#### Last Time Out

The Gators dropped their last contest to the 17th-ranked Baylor Bears on Saturday, falling in three sets.

T'ara Ceasar led the way offensively for Florida, recording 19 kills on the night - tying her season-best mark. Thayer Hall pitched in eight kills of her own, while Marlie Monserez dished out 34 assists in the three-setter.

Florida recorded five blocks in the match, led by a four-block performance from Lauren Dooley.

Elli McKissock and Ceasar paced the backcourt defense, with each recording 10 digs on the night. Ceasar's 10 digs secured her second double-double of the year. Monserez and Hall pitched in five digs apiece as well.

#### Gators in the Polls

After dropping two matches to the then-No.17 Baylor Bears, the Gators moved to No. 14 in this week's poll.

Three SEC teams are ranked in the Top-25: Kentucky (No. 8), Florida (No. 14), Tennessee (No. 22). South Carolina (32) and Ole Miss (14) are receiving votes.

Mary Wise is one of two coaches to have been named AVCA Coach of the Year at least three times in their career (Russ Rose, Penn State, five times).

Since Wise took over the program in 1991, no other team in the nation has won more matches, with the Gators sitting at 902. Penn State has also won 902, with the next closest being Nebraska at 863. Florida sits third all-time in program wins since 1984 with 1,058. That trails only Penn State and Nebraska for the most in the nation.

#### LAST TIME AGAINST FLORIDA STATE

- The last time the Gators and Seminoles faced off, it was a 3-0 sweep for Florida in Gainesville (25-21, 27-25, 25-14)
- As a squad, the Gators hit .322 on the night, racking up 52 kills, while limiting FSU to a .150 hitting percentage. Florida's offensive attack was led by Thayer Hall, who registered 15 kills in the match
- Former Gator Paige Hammons and Lauren Dooley pitched in 10 and nine kills, respectively to secure the victory
- Marlie Monserez once again ran the offense for the Gators, dishing out 40 assists in the three-setter
- Gator alum Allie Gregory led the way with 12 digs on the evening, while Hall pitched in 11 for her double-double

#### SEC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

- Monserez earned the title of both SEC Overall Player of the Week and SEC Setter of the week after matches against No. 10 Minnesota and No. 20 Stanford
- Over the course of the two matches, Monserez averaged 12.12 assists per set, 4.38 digs per set and led the team to a .278 clip. Against Stanford, she recorded 41 assists and 21 digs for her first double-double of the year. The 21 digs were just one off tying her career-high mark that she set a season ago
- The Windermere, Fla. native also recorded four blocks and three kills against the Cardinal. In the win
  over No. 10 Minnesota, Monserez recorded 56 assists, while leading the team to a .306 clip in the
  four-setter
- She recorded 14 digs to pick up her second double-double on the season and also notched two kills in the victory
- Against the Golden Gophers, Monserez moved into the Top-10 in program history for career assists, surpassing Kelly Murphy's 2,671. The senior currently sits at 2.691 assists, just 37 away from claiming the No. 9 spot

#### SHOWTIME

- Wednesday's matchup will air on the ACC Network Extra
- The Gators will appear on the ESPN family of networks seven times throughout the 2021 campaign. Four
  of Florida's matches will air on the SEC Network and the Gators will also appear on ESPNU thrice during
  the fall
- Florida fans will also have the chance to see the squad on SEC Network + for those matches that are not televised throughout conference play

#### THE WISE FILES

- The 2021 season will serve as Mary Wise's 31st season at the University of Florida, making her the longest tenured coach in UF's history
- In her 31 years at Florida, she has racked up numerous accolades, including three AVCA National Coach
  of the Year awards, 15 SEC Coach of the Year awards and she is the only female coach in NCAA history
  to coach in more than one Final Four
- Wise's 983 career victories are the most among women's Division I head coaches since the NCAA's first volleyball season in 1981
- Wise has accumulated 902 wins at Florida, the seventh-most by a Division I coach at one school in NCAA history
- In her previous 30 seasons with the Gators, Wise has racked up 24 SEC Championship, the third-most in any SEC sport by any team since volleyball's debut in 1979
- She has tutored the squad to a NCAA Tournament berth in each of her 30 seasons at Florida and she has also won at least 21 matches every season at UF

