GAME OVERVIEW

Geneva is making a return to the postseason for the first time since 2009 when the Golden Tornadoes won the NCCAA Victory Bowl out in Greenville, Illinois, 29-28. SUNY Brockport is making its ninth straight postseason appearance, the last five coming in the form of an ECAC bowl game. Geneva is now the fourth PAC opponent Brockport has faced over the last five years. The Golden Eagles lost to Carnegie Mellon in 2023, had its game against Westminster cancelled in 2022, and defeated W&J in 2021. Both teams have strong offenses averaging over 35 points per game. Geneva does most of its damage through the air, while Brockport has a very balanced offense. Brockport has had the better defense, giving up just 16 points per game.

GENEVA GAME NOTES

-- Geneva is back in the postseason for the first time since 2009 when the Golden Tornadoes won their fifth National Christian College Athletic Association Victory Bowl with a dramatic comeback victory at Greenville (IL), 29-28.

-- It's been a fitting season to end the standout coaching career of Head Coach Geno DeMarco, who announced prior to the season that this year, his 33rd season at the helm of the program, would be his last. He's the longest tenured coach at any school at the collegiate level. He's the winningest coach in program history at 173 victories. He was also an assistant at Geneva for five seasons before taking over as head coach, and he spent four years as a player for the Golden Tornadoes, giving him over 40 years that he's been directly involved with the program.

-- Junior quarterback Caleb Romano has been the star of the offense all year. After running the triple option rushing attack the prior eight seasons, Coach DeMarco revamped the offense around the talents of Romano, and the team responded. He's currently third in Division III with 3,425 yards passing, the most in a single season in school history. He's also thrown for 33 touchdowns, a school record, while also adding five rushing touchdowns. He needs nine completions to break that school record too.

-- Geneva has a quartet of receivers who have helped the passing game achieve record heights. Senior Keaton Baker was the first receiver in Division III to surpass 1,000 yards, and he leads the team with 1,110 yards and 12 touchdowns. Senior Luke Crumbacher has caught a touchdown pass in nine straight games and is up to 910 yards receiving. Senior Seth Tyson leads the team with 65 catches, while sophomore Dayne Johnke has been a strong fourth option with 42 catches.

-- Geneva's defense had its best performance of the season last week in the 43-16 win at Case Western Reserve, which broke a 10-game losing streak to the Spartans. The Golden Tornadoes came up with six sacks and produced four turnovers, two of which were returned for touchdowns. Senior Nicholas Ciriello earned PAC Defensive Player of the Week honors after posting 12 tackles while returning a fumble for a TD. He's the first Geneva player to reach 100 tackles in almost ten seasons. Ciriello is from Port Colborne, Ontario, so Saturday's game is a Homecoming of sorts for the linebacker.

SUNY BROCKPORT GAME NOTES

-- This will be SUNY Brockport's ninth straight trip to the postseason. The past four years the Golden Eagles have played in an ECAC bowl. From 2017 through 2019 Brockport qualified for the NCAA Division III playoffs and won at least one game all three seasons, including in 2017 when the Eagles won three games before falling in the semifinals.

-- The star of the offense is junior running back Isaiah Simmons. He's rushed 220 times for 1,338 yards and 19 touchdowns. He's currently sixth in DIII in rushing yards. He'll be the toughest test this year for Geneva's defense, who has generally been a strong rushing defensive team so far.

-- Brockport can move the ball through the air as well, though, behind junior quarterback Ben Gocella. He's thrown for 1,918 yards and 16 touchdowns, giving the Golden Eagles a very balanced offensive attack. Senior Daniel Manneh has been his primary target, with Manneh posting 59 catches for 829 yards and seven touchdowns. In total Brockport has six different players who have caught at least ten passes this year.

-- Brockport's defense has been a strong unit all year, especially against the run where the Golden Eagles have allowed just 60 yards per game. In total, the defense is allowing just 213 yards per game of total offense.

-- A total of six different defenders have posted at least 5.5 TFLs, and as a team Brockport has 79 TFLs, averaging almost eight stops behind the line of scrimmage per game. Freshman lineman Jayden Ferrell leads the team with 12.0 TFLs. The Golden Eagles also have 21 sacks to their credit.

-- Three of Brockport's losses have been by one score, and all four losses came against teams that qualified for the postseason, including Utica, RPI and St. John Fisher who all qualified for ECAC bowls. Cortland, their only big loss this year, made the D3 playoffs.

-- Brockport has 108 players on its roster, and all but one are from New York.

LAST MEETING (1989)

Geneva has played SUNY Brockport four times in its history, all four coming over a four-year stretch from 1986 through 1989, the last one a 45-0 Golden Tornado victory up in Brockport, New York. Head Coach Geno DeMarco was an assistant coach during the last two of those victories. In fact, over those four games, Geneva outscored Brockport 133-48. The closest game in that stretch was in 1987 when the Golden Tornadoes won 32-26. That 1987 season was the year Geneva made a run to the NAIA national semi-finals while also ending a long losing streak to rival Westminster in those same NAIA playoffs.
