### WASHINGTON AND LEE HEAD COACH GARRETT LeROSE:

**Garrett LeRose (W&L '07)** is in his fourth year as the head coach at Washington and Lee. His first three seasons have resulted in an 11-9 (.550) overall record. During his first season in 2018, the Generals posted a 5-4 record. His second in 2019 produced a 6-4 mark. Prior to becoming head coach, LeRose had served as an assistant coach with W&L ever since finishing his playing career with the Generals in 2006. He won one ODAC title as a player (2006) and has had a hand in four more (2010, 2012, 2015, 2017) as a coach. LeRose is 2-0 all-time against Sewanee.

### SEWANEE HEAD COACH TRAVIS RUNDLE:

Sewanee is led by fifth-year Head Coach **Travis Rundle (Albion '02)**, who carries a 7-24 (.226) overall record with the Tigers. He is 0-3 all-time against the Generals and this will be the third time he has faced W&L on the road in four meetings.

### ALL-TIME RECORD:

W&L has a storied tradition that began with the first officially recognized game in the South, an 1873 matchup with neighboring VMI. The first official season was 1890 and over their 127 seasons, the Generals have compiled a 528-539-39 (.496) overall record.

### THE SERIES:

W&L and Sewanee will be meeting for the 69th time, with the Generals holding a 45-23 advantage in the all-time series that began during the 1892 season. W&L has won 14 of the last 15 meetings, including a 42-7 win two years ago at Wilson Field. The home team has had a decided advantage in the history of the series, and W&L has won 16 straight home games against the Tigers. The last Sewanee win in Lexington was a 14-7 victory in 1986.

### SERIES TRENDS:

W&L has dominated the series with Sewanee over the last 15 years, but particularly so over the last three meetings. Across the last three contests, W&L has outscored the Tigers by a count of 152-51. The Generals are averaging 50.7 points, 556.3 total yards and 484.7 rushing yards per game in those games. W&L has produced more than 400 rushing yards and 500 total yards in all three games, including 629 total yards and 554 rushing yards in a 63-30 victory in 2017. Senior running back **Josh Breece** has personally accounted for 264 yards and five touchdowns in those games.

### SUSTAINED SUCCESS:

Since the beginning of the 2010 season, W&L has produced a 66-38 (.635) overall record and a 46-21 (.687) mark in the Old Dominion Athletic Conference. The Generals have also claimed four ODAC titles during that stretch.

### CHASING HISTORY:

W&L is currently riding a string of five straight winning seasons, the fourth-longest stretch of consecutive winning seasons in program history and the longest such streak since posting six straight winning campaigns from 1980-85. W&L also had six straight from 1919-24 and a record 13-straight from 1905-17.

## SCOUTING SEWANEE:

Sewanee hasn't played since dropping a 24-21 decision to Greensboro last spring on April 3. The Tigers' scheduled opener for Saturday at St. Scholastica was canceled due to Covid-19 protocols. In the loss to Greensboro, the Tigers were paced by now junior quarterback **Cooper Hancock**, who completed 13-of-22 passes for 166 yards and two touchdowns with two interceptions. He also rushed three times for 10 yards. Now junior running back **Michael McGhee** carried 17 times for 55 yards and now sophomore wide receiver **Dagem Samuel** caught 10 passes for 109 yards and one touchdown. Now senior linebacker **Parker Hughes** produced six tackles and a sack to lead the defense. In the last full season played in 2019, Sewanee finished the season 0-10 and the Tigers are currently riding a 12-game losing streak. In 2019, McGhee was the team's second-leading rusher with 78 yards and a touchdown on 39 carries. Hancock completed 68-of-140 passes for 595 yards and two touchdowns with six interceptions, while now senior wide receiver **Cyrus McCullough** led the team in receiving with 48 catches for 568 yards and four touchdowns. Now senior **Jacob Viccari** was fourth in receiving with 22 catches for 214 yards and one touchdown. Now junior defensive back **Daniel May** was fifth on the team in tackles (48) two years ago and he led the team with five interceptions.

## LAST TIME OUT:

(CHRISTOPHER NEWPORT 28, W&L 24 - 9/4/21 - NEWPORT NEWS, VA.)

