UNBEATEN CAMPBELL TRAVELS TO FLORIDA

Off to its first 2-0 start since 2018, Campbell heads to Florida on Saturday, September 12. Kickoff is set for 5:30 p.m. at Ben Hill Griffin Stadium in Gainesville, Fla.

QUICK HITS

- Campbell will take on an FBS opponent for the 15th time in its history on Saturday against the Gators. Florida will mark the Camels' fourth P4 conference opponent, and the first time the program will take on a foe from the SEC.

- Campbell is 0-14 all-time against FBS foes.

- The game at Ben Hill Griffin Stadium is poised to be the largest crowd ever for a game in which Campbell is a participant. Last year's October matchup at North Carolina State (56,919) currently holds that distinction.

- The Camels are 2-0 to start a season for the first time since 2018.

- For the second straight week, and for the first time since 2024, Campbell is receiving votes in the FCS top-25 polls. CU picked up votes in both the media and coaches polls this week, and sit just outside the top-25. Campbell has never held a top-25 ranking in football.

- Heading into Week 2 of the season, Campbell owns one of the nation's top offenses, ranking fourth in the FCS in passing offense at 336.5 yards per game and eighth in total offense at 521.0 yards per game.

- Individually, QB Kamden Sixkiller ranks among the FCS' top-10 in five categories, including completions per game (29.0, 2nd), total offense (393.5, 3rd), passing yards (673, 4th), rushing TDs (3, 8th), and points responsible for (42, 9th).

- Campbell begins the 19th season of its modern era of football (since 2008) in 2026, its fourth year as a member of the CAA.

- Campbell's September 26 game against Hampton will mark the 200th game in the program's modern history. The team's season opener was the 100th road game in program history, while the November 7 Stony Brook game will be the Camels' 100th home game.

- The Fighting Camels under third year head coach Braxton Harris return six full-time starters on the offensive side of the ball, and four on defense from 2025. Harris is the third head coach in Campbell's modern history.

- The 2026 Campbell team features 44 total returners and 62 newcomers, including 34 freshmen and 28 transfers.

LAST TIME OUT

Campbell rolled up more than 500 yards of total offense and held No. 24 Western Carolina to just one rushing yard, topping the visiting Catamounts 28-19 on Sunday at Barker-Lane Stadium.

With the home opener win, the Camels (2-0) earned their first 2-0 start since 2018, as well as the program's second victory over an FCS top-25 opponent (last at then-No. 17 Western Carolina, 24-16, 9/7/24).

WCU's (1-1) single rushing yard marked Campbell's fewest rushing yards ever allowed against a nonconference opponent, and second fewest all-time (record: -7, vs. Maine, 10/21/23).

Campbell posted 528 yards of total offense, its second straight game over the 500-yard mark, adding seven tackles for loss on the defensive side while holding WCU to 2-of-13 on third down chances.

LEADING THE CAMELS

Campbell quarterback Kamden Sixkiller ranks among the FCS' top-10 in five categories, including completions per game (29.0, 2nd), total offense (393.5, 3rd), passing yards (673, 4th), rushing TDs (3, 8th), and points responsible for (42, 9th). He was named the FCS national offensive player of the week after the season opening victory at ETSU.

Heading into Week 2 of the season, Campbell owns one of the nation's top offenses, ranking fourth in the FCS in passing offense at 336.5 yards per game and eighth in total offense at 521.0 yards per game.

Four Camels have rushed for at least two touchdowns through just two games, while Spencer Jones owns team-highs of 11 catches and 175 receiving yards.

BENTON TAKES CAA WEEKLY HONOR (9/7)

After leading 2-0 Campbell in tackles and limiting No. 24 Western Carolina to a record low rushing attack, linebacker AJ Benton was named CAA Football Defensive Player of the Week. Camels have earned CAA weekly honors in each of the first two weeks of the 2026 season.

Benton, a sophomore linebacker, posted a career-high eight tackles, including a sack on the Camels' first defensive play of the game, helping Campbell top No. 24 Western Carolina 28-19 on Sunday. He later added a pass breakup, forcing 3-and-outs on WCU's first two possessions and helping Campbell jump out to a 21-3 second quarter lead.

The Roswell, Ga. native led a CU defense that limited WCU to one rushing yard and 2-of-13 on third down chances, while racking up seven tackles for loss. WCU's single rushing yard marked Campbell's fewest rushing yards ever allowed against a nonconference opponent, and second fewest all-time (record: -7, vs. Maine, 10/21/23).

