GEORGE MASON

- The Patriots finished the 2024 season with an overall record 20-32, including an 11-15 Atlantic 10 Conference record. The Patriots went 10-10 at home, 6-15 on the road and 4-7 in games played at a neutral site.
- George Mason has 12 returners, and added 10 newcomers on the roster heading into the season under Justin Walker, who enters his fifth season as head coach of the Patriots
- The Patriots added 10 newcomers, including 7 freshman, 2 juniors, and one graduate student who enter their first year at George Mason
- Earlier this season, Abbey Lane received Rookie of the Week honors. She pitched 5.1 innings pitched and struck out a career-high seven batters. She surrendered two runs on two errors and six hits. Lane earned the save in the Patriots' second game against Longwood. She pitched three shutout innings with one walk and two strikeouts
- Madi Sobota earned Rookie of the Week honors for the week of March 17th. She made all five starts at DP for the Patriots. She crushed three home runs over four games. Sobota connected for a three-run homer in GM's second game against Rhode Island. In the third game, she added an inside-the-park home run. Over the four-game stretch, Sobota was 4 for 17, with three home runs, eight RBI, seven runs scored, and three stolen bases
- Maddy Johnson received Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Week honors, her second weekly honors this season. She went 6 for 9, scored four runs, and had two RBIs and two stolen bases
- Tess Altevers Harris received Atlantic 10 Player of the Week honors this week. She went 6 for 9 and had two doubles, two triples, and two home runs in the sweep against St. Bonaventure. She also recorded seven RBIs and had a 2.000 slugging percentage.
- Last week, The Patriots won the series against St. Bonaventure 3-0. On day one they played a single game and won 10-2 in five innings. On day two George Mason won 8-4 in the first game and later won the second game 10-3.
- Last time George Mason and Massachusetts met in April of 2024, the Patriots pulled away with a series with 2-1 in Amherst, Mass.

NEW ADDITIONS

The Patriots added 10 new players, with seven freshman, two juniors, and one graduate student entering their first year at George Mason.

There is one new pitcher joining the Patriots, freshman Abbey Lane (RHP)

New Position players include one graduate student, catcher/utility player Kaylee Stinnett. Juniors include infielder Tess Altevers Harris and outfielder Meredith Wayland.

Freshman position players embarking on their rookie year are infielders Maddy Johnson, Jessica Chan, and Kaitlyn Bronowicz, Outfielder Emma Salzman, and catchers Madi Sobota and Jasmine Mack.

FAMILIAR FACES

There are four seniors this year. Pitchers Jordan Anderson and Jordan Tallman, outfielder Charlotte Montgomery, and infielder Maya McGowan. The Junior class includes pitcher Harlowe Nigh, infielder Kamryn Inman, outfielder Elyssa DeRosa, and catcher Logan Pickford.

Sophomores returning for their second year are pitchers Haleigh Dellow and Kylie Wilkerson, infielder Kaleigh Friend, and outfielder Emily Lampela.

A-10 SOFTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

In the 2023 A-10 Softball Championship, the Patriots (35-24, 16-10 A-10) went 4-1 to claim the title for the first time in program history.

The #4 Patriots defeated #5 Fordham 1-0 on day one (May 10th), downed #1 Saint Louis 5-2 on day two (May 11th), and beat #2 Loyola Chicago on day three (May 12th) 3-0. On day four the Patriots dropped a game against Loyola Chicago 2-3 in eight innings, then secured the championship in the next game beating Loyola Chicago 6-3 in 10 innings.

NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Patriots made their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance in 2023. Mason played #8 Duke in the first round and lost 2-1. The next day (May 20th) the Patriots were eliminated by Campbell University, losing 7-1.

HEAD COACH JUSTIN WALKER



Justin Walker was named head coach of the George Mason softball program in July 2021 after having served in an interim role during the 2020 campaign. He will be coaching his fifth season with the Patriots in the 2025 season. Walker joined the softball coaching staff as an assistant in 2018.

