### No. 9 Georgia Hits The Road To Face Missouri

The ninth-ranked Georgia Bulldogs (36-11, 12-9 SEC) close out the season with three SEC series including the next two on the road. Starting Friday night, they face Missouri (13-31, 0-21 SEC) in Columbia and then go to No. 18 Alabama (May 9-11) before finishing with Texas A&M (May 15-17) at Foley Field. In year two of the **Wes Johnson** era, the Bulldogs have been a consensus top 10 ranked team all season and are ranked as high as No. 3 (Perfect Game) this week. This year, the Bulldogs are 27-3 at home, 6-8 on the road and 3-0 at neutral sites.

The Bulldogs, who have the No. 2 RPI by the NCAA, went 24-2 against non-conference teams during ther regular season following a 9-2 win over Kennesaw State this past Tuesday in Athens. The two losses outside the SEC came at UNC Wilmington on Feb. 16 and at No. 2 Clemson on Apr. 22. Prior to the KSU contest, Georgia had wrapped up an 11-game stretch against ranked opponents, going 5-6 and that included a season-long five-game losing streak. Georgia bounced back to win a series over No. 14 Oklahoma this past weekend in Athens. The rubber game of the series Saturday featured four home runs by the Bulldogs as part of a 6-3 victory. Georgia leads the nation with 113 home runs and is seventh in slugging percentage at .569.

Georgia leads the series with Missouri 17-16 as the programs have met every year (except 2020 due to COVID-19 pandemic) since the Tigers joined the SEC in 2013. The Tigers swept the Bulldogs in Columbia in 2023 while Georgia claimed the series last year 2-1 in Athens.

Missouri (13-31, 0-21 SEC) fell 9-3 at No. 25 Kansas (36-10) this past Tuesday as the Tigers have dropped their last eight contests. Game two of the Georgia-Missouri series on Saturday will be at 8 p.m. ET on the SEC Network. Games one and three will be available on SECN+.

### The Bats, The Pitching And The Gloves

The Bulldogs are batting .292 with a .569 slugging percentage and an NCAA-leading 113 home runs. They have a .421 on base percentage, been hit 102 times plus are 56-for-63 in stolen bases. The team's leading hitters are **Ryland Zaborowski** (.372-16-58, .822 SLG%), **Slate Alford** (.335-13-51) and **Robbie Burnett** (.316, SEC-leading 19 home runs plus 57 RBI). Earlier this year, Zaborowski was named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List, the NCBWA/Dick Howser Trophy National Hitter of the Month for March and a mid-season All-American by multiple outlets. The injury bug has limited Zaborowski of late as he missed the final two games of the Vanderbilt series due to his foot and then left last Saturday's game in the second inning due to an elbow injury on a throw home. He did not play Tuesday against Kennesaw State and is out for the series with the Tigers. Meanwhile, Burnett was the team's top hitter in the Commodore series, batting .417 (5-for-12) with two doubles, a home run and two RBI while Alford and Junior **Kolby Branch** (.311-10-29) were the team's top threats against No. 14 Oklahoma. Alford and Branch hit .417 in the series with four RBI. Alford has a team-best 30-game on base streak and has reached base in 46 of 47 games this season.

Missouri is batting .267 with a .420 slugging percentage and 43 home runs. The leading hitters for the Tigers are Jackson Lovich (.352-8-40) and Pierre Seals (.305-4-17).

The Bulldogs have posted a 4.92 ERA with 490 strikeouts and 215 walks. Opponents are batting .230 against Georgia. The Tigers have a 9.63 ERA with 351 strikeouts and 236 walks this season. Opponents are batting .327 against the Tigers with 74 home runs. Georgia's fielding percentage is .982 while Missouri is fielding .962.

#### **Bulldog Resume In 2025**

Last season in Coach Johnson's first year in Athens, the Bulldogs entered the NCAA Tournament with a No. 7 RPI, a 39-14 record including a 17-13 mark in the SEC. That was good enough for a No. 7 national seed, and the Bulldogs fell one game shy of advancing to the College World Series.

In 2025, Georgia enters the Missouri series with a No. 2 RPI, ranked as high as No. 3 in the polls plus a mark of 36-11. After 47 games, that's the second best record in school history. The best mark after 47 games belongs to Georgia's 1990 national champions as they were 39-8 at that point.



