GAME OVERVIEW

Both teams come into Saturday's game off a victory in their PAC opener. Geneva's passing attack set records in a 55-35 victory over Saint Vincent, while Allegheny posted its first shutout in six years in a 26-0 home defeat of Thiel. For Geneva, junior quarterback Caleb Romano passed for 484 yards and seven touchdowns, while also running for a touchdown, while senior receiver Keaton Baker caught 12 passes for 282 yards and four touchdowns. For Allegheny, sophomore running back Dominic Berarducci led the offense with almost 200 yards of total offense, 157 coming on the ground, and three touchdowns. Geneva won last year's matchup on Reeves Field and has defeated the Gators all three times since Allegheny rejoined the PAC in 2022.

GENEVA GAME NOTES

- Geneva fans got to watch some history in Saturday night's 55-35 victory over Saint Vincent on Reeves Field. The Golden Tornadoes new passing offense put together an aerial display never seen before on Reeves, and the Bearcats had no answers for the new spread attack.
- Junior quarterback Caleb Romano is the engine behind Geneva's new passing attack, and he passed for 484 yards and seven touchdowns against the Bearcats, while also running for one touchdown. His 484 yards passing are second in school history for a single game, while his seven passing touchdowns tied the record set by Geneva Hall of Fame quarterback Zack Hayward 2012. Romano's eight combined touchdowns are a school record for a single game, and his efforts earned him PAC Offensive Player of the Week honors.
- Romano has a talented quartet of receivers to throw to, and senior Keaton Baker was the biggest beneficiary of Romano's big night. Baker caught 12 passes for a school record 282 yards, and his four receiving touchdowns tied the school record. He was named to the D3football.com Team of the Week for his performance. Seniors Seth Tyson, Luke Crumbacher and David Reid also caught touchdowns from Romano.
- An underrated part of Geneva's passing success has been the play of the offensive line, along with running back David Reid's good work in pass protection. The offensive line has given up just one sack in the last two games, giving Romano time to throw.
- Geneva spread its rushing attack around, totaling 145 yards on the ground. Geneva's 629 yards of offense were the most in a game since the Golden Tornadoes put up 665 yards of offense in 2013 in a 51-33 victory over Bethany. Geneva is now third in the PAC with 428.7 yards per game, while its 33.7 points per game are second.
- Geneva's run defense has been a strength for the team, and against the Bearcats the Golden Tornadoes gave up just 16 yards on 20 carries. The defense also sacked quarterback Jake Phillips five times, two by sophomore Wyman Shaheen.
- Senior linebacker Nicholas Ciriello leads the team with 32 tackles, sixth in the PAC, while senior linebacker Reed Gordon has added 25 stops, 10th in the PAC.

ALLEGHENY GAME NOTES

- Allegheny has played well in all three of its contests so far this year. The Gators led Denison 18-13 going into the fourth quarter in their season-opener before falling. In week two at Juniata, Allegheny led with a minute to go before allowing a game-winning touchdown with seven seconds remaining. The Gators could easily be 3-0.
- The Gators boast a balanced offensive attack. Allegheny is averaging 146.7 yards rushing and 169.7 yards passing. The Gators have averaged 29.3 points per game, fourth in the PAC.
- Two of Allegheny's best players are brothers. Sophomore Carson Colucci, who started his career at Wheeling before transferring to Allegheny prior to this season, is the starting quarterback and has thrown for 500 yards and three touchdowns, while running for 76 yards and two scores. Senior linebacker Coltin Colucci is one of the top defensive players in the PAC. He leads the team with 26 stops.
- Sophomore running back Dominic Berarducci has been a workhorse for the Gators so far this year, and the offense often runs through him. He missed the season-opener against Denison, but he's rushed for over 100 yards against both Juniata and Thiel, totaling 274 yards on 44 carries for a 6.2 yards per carry average. He's also scored four rushing touchdowns in those two games. In addition, he's caught six passes for 71 yards and score, meaning he's reached the endzone five times in the last two games. Last year, Berarducci had his worst game of the year against Geneva as the GTs held him to -1 yard on nine attempts.
- Sophomore receiver Devin Larry has been the primary target for Colucci. Larry has caught 15 passes for 270 yards and three touchdowns.
- Allegheny currently boast the second-best passing defense in the PAC, giving up just 180.7 yards per game, so Saturday's game will be a good test for both teams.

LAST MEETING

Geneva stormed out to 30-0 halftime lead in last year's meeting, taking control of the game early and cruising to victory. Quarterback Caleb Romano had a big day for the Geneva offense, passing for 161 yards and two touchdowns while running for 81 yards and a score. Receiver Seth Tyson was Romano's primary target in the game, catching six passes for 139 yards and a touchdown. Logan Hartshorn added a rushing and receiving TD to the attack. Geneva's defense dominated the first half, only allowing Allegheny 62 yards of offense before halftime, and the Gators only broke into the scoring column in the fourth quarter against the Golden Tornado reserves. Ryan Clark totaled a career high 10 tackles to lead the defense, while Coltin Hill was a disruptive force on the d-line, totaling 2.5 TFLs.
