STORY LINES

NOTING WEEK 4

- The Apprentice School will take the field Saturday against Washington & Lee for Homecoming 2023. The game has been moved to Sunday due to the tropical cyclone that moved through Hampton Roads Friday and Saturday.
- The Builders will tangle with the Generals in Newport News for the first time in the all-time series.
- Apprentice won last year's Homecoming game against Louisburg, 40-37.

LAST TIME OUT: APPRENTICE

- The Apprentice School football team erased a 21-point deficit and took the lead, but Moravian put together a perfect drive late in the fourth to escape with a 29-28 win.
- After a scoreless first quarter, the Hounds punched in the game's opening score on a 10-yard run with 5:02 to play before halftime. After getting the ball back, Moravian found a way to score again on a 37-yard pass with just 38 seconds left until halftime to lead 14-0 at the break.
- The Greyhounds opened up the third quarter with another deep passing score before Apprentice finally got on the board on a Mason Tatum 4-yard rushing touchdown to cut the lead to 21-6 after a blocked point after.
- It was all Builders for most of the fourth quarter as Tatum hooked up with Ricardo Corpus for a 14-yard touchdown and two-point conversion that trimmed the lead to 21-14. AS tied the game up just two minutes later as Tatum found Ta'Kevion Petty for a 42-yard touchdown with 9:13 left on the clock. Apprentice wound the clock down on their next possession to 1:49 when Tatum powered his way in from three yards out to give the Builders their first lead of the game, 28-21.
- Moravian answered, though, as Jared Jenkins led a two-minute drill down the field, ending with a 2-yard touchdown pass to Jordan Bingham, followed by a two-point conversion with just 19 seconds left that gave the win to the home team. Lawrence Reed nearly eclipsed the century mark in rushing, getting 97 yards on 14 touches. Tatum threw for 189 yards as the Builders racked up 398 yards of total offense.

LAST TIME OUT: WASHINGTON & LEE

- Following a bye in the second week of the season, Washington and Lee's running game was on full display as they defeated Methodist University, 54-14. On the Generals second drive of the game, Anthony Crawford capped off a nine-play, 52-yard drive as he walked into the endzone from two yards out to give W&L a 7-0 lead. After the Blue and White defense forced its' third punt of the quarter, Stephen Murrin connected with Evan Novak for a 38 yard gain which led to a seven yard touchdown scamper for Cameron Reed, giving the Generals a 14-0 lead.
- Feeding off a Generals' mistake, Methodist quarterback Brandon Bullins capped off a seven-play, 50-yard drive with a 23-yard passing touchdown to Thomas Wade III to cut the W&L lead to seven. The W&L offense only needed four plays to respond as Jacob Romero snuck around the right side and streaked up the field for a 36-yard touchdown to put the Blue and White up 21-7. Methodist's next drive ate up 6:41 of the game clock as they marched 72 yards down the field on sixteen plays which ended on a one-yard rushing touchdown from Keyshaun Pete. A six yard rushing touchdown from Burke Cigelske gave the Generals a 27-14 lead heading into halftime.
- Following a 23-yard return from Cigelske on the opening kickoff of the second half, the Generals used a 15-play, 67-yard drive to extend their lead to 20 as Murrin found Novak all alone in the endzone for an eight yard score. Starting their drive at their own 20 yard line, Marcus Payne and Giorgio Antonacci both rushed for 11 yards before Payne broke off a 58-yard rush to give the Generals a commanding 41-14 lead with 13:27 left in the fourth quarter. Payne sealed the deal with a 17-yard rushing touchdown to put W&L up 54-14 with just five minutes remaining in the game.
- The Generals recorded 535 yards of total offense on 66 plays. The last time the Blue and White had over 500 yards in a game was on Oct. 1, 2022 in a 31-0 win over Averett University.

HEAD COACH VINCENT BROWN



Vincent Brown enters his sixth year with the Builders and third season as head coach.

In 2022, the Builders put together their best ever winning percentage, striking up a .900 record in a 9-1 season that included wins over Averett, Brevard, Christopher Newport and Bridgewater in the Neptune Bowl. Brown led the team to having the single season record holder in passing in Mason Tatum and multiple other records being broken

throughout the season, including the second most points scored in a single game against Central International in an 81-0 win.