Walker was named interim head coach of the Patriot softball program on April 15, 2020, where he later led the Green & Gold to an 8-0 record to start the 2021 season, the program's best start since 1983. Walker capped off his first season at the helm with the program's first winning season (18-17 overall record) since 2014.

Walker's second year as head coach saw more improvement on the field. In 2022, the team won 24 games, the most since 2004. Four patriots earned postseason conference accolades that year as well. Haley Taormina, Taylor Dadig and Marlaina Bozek were named All-Conference Second Team, while freshman Jordan Anderson was named to the All-Rookie team. In that same season, Bozek was named to the NFCA Mid-Atlantic All-Region Second Team. Bozek, along with Dadig, were also named to the Virginia Sports Information Director (VaSID) All-State's Second Team.

In his third year, Walker led the 2023 Mason Softball team to its best season in softball history, winning the Atlantic 10 Conference Tournament and earning a bid to the NCAA College Softball Tournament. He and his coaching staff were also honored with the ATEC/NFCA Division I Regional Coaching Staff of the Year award, Mason's first ever such award.

The softball team broke numerous Patriot records, such as home runs (27), doubles (90), slugging percentage (.408), RBI (226), stolen bases (135), walks (191), fielding percentage (.977) and strikeouts pitched (360). Their 35-win season is also tied for the fourth-most wins in a single season in program history and the most since 2002.

Over the course of the 2023 season, the Atlantic 10 recognized George Mason 10 times in their weekly Pitcher/Player/Rookie of the Week awards, the most of any school in the conference that season.

Atlantic 10 Pitcher of the Year and First-Team All A-10 Team member Aly Rayle and First Team All A-10 member Nicole Bechtel were also nationally recognized as NFCA Pitcher (March 28) and Player of the Week (April 25), respectively. Being given national awards was also a first for Mason Softball.

Two other Patriots were awarded end of the season conference awards in the 2023 season. Second baseman Marlaina Bozek was named First Team All A-10, while third baseman Haley Taormina earned Second Team All A-10. Taormina, Rayle and Bechtel were also named to the NFCA's Mid-Atlantic All-Region Second team.

In the 2023 Atlantic 10 Conference Tournament, Walker and the fourth-seeded Patriots created even more history. Not only did they become the lowest seed to be crowned conference champion since 1990, but they were lowest-ever sole owner of the championship, as the 1990 tournament had co-champions.

The road to the A-10 trophy for the #4 Patriots meant beating #5 Fordham (the previous champions), #1 Saint Louis and #2 Loyola Chicago. Four Patriots were named to the All-Championship team for their exceptional play that week. The players named were Carly Cooper, Maddy Myers, Haley Taormina and Aly Rayle.

Rayle was also named Most Outstanding Player of the Tournament. She went 4-1 with a 1.06 ERA, striking out 39 batters in her 33 innings and allowed only two walks. Rayle pitched a gem of a first game against Fordham, striking out a record 18 batters en route to her complete game shutout victory.

Under the direction of Walker in 2021, the Patriots' pitching staff finished with the fewest hits surrendered in the Atlantic 10, second-fewest earned runs, third in team ERA (2.68) and opponent batting average (.254) and fourth in total shutouts (6). The Green & Gold also finished second in the conference in stolen bases (62) and fourth in fielding percentage (.964) last season.

During his first season as interim head coach, sophomore Rachel Warrens was named to the A-10 All-Conference Second Team and A-10 All-Rookie Team while junior EJ Bankson earned VaSID All-State honors. Senior pitcher Haellie Gordon was also named A-10 Pitcher of the Week (March 16) under Walker.

In the fall of 2023, George Mason and Coach Walker agreed to a contract extension that would last through the 2027-28 season.

Prior to his time with Mason softball, Walker spent four seasons with the baseball program.

