#### PATRIOT POINTS

- ► George Mason and James Madison will meet for the 99th time Saturday as part of a historic rivalry series.
- ► Mason (3-0) is off to its best start since 2013-14, when the Patriots began the campaign 4-0.
- ► Last time out, Mason took down NEC preseason favorite LIU, 80-74, on Wednesday night inside EagleBank Arena. Mason shot 53.3 percent in the second half and forced 15 LIU turnovers.
- ► Sophomore Jordan Miller exploded with a career-best 25 points (3-5 3pt FG), to go along with five rebounds, two blocks and two steals in the win. After averaging 5.5 shots over the first two games of 2019-20, Miller took 18 (and made 10) vs. LIU.
- ► Redshirt-junior AJ Wilson chipped in 10 points (5-8 FG) vs LIU and is averaging 12.0 ppg and 7.0 rpg through three contests. Wilson is eighth in the country in blocks/game (4.3) and seventh nationally in block rate (18.2%).
- ► Sophomore point guard Jamal Hartwell II is averaging 12.0 ppg, shooting 41.2 percent from 3 and has committed just one turnover in 113 minutes (6.0 A/T0 ratio thru 3 games).
- ► Freshman point guard Xavier Johnson is averaging 26.7 mpg and has scored 10+ points in two of three contests. 11 of his 13 points vs. LIU came in the final six minutes of play.
- ▶ Junior Javon Greene leads Mason in assists (3.3 apg), 3pt FG% (.444) and 3pt FG made (8). He's averaging 13.7 points, has scored 10+ points in all three games, and tallied 12 points (4-5 FG) and a team-high eight rebounds in the win over LIU.

- ▶ Mason is holding opponents to 39.9 percent overall and 26.4 percent from 3-point range through three games.
- ▶ In large part due to Wilson's efforts, Mason leads the A-10 in blocks/game (6.3) through three games this season.
- ➤ This season, 59.8 percent of Mason's points come from 2-point range (43rd nationally). Five Patriots (four starters) are shooting 50 percent or better from the floor overall this season.
- ► Through two games, Mason is grabbing an offensive rebound on 35.5 percent of missed shots (58th nationally) but allowing an offensive rebound on 36.6 percent of opponent misses (314th nationally).
- ► 2019 Atlantic 10 Most Improved Player Justin Kier is expected to miss the first part of the season as he recovers from a stress fracture in his right foot.
- ►The Patriots will open the 2019-20 schedule with five-straight home contests. It's the most home games to start a campaign for the Green & Gold since 1996-97.
- ► The Patriots return 10 letter winners and three starters from a 2018-19 squad which won a school-record 11 A-10 games, captured a program-best five A-10 road victories and won an A-10 Tournament game for the third-straight season.
- ▶ In the win over Navy, head coach Dave Paulsen picked up his 200th career Division I victory. His 202 Div. I wins include 134 victories at Bucknell and 68 at George Mason. Paulsen has recorded 463 wins overall in his career in 26 seasons.



### 2019-20 Men's Basketball Game Notes

### Last Time - Mason 80, LIU 74 EagleBank Arena - Fairfax, Va. | November 13, 2019

**FAIRFAX, Va.** - The George Mason University men's basketball team improved to 3-0 on the young season with a gutty 80-74 triumph over Long Island University Wednesday night inside EagleBank Arena.

The Patriots battled an LIU team which ranks top-50 in the nation in tempo. The Sharks pushed the pace after nearly every made Mason basket and tallied 14 fast break points, which kept the Northeast Conference favorites within striking distance for much of the contest.

In the end, Mason withstood the onslaught and used a 53.3 percent shooting effort (16-30) in the second half to secure the victory.

The Patriots had just 10 turnovers against LIU's funky triangleand-two defense and forced 15 LIU miscues which led to 16 Mason points.

Mason shot 46.3 percent overall for the game and had a solid night (13-17, .765) at the free throw line.

#### **MEDIA COVERAGE**

Saturday's game will be broadcast on MASN, featuring commentary from Bill Rohland and Craig Esherick. In addition, Steve Kolbe will call the game on the GoMason Digital Network. Pregame coverage will begin at 6:45 p.m.

