own. **Dani Keymont** has won three individual events as well as a relay this season and **Bella Garfalo** has one individual event victory. **Tori Bindi** has recorded one relay win to round out the women. **Khader Baqlah** leads the men with 16 wins (nine individual, seven relays) through the season thus far and **Maxime Rooney** is close behind with 11 of his own - five individual and six relay wins. **Chandler Bray** has picked up two relay wins, while **Grant Sanders** has one of his own. **Marco Guarente** has notched five individual wins this season and **Drew Clark** has two individual wins on the year **Dakota Mahaffey** and **Alex Farrow** both have one event victory.

FRESHMEN IMPACT

Eight Gator freshmen have earned a tally in the win column over through the season thus far. **Michael Taylor** has recorded five relay wins to go along with four individual wins. At the final meet before SEC Championships, **Santiago Corredor** and **Erge Gezmis** each claimed first place finishes for Florida, while **Corredor** winning two events and **Gezmis** claiming one victory. **Clark Beach** has picked up a relay win and an individual win, while twin **Ethan Beach** notched his first individual victory. On the women's side, **Taylor Ault** has won eight individual events and two relays, while **Nikki Miller** has won one of each. **Emma Whitner** closes out the wins for the freshmen with an individual 3-meter victory.

SUCCESSFUL SUMMER

The Gators had a fantastic summer both at national and international competition. Florida had 23 swimmers compete in the Phillips 66 National Championships. **Caeleb Dressel** led the pack with five qualifications for the FINA World Championships, while alums **Elizabeth Beisel** and **Conor Dwyer** each earned a spot on Team USA as well.

11 Gators competed in the 17th FINA World Championships this summer, with **Caeleb Dressel** setting numerous records in the process, earning the Male Swimmer of the Championship Meet award. He tied Michael Phelps for the most gold medals at a World Championship (seven) and he became the first person to win three gold medals in one day. The senior set four American records, along with two world records during the week. His time in the 100m fly is the second fastest in history, only .04 seconds off Phelps' world record (2009) and he became the third fastest swimmer in the 50m free. **Coach Troy** served as an assistant coach for Team USA during competition.

32 Gators raced at this year's U.S. open championships and senior **Andrew Brady** led the way for them as he earned the High Point award for the men's side.

Five Gators competed at the WUGs this past August, with **Maxime Rooney** leading the way with three medals (two gold, one silver). **Grant Sanders** and **Mitch D'Arrigo** also claimed a silver medal in the men's 4x200m free relay, along with **Rooney**. **Georgia Marris** and **Bayley Main** each competed for Team New Zealand, while **Coach Poppell** served as an assistant coach for Team USA.

HEAD COACH GREGG TROY

As head coach of the men's and women's swimming teams, **Gregg Troy** has created an atmosphere of consistency and excellence in his years at the helm. He has guided the Gators to 37 NCAA event titles, 168 SEC event

titles, more than 400 SEC Academic Honor Roll selections and close to 1,000 All-American honors. Troy has tutored over 75 Olympians and has coached athletes to more than 155 U.S. and international records. Just this past summer, he was chosen as an assistant coach for Team USA at the FINA World Championships in Budapest, Hungary. He served as the 2012 USA Men's Olympic Swim Team head coach in London and in that same year he was inducted into the American Swimming Coaches Association Hall of Fame.

SUCCESS IN & OUT OF THE POOL

The men's and women's teams both finished the fall semester with GPAs over 3.0, earning them the title of CSCAA Scholar All-America. The women's team boasted a team GPA of 3.42 and the men followed with a cumulative GPA of 3.21. Florida's women are one-of-12 SEC teams to earn All-America honors, while eight SEC men's teams - including the Gators - earned the accolade.

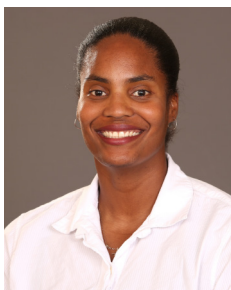
