# **SERIES VS. FLORIDA**

• The series between Missouri and Florida is tied at 5-5. Last time in CoMo, the Gators took a 23-6 win during the 2019 slate. The Tigers' last victory came in 2018, a 38-17 decision in Gainesville.

# 2020: MIZZOU AT FLORIDA

Mizzou dropped a 41-17 decision at No. 10/9 Florida, on Oct. 31, at Ben Hill Griffin Stadium. The Tigers got a pick-six score from Jarvis Ware but failed to get much going offensively. Junior LB Nick Bolton continued his All-SEC caliber season with 10 tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss as he continues to lead the team in tackling this season. Sophomore LB Devin Nicholson posted a career-high 13 tackles as well, his second double-digit tackle outing this season.

# **LAST TIME OUT: MIZZOU**

The season's best performance by the Tiger defense and the running of Tyler Badie propelled Missouri to a 31-28 SEC victory over the South Carolina Gamecocks. With their third straight victory over Carolina, the Tigers retained the Mayor's Cup. On the night, Badie ran 34 times for 209 yards - his fourth 200-yard game of the season, most in school history – and he climbed to fifth place on Missouri's single-season rushing chart. He now has 1,239 yards this season. The Tiger defenders forced three turnovers, sacked the quarterback three times and had three other tackles for loss and limited the Gamecocks to 250 total yards - the fewest USC has ever gained against Mizzou. That included just five yards in the third quarter when Mizzou scored a defensive touchdown and 57 rushing yards for the game.

# **LAST TIME OUT: FLORIDA**

Quarterback Emory Jones passed for 464 yards and six touchdowns and smashed the UF single-game record for total offense with another 86 yards rushing and a score in leading the Gators from a two-touchdown first-half deficit to a wild victory in a shootout over FCS foe Samford at Spurrier/Florida Field. The story of the game was the Gators averting utter disaster against a 1-AA opponent that had not beaten a Southeastern Conference team since 1934. The Bulldogs, who came in with a 3-4 record in the Southern Conference (with a blowout loss of 55-13 against Tennessee-Chattanooga just three weeks ago), scored touchdowns on their first three possessions, and five of their first six during a first half when they broke a record for most points ever scored in a half against the Gators. Samford, behind quarterback Liam Welch's 400 yards and three touchdowns passing, plus a 98-yard kickoff return by Montrell Washington, had a 42-28 lead with less than three minutes to play in the first half. Jones' 45-yard touchdown pass to running back Nay'Quan Wright with 1:03 to go in the half cut the lead to seven. The Gators got the opening kickoff in the second half and went 70 yards in nine plays to tie the game at 42 and then, after a Mordecai McDaniel interception, took their first lead of the game, 49-42, on a seven-yard pass from Jones to Kemore Gamble.

# **BADIE IS A BAD MAN**

- Senior RB Tyler Badie ranks fourth nationally in rushing yards (1239), yards per game (123.9), fifth in total touchdowns (16) and 11th in total points (96). Each of those marks lead the SEC. Badie is also second in the SEC and 15th nationally in scoring (9.8 ppg) and 18th nationally and second in the SEC in rushing touchdowns (12).
- With his 209-yard performance against South Carolina, Badie moved into fifth all-time at Mizzou in single-season rushing yards with 1,239 through 10 games this season. He needs just 62 yards to reach fourth (Brad Smith, 705), 73 for third (Joe Moore, '69) and 167 for second (Smith, '03). Badie needs 339 yards over the final two games to reach Devin West's record of 1,578 yards set in 1998.
- Badie has rushed for over 200 yards on four different occasions this season (209 vs. South Carolina, 254 vs. Vanderbilt, 209 vs. North Texas, 203 vs. CMU). He is the only player in the country with four, 200-yard games this season and one of just three SEC players to complete the feat since 2000 (Leonard Fournette & Derrick Henry).
- His 254-yard rushing performance at Vanderbilt marked the most by a Mizzou back in the SEC era (2012-pres.) and the fifth most in program history. He is the only Mizzou player to ever produce four, 200-yard rushing games in his career - let alone a single season.