After a complete rebuild following the 2020 COVID year where the team did not play any games, Brown looks to capitalize on the experience that his young group gained last season, competing against a strong ODAC schedule where the Builders played every game on the road but one. They also defeated USA South Conference playoff contender Brevard. Coupled with a strong recruiting class and off season, the Builders look to prepare the ship for battle.

In 2019 the Builder defense continued to excel. Under Brown's leadership, the defense has ranked as one of the best in school history. As an addition this past season, Coach Brown introduced the "24K" Turnover Hard Hat and the defense responded to it's new incentive. With a new emphasis on takeways, the Builder defense forced a total of 26 turnovers, including 11 interceptions and 15 forced fumbles. The unit also set a school record with 17 sacks, as well as ranking nationally for fewest rushing touchdowns allowed with 12

Combined with an efficient offense, Coach Brown and the defense led the Builders to a 6-3 regular season record and an appearance in the inaugural Neptune Bowl vs. Randolph-Macon College. The six wins marked the first time the Builders program finished above .500 vs. all varsity opponents since 2006 and just the 4th time since 1993.

As a testament to Coach Brown's coaching prowess, for the 2nd year in a row the team's Defensive MVP has emerged from his position group in 2018 winner Isaiah Washington (Sr.) and 2019 winner Javion Walker (Jr.)

Brown has coaching experience at all levels, including HS, junior college, NAIA, NCAA DIII and the European Football League. Brown is coming to Apprentice School after his coaching stop at Campbellsville University in Kentucky, which he started in 2017.

As linebackers coach Brown's impact was felt immediately as the Tigers finished 2017 with an 8-2 overall record and were ranked

17th nationally in the NAIA Top 25 poll. In addition, the Tigers won the 2017 Victory Bowl. Following a 2-8 mark in 2016 before his arrival, Brown assisted in a complete defensive turnaround in 2017 with the team giving up nearly 40% fewer points per game (26.6) and allowing only 96 yards rushing per game (6th best mark in NAIA Division I).

In addition to his coaching career, Brown had an exceptional career as a student-athlete. He played two seasons for the University of Memphis from 2000-2002 before transferring to Morgan State University, where he graduated with a degree in communications.

During his time at Morgan State, Brown was the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Rookie of the Year in 2003 and was nominated to the All-MEAC First Team. In addition, he was presented the Iron Man Award for leading the Bears with 98 tackles, 68 solo, 22 for loss over 100 yards and seven sacks. In 2004, Brown, received Preseason All-American honors and was the runner-up for MEAC Defensive Player of the Year during his senior campaign.

After his college career, Brown had private workouts with multiple NFL teams and was offered a contract to play in the Canadian Football League with the Edmonton Eskimos in 2005 before playing two seasons in the Arena Football League with the Arizona Rattlers and Kansas City Brigade as a linebacker and fullback. He closed his playing career in 2009 with the Bolzano Giants of the Italian Football League (IFL).

Prior to Campbellsville, he was the Assistant Head Coach and Safeties Coach for Gallaudet University. He also spent time serving as the defensive coordinator, linebackers coach and recruiting coordinator.

Brown served as the Head Coach for the Egyptian national football team in the winter of 2014 where he was responsible for organizing and selection of the team, practice and game-playing and making the first African national game appearance for the program.

In 2013, Brown coached the linebackers on a defense that ranked ninth in NCAA DIII in total defense (264.5 yards allowed/game) and topped the Eastern Collegiate Football Conference. In 2015, the Gallaudet defense ranked third in the ECFC and 23rd overall by allowing 282.8 yards a game.

Prior to Gallaudet, Brown was the head strength & conditioning coordinator and defensive line coach at Louisburg College assisting the Hurricanes to their best record in school history and first-ever trip to a bowl game. In addition, Brown brought a strong recruiting class to contribute to the school's record setting season. He joined the Hurricanes after one season as the defensive coordinator and strength coach for the 2012 State Champion Virginia Episcopal School located in Lynchburg, VA.

Brown, a native of Detroit, Mich., graduated from E.C. Glass High School in Virginia, where he was a two-sport athlete in football and basketball.
