PATRIOT POINTS

- In front of a season-high attendance, the Patriots erased a seven-point fourth guarter deficit to force overtime and down Davidson, 62-58.
- ► Senior Nalani Kaysia matched her career-high of 19 points to go along with 12 rebounds for her secondstraight double-double and fourth of the season.
- ▶ Jameson (16) and Smith (11) joined Kaysia in doublefigure scoring and were joined by Paula Suarez as the four Patriots to score in overtime.
- Suárez dished out a career-high six assists for the second-straight game to go along with six points, three rebounds and a steal
- ► Mason outscored Davidson in the paint (28-22), on fast breaks (9-2) and on second chance points (10-4) and outrebounding the Wildcats 41-35.
- Mason currently has the third-best scoring defense in the A-10, limiting opponents to 61.6 points per game. Rebounding continues to be a bright spot for the Patriots, as they rank fourth in the conference with 13.4 offensive rebounds and 39.3 total rebounds per contest.

- ► Taylor Jameson ranks 15th in the A-10 with 13.3 ppg and Nalani Kaysia ranks 12th with 0.8 bpg and 12th with 7.2 rpg. Paula Suarez ranks 16th with 3.0 apg.
- ► Coach Blair-Lewis is assisted by the same coaching staff consisting of Chandler McCabe, Niki Washington and Demetria Frank, as well as Andre Bolton, who serves as special assistant to the head coach.
- ► Brittany Ward returns for her second season as a graduate assistant, while five-year member of the George Mason women's basketball team, Livija Kaktaite, joins the staff as a graduate assistant as well.
- ► The Patriots welcome eight newcomers to the 2022-23 roster. That group includes four transfers: grad student Riley Childs (Boston Univ.), senior Sonia Smith (Sacred Heart), senior Trey Kennedy (Marist) and senior Nalani Kaysia (Charlotte- volleyball). Jada Brown, Nehku Mitchell and Zahirah Walton joined Mason in August and Amy O'Hara in December after graduating high school in November.
- ► The Atlantic 10 Conference announced its Women's Basketball Championship will return to CHASE Fieldhouse in Wilmington, Del. from March 1-5, 2023.

Last Meeting: Mason 65, Saint Louis 50 CHASE Fieldhouse | Wilmington, Del. | March 2, 2022


WILMINGTON, Del. — The George Mason women's basketball team stunned No. 11 Saint Louis, 65-50, in the first round of the Atlantic 10 Women's Basketball Championships on Wednesday evening inside the CHASE Fieldhouse in Wilmington, Del.

Mason advances to the second round and will face sixth-seeded Fordham at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday. The Patriots earned their first A-10 Championship win since 2018 and is the first No. 14 seed to upset its opponent in the A-10 Championships.

Junior Tamia Lawhorne led the Patriots with a career-high 24 points. She made a career-best six three-pointers to go along with five rebounds. Her six three-pointers are the second-most made in a single game in A-10 Championship history.

Junior Jazmyn Doster ignited in the second half, finishing with 14 points (7-11 FG) and a team-high seven rebounds. Senior Amaya Scott was the third Patriot in double figures with 11 points to go along with six rebounds and three assists.

Mason shot an efficient 42.4 percent from the field (25-59) and made seven three-pointers (.333). Defensively, Mason held Saint Louis to just 28.8 percent from the floor (17-59) and 13.0 percent from deep (3-23). Mason was +5 in rebounding (41-36) and scored 19 points off SLU's 13 turnovers.

WEDNESDAY'S MATCHUP

MEDIA COVERAGE

Wednesday's match-up will be broadcast live on ESPN+. In addition, Brian McSweeney will call the game on the GoMason Digital Network, with streaming coverage beginning at approximately 11:45 a.m. ET/10:45 a.m. CT.

