GAME OVERVIEW

Both Geneva and Shenandoah picked up a win last Saturday to open the season. For Geneva, it was the program's first victory to open the year since 2015. The Golden Tornadoes were led by their defense for most of the game, as Geneva trailed 7-0 at halftime with the offense unable to generate any points. However, quarterback Caleb Romano found his groove in the second half, leading the GTs to three second-half touchdowns to allow Geneva to come from behind for the win. Shenandoah won easily at Methodist to start its season, 30-3. The Hornets did most of their damage on the ground behind running back Aidan McCloskey. He ran for 138 yards and a touchdown on just 11 carriers and was named the ODAC Offensive Player of the Week.

GENEVA GAME NOTES

-- Geneva accomplished something it hadn't done since 2013, and that's winning its season opener. The Golden Tornadoes had lost their last 12 season openers before Saturday's comeback victory over Widener. The victory was new coach Tom Contenta's first career victory.

-- It was a challenging first half for the Geneva offense, which came into the season with much fanfare after senior quarterback Caleb Romano returned after breaking most of Geneva's single-season passing records last year. However, the GT offense was held scoreless in the first half, with three turnovers. In fact, the lone score in the first half for either team was an interception return for a touchdown for Widener early in the first quarter. Eventually, the offense did get going in the second half, with Romano and junior wide receiver Dayne Johnke doing most of the damage. Romano passed for 335 yards and a score, while also running for a score, while Johnke grabbed a career high 11 catches for 161 yards and a score.

-- The defense was the key to victory on Saturday. They kept Geneva in the game in the first half when the offense was struggling to get points on the board, with the GT defense allowing just one touchdown in the game. The defense harassed Widener QB Corey Schock all game, finishing with five sacks, 11 QB hurries and 11.0 TFLs.

-- Junior defensive back Noah Hutcherson was one of the stars of the defense, finishing with ten tackles, four QB hurries, 3.0 TFLs and two pass breakups. He was named the PAC Defensive Player of the Week for his play.

-- Sophomore defensive back Christian Hunter also finished with ten tackles, while senior lineman Coltin Hill was a problem all game for the Widener offensive line. Hill finished with eight tackles, 2.5 TFLs and two sacks. Junior lineman Ry'Shaun Johnson also had a big day, posting seven tackles and 1.5 sacks.

-- Junior running back Liam Gibson scored his first career touchdown.

-- Geneva begins the tough stretch of its season this week with the GTs not returning back to Reeves Field until October 10 for their Homecoming game against Hiram.

SHENANDOAH GAME NOTES

-- Shenandoah made quick work of Methodist in its season opener, winning 30-3. The Hornets were picked fourth in the preseason ODAC football poll. Randolph-Macon, which started the season ranked No. 25 in the nation, was picked as the favorite.

-- Shenandoah returned five All-ODAC honorees from last year's roster, including the ODAC Rookie of the Year in quarterback Mekhi Brown. Brown did not play in last year's Geneva matchup. He stepped into the starting lineup in the fourth week and never let go of the spot.

-- The star offensively of the win over Methodist was senior running back Aidan McCloskey, who rushed just 11 times but finished with 138 yards (12.5 ypc) and a touchdown. He was named the ODAC Offensive Player of the Week. In total, Shenandoah rushed for 252 yards, not needing much from its passing game. Brown threw 25 times, completing 14 passes for 108 yards and a touchdown.

-- The Shenandoah defense gave up very little to Methodist, yielding 121 yards on the ground and just 83 yards through the air. The Hornets finished with five sacks and 7.0 TFLs. Sophomore linebacker Ace Heinrichs led the team with nine tackles, while junior linemen Phoenix Andes-Stowell and Ryan Apietu each totaled two sacks.

-- Shenandoah has been a model of consistency under Head Coach Scott Yoder, in his 14th season. The Hornets have not had a losing record in a full season since his third season, 2015, when the team finished 4-6. Since then, the team has posted anywhere from a 5-5 to 8-2 record. Shenandoah has advanced to the postseason in each of the past two years, including last year's trip to the Cape Henry Bowl.

-- Junior punter Connor Moyssiadis averaged over 40 yards per punt last week against Methodist, while junior kicker Carson Gallant connected on a 35-yard field goal.

LAST MEETING (2025)

Geneva and Shenandoah met for the first time in program history last year on Reeves Field, and after an early lead for Shenandoah, the Golden Tornadoes stormed back and led until late, when a Shenandoah field goal with five minutes left allowed the Hornets to leave town with a one point, 29-28 victory. In fact, after falling behind 12-0, Geneva went on a 28-7 run over the second and third quarters to take a 28-19 lead into the final quarter, but Shenandoah scored the final ten points of the game to win. Caleb Romano passed for 260 yards and touchdown, while Jaden Duckett scored a defensive touchdown on a 41-yard interception return, but a balanced offensive attack from the Hornets was just enough to pull out the victory.