SIXKILLER EARNS NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR (8/31)

After combining for 438 yards and four touchdowns in Campbell's week 0 road win, Kamden Sixkiller has been named the Stats Perform FCS National Offensive Player of the Week, as well as CAA Offensive Player of the Week.

Sixkiller threw for 343 yards and combined for four touchdowns, leading Campbell over East Tennessee State 49-37 to open the 2026 season. The senior piloted Campbell to 514 yards of total offense, finding the end zone on seven of its 11 full possessions, including four of its first six.

Sixkiller completed 29-of-42 passes with two touchdowns, while rushing for 95 yards, his most as a Camel, and two more TDs. The Norman, Okla. native passed for 243 yards in the first half alone, helping Campbell to a 28-24 lead at the break, the program's most points ever in an opening half against a Division I opponent in a season opener.

Sixkiller's 343 yards passing are the sixth most passing yards in Campbell single-game history. Six Camels totaled 40 or more yards receiving.

PETTIS EARNS PRESEASON ALL-CAA HONORS, CAMELS PICKED EIGHTH IN POLL

Campbell linebacker DaVonyae Pettis has been named honorable mention Preseason All-CAA, while the Fighting Camels were picked eighth in the conference's preseason poll, as selected by the CAA's head coaches.

Rhode Island, which took the CAA title last season, was the unanimous choice to claim the championship again in 2026, picking up all 12 possible first-place votes (coaches can't vote for their own team) and 144 points in the preseason poll.

Monmouth was chosen second with 119 points, while Elon was close behind in third with 115 points. Placing fourth was New Hampshire with 106 points, and Stony Brook, which got one first-place vote, took fifth with 105 points. Towson (93 points) finished sixth in the poll, followed by Maine (88 points), Campbell (56 points), Bryant (50 points), CAA newcomer Sacred Heart (49 points), UAlbany (35 points), North Carolina A&T (28 points) and Hampton (26 points).

Headlining the preseason all-conference teams, Rhode Island quarterback was chosen as the CAA Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, while Monmouth safety Jaeden Jones was selected as the CAA Preseason Defensive Player of the Year.

Campbell's Pettis, meanwhile, earned the honorable mention nod after posting 25 tackles, including team highs of 8.5 stops for loss and 4.0 sacks, while forcing three fumbles, registering seven QB hurries and breaking up three passes in his first season at Campbell in 2025.

The Shelby, N.C. native, selected as a team captain heading into the 2026 season, has been nominated for the 2026 Good Works Team, recognized for leadership in community service and announced by Allstate and the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA).

EIGHT CAMELS NAMED TO PHIL STEELE PRESEASON ALL-CAA TEAMS

CAMELS AGAINST THE FBS

The Camels are 0-14 all-time against FBS opponents. Prior to the 2020 season, Campbell had played against just four FBS opponents in its modern history, traveling to Troy in 2019 and hosting Coastal Carolina in 2018, while facing off with Old Dominion in 2013 and Appalachian State in 2014.

Campbell's 2020 finale at Wake Forest marked the program's first ever against a Power Five opponent in football. CU has now faced seven different in-state FBS foes (ECU twice). In its 14 games against FBS foes, Campbell held the lead in six different outings.

This season, Campbell will take on its first opponent from the SEC.

DaVonyae Pettis was selected as a second team All-CAA pick at linebacker, while seven other Camels were predicted as third team members, including punter Brandon Bowman, offensive lineman Kameron Durant, kicker Caleb Robison, quarterback Kamden Sixkiller, punt returner Barry Tate, linebacker Kalen Villanueva, and wide receiver Jyron Waiters.

BEDADA NAMED TOP-20 IN CFL SCOUTING BUREAU PRESEASON RANKINGS

Campbell defensive lineman Ebenezer Bedada has been selected as one of the top professional prospects in Canada, earning the No. 19 spot in the Canadian Football League (CFL) Scouting Bureau's Preseason edition of the Class of 2027 prospect rankings.

The Calgary, Alberta native saw time in all 12 games for the Camels in 2025, posting 12 tackles, including one stop for loss, with a pass breakup, three hurries and a fumble recovery. He made multiple tackles three times on the year, including a season-high three against New Hampshire and William & Mary, tacking on a stop for loss against UNH, and a QB hurry against the Tribe.

The fifth year CAA Commissioner's Honor Roll recipient, earning High Honors in 2025, heads into his third season at Campbell after beginning his career at Murray State.

