## Introduction

The men's lacrosse program at Geneseo began as a club sport in the spring of 1966 under head coach John Hoey, who had played lacrosse at the University of New Hampshire, and assistant coach John Linfoot (a 1994 inductee into Geneseo's Sports Hall of Fame), who had played lacrosse at Yale.

Hoey and Linfoot held fundraisers in order to purchase equipment for the team and began with one (Doug Bartlett) of 24 players having played the game previously.

The team posted one win in its inaugural campaign, a 13-12 victory over the RIT Tigers, who were coached by John Spring (Geneseo's athletic director from 1987-99). In 1968, Hoey and assistant coach Ed Thomson embarked on the first varsity season.

Geneseo participated in the SUNYAC men's lacrosse league from 1978 until it was disbanded for lack of teams after the 1987 season, winning one conference championship in 1982. The Knights joined the Empire Lacrosse League with Elmira, Keuka, Oswego, Oneonta, and Potsdam from 1988 to 1999, but resumed SUNYAC league play in 2000 with the additions of Plattsburgh and SUNYIT.

The following pages are an attempt to provide a historical perspective on the evolution of men's lacrosse at Geneseo. If you find any errors or omissions, please bring them to our attention so that we can make corrections in future editions.