#### THE QUEST FOR 1.000

- Mary Wise is just 17 wins away from claiming her 1,000th overall career victory
- Currently, there is only one active Division I coach with over 1,000 career victories (Russ Rose). Across all
  Divisions, there are four active coaches with over 1,000 career victories: Peggy Martin (Spring Hill DII),
  Russ Rose (Penn State DI), Chris Catanach (Tampa DII), Shelton Collier (Wingate DII)
- Julie Jenkins (Trinity DIII) sits at 989 career victories
- Wise would be the first female Division I head coach to hit the milestone and would be just the fourth head coach overall to record 1,000 victories all at the Division I level (Russ Rose Penn State; Dave Shoji Hawaii; Andy Banachowski UCLA)
- Florida softball coach Tim Walton is also on the verge of his 1,000th career victory during the 2021-22 season, sitting at 962
- Should both Wise and Walton achieve the milestone this season, Florida will be the only school in the country to have two active 1,000 win head coaches

#### 900 WIN MILESTONE

- · Against UC Davis on Aug. 28, Mary Wise grabbed her 900th victory at the University of Florida
- · She became just the second female coach in Division I history to reach 900 wins at a single school (Karen Chisum, Texas State)
- Only one other active Division I head coach has crossed the 900 win threshold (Russ Rose, Penn State)
- In NCAA Division I history, Russ Rose (Penn State), Dave Shoji (Hawaii), Andy Banachowski (UCLA) and Karen Chisum (Texas State) are the only four coaches to achieve 900 wins at a single institution

#### HOME COOKING

- The Gators hold a 538-72 (.882) record at home since the inception of the program in 1984
- After the home opener, the Gators rank sixth in average attendance at 3,415 fans per match
- · Florida finished the 2019 season ranked eighth in the NCAA in average attendance, averaing 2,876 fans per match

#### **BLOCK PARTY**

- The Gators have led the league in blocks per set for the last four seasons
- Currently, Lauren Dooley sits seventh in the SEC with 1.22 blocks per set
- During last season's campaign, Lauren Dooley led the league and sat 17th in the nation in blocks per set with 1.40
- In the 2020-21 season, the Gators averaged 2.75 blocks per set, putting the squad 12th in the nation. In 2019, Florida averaged 2.49 blocks per set; in 2018 UF averaged 2.82 blocks per set (11th in the nation); in 2017 the Gators averaged 2.93 blocks per set (ninth in the nation)
- In nine out of the last 11 seasons. Florida has been among the top-3 in the conference in blocks per set

#### **MILESTONES TO WATCH**

- Marlie Monserez currently sits 9th in program history in career assists 2761 with three+ years under her belt.
- . Thayer Hall currently sits 18th in Florida's record books in career kills with 1,077. She broke in to the Top-20 all-time against Sacramento State
- Mary Wise is one of the most decorated coaches in the NCAA Volleyball world, currently sitting at 11th in all-time wins in NCAA history (across all Divisions). Of the 10 ahead of her on the list, only five are current coaches and only one is an active Division I head coach

#### #SOPHIASTRONG

- The Gators welcomed their newest teammate, six-year old Sophia Murrillo, through the Friends of Jaclyn Foundation back in July 2019
- Sophia loves Minnie Mouse, the Wizard of Oz and purple
- The Friends of Jaclyn Foundation's mission is to improve the quality of life for children battling pediatric brain tumors or other childhood cancers. They also raise awareness through their Adopt-A-Child, Safe on the Sidelines and Guardian Angel programs