# **STORY LINES**

- With his 17-yard reception against Tennessee, Badie became the first Mizzou Tiger in program history to reach 1,000 rushing yards and 1,000 receiving yards in his career. He became the first SEC player to reach the mark since Kentucky wide receiver Lynn Bowden, Jr., did so
- Another first, Badie is the lone Tiger to score a combination of 15 rushing scores and 10 receiving TDs.
- Badie is the first Tiger since Jeremy Maclin in 2007 to record four rushing and receiving touchdowns in a
- His 203-yard performance in the season opener was the first by a Tiger since Larry Rountree went for 204 in Dec. 2018 against Oklahoma State. The 203 rushing yards were the 15th most in Mizzou history.
- At Kentucky, Badie hauled in a career-best 10 receptions for 88 yards. He became the first Tiger to catch 10 passes in a game since Emanuel Hall did so against Wyoming in 2018.
- Badie is one of five Tigers to accumulate 500 yards on the ground and receiving alongside:

# McGuire sec D-lineman of the week

- Junior Isaiah McGuire picked up SEC Defensive Lineman of the Week honors after a stat-stuffing effort in Mizzou's win over South Carolina.
- McGuire racked up a career-best six tackles, including two for loss. The two TFL set the Gamecocks back 17 yards.
- One of the two TFL was a 13-vard sack of Jason Brown. It was McGuire's fifth-straight game with a TFL
- McGuire also forced and recovered a South Carolina fumble in the victory.

# **BAILEY BRINGING THE BOOM**

- Redshirt junior linebacker Chad Bailey has made the most of his opportunity to step into the starting lineup this season, racking up 28 of his 36 tackles in his six
- Bailey produced a career day at No. 1 Georgia, making 10 tackles to help the Mizzou rush defense to its best performance of the season.
- At Vanderbilt, Bailey made two tackles for loss and

recorded his first career sack in a six tackle effort.

• Bailey added a five-tackle day against South Carolina to give him three-straight games with five or more stops.

#### **D THE DIFFERENCE**

- Mizzou scored 21 points off of three South Carolina turnovers in the Tigers' 31-28 win over the Gamecocks.
- The Tigers produced a defensive score for the second time this season when Martez Manuel sacked Jason Brown and forced a fumble which was recovered in the end zone by Trajan Jeffcoat.
- It was Mizzou's first fumble recovery for TD since 2018, also against the Gamecocks.
- The Tigers added another fumble recovery courtesy of Isaiah McGuire and an INT from Kris Abrams-Draine. Mizzou also had two more INTs called back for penalties in the game.
- Mizzou held SC to just 250 yards of total offense, the lowest total for the Gamecocks in series history.

#### **FOLLOW THE MANUEL**

- Mizzou safety Martez Manuel leads the Tigers with 64 tackles this season, including a team-leading 50 solo stops.
- His 64 tackles match his 2020 total and his next stop will mark a career high for the Columbia native.
- Against South Carolina, Manuel had a strip-sack which was recovered by teammate Trajan Jeffcoat in the end zone for a Tigers' touchdown. The play helped stake Mizzou to a 31-14 lead in the second half and marked Manuel's career-high 3.5 sack of the season.
- The junior earned his first interception at Vanderbilt, icing the game with a pick of Mike Wright with 1:31 on the clock in the fourth quarter.
- The junior's seven tackles for loss match his singleseason best set last year in 2020.
- He had a career-high 10 solo stops against Tennessee while matching his personal best of 11 total tackles.
- The versatile Manuel is tied for the team lead with a trio of quarterback pressures as well.

# **KAD ALL THE WAY**

- Kris Abrams-Draine produced a 100-vard kickoff return for a touchdown against Tennessee. It was the first kickoff return touchdown for Mizzou since 2014 when Marcus Murphy housed a 96-yard return at Florida.
- The 100-yard return was just the fifth 100-yarder in program history and the first of its kind since Oct. 30, 1976 when receiver Joe Stewart went endzone-toendzone against Oklahoma State.

# **GOOD ON THIRD**

- Mizzou ranks 13th in the country on third downs, converting 47.3 percent of the time.
- The Tigers' conversion rate ranks third in the SEC through 10 games on the season.

# **MEVIS MAGIC**

- Sophomore kicker Harrison Mevis the SEC Special Teams Player of the Week for Oct. 30 - saw his consecutive made field goals streak end at 20 against Georgia. The streak was the longest in the nation.
- Mevis bounced back, hitting each of his next two kicks to improve to 14-for-15 this season including 3-for-3 from beyond 50 yards and 7-for-8 from 40-49.
- Mevis started his season with a bang, drilling a 53vard field goal in the waning seconds of the first half to

give Mizzou a lead over Central Michigan. The kick was a then-career-long from Mevis and had plenty of leg to spare.

- He was equally impressive at Boston College, hitting a career-long 56-yard boot to send the game to overtime.
- Mevis is now 7-for-8 in his career from beyond 50
- He is one of just two Tigers in program history to make five or more kicks of 50+ yards, joining Tom Whelihan (6,

#### **HAIL KEKE**

- · Senior wideout Keke Chism turned the momentum when he hauled in a first-half ending Hail Mary to give Mizzou a 17-14 lead at Vanderbilt.
- The 45-yard snag among seven Commodore defenders in the endzone was Chism's second TD of the year and second-longest catch of the season.
- . Both of Chism's TD grabs have come late in the first half, with the other coming with four seconds left on the clock at Kentucky.