The CFL Scouting Bureau, comprising CFL scouts, as well as player personnel directors and general managers from the league's nine clubs, releases its rankings three times each year, with the cycle beginning in the fall to coincide with the opening of the collegiate season, in winter ahead of prospects' postseason, and a final ranking in the spring following CFL Combine Season.

PETTIS NAMED GOOD WORKS TEAM NOMINEE BY ALLSTATE, AFCA

Campbell linebacker DaVonyae Pettis has been nominated for the 2026 Good Works Team, recognized for leadership in community service and announced by Allstate and the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA).

Pettis has made an impact in the community, especially at Buies Creek Elementary School, located next to the Campbell University campus, volunteering on multiple occasions, often multiple times per week, while also joining BCES for its international day where the grade levels put on international dances.

In addition, Pettis has volunteered with a special needs prom, assisting with food assistance for the homeless, and helped with Campbell's freshmen move in.

In his first season at Campbell in 2025, the Shelby, N.C. native also made an immediate impact on the field, posting 25 tackles, including team highs of 8.5 stops for loss and 4.0 sacks, while forcing three fumbles, registering seven QB hurries and breaking up three passes. He has also been selected as a team captain heading into the 2026 season. Pettis also carries a 3.642 GPA and will be graduating with his BBA-Management degree this December.

Pettis is one of 175 student-athletes and coaches nationally across all divisions nominated on this year's Good Works Team, including one of only 20 student-athletes from the FCS ranks.

The Allstate AFCA Good Works Team recognizes college football student-athletes who demonstrate exceptional commitment to community service, academics and athletics. Established in 1992 and presented by Allstate since 2008, the program honors players who use their platforms to strengthen communities and support causes important to them.

BOWMAN NAMED TO FCS PUNTER OF THE YEAR PRESEASON WATCH LIST

Campbell newcomer Brandon Bowman has been named to the 2026 FCS Punter of the Year Award Preseason Watch List by the Augusta Sports Council.

The watch list, which honors the nation's top collegiate punter in the Football Championship Series (FCS), includes 14 student-athletes on its preseason edition.

Bowman, a Harrisburg, N.C. native, heads into his first season at Campbell, transferring from North Carolina Central where he was named a 2025 honorable mention BOXTOROW HBCU All-American, as well as First Team All-MEAC at punter. The senior was also named to the MEAC Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll following the 2025 season, his only year in Durham after starting his collegiate career at NCAA Division II member North Greenville.

The 14 candidates on the list incorporate a broad spectrum of FCS punters and were compiled based on previous FCS Punter of the Year semifinalists, 2025 All-American, and All-Conference selections, top performing punters, and 2026 Preseason All-American and Preseason All-Conference selections. This is not a final list as the winner of the FCS Punter of the Year Award does not need to appear on the preseason watch list.

CAMPBELL MOURNS THE LOSS OF DALE STEELE, HALL OF FAME FORMER HEAD FOOTBALL COACH

Dale Steele, Campbell Athletics Hall of Fame member, former head coach and the architect of the rebirth of the Campbell football program, passed away on Sunday, July 19 after a courageous battle with cancer. He was 70 years old.

Inducted into the Campbell Athletics Hall of Fame in 2025, Steele was named Campbell's first head coach of its modern era on June 15, 2006, of a program that had been dormant since 1950. Steele built the coaching staff and oversaw Campbell's first six recruiting classes on the NCAA Division I level.

Under Steele's guidance, the Camels produced 33 All-Pioneer Football League performers from 2008-12 and 192 PFL Academic Honor Roll members. The team led the PFL – and ranked among the nation's top-20 programs – in rushing for three-straight years from 2009-11. In 2011, Campbell won five consecutive games and finished with the program's first overall (6-5) and conference (5-3) winning records.

The son of a high school coach and a 1976 graduate of the University of South Carolina, where he played on both the offensive and defensive line, Steele began a collegiate coaching career that lasted more than 45 years in 1977 as a graduate assistant at Ball State. Among the many accomplishments his teams produced were five bowl games – including four during two stints on the staff at East Carolina, as well as back-to-back NCAA FCS national championships in 2016 and 2017 while serving as Director of Football Administration at James Madison.

In November 2025, Steele was presented with the Orange Tie Award at the 2025 Orange Tie Gala after establishing the Steele Family endowed scholarship.

A 35-year member of the American Football Coaches Association, Steele served as FCS representative on the NCAA Football Issues Committee, as well as a voting member on the FCS Coaches Poll and All-America selection committee.