SERIES HISTORY

The Patriots and Billikens meet for the 13th time in program history on Wednesday in Chaifetz Arena at 11 a.m. CT for Saint Louis' Education Day. The morning tip-off is the first of the year for Mason, but the fifth for the hosts. SLU holds a 4-8 all-time record, including the last four regular season match-ups. However, the Patriots stunned the Billikens in the A-10 Tournament last season, downing No. 11 Saint Louis 65-50 as the No. 14 seed.

SCOUTING THE BILLIKENS

The Billikens mustered a 4-11 out of schedule conference against a slew of difficult opponents, including then-No.21 Baylor and SEC member Missouri. SLU has gone 3-5 so far in league play and most recently upset Fordham 87-84 in a thriller at home.

Saint Louis is led by the No. 3 scorer in the conference, Kyla McMakin, who is averaging 17.6 points per game this season. The Billikens also boast one of the top defenders in the league, Brooke Flowers, who ranks first in the A-10 with 3.7 blocks per game, and second in the nation with 85 total blocks. She is also first on the team in rebounding with 8.0 boards and second in scoring with 11.3 points per contest.

Julia Martinez leads the A-10 with 3.3 steals per game and is second in rebounding (7.9 rpg), assists (3.6 apg) and third in scoring (10.1 ppg). Meanwhile, Kennedy Calhoun is dishing out a team-high 4.4 assists per game (6th, A-10) and contributes 5.7 points per contest.

2022-23 PROSPECTUS

Mason returns six letter winners including five players who played in at least 20 games in 2021-22. The Patriots will be led by the duo of senior Jazmyn Doster and junior Taylor Jameson. Doster returns for her senior season after leading last year's squad in rebounding (6.4) and blocks (20). Meanwhile, Jameson returns as the top pointscorer from last year's team. She averaged just under 10 points per game (9.8), including two games of over 20 points. Senior forward Tamia Lawhorne was just behind Jameson, averaging 9.0 points and was the Patriots' best 3-point shooter a year ago, shooting at a .352 clip with 45 makes.

WINNING WAYS

In her first season at Mason, head coach Vanessa Blair-Lewis helped lead the Patriots to their first double-digit win total since 2018-2019 when the team finished with a 16-14 record. George Mason more than tripled their win total from 2020-21, winning 10 games last season, including a 75-71 victory over SEC powerhouse and NCAA Tournament selection Florida on Dec. 1. Further more, the Patriots won their first A-10 post-season game since 2018 when they were victorious in the First Round of the A-10 Tournament with a 65-50 win over St. Louis. The Patriots were the first No. 14 seed to upset its opponent in the A-10 Tournament, dating back to the league expansion in 2015.

TRANSFER PATS

The Patriots have six student-athletes on their roster who began their college basketball careers elsewhere. Mason welcomes back J-Naya Ephraim (Illinois) after a successful first year as a senior in the green and gold. The Patriots also welcome graduate transfer and Patriot League All-Rookie selection Riley Childs (Boston University), senior transfer and All-NEC honoree Sonia Smith (Sacred Heart), senior transfer and All-MAAC member Trey Kennedy (Marist) and senior transfer Nalani Kaysia (Charlotte) to Fairfax.

SENIOR STRONG

Featuring three transfers, the senior class is now five strong. Senior Nalani Kaysia will put on a basketball jersey for the first time since high school, transferring into Mason after a successful Division I volleyball career at UNC Charlotte, where she was a NCCSIA All-State selection and tallied over 500 kills, 250 digs and 150 blocks in three seasons. As a group, the rest of the senior class of Jazmyn Doster, Tamia Lawhorne, Sonia Smith and Trey Kennedy averaged 9.6 points, 4.4 rebounds and 26.5 minutes per game last season.

HOMESTAND

The Patriots will kick off their season playing four of six games in EagleBank Arena. Mason will open the season with 2022 Sweet 16 team Maryland before heading out on a two-game road trip in Pittsburgh to play Robert Morris (Nov. 10) and Pitt (Nov. 12). The Patriots will then return for three-straight home games in Fairfax, hosting Charleston Southern (Nov. 16), Loyola (Md.) (Nov. 19) and William & Mary (Nov. 21). George Mason struggled at home last year, going just 2-10 in EagleBank, and will look to flip the script and get off to a strong start in 2022 on their home court.

