Joseph Fahnbulleh, was crowned NCAA champion in the 200 meters outdoors with a time of 19.91 seconds, the second-fastest in UF history and sixth-fastest in the world this year. Additionally, Fahnbulleh tied for eighth-best performer in collegiate history and 10th-fastest time in collegiate history. He also finished third nationally indoors, and second in the conference both indoors and outdoors.

Team Highlights

- Florida finished fourth at both NCAA
 Outdoors and Indoors Championships.
 The Gators collected at total of 34.5
 points outdoors and 34 indoors.
- Outdoors, the Gators have finished every NCAA Championships meet in the top four since 2009.
- At the conference level, Florida finished fourth outdoors with 74 points and fifth indoors with 57 points.
- The Gators' fifth-place SEC finish indoors marked the 25th consecutive Florida finish among the top five teams in the conference, including league titles in 2004, 2011, 2015 and 2019. The finish also marked Florida's 53rd alltime top-five finish, which is the most by any school in the SEC followed by LSU with 47 and Tennessee with 46.
- Outdoors, Florida has finished in the SEC Championships' top four 15 times since 2003, which is the second-most in that span. Arkansas leads the Gators by one with 16.

Individual Highlights

Connor Bandel

- Earned bronze in the shot put at both SEC Indoors and Outdoors.
- Finished 10th at NCAA Outdoors with a mark of 19.13 meters (62 feet, 9.25 inches).
- Moved into fourth place on UF's All-Time Outdoor Top 10 list after logging a personal-best mark of 19.61 meters in the shot put at the SEC Outdoors.
- NCAA Outdoors qualifier and USTFCCCA Second-Team All-American.

Clayton Brown

- Collected a bronze medal at SEC
 Outdoors in the high jump and scored in
 the triple jump with a sixth-place finish.
- Finished fifth at NCAA Outdoors both in the long jump and high jump.

- Logged the seventh-best triple jump mark in UF history at NCAA Outdoors (16.56 meters, 54 feet, 4 inches).
- NCAA Outdoors qualifier and scorer, and collected two USTFCCCA First-Team All-America honors (Long Jump and Triple Jump).

Joseph Fahnbulleh

- NCAA Outdoors Champion in the 200 meters.
- Logged a personal-best time of 19.91 seconds in the 200 meters at NCAA Outdoors, which is the second-fastest in UF history and sixthfastest in the world this year.
- · His time at NCAA Outdoors tied him for eighthbest performer in collegiate history and it was 10th-fastest time in collegiate history.
- SEC 200 meters runner-up at both Indoors and Outdoors Championships.
- Finished third nationally indoors in the 200 meters with a time of 20.38.
- Finished the season as the second-fastest 200 meters runner in school history both indoors and outdoors.
- Also competed in the 100 meters at NCAA Outdoors, finishing seventh in the nation.
- Three-time USTFCCCA First- Team All-American (1x Indoors: 2x Outdoors).

Thomas Mardal

- · Finished his senior campaign undefeated, sweeping NCAAs and SECs.
- Won the indoor national championships in the weight throw with a school-record mark of 24.46 meters (80 feet, 3.75 inches), becoming the third-best performer in collegiate history.
- Became the first person in NCAA Indoor Championships history, and the second in collegiate history, to have at least two throws of 80 feet or further in the same meet.
- · Won SEC Indoors after breaking UF's record three times in the same meet. Additionally, he broke the SEC championships meet 11-year-old record with a mark of 24.16 meters (79 feet, 3.25 feet).
- Claimed his fourth-career conference title at SEC Outdoors with a hammer throw winning mark of 74.78 meters (245 feet, 4 inches), becoming the fifth thrower since 2006 to compile at least four combined SEC crowns.
- · Among UF throwers, his four conference titles rank tied for second-most in UF history.

- · Captured his first NCAA Outdoors title with a mark of 76.74 meters (251 feet, 9 inches), breaking his own school record for the third time this season and becoming the sixth-best performer in NCAA Outdoor Championships history.
- Finished his collegiate career as UF's record holder in the weight throw and hammer throw.
- · Named the SEC Outdoors Track and Field Scholar Athlete of the
- Two-time USTFCCCA First-Team All-American.

Ryan Willie

- Finished sixth nationally outdoors and fourth indoors in the 400 meters.
- At the conference level, he earned a bronze medal indoors in the 400 meters.
- Led off UF's 4x400-meter relay team, finishing sixth at SEC Indoor and fifth at SEC Outdoors. Florida's 4x400 relay team also collected fifth- and seventh-place finishes at NCAA Indoors and Outdoors, respectively.
- . Ranks eighth in UF history in the 400 meters outdoors and fifth indoors
- Four-time First-Team UFTCCCA All-American (2x Indoors; 2x Outdoors).