# **BENSON BLOCKS IT**

- Walk-on Stephen Benson produced Mizzou's first blocked punt of the season at Vanderbilt.
- The blocked punt was Mizzou's first since the 2020 game against Georgia.
- · Benson transferred in to Mizzou from NAIA Culver-Stockton College in Canton, Mo.

# **BAZELAK CREATES COMPLETIONS**

- Redshirt sophomore Connor Bazelak has already produced a career-best 13 touchdown passes through seven games on the season. The QB is completing 68.2 percent of his passes in 2021, good for fourth in the SEC and 21st nationally.
- Bazelak has thrown for over 200 yards in six games this season, including three, 300-yard performances.
- The QB is seventh nationally and second in the SEC in completions per game at 25.8.
- The redshirt sophomore has thrown a touchdown pass in six-of-eight games this season.
- · At Kentucky, Bazelak matched his career high by slinging four touchdown passes. He finished the day 34for-51 for 294 yards in the air. The 34 completions mark a career high for the Tiger QB.
- During the Kentucky game, Bazelak passed the 3,000 career passing yards mark in his 15th game played.

# SCORE ON D

- Mizzou produced its first defensive score of the season against North Texas, as Trajan Jeffcoat deflected a pass which was intercepted by freshman defensive lineman Mekhi Wingo and returned 40 yards for a touchdown.
- The interception was the first of Wingo's career and marked the first time a Mizzou defensive lineman has scored since Akial Byers in 2018.
- The INT return for TD was part of a three-turnover performance for the Tigers' defense. Kris Abrams-Draine picked off a pass to setup Mizzou's first score of the day and later recovered a fumble forced by corner Akayleb **F**vans
- Evans forced two fumbles on the day, the first two FF of his career.
- Mizzou scored 14 points off the three turnovers.

#### SPREADING THE LOVE

- · Mookie Cooper became the 10th Tiger to haul in a touchdown reception this season with his 60-yard bomb against South Carolina. The 10 players with a TD grab are the most by the Tigers since 2016.
- Four Tigers have multiple TD receptions, led by Tyler Badie with four.
- This season, 16 different Tigers have caught a pass with six Tigers making their first career TD grabs.

- The safety picked up his fourth INT of the season at Georgia, tying Carlies for fourth nationally and second in the SEC this season.
- Carlies recorded his first collegiate interception in the season opener against Central Michigan. He made it two-straight games with an INT by pulling in a deflected pass from Kentucky QB Will Levis in week two.
- The back-to-back INTs made Carlies the first Mizzou player to pick off a pass in consecutive games since Adam Sparks accomplished the feat against Vanderbilt and Arkansas in 2017.
- The safety also made one of the biggest plays of the game, forcing a UK fumble late in the first half which was recovered by the Tigers in the end zone. The play led to a Mizzou touchdown with four seconds to play in the half, pull the Black & Gold within seven at the break.

A winner at every stage of his coaching career, Eliah Drinkwitz — considered one of college football's top offensive minds — was introduced as Mizzou's 33rd head football coach in December of 2019, and despite all the challenges presented by the COVID-19 pandemic, led his 2020 Tigers to a 5-5 record against an All-SEC slate.

Drinkwitz, who took over the Tiger program following an impressive 2019 season at Appalachian State that saw the 20th-ranked Mountaineers win the Sun Belt Conference title en route to a 12-1 record, joined Warren Powers as the only head coaches in Mizzou history to earn a bowl bid in their first season patrolling the sidelines in Columbia. Drinkwitz joins Frank Broyles, Dan Devine and Powers as the only first-year Mizzou head coaches to reach five victories in year one of their Tiger tenures.

Picked to finish sixth in the SEC East Division by many preseason pundits and projected to win only two or three games at most against the All-SEC schedule, the Tigers split their 10-game league slate at 5-5 to finish third in the SEC East, with four of the losses coming at the hands of teams that were ranked at

kickoff and three that finished at No. 1 (Alabama), No. 7 (Florida) and No. 8 (Georgia) in the final College Football Playoff ranking, while a fourth loss came in week two at then-No. 21 Tennessee. Mizzou's five SEC wins are the second-most ever behind its 7-1 mark that it posted en route to winning back-to-back SEC East crowns in 2013 and 2014.

Despite playing with less than 60 scholarship players for more than half of their games in 2020 and having just three games played on their original dates, the Tigers overcame an 0-2 start to win five of their final eight games down the stretch, a run that included:

- · A goal-line stand in the closing minute to hold off defending National Champion LSU, 45-41.
- Snapping Kentucky's five-game series win streak with a 20-10 victory that wasn't nearly as close as the final score indicated.
- Mizzou's first win in Columbia East since 2014, a 17-10 decision at South Carolina and a thrilling comefrom-behind 50-48 walk-off victory over Arkansas, its fifth-straight in the series
- An appearance at No. 25 in the College Football Playoff rankings Dec. 7, only the third season the program
  has appeared in the CFP's seven-year run.

