GAME OVERVIEW

These two teams enter Saturday's game on opposite ends of the spectrum. Geneva comes in having won four of its past five games, including three games in which the Golden Tornadoes have scored over 50 points, while Bethany enters having lost its first six games of the season, with its closest defeat coming by 21 points. Geneva's junior quarterback Caleb Romano continues to put up historic passing numbers for the Golden Tornadoes, and he earned his third PAC Offensive Player of the Week honor on Monday for his performance in the 62-20 win at Waynesburg. Bethany has seen an improvement in its play offensively since the return of junior starting quarterback Brett Phillips, one of the most talented and dynamic QBs in the PAC.

GENEVA GAME NOTES

-- Geneva defeated Waynesburg 62-20 on Saturday on the road, the most points scored by the Golden Tornadoes since Geneva defeated Olivet Nazarene 77-14 in 2001. In fact, Geneva has scored over 50 points in back-to-back games, the first time that has happened since 1903 when the football team defeated Mount Union, 63-0, and Pittsburgh, 53-0, in consecutive weeks. The program has never had three straight games scoring over 50 points.

-- Quarterback Caleb Romano continues to put up historic numbers in the passing game. He threw for 373 yards and four touchdowns in the win at Waynesburg, earning PAC Offensive Player of the Week honors. He's now thrown for at least 335 yards in five straight games. For the season he has thrown for 2,466 yards, the most in Division III, and his 23 passing touchdowns are tied for first in Division III. He's on pace to break the single season program record of 3,125 yards set in 1997 by Justin Myers.

-- Geneva now has three receivers with over 500 yards receiving this season. Keaton Baker leads the team with 45 catches for 836 yards and nine touchdowns, which puts him in the top ten in multiple categories in Division III. Luke Crumbacher has 30 grabs for 604 yards and six touchdowns, putting him in the top 35 in Division III at 20.1 yards per reception. Seth Tyson has a team-high 52 catches, tied for fifth in Division III, along with 566 yards and four touchdowns.

-- The Geneva defense forced seven turnovers in the win at Waynesburg, four interceptions and three fumble recoveries. That's the most turnovers the Golden Tornadoes have forced in a game since 2001 when Geneva forced seven turnovers in a 56-0 win over Urbana.

-- In addition to the turnovers Geneva's defense forced on Saturday, that side of the ball has seen some improvement in recent weeks and is now fifth in the PAC in points allowed at 28.9 ppg. The GTs have been particularly strong against the run, where Geneva in PAC play is allowing just 83.6 yards per game, fourth in the conference.

-- Geneva enters the last three games of the season with a real chance to win the PAC if the Golden Tornadoes can win their final three games.

-- Geneva will be off next week, enjoying the bye week that each school gets once.

BETHANY GAME NOTES

-- It's been a struggle for the Bethany Bison football team this year, who have lost all six games by an average of 38 points per game. The Bison have seen some improvement offensively in recent weeks, though, after standout junior quarterback Brett Phillips returned to the lineup two games ago after being injured early in the season-opening game against Sewanee.

-- Phillips is one of the most dynamic players in the PAC at quarterback. He was an All-PAC performer last season for the Bison and is both a skilled passer and runner, generating most of the offense for Bethany with either his arm or his legs. After managing just 13 total points in their first four games, the Bison have averaged 28 points per game over their last two games, which coincided with Phillips' return to the lineup. In those two games Phillips combined to throw for 600 yards while adding another 145 yards on the ground.

-- Outside of Phillips, Bethany hasn't found much success on the ground. In fact, Phillips has accounted for over half of Bethany's rushing yards this season, despite playing in just a little over two games this year.

-- The area where Bethany has struggled the most this year has been on the defensive side of the ball. The Bison are allowing almost 50 points per game, and Bethany's lowest points allowed came in the season-opening 41-6 loss to Sewanee. The Bison have allowed 553 total yards per game, 320 through the air and 223 on the ground.

-- While Geneva has the second-best kickoff net yards at 40.5 in the PAC, Bethany has the second-worst net average on kickoffs at just 28.5 net yards per kickoff. The Bison have gotten a good performance from sophomore punter Caden Langley, though, who is third in the conference in punting at 37.0 yards per punt.

LAST MEETING

Geneva prevailed last year in a high-scoring affair between the two teams down at Bethany. After scoring a combined 61 points through three quarters, neither team scored in the fourth and Geneva held on to a narrow victory. The Golden Tornadoes received a balanced offensive attack. David Reid ran for 93 yards and three TDs, while Caleb Romano passed for 171 yards and two scores, both going to Keaton Baker who finished with 155 yards receiving. For Bethany, it was the Brett Phillips show as he threw for 361 yards and four touchdowns to go with 117 yards rushing. The game produced four touchdown passes of at least 42 yards, two each for each team, as both squads utilized the deep passing game to produce points. The win was Geneva's fourth straight in the series.
