Bulldog Bytes

*The Georgia Bulldogs are 25-8 (5-7 SEC) under first-year Ike Cousins head coach **Wes Johnson**. Georgia is 20-1 at home this year. The lone defeat at Foley Field came to Michigan State on Feb. 28.

* The Missouri series begins Thursday at 7 pm on the SEC Network. Game two will be Friday at 6 p.m., and Saturday's contest is at 3:30 p.m. due to G-Day.

*Georgia is the nation's co-leader in home runs (89), sharing the top spot with Tennessee. The Bulldogs have a .634 slugging percentage (2nd nationally) and a .448 on base percentage (3rd nationally). The Bulldogs average 9.6 runs a game. In the MSU series, Georgia batted just .240 with three home runs and was outscored 17-12. Graduate **Clayton Chadwick's** ninth-inning home run proved to be the difference in a 3-2 Saturday win in front of a crowd of 13,477. Also, Georgia got 4.1 scoreless innings and eight strikeouts from graduate **Brian Zeldin** in the victory. This past Sunday, sophomore **Kolby Branch** tied a school record with his third grand slam of the season, and it was Georgia's eighth this year, which also tied a school mark. The Bulldogs had perfect fielding in the first two games before three errors Sunday aided MSU's 9-8 win to claim the series.

Bounce Back Dub: Georgia bounced back this past Tuesday with a 15-5 run-rule victory over Kennesaw State in eight innings here this past Tuesday. The Bulldogs collected 20 hits including five players with three hits apiece. **Charlie Condon** and **Kolby Branch** were part of this group, and they had home runs too.

Top Hitters To Watch: The Midseason Player of the Year according to D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game USA is Georgia redshirt sophomore infielder/outfielder **Charlie Condon**. He ranks among the national leaders in several offensive categories. He is batting .468 with an NCAA-best 21 home runs while tallying 44 RBI. Senior **Corey Collins** is next at .382-12-32. Freshman **Tre Phelps** has seen his average jump to .356 of late. He is enjoying a five-game stretch where he is batting .4524, going 11-for-21 with six RBI. The Tigers top hitters include sophomores Brock Daniels (.341-3-18) and Jackson Lovich (.307-6-21) plus senior Trevor Austin (.279-8-21),

***Series History:** The series with the Tigers began when they joined the SEC in 2013. It is tied at 15-15. Missouri swept Georgia last year 13-3, 14-12 and 5-4, and the Tigers won the series in Athens 2-1 in 2022. Georgia's last series win came 2021 in Columbia (2-1), and the last one in Athens came via sweep in 2019. In 2017, the final game of the series here was played at then SunTrust Park in Atlanta, which marked the first-ever game open to the public in the Atlanta Braves new field. A crowd of 33,025 saw the Tigers beat Georgia 6-1 to win the series. It was the second largest crowd in college baseball history.

***About Missouri:** The Tigers (15-19, 4-8 SEC) turned heads this past weekend by sweeping No. 4 Florida in Columbia, winning three one-run games. They won the opener 2-1 in 11 innings as the Gators were held to two hits, 4-3 in game two and 11-10 for the sweep. In game three, the Tigers built a 7-1 lead by the second inning, then the Gators rallied for a 10-8 lead in the eighth and then had the Tigers answer with a walk-off. The Tigers dropped a midweek affair with SIU-Edwardsville 5-4 before coming to Athens. Last year in Columbia, the Tigers swept the Bulldogs. The series with Missouri is all square at 15-15.

In SEC action, Georgia opened by getting swept at UK, who is tied for first place in the SEC with an 11-1 league mark. Georgia returned home and swept No. 8 Alabama. Then, Georgia went 1-2 at No. 5 UT and 1-2 at No. 19 MSU.

***Starting Rotation:** Georgia's rotation will feature sophomore left-hander **Jarvis Evans** (2-1, 4.50 ERA) on Thursday followed by sophomore right-hander **Leighton Finley** (2-1, 4.96 ERA) on Friday while Saturday's starter is TBA. Missouri's rotation is TBA. Evans has made nine appearances including five starts this year while all eight of Finley's outings have been starts.