Of the SEC's four new head coaches to begin work in the nation's toughest conference in 2020, Drinkwitz's 5-5 regular-season record was the league's best, ahead of Ole Miss' Lane Kiffin (4-5), Mississippi State's Mike Leach (3-7) and Arkansas' Sam Pittman (3-7). In addition, Drinkwitz and his staff signed a top-25 recruiting class currently ranked No. 20 by Rivals.com (highest ranking in program history) to help secure a promising future for the storied Mizzou program.

Drinkwitz's offensive acumen has been a key element in his team's winning five conference championships while compiling a perfect 8-0 bowl game record in 11 seasons at the FBS level. The combined record of his teams from 2010-20 is 103-39 overall (.725), including a 62-27 conference mark (.687).

The 2019 campaign saw Drinkwitz turn in one of the most impressive FBS head coaching debut seasons ever. His Mountaineers set a Sun Belt record with their 12 wins, and also set the mark for the best regular season in conference history (11-1). They claimed the Sun Belt Championship with a 45-38 win against Louisiana on Dec. 7

Also in 2019, App State became the first-ever Sun Belt program to earn a top 20 ranking in the Associated Press poll, while also becoming the first team in league history to receive an in-season ranking in the College Football Playoff poll. Drinkwitz's team also made history in 2019 with a pair of Power 5 road wins (at bowleigible North Carolina, and later at South Carolina) – making it the first-ever Sun Belt team to register two Power 5 wins in a season. In all, the Mountaineers claimed an FBS-best six road wins en route to becoming the first-ever 12-win team among North Carolina's FBS members.

For his efforts, Drinkwitz was named a finalist for the 2019 Eddie Robinson Award, a prestigious award which goes annually to the nation's top coach. He was also named the North Carolina Coach of the Year by the North State Journal.

App State proved to be one of the nation's most balanced teams in 2019, thanks in large part to an efficient offense that ranked ninth nationally in scoring (39.4 points per game), coupled with a stingy defense that ranked 22nd nationally in points allowed (20.2 ppg). The Mountaineers also excelled in the critical turnover category, ranking eighth nationally in 2019 with a plus-12 turnover margin. App State junior running back Darrynton Evans was named the Sun Belt Offensive Player of the Year, after rushing for 1,323 yards and 17 touchdowns.

Prior to App State, Drinkwitz spent three years as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for recordsetting NC State teams (2016-18), after excelling in a similar role at Boise State for two years (2014-15), where the Broncos won the Mountain West title in 2014 and finished 12-2 and ranked 16th nationally. In 2015, Drinkwitz was promoted to offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach, and he helped the Bronco offense rank in the top 15 nationally in points (39.1) and yards (501.3) per game.

Before Boise, Drinkwitz was a key figure in back-to-back Sun Belt Championships in 2012-13 as running backs coach and co-offensive coordinator at Arkansas State. He got his first taste at the FBS level in the Southeastern Conference, as he served as a quality control assistant at Auburn for the 2010-11 seasons. The Tigers won the SEC in 2010, and went on to the BCS Championship that season with a perfect 14-0 record.

Following a 7-6 season in 2016 at NC State, Drinkwitz helped the Wolfpack to consecutive nine-win seasons (2017-18) for the first time since 1991-92. With an average of 35.6 points per game under his direction in 2018, NC State had a 1,000-yard rusher for the third-straight year, two 1,000-yard receivers and a quarterback with nearly 4,000 passing yards. The Wolfpack made a steady rise from 63rd nationally in total offense in his first season in 2016 to 25th in 2017 and 16th in 2018. He was a Broyles Award nominee as one of the nation's top assistant coaches in his final year with the Wolfpack.

The Wolfpack offense had six players selected in the 2018 and 2019 NFL Drafts combined, including recordsetting quarterback Ryan Finley, who was a fourth-round selection in 2019 by the Cincinnati Bengals.

In his six seasons as an offensive coordinator and head coach, Drinkwitz has produced five 1,000-yard rushers, four 3,000-yard passers and four 1,000-yard receivers. Three of those years (2015, 2017, 2018) his offenses produced at least one in each category.

Drinkwitz, 38, graduated magna cum laude and was the student body president at Arkansas Tech (bachelor's, education) before beginning his coaching career at the prep level in his hometown of Alma, Ark., in 2005. He and his wife, Lindsey (Sivils), have four daughters: Addison, Emerson, Ella and Parker Lynn.