As a member of Mason baseball, Walker was part of a coaching staff that brought an A-10 Championship to Fairfax in their inaugural season (2014) as members of the conference and the program's first conference title since 1992.

A native of Marengo, Ohio, Walker is a graduate of Rio Grande University in Ohio, where he earned his degree in sports and exercise studies with a minor in coach leadership.

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH CAMPBELL HUTCHERSON



Campbell Hutcherson was named as an assistant coach for the George Mason softball program in June 2022. Hutcherson will be entering her third season with the Patriots in the 2025 season.

On July 27, 2023, Campbell Hutcherson was promoted to associate head coach. She will enter her second season as associate head coach in the 2025 season as well.

Prior to her move to Fairfax, Va., Campbell spent this past year at the University of Virginia as a volunteer assistant coach. Hutcherson helped the Cavaliers finish with an overall record of 28-26, 13-11 in conference play. Virginia made a post season appearance in the National Invitational Softball Championship tournament in Fort Collins, Colorado.

A North Carolina native, Hutcherson spent the past five years (2017-21) playing first base at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

As a freshman (2017), Hutcherson was ranked seventh in the Atlantic Coast Conference in chances and putouts (297), ranking fifth in both categories during conference play. In addition, she helped UNC tie the single season record for double plays, turning 10, the third most by a freshman in school history.

In Hutcherson's junior campaign (2019), she contributed to 14 double plays, which ranked fifth in the UNC single season record book. Campbell helped the Tar Heels advance to the NCAA Regional Final against Ohio State with her single and RBI.

In 2020, Campbell led the Tar Heels in walks (11) for a team best on-base percentage (0.473). The senior turned six double plays in her 23 appearances before the season was cut short due to COVID-19.

During her five years in Chapel Hill, Campbell started in 172 of her 200 games played. The former first baseman finished her collegiate career with a 0.233 batting average in 305 at-bats, notching 71 hits, 13 doubles, six home runs, 43 RBI's and 49 runs scored. Hutcherson was named a Tar Heel Scholar-Athlete her senior year (2020) and was named to the ACC Academic Honor Roll twice (2019, 2020).

ASSISTANT COACH MARLAINA BOZEK



George Mason University softball head coach Justin Walker has named Marlaina Bozek as an assistant coach. Bozek will begin her first season with the Patriots in 2024-25.

“We are super excited that Marlaina is back at George Mason with our Patriot family. I’m looking forward to seeing her energy and passion on the field and watching her grow as a coach,” said Coach Walker.

Before stepping into her new role, Bozek was a four-year letter-winner for the Patriots with an impressive track record. As a senior in 2024, she earned the Atlantic 10 Player of the Week award, Easton/NFCA All-American Scholar-Athlete honors, and was recognized as a Peter N. Stearns Provost Scholar-Athlete.

She etched her name in the program’s All-Time Record Book, ranking ninth in stolen bases (32), 10th in career hits (166), and 11th in both games played (183) and games started (180). She also ranks 11th in career doubles (30).

A 2023 Atlantic 10 Tournament Champion, Bozek earned All-Conference First Team honors that season. She recorded career highs in several categories, including 10 doubles, three triples, one home run, 25 walks, 29 runs scored, 12 RBIs, and four sacrifice flies. Defensively, she posted a career-high .992 fielding percentage with 64 putouts, 60 assists, and only one error.

As a sophomore in 2022, Bozek earned VaSID All-State Second Team honors, was named to the Atlantic 10 All-Conference Second Team, and secured a spot on the NFCA Mid-Atlantic All-Region Second Team.

Associate Head Coach Campbell Hutcherson expressed excitement about Bozek’s return, stating, “We’re thrilled to welcome Mar to our staff! Her passion, drive, and dedication will be an incredible asset to our journey ahead. Her skills and energy will be a wonderful addition to our team. Mar’s playing experience in the A-10 Conference will play an integral role in helping us achieve our goals and uphold our standards. I’m looking forward to working alongside her!”