NEWCOMERS TO NOTE

George Mason also welcomed three true freshmen to campus in August. Local Virginia product Jada Brown joins Mason after a successful high school career at New Hope Acdemy. Nekhu Mitchell joins the roster from McDonogh, boasting First-Team All-League honors and a Tournament MVP nod in 2020. She was also a two-time team captain for the Eagles as a junior and senior. Rounding out the freshman class is Zahirah Walton, who hails from Kent, Washington and graduated from Kentlake High School, and previously starred at East Catholic High School. Throughout her high school career, she accumulated team MVP honors, First Team All-League honors and was named to the Washington 3A State All-Tournament Team in 2019-20. The Patriots were also joined by Australian native Amy O'Hara in mid-December after graduating from Bacchus Marsh Grammar School in November. The Hoppers Crossing native is a three-time Australian Basketball Junior Championship gold medalist (2022, U20; 2019, U16; 2018, U16) and played for Keilor Thunder Basketball club. She was also a threetime Basketball Australia National Performance Camp selection and was selected for the U19 Women's GEMS Camp this past year.

RECORD WATCH

There are several Patriots who have already etched their names into the record books at George Mason, and will continue to rewrite history throughout the season. Senior Jazmyn Doster highlights this chase, as she already ranks 13th all-time at Mason in career blocks with 60. The center will also look to move up the list in career rebounds, as she has grabbed 412 (33rd) so far in the first three years of her career.

Senior Tamia Lawhorne and junior Taylor Jameson both currently rank in the top-30 all time in George Mason program history in 3-pointers made. Lawhorne has tallied 62 (25th) and was the teamleader in the category last season, while Jameson has tallied 56 (28th) in just two seasons as a Patriot.

Her six three-pointers are the second-most made in a single game in Atlantic 10 Championship history.

Second Season at Mason; 24th overall

- Vanessa Blair-Lewis begins her second season at Mason as the ninth head coach in the history of the Patriot women's basketball program in 2022-23.
- Last season, she led the Patriots to the first double-digit win total since the 2018-19 season while coaching the team to their first post season win since 2018.
- The four-time MEAC Coach of the Year, Blair-Lewis led Bethune-Cookman to a 196-168 (.538) overall record and six winning seasons, rebuilding a program that had only had two winning seasons in the 19 seasons prior to her arrival.
- In 2019-20, the Wildcats finished 23-6 overall and 15-1 in MEAC play for its fourth regular season championship in the last five years. The team earned a bid to the WNIT before the remainder of the season was canceled due to COVID-19.
- In 2018-19, she led Bethune-Cookman to the MEAC Tournament Championship and its first NCAA Tournament berth in program history. The Wildcats defeated Norfolk State to clinch the program's first tournament championship since 1984 and earned a No. 16 seed in the NCAA Tournament.
- Blair-Lewis became the first women's head coach in MEAC history to win the award three consecutive years and four times overall.
- As a Division I Head Coach, she has recruited and coached 37 all-conference team selections, as well as three Players of the Year, one Rookie of the Year, and six Defensive Players of the Year.
- A 22-year coaching veteran, Blair-Lewis previously served as the head women's basketball coach of her alma mater, Mount St. Mary's. From 1998 to 2007, she led Mount St. Mary's to 120 overall wins and a 97-67 (.591) NEC record, two 20+ win seasons, and two NEC Regular Season Championships.
- As a player, she set the Mount's single-game, season and career records in blocked shots. A two-time NEC Player of the Year, she was inducted into the Mount St. Mary's Sports Hall of Fame in 2002, NEC Hall of Fame in 2013 and her playing jersey was retired in 2019.
- Mentored six Academic All-Patriot League honorees, three Academic All-District II recognitions and one Academic All-American.