Following retirement, Steele remained involved in college football as an advisory and team host for the Myrtle Beach Bowl and has remained present in Campbell Athletics in an unofficial capacity, connecting the entirety of the Camels' modern era of football while continuing to serve the program's coaches, student-athletes, administrators and alumni.

FIRST TIME OPPONENTS

Campbell will face off against three first time opponents in 2026, including the opener against ETSU, Florida and CAA Football member Albany. Since the 2018 campaign, which coincided with the program moving to the Big South, and then the CAA in 2023, CU has faced 33 first time opponents, with that number set to grow to 36 by the end of the season.

Campbell faced eight first time opponents during the 2022 season.

ABOUT CAMPBELL

Founded in 1887 as Buies Creek Academy, Campbell is a private, Christian liberal arts University located in the North Carolina Sandhills region between Raleigh and Fayetteville. Campbell operated as a junior college from 1926-61 before reaching senior college status in 1961 and University status in 1979. The main campus in Buies Creek is home to its College of Arts & Sciences, College of Pharmacy & Health Sciences, Divinity School, School of Education, Lundy-Fetterman School of Business, and the School of Engineering. The nearby Health Sciences Campus is home to the Jerry M. Wallace School of Osteopathic Medicine and the Catherine W. Wood School of Nursing. The Raleigh campus includes the Norman Adrian Wiggins School of Law. Campbell also provides online classes through Adult & Online Education, has campuses in Fort Liberty/Pope Field and at Camp Lejeune in North Carolina, and maintains a degree program at Tunku Abdul Rahman College in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. Founded in 1956 by Coach Fred McCall and former Wake Forest coach Bones McKinney, the Campbell Basketball School became the nation's oldest and largest summer basketball camp in continuous operation and included guest coaches and instructors like John Wooden, Press and Pete Maravich, Michael Jordan and five others named to the NBA's all-time top-50 players list. Old Carter Gym, which hosted Campbell basketball games from 1953-2008, was the site of the longest organized basketball game in the history of the sport. On Feb. 29, 1964 Angier and Boone Trail played 13 overtimes at the site in the Harnett County high school championship game. Boone Trail eventually won 56-54, but that is not as memorable as the fact that neither team substituted during the contest.

CAMPBELL FOOTBALL HISTORY

Campbell has a football history that dates back to 1925 when the school fielded its first varsity team. That team led by coaches Edge and Baker went 3-1-1 including the historic first 7-0 victory over Carthage. The details of some of early teams remains incomplete, but it is known that the 1929 team, under the direction of Coach Bob Hays, posted Campbell's first-ever state championship with a 5-2-1 record.

Campbell continued to be a program to account for and posted a state junior college championship in 1932 under the guidance of Coach S.O. Brandon. The third state title came in 1939 when Campbell tied both Belmont Abbey and Brevard.

With World War II in full swing Campbell made the decision to suspend football play from 1940-45 until the war came to an end. When CU resumed play the Camels continued to win. The team won the 1946 and 1948 North Carolina Junior College State Championships and finished as the runner-up in 1947 all under the direction of Coach Earl Smith.

The 1947 team lost to South Georgia 46-7 to finish as the runner-up for the Eastern United States Junior College Championship. One year later in 1948, Campbell won the North Carolina title, but fell to familiar foe South Georgia 26-19 in the Eastern U.S. Championship.

With the on-set of the Korean Conflict and the movement of many North Carolina schools to senior college status in the 1950's, Campbell dropped its varsity football program after the 1950 season until the present day.

In August 2004, Campbell first began to explore, by way of a feasibility study, the possibility of adding non-athletic scholarship football as a varsity sport. When results came back as something that should be pursued CU made the official announcement on April 7, 2006 that football was coming back to the Creek as varsity sport in time for the 2008 season. It was decided that the program would compete at the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (non-scholarship) level.

In 2006, the Camels formally submitted a bid to join the Pioneer Football League. On June 15, 2006 Dale Steele was named head coach and began to assemble his staff and his first signing class in 2007.

Steele and his staff continued their preparation for the 2008 season by conducting the team's first official football practice in more than 50 years on August 28, 2007 with more than 100 players participating.

The Pioneer Football League formally accepted Campbell's application for the 2008 season on December 5, 2007. That day also served as the official unveiling of the 2008 game schedule.

After years of planning and waiting, the Camels were finally able to take the field on August 30, 2008 with a contest against Birmingham-Southern College. In front of overflowing crowd of 5,845 CU lost a hard-fought 12-6 game.