FOLEY FIELD RENOVATION PROJECT UPDATE

The current \$45 million renovation of Foley Field will continue to elevate both the player and fan experience at UGA's baseball facility. The entire project is slated to be completed by the start of the 2025 season.

Improvements will be made along the left field line and will include a new pitching lab and hitting tunnels, coaches' office and other amenities. For the fans, there will be multiple new premium spaces as well as enhanced fan experiences throughout the venue. For 2024, the Bulldogs already have a new locker room and team meeting room plus new stadium LED lights.

Wes JOHNSON

Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach 1st Season at UGA (Arkansas Monticello '94)
RECORD: 25-8 (5-7 SEC)

Wes Johnson, the renowned pitching coach for LSU, was named the Ike Cousins head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 5, 2023.

A native of Sherwood, Ark., Johnson became the first pitching coach in Major League Baseball history to make the move directly from the college ranks to the big leagues when he was hired by the Minnesota Twins in November of 2018. He served as a collegiate pitching coach since 2008 with stints in the SEC at Mississippi State and Arkansas. Minnesota was the leading the American League Central in June of 2022 when he opted to return to college at LSU.

Johnson remained with the Tigers until their 2023 season was complete, culminating in their seventh national title. The Tigers made their first CWS since 2017 and won their first national title since 2009. LSU finished 54-17 and had a school record 13 players (eight pitchers) selected in the MLB Draft including the first (Paul Skenes, RHP, record \$9.2 million bonus/Pittsburgh Pirates) and second (Dylan Crews, OF) picks.

The Twins won their division in Johnson's first two years directing the pitching staff, and in 2020, the club ranked fourth in the Majors in ERA and WHIP. Kenta Maeda posted a 2.70 ERA and a 6-1 mark to earn a runner-up finish for the American League Cy Young Award.

During his time as a college coach, 38 of Johnson's pitchers have been drafted by MLB teams, and he has been at the forefront of utilizing technology.

As pitching coach at Arkansas, Johnson helped the 2018 Razorbacks reach the College World Series Finals as they finished 48-21. The top pitcher on that 2018 staff was Blaine Knight who went 14-0 with a 2.80 ERA and was a third-round pick of the Baltimore Orioles.

In his one season at Mississippi State, Johnson was instrumental in a dramatic turnaround by the Bulldogs going from worst to first. After winning only eight SEC games the previous year and having the highest ERA in the league, the 2016 club claimed the SEC regular-season title and advanced to an NCAA Super Regional. MSU won 44 games, its most since 1997.

In four seasons at Dallas Baptist University, Johnson helped the Patriots to three NCAA Regionals, had 14 pitchers drafted and his pitching staffs set single season records for almost every major statistical category.

Johnson earned a bachelor's degree in marketing from the University of Arkansas Monticello in 1994. He completed a master's degree in kinesiology in 2017. Johnson and his wife Angie, have three children: Ryan, Anna and Ava; and one grandson, Mason.

DID YOU KNOW?

The only SEC player to hit .500 in a season was Alabama's Dave Magadan in 1983 when he posted a .525 mark. Former Bulldog great Ronnie Braddock ranks second in SEC history with a .489 batting average in 1962. Magadan has the SEC career mark too at .439.

Currently, **Charlie Condon is batting .468 while his career average is .413**. He has 28 walks and 22 strikeouts on the year. Last year as a redshirt freshman, he hit .386-25-67 and was the consensus National Freshman of the Year.

C+C Hitting Factory

Formed in 1989, C+C Music Factory had hit singles like "Gonna Make You Sweat," "Here We Go and "Things That Make You Go Hmmm..." Now located in Athens and formed in 2023, there's "C+C Hitting Factory of **Charlie Condon** and **Corey Collins** that have pitchers sweating, fans barking and leading a team that produces mammoth home runs that make everybody go hmmm...and wow!