Quarterback Mat Dzierski scored on a 6-yard touchdown run with 0:39 remaining to lift Christopher Newport to a 28-24 win over Washington and Lee in the football season-opener for both teams. The Generals broke a 21-21 tie on the prior possession by moving the ball 36 yards on six plays, finishing the drive with a 35-yard field goal by sophomore placekicker **Arturo Ramirez** for a 24-21 lead. CNU began the next series on the 25-yardline, marching 75 yards on 13 plays. The Captains converted on two third-and-long situations on the drive. Dzierski picked up the first on a 3rd-and-12 from his own 36-yardline, scrambling 17 yards for a first down. The second was a 14-yard strike to tight end Brandon Johnson on a 3rd-and-8 from the 20-yardline with just under one-minute remaining. Dzierski completed the comeback two plays later. W&L advanced to midfield on the final series, but ran out of time and the Captains walked away with a win in the first-ever meeting between the two programs. Christopher Newport seized a 7-0 lead on a 12-yard touchdown run by Dzierski with 8:20 left in the first period. The Generals tied the game at 7-7 with 5:47 left in the half on a 1-yard touchdown run by senior running back **Josh Breece**. His run capped a 15-play, 66-yard drive that used 7:51 on the game clock. CNU drove into W&L territory on the next series, but junior linebacker **David Onyejekwe** tipped a pass and then corralled his own deflection for an interception. He proceeded to return the ball 71 yards to the Captains' 3-yardline, setting up a 3-yard touchdown run by senior running back **Alex Wertz** one play later for a 14-7 lead with 2:56 left on the clock. CNU battled back and marched 78 yards on eight plays, tying the game heading into the break (14-14) with a 36-yard touchdown pass from Dzierski to wide receiver Xander Jedlick with just 26 seconds remaining in the half. Neither team could make headway in the third period, but CNU broke through for a 21-14 lead just 1:51 into the fourth period on a 27-yard touchdown pass from Dzierski to Jedlick. W&L responded on the following possession, driving 64 yards on just four plays to tie it up at 21-21 with 10:49 left in the game. Senior quarterback **Jack Pollard** began the series with a 40-yard run and senior running back **Coby Kirkland** finished it off with a 20-yard touchdown run. Christopher Newport out-gained the Generals, 354-225, making good on 8-of-13 third down conversions. Pollard led the W&L offense by rushing for 93 yards on 18 carries and completing 4-of-10 passes for 52 yards. Breece rushed 12 times for 35 yards and one touchdown, Kirkland had two carries for 21 yards and one score, and Wertz rushed two times for 10 yards and one touchdown. Junior defensive end **Robert Poindexter** posted a team-best six tackles and one sack. Onyejekwe had three tackles, one sack and one interception. Dzierski led the Captains by completing 29-of-39 passes for 266 yards and two touchdowns. He also rushed 14 times for 47 yards and two more touchdowns.

## HOME SWEET HOME:

Since the turn of the century (2000), Washington and Lee is a combined 69-28 (.711) in games played at Wilson Field. The Generals have won 37 of their last 50 (.740) home contests dating back to the 2010 season. W&L's game against Sewanee will mark its first home game in 672 days. The last was a 28-7 win over Southern Virginia on November 9, 2019.

## SUSTAINED SUCCESS:

Since the beginning of the 2010 season, W&L has produced a 66-38 (.635) overall record and a 46-21 (.687) mark in the Old Dominion Athletic Conference. The Generals have also claimed four ODAC titles during that stretch.

## THE MAGIC NUMBER:

The magic number for success for W&L is 400. The Blue & White has managed 400 rushing yards in a game 41 times since 2010 (103 games). In those games, the Generals are 38-3, scoring an average of 44.5 points per game with a scoring margin of +20.4 points per game. To contrast this point, when W&L fails to rush for 400 yards during the same span, it is just 28-35 with an average of 24.2 points per game and a scoring margin of -1.36 points per game.

## BREAKING DOWN THE ROSTER:

Washington and Lee boasts 92 players on the roster, one of its largest rosters in program history. The breakdown includes 22 seniors, 20 juniors, 22 sophomores and 28 first-year players, who hail from 21 different states and also includes one player from Switzerland. Virginia tops the list with 24 players, while there are 13 players from Georgia, 11 from Texas and eight from North Carolina.

## TOUCHDOWN TALK:

Senior running back **Josh Breece** opened the 2021 season by rushing for 35 yards and a touchdown on 12 carries. Breece's 1-yard touchdown against the Captains marked his fourth straight game with at least one touchdown and tied him with Brett Murray '13 and Marc Watson '01 for third-place on W&L's career touchdowns list with 36 total touchdowns. It also moved him into a tie with Murray for fourth on the all-time scoring list with 216 points.

## DAVID OHHHH!

Junior linebacker **David Onyejekwe** had his coming out party with a fantastic performance against Christopher Newport on Saturday. Onyejekwe recorded three solo tackles, one sack and an interception that he returned 71 yards to set up the Generals' second touchdown of the game. Onyejekwe played in all 10 games as a rookie in 2019, totaling 10 tackles.

## TALKIN' DEFENSE:

Junior defensive end **Robert Poindexter** also broke out in the season-opener, tallying a team-best six tackles, including two tackles for a loss (-7). He added one sack as well, doubling his career total. Poindexter had posted 20 tackles and one sack in his first season two years ago.

## IN A RUSH:

W&L has consistently possessed the most potent rushing offense in the country in recent seasons and finished fifth in Division III with an average of 315.7 rushing yards per game last season. The Generals led all of college football in rushing in 2016 and 2015, and they have ranked no lower than sixth in DIII in rushing offense since 2010.