#### **DEPARTURES & ARRIVALS**

- The Gators lost four seniors to graduation after the 2020-21 season: two-time All-American Holly Carlton, All-SEC selection Paige Hammons and two fiveyear seniors in Darrielle King and Mia Sokolowski
- Florida also lost defensive specialists Paula Cerame and Riley Fischer, as well as opposite Haley Warner to the transfer portal
- The Gators return .805 percent of its kills, .627 percent of its service aces, .893 percentage of its solo blocks, .777 percent of its block assists and .904 percent of its assists
- UF welcomes four incredibly talented freshmen to the team this season in Trinity Adams, Merritt Beason, Gabrielle Essix and Bre Kelley
- Once again, Marlie Monserez will be looked to for a majority of the setting duties this season, with the help of Birdie Hendrickson, a two-time Missouri Gatorade Player of the Year
- The libero jersey is solidly in the hands of Elli McKissock, who stepped into the role during her freshman season. Trinity Adams will aid McKissock in the backcourt as a freshman DS. Hendrickson is also an option in the backcourt, as she saw time as a DS at the end of the 2020-21 season
- The Gators are stacked at the middle blocker position, bringing back Lauren Dooley, Lauren Forte and Nnedi Okammor to the position all of whom have started for UF at one point. Florida also welcomes two stellar freshman MBs to the court this fall in Bre Kelley and Gabrielle Essix. Kelley enrolled in Jan. 2021 and although she was unable to compete in the spring matches, she was working with the team in the gym. Essix had a tremendous senior high school season and summer leading up to her freshman campaign. She helped lead Hoover to a state championship and was selected to the U20 National Team, which competed in Belgium and the Netherlands in July
- Similar to the middle blocker position, UF has plenty of heavy hitters at the outside hitter position. The Gators return AVCA All-Americans T'ara Ceasar and Thayer Hall, alongside Sofia Victoria who has a plethora of experience with the Puerto Rico National Team. Merritt Beason joins the OHs as a dynamic freshman with a lot of talent. Beason also joined UF in Jan. 2021, working in the gym for the spring semester
- The biggest question to this year's team is who fills the hole left by two-time All-American Holly Carlton on the right side. MB Bre Kelley, OH Merritt Beason and S Birdie Hendrickson are battling for the position

Mary Wise, the architect of one of the most storied programs in NCAA history enters her 31st season at the helm of Florida volleyball. Wise's achievements since joining the Gators in 1991 are nothing short of unprecedented.

There are 24 SEC titles, including 18 straight from 1991-2008 -- the Division I record for most consecutive conference titles by a single program. There are 30 straight NCAA Tournament bids, eight NCAA Semifinals, a trip to the 2003 and 2017 NCAA Championships match, 15 SEC Coach of the Year honors and three AVCA National Coach of the Year accolades.

Wise has coached all 46 All-Americans in school history, with those student-athletes amassing 127 All-America honors. Additionally, 13 Gators have combined for 19 SEC Athlete of the Year awards since 1992, including Angie McGinnis in 2006 and 2007, when she became the first setter in history to claim the honor and one of only five multi-time winners.

She also coached three Olympians (2 indoor, 1 beach doubles), most recently Kelly Murphy (United States) and Aury Cruz (Puerto Rico) in 2016.

Moreover, Wise and the Gators became the *first program in NCAA history to win 100 consecutive sets, as well as the first to win 130 consecutive regular-season conference matches.* 

In addition to the being the most successful female head coach in Division I history (the evidence of which you can see on both these pages), Wise is the *only coach in history to amass a .900-plus winning percentage in the first 20 seasons at one school*, posting a record of 632-69 (.902) from 1991-2010.

Florida and Coach Wise paired their national success with a dominance of the SEC, logging a .933 winning percentage and 472-34 record in SEC matches.

The Gators draw their success from Wise's exciting, high-powered offense, which ranks among the nation's best seemingly every year.

Florida boasts three of the top 10 all-time hitting percentage leaders in Division I history, including Chloe Mann's (2010-13) record clip of .476--which ranks all-time across all divisions. Heather Wright (1997-2000) finished with a .424 clip, ranking her sixth in Division I history and Rhamat Alhassan (2014-17) hit .423, putting her eighth overall.

On that same note, Florida is the *only program to have more than two individuals lead the nation in hitting percentage since the NCAA began tracking the statistic in 1994*, with Wright doing so in 1999 (.451), Mann doing so in 2012 (.444) and 2013 (.506), and Rhamat Alhassan doing so as a freshman in 2014 (.458).

As a team, the Gators are one of two Division I programs to lead the nation in hitting percentage more than twice since the NCAA began tracking the stat in 1994. Florida led the nation in back-to-back seasons (.313 in 2015, .338 in 2016) and did so in 2011 (.309).