Condon, a 6-6, 216-pound infielder/outfielder, is a National Player of the Year candidate and the potential number one overall pick of the 2024 MLB Draft. In early April, he was named the Mid-Season Player of the Year by both D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game USA.

He has led the nation in as many as six categories during the 2024 season: Currently, he is batting .468 with 21 home runs and 44 RBI. He has 134 total bases with a 1.081 SLG% and a .573 OB%.

In game two of the No. 5 UT series, he went a career-best 5-for-6 with two home runs and three RBI. Since then, he went just 3-for-21 with one home run and two RBI in a five-game stretch, dropping his average to a mere .458. He bounced back this past Tuesday versus KSU, going 3-for-4 with a home run and two RBI.

This season, he has started all 33 games with 12 at third base, 10 in centerfield, five in left field, four in right field, and two at first base. Condon has a .990 fielding percentage in 97 total chances. He made his first error of the season last Sunday at No. 19 Miss. State while playing centerfield.

Condon has a team-high 28 walks including 12 intentional passes, and he has only 22 strikeouts. His exit velocity is routinely more than 100 mph and has been as high as 118. Against Stetson, his two-run home run measured a season-long 454 feet!

*Condon's only baseball offer coming out of high school was Georgia. He was a quarterback/punter and baseball player for The Walker School (K-12, approx. 900 students) in Marietta, Ga. He redshirted at Georgia in 2022. Recently, *Baseball America* rated him No. 1 overall while other outlets including MLB.com (#4 on MLB Draft 100) have him as a consensus top five pick.

Collins, a 6-3, 236-pound first baseman, is batting a team-best .395-7-15 in SEC action. He earned SEC Player of the Week honors on March 25 after batting an SEC best .647-6-13 in helping Georgia sweep #8 Alabama. In four games that week, he started off three contests with a home run.

Collins (.382-12-32) has 26 hits on the year and 12 are home runs! Currently, he has reached base in 21 straight games, which is the longest streak by a Bulldog this season.

Ain't Life Grand

Georgia hit six grand slams in one week (March 5-10), and it was done by five different players: **Slate Alford** (2), **Kolby Branch**, **Corey Collins**, **Dylan Goldstein** and **Fernando Gonzalez** each with one.

Branch had a walk-off grand slam to beat No. 8 Alabama for the team's seventh of the year. Then, Branch tied a school record with his third grand slam of the season, blasting one at No. 19 Miss. State on Apr. 7.

Georgia has tied the single season school record for Grand Slams with eight, also done by the 2019 club.

Another One

In the 18-6 win over Wofford on March 19th, Georgia blasted a season-high seven home runs including a school record-tying three by **Corey Collins** and two in the same inning by **Clayton Chadwick**.

A Really Big Team With Some Really Big Wins

Georgia has won big (nine by run-rule), lost big (two run-rules) and rallied twice in the ninth for comeback victories with two true Walk-Offs. Georgia has had 19 games when it scored double-digit runs, going 17-2 in those contests.

The most impressive comeback came at Coolray Field on March 3 as Georgia trailed Ga. Tech 9-3 going to the 7th and 9-8 in the 9th as the visitors. They rallied for an 11-9 series-clinching win in front of a crowd of 8,163.

YOU GUYS RANKED?

Georgia made its 2024 debut in the Top 25 rankings on March 11 at No. 25 in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association poll (NCBWA). This was the first ranking for the Bulldogs since 2022 when they were regulars in the polls, reaching as high as No. 5.

After getting swept at UK to open SEC play, Georgia fell out of the rankings. Following a sweep of #8 Alabama, Georgia returned to the Top 25 on March 18, checking at No. 22 in NCBWA and No. 24 in Baseball America and USA Today Coaches. During the week of Apr. 1, Georgia was No. 24 in the USA TODAY poll.

This week, the Bulldogs (are not ranked).

There are five national top 25 polls: *Baseball America*, *D1Baseball*, *NCWBA*, *Perfect Game* and *USA Today Coaches*.