#### **FOLEY FIELD IN 2025**

The \$45 million renovation of Foley Field has continued to elevate both the player and fan experience at UGA's baseball facility, often referred to as the Wrigley Field of the SEC. Georgia has played here since 1966.

With an updated capacity of 3,633, the ballpark has a neighborhood feel that rivals any of its league counterparts in terms of fan experience and entertainment. Fans can feel like their right on top of the action with excellent sight lines throughout the facility. There's even a field level premium area behind home plate that stretches to each dugout.

The Player Development features include:

\*A new pitching lab and hitting tunnels with the latest technology

\*A weight room, nutrition station and coaches' office

\*The entire playing field along with foul territory now features a new AstroTurf surface.

\*The two-year project began in 2024 when the Bulldogs enjoyed a new locker room and team meeting room plus the facility added stadium LED lights.

Overall, fans have new seating options, enhanced experiences throughout the venues plus multiple new premium spaces. The stadium area is covered seating except for a new, small section down the third base line past the Bulldog dugout.

# Wes JOHNSON

Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach 1st Season at UGA (Arkansas Monticello '94) RECORD: 79-28 (29-22 SEC)

Wes Johnson is in his second season as the Ike Cousins head baseball coach at Georgia. He made an immediate impact in

vear one.

At the baseball press conference announcing his hire in June of 2023, UGA's J. Reid Parker Director of Athletic Josh Brooks noted Johnson had a proven track record of developing student-athletes and that his teams at every level had achieved impressive results. Brooks added he was confident Johnson would make Georgia Baseball one of the premier programs in the country.

Johnson directed the Bulldogs to their most successful season since reaching the College World Series (CWS) Finals in 2008. The 2024 Bulldogs earned a No. 7 National Seed for the NCAA Championships, captured the NCAA Athens Regional, hosted an NCAA Super Regional and came within one game of reaching the CWS.

In 2024, Georgia posted a 43-17 record (17-13 SEC) as Johnson established school records for most overall wins and most SEC wins by a first-year baseball coach, and Georgia finished with a top 10 national ranking for the first time in a full season since 2008. He became the first Georgia baseball coach to host and win an NCAA Regional in his first season along with serving as a Super Regional host. In a preseason poll, SEC coaches projected Georgia would finish sixth in the Eastern Division and instead the Bulldogs placed third and had the fifth best mark in the 14-team league.

In 2024, Georgia featured one of the nation's elite players in All-American Charlie Condon. He earned the Dick Howser Trophy, which is widely considered the Heisman Trophy of college baseball, and USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award as the nation's top amateur player. Also, Condon took home the Bobby Bragan National Collegiate Slugger Award. At the end of the season, sophomore Kolten Smith and freshman All-American Tre Phelps received invitations to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team Training Camp. Corey Collins joined Condon as an All-American and became the first SEC player to lead the NCAA in on base percentage, posting a .574 mark.

#### **Review Of The 2025 SEC Series**

Week 1: #4 Georgia vs. #23 Kentucky (UGA 2-1): The Wildcats arrived in Athens with the nation's second best ERA at 1.89 ERA , 143 strikeouts and only 47 walks while holding opponents to a mere .175 batting average. UK had allowed just three home runs. When the dust settled at Foley Field, Georgia claimed the series 2-1 by batting .330 with 11 home runs and a .493 OB%, featuring 23 walks and 11 hit-by-pitches. Meanwhile, Georgia's pitching has plenty of room to improve as no starter made it past the second inning, and the Bulldogs trailed in every game including 3-0 twice before coming to bat. Overall, UK scored 26 runs on 27 hits with 20 walks, 12 hit-by-pitches and eight wild pitches. Georgia did post perfect fielding while UK made five errors.

Week 2: #4 Georgia @ #13 Florida (UGA 3-0): Georgia posted its first road sweep of Florida since 2006. UF was 15-1 at home, and the Bulldogs held them to 13 runs in the series while the Bulldogs slugged 13 home runs and outscored the Gators 40-13. Georgia batted .342 with a .775 SLG%, posted a 4.68 ERA and fielded .990 (one error) in the series. After UF took an 7-6 lead in the bottom of the eighth of game one, Ryland Zaborowski smashed a one-out, two-run home run and Kolten Smith registered a save for an 8-7 win. Games two and three were never close as Georgia won 17-2 and 15-4 (7 inn./run-rule) as the Bulldogs got quality starts from Brian Curley and Leighton Finely, each going five innings. UF hadn't been swept at home since 2022 (UT).