#### **HISTORY vs. JMU**

The Patriots hold a 48-50 (.490) all-time record vs. the Dukes. James Madison is Mason's most common opponent over the program's 54-year history, as Saturday will mark the 99th meeting. Mason is 26-19 vs. JMU in Fairfax, 18-27 in Harrisonburg and 4-4 on neutral courts vs. the Dukes. The Patriots have won 22 of the past 24 games between the schools. In the most recent matchup, Mason won 66-53 in Fairfax on Dec. 7, 2018, behind 21 points from Otis Livingston II and a double-double (16 pts, 11 reb) from Justin Kier. Kier is from Grottoes, Va., just minutes from downtown Harrisonburg and the JMU campus. Two seasons ago, Mason completed an improbable comeback to defeat the Dukes on Nov. 29, 2017 in Harrisonburg. The Patriots overcame a four-point deficit with seven seconds to play to take a 76-72 victory. That finish included four clutch free throws during one-and-one opportunities by then freshman Goanar Mar.

#### A LOOK AT THE DUKES (2-1, 0-0 CAA)

James Madison was picked to finish fourth in the 2019-20 CAA preseason poll and received four first-place votes. JMU has captured home wins over Charlotte (79-74) and Div. III Shenandoah (96-48), and dropped a 65-34 contest to No. 11 Virginia on Nov. 10 in Charlottesville. The Dukes have held opponents to 34.1 percent shooting and a paltry 20.2 percent from 3-point range over the first two games of the season. JMU is led by preseason All-CAA First Team selection Matt Lewis, who paces the Dukes in scoring (14.4 ppg), rebounding (10.0 rpg) and assists (3.7 apg). Four Dukes average double figure scoring totals, including Zach Jacobs (11.7 ppg), Michael Christmas (10.3 ppg) and Deshon Parker (10.0 ppg).

#### HISTORY vs. IN-STATE DIV. I OPPONENTS

Saturday's game marks the 395th all-time game for Mason against an in-state, Div. I foe. The Patriots are 184-210 (.467) vs. Commonwealth opponents over the past 53 seasons. Harkening back to its CAA history, Mason's most common in-state opponents are James Madison (48-50), William & Mary (40-28), Richmond (25-37), VCU (20-41) and Old Dominion (21-36). This season, Mason will host the Dukes and play home-and-homes with A-10 Virginia schools Richmond and VCU. Mason already defeated Longwood 76-65 on November 8.

#### **UP NEXT**

Mason plays the final game in its season-opening homestand Tuesday when the Patriots battle Loyola (Md.). Tip-off against the Greyhounds is scheduled for 7 p.m.

#### **MASON SIGNS THREE FOR 2020-21**

George Mason has signed three players in its 2020 class. That group includes forward Malik Henry (Longview, Texas), guard Tyler Kolek (Cumberland, R.I.) and guard Ronald Polite (Oxon Hill, Md.). Henry is a 3-star recruit and the No. 39 power forward in the nation according to Rivals.com. Kolek was named the 2019 Rhode Island Gatorade Player of the Year, while Polite is ranked as a top-10 rising senior in the DC/Maryland area.

#### OTIS OUT, HARTWELL II/JOHNSON IN

The opener vs. Navy marked the first time since Nov. 13, 2016, that Otis Livingston II did not start for Mason at point guard. Livingston II played all 132 games of head coach Dave Paulsen's first four seasons in Fairfax and left Mason second all-time in assists (493), fourth in scoring (1,865 pts) and first in free throw percentage (.859).

Mason has replaced Livingston II with a two-headed attack of speed and power. On the speed side, sophomore Jamal Hartwell II gets the starting nod. He's averaging 13.0 ppg ppg while shooting 41.2 percent from 3-point range. He's committed just one turnover in 113 minutes on the court. On the power side, freshman Xavier Johnson posted a game-high 15 points (5-7 FG) in the opener vs. Navy and scored 11 of his 13 points in the final six minutes during a win over LIU. He's playing 26.7 minutes per game. Hartwell II and Johnson also have been playing together for stretches so far this season.

#### WILSON READY FOR BIGGER ROLE IN MASON LINEUP

Redshirt-junior AJ Wilson has dazzled Mason fans with acrobatic dunks and huge blocks during his first two seasons in Fairfax while averaging 11.2 minutes per game. In 2019-20, Wilson will look to impact Mason with a stronger all-around presence after an outstanding summer and fall of work. The Laurel, Md., product broke out for the Patriots with 15 points, 11 rebounds and five blocks in 30 minutes vs. Navy and followed that up with 10+ point efforts in the next two games. He has tallied eight dunks through three games and is currently seventh in the nation in block rate. He leads the A-10 in blocks/game (4.3) and is eighth nationally in the category.