In 2011, Campbell produced its first winning season at 6-5 overall.

Campbell announced in November 2016 that it would move to the Big South Conference, playing from 2018-22.

The Camels then announced a move to the CAA in August 2022, playing their first season as a league member in 2023.

Announced as the Fighting Camels' head coach on January 2, 2024, Braxton Harris heads into his third season leading the Campbell football program.

In his second stint in Buies Creek, Harris previously spent the 2021 and 2022 seasons on staff at Campbell, returning to Buies Creek after spending 2023 as head coach at FCS Southland Conference member Houston Christian.

The third head coach in Campbell's modern football history (since 2008), has reshaped the roster and culture of the program since returning to campus.

Harris picked up his first win as Campbell head coach in historic fashion, defeating No. 17 Western Carolina on the road on September 7, 2024, the program's first ever win over a top-25 ranked opponent.

Taking on the 10th hardest schedule in the FCS in 2024, three Camels were named to All-CAA teams, including wide receiver Sincere Brown (First Team), linebacker Jalen Brooks (Second Team) and long snapper Bobby Cleary (honorable mention).

Brown became Campbell's third 1,000 yard receiver, while Brooks set a school record for tackles in a single season (118), and rookie wide out Randall King added FCS Freshman All-America accolades from Phil Steele.

In 2025, Harris' Camels notched one of the most memorable wins in program history, a 50-48 double overtime win over Bryant in their CAA home opener. Three Camels, Trayjen Llanas-Wilcox (third team, punt returner), Randall King (honorable mention, wide receiver) and Freddie Pelling (honorable mention, offensive line), also represented CU on the CAA Football all-conference teams.

Since becoming head coach, Harris' squads have also posted record numbers in the classroom, posting a program record 3.108 cumulative team GPA for the 2026 Spring term, and three straight semesters with a team mark over 3.0 for the first time in recorded team history.

At HCU, Harris coached the Huskies to their first winning season in program history in 2023, going 6-5 overall after inheriting a program that had won more than two games once in the previous six years. HCU also fashioned its first winning record in conference play, going 4-3 in the SLC and finishing fourth in the league after being picked last in the preseason poll.

Additionally, linebacker Jalyx Hunt, before being drafted and winning a Super Bowl championship with the Philadelphia Eagles as an NFL rookie, posted an All-America campaign (AFCA, Stats, Perform, Phil Steele), also earning SLC Defensive Player of the Year honors, headlining a group of five Huskies named to All-SLC teams.

In his first stop at CU, Harris served as associate head coach and linebackers coach in addition to recruiting coordinator duties under Mike Minter, who resigned in December 2023 after 11 seasons.

Under Harris' guidance, the Camels hauled in the top signing classes in the FCS in back to back seasons, a feat he matched in his first year at HCU, making him responsible for the subdivision's top recruiting class for three consecutive years. In fact, in December 2021, Harris and the Camels signed three of the FCS' top-10 recruits.

In his first season at Campbell in 2021, Harris helped the Camels rank fourth in the FCS in takeaways (25) and defensive touchdowns (4). Linebacker CJ Tillman earned Freshman All-America honors and was a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award, given to the top freshman in the FCS.

Campbell also placed a program-record 12 student-athletes on All-Big South teams in 2022, including Tillman, while safety Myles Rowser was named to The Bluebloods Freshman All-America Team.

Prior to Campbell, Harris was the head coach at Howard Payne in Brownwood, Texas, from 2017-19. He led the Yellow Jackets to a 5-5 record in his final season, posting the program's most overall wins and conference wins (4) since 2006.

Harris was the assistant head coach and co-defensive coordinator at Texas Lutheran in Seguin, Texas, from 2013-16. He helped guide a previously 0-10 program to a 25-5 record over three years and three consecutive conference championships (2013, 2014, 2015). He originally joined the TLU staff in 2011 as the defensive ends and linebackers coach, as well as special teams coordinator and recruiting coordinator.

Harris was the safeties coach at Waco High School for one year, after beginning his coaching career at his alma mater, the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor, in Belton, Texas, from 2006-09. He played quarterback for UMHB from 2003-05 and was a member of the Crusaders' 2004 NCAA Division III National Championship finalist team.

A Mexia, Texas, native, Harris graduated from UMHB with a bachelor of science degree in education in 2008, then earned a Master's in education administration in 2009.

Harris and his wife, Jennifer, have three sons, Brooks, Fisher and Cooper, and a daughter, Cate.
