'Dogs SEC, Rose Bowl Champions; earn first trip to CFP Championship Game

Following its only regular season loss (at Auburn), the Bulldogs began a remarkable run that ended in Georgia's first appearance in the College Football Playoff and the CFP championship game. The 'Dogs won the East for the first time since 2012 earning a spot in the SEC Championship game and a repeat encounter with Auburn. Georgia came out on top, 28-7 for its first league title since 2005. The win sent Georgia as the number 3 seed into the College Football Playoff and a semi-final clash with Oklahoms in the Rose Bowl--the Dogs' first appearance in Pasadena since 1943. After trailing 31-14, Georgia mounted a second half comeback sending the game into overtime before winning, 54-48, on a Sony Michel TD run. Next was the CFP championship game in Atlanta where the 'Dogs fell in another overtime to Alabama, 26-23.