#### X GON GIVE IT TO YA

Freshman guard Xavier Johnson tallied 15 points (5-7 FG), four assists and two steals in 30 minutes vs. Navy. That 15-point effort marked the highest scoring total in a Mason freshman debut since George Evans had 15 vs. Howard in November 1997. He followed that up with a clutch performance vs. LIU, where he drove to the basket at will while scoring 11 of his 13 points in the final six minutes of action. He's averaging 11.3 ppg and shooting 52.2 percent from the floor.

#### **NEW D. WHO DIS?**

Head coach Dave Paulsen has unveiled a new full-court pressure defense in 2019-20, and the results have been impressive to date. Through three games, Mason opponents are averaging 14 turnovers per game. The pressure defense also is forcing opponents to enter their halfcourt offense later in the shot clock. As a result, those three opponents have combined to shoot 39.9 percent (75-188) from the floor and 26.4 percent (19-72) from 3.

#### **ACTIVATING SUCCESS IN THE ATLANTIC 10**

Over the last three seasons, George Mason has become one of the most consistent programs in the A-10. The Patriots are one of just four programs to post a league record of .500 or better in each of the past three campaigns. The other programs are Rhode Island, St. Bonaventure and VCU. Mason has averaged 9.7 A-10 wins over the

past three seasons. The Patriots averaged 4.3 conference victories over their first three seasons in the league.

#### IT'S MILLER TIME!

Sophomore guard Jordan Miller returns to the Mason lineup after a stellar back-half of his freshman season. Initially expected to redshirt the 2018-19 campaign, Miller worked his way into the Patriot lineup after injuries challenged Mason's depth. The Middleburg, Va., product responded admirably, scoring 10+ points in nine of the final 12 games of the season. The ball hawk led Mason in offensive rebounds (64) despite playing just half the season. He tallied three doubledoubles on the year, including a 14-point, 13-rebound effort at VCU on Feb. 2. After posting nine and eight point efforts over the first two games of 2019-20, Miller exploded for a career-high 25 against LIU.

#### **INJURY BUG BITES PATRIOTS EARLY**

Mason will be without a senior for at least the first few weeks of the season as Justin Kier recovers from a stress fracture in his right foot. In addition, senior guard Ian Boyd is out for the season after having a surgical procedure on his right wrist. The two seniors have combined for 1,632 points, 799 rebounds and 280 assists over their three seasons in a Mason uniform. In addition, freshman Bahaïde Haïdara is out 4-6 weeks as he recovers from a left wrist sprain. The bad injury luck carries over from last season, as Mason players missed a combined 48 games due to injury.

#### KIER CONTINUES TO SERVE AS MASON'S SWISS ARMY KNIFE

Last season, Justin Kier emerged as one of the premier all-around players in the Atlantic 10. He was one of just 14 players nationally who averaged 14+ points, 6.5+ rebounds, 2.5+ assists and 1.5+ steals per game. In conference play, he led the Patriots in scoring (14.2 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg, 7th in A-10) and was second in 3-point field goal percentage (.383), assists per game (2.8) and steals per game (1.2). His 1.6 steals/game overall was seventh-best in the A-10, while his .371 3pt FG% ranked fifth. Kier tallied a team-high seven double-doubles on the year and earned A-10 Player of the Week accolades on Jan. 14 and Jan. 21.

#### PLAYER DEVELOPMENT KEY PILLAR OF MASON PROGRAM

Head coach Dave Paulsen takes pride in his program's focus on developing players and the proof can be found in the Atlantic 10's postseason awards haul. The Mason roster has featured the A-10's Chris Daniels Most Improved Player in two of the past three seasons. Marquise Moore captured the honor in 2017, while Justin Kier won the award as a junior in 2019.

#### **GREENE MADE MAJOR STRIDES IN SOPHOMORE SEASON**

Javon Greene took a huge step forward during his sophomore campaign in 2018-19. After scoring in double figures five times in 33 games during his freshman campaign, Greene surpassed that number with 13 10+ point efforts in 2018-19. He shot 44.6 percent for the year (up from 35.4% in 2017-18) and grabbed 4.9 rebounds per contest. He emerged as one of the team's top perimeter defenders on the other end of the floor and became nearly automatic from the free throw line, where he led the A-10 in FT percentage (.905). So far as a junior, Greene is averaging an improved 13.7 points, 6.3 rebounds and 3.3 assists while shooting 44.4 percent from 3-point territory.

#### **FRESH FACES ON STAFF**

Prior to this season, head coach Dave Paulsen had enjoyed consistency on his staff for more than a decade of his coaching career. Departed Mason assistant coaches Dane Fischer (13 seasons)