Week 3: #3 Georgia vs. #11 Auburn (UGA 3-0): The Bulldogs swept No. 11 Auburn in a span of a little more than 24 hours. In game one, Georgia got two-run home runs from Devin Obee and Daniel Jackson plus five shutout innings and eight strikeouts from Kolten Smith in relief of Charlie Goldstein to post a 4-1 win. With inclement weather forecasted for Sunday, the teams concluded the series with a Saturday doubleheader. The Bulldogs built a 6-1 lead only to have Auburn tie it up with a five-run outburst in the sixth inning. Georgia answered with a four-spot in the bottom of the sixth, highlighted by a go-ahead three-run blast by Christian Adams. JT Quinn provided three innings of relief for a save in an 11-7 series-clinching victory. In the finalé, Georgia took a 4-3 lead to the ninth, and the Tigers forced extra innings, and then hit a two-run home run to go up 6-4 in the 10th. Georgia responded with a five-spot including a three-run walk-off home run by Jackson for a 9-6 win and another sweep!

Week 4: #3 Georgia @ #5 Texas (UT 3-0): After two straight sweeps of ranked teams, the Bulldogs were swept by No. 5 Texas in Austin. It was a matchup of elite hitting versus elite pitching, and as is the case most of the time in baseball, pitching trumped hitting. Georgia's high-powered offense was held to eight runs including three solo home runs. The Bulldogs batted .156 (15-for-96) with 38 strikeouts and 10 walks. UT hit just .211 but tallied five home runs (four two-run blasts and one solo walk-off) and drew 20 walks. UT's staff carded a 2.25 ERA with only 10 walks. Both teams made only one error in the series. Game one saw UT win 5-1 behind Jared Spencer's 11Ks in 7.2 innings. Georgia's lone run was a solo shot by Nolan McCarthy. Georgia looked to be in good shape in game two, carrying a 4-2 lead to the seventh before the bullpen allowed a fivespot in a 7-4 loss. Game three was a tight battle with three lead changes and ended on a 10th-inning walk-off solo home run by Rylan Galvan.

Week 5: #7 Georgia vs. #1 Arkansas (UGA 2-1): Game one was 3-all going to the seventh when top-ranked Arkansas scored 10 runs over the final three frames including a seven-run ninth to take the opener 13-3. In game two, Georgia jumped ahead 3-0 in the first and built a 7-3 lead through six as Robbie Burnett and Ryland Zaborowski each homered and combined to drive in five runs. However, Arkansas closed the gap to 7-6 in the ninth and had the tying run at second with nobody out. Matthew Hoskins notched his second save to even the series. In the rubber game, Georgia had a 5-3 lead going to the ninth only to see UA blast a pair of solo home runs including one with two outs. In the 11th, UA took a 6-5 lead and Georgia responded with a two-out RBI-double from Tre Phelps to send it to the 12th. With two outs, left-handed hitting catcher Henry Hunter blasted a solo shot off lefty Cole Gibler for a series-clinching walk-off home run. It was Georgia's first series win over a No. 1 team since 2021 against Vanderbilt in Nashville and the first at Foley Field in Athens since 1993 against Miss. State.

Week 6: #5 Georgia @ #19 Vanderbilt (VU 3-0): VU's pitching staff held the Bulldogs to a .170 average (17-for-95) in the series as the Bulldogs were outscored 21-10 and struck out 40 times. VU hit .305 and outhomered Georgia six to five. Left-hander JD Thompson threw 120 pitches and struck out a career-high 14 over eight innings to lead #19 VU to a 3-1 win in the opener. VU clinched the series with a 13-7 win in game two, hitting four home runs as part of a 13-hit attack. Six of Georgia's seven runs came on three-run homers by Daniel Jackson and Brennan Hudson. The Commodores completed a sweep with a 5-2 victory with more timely hitting and another stellar pitching performance by a starter. Connor Fennell struck out 11 in seven innings. The last three series between the Bulldogs and Commodores have been sweeps by the home team.

Week 7: #10 Georgia vs. #14 Oklahoma (UGA 2-1): For the second time this season, Georgia dropped game one only to come back and win the series. OU ace Kyson Witherspoon led the Sooners to an 8-6 win as the Bulldogs scored four late runs to make it close only to drop their fifth straight. Georgia snapped out of it in game two, holding on for a 10-9 victory to set up a rubber game. The Bulldogs smashed four home runs, two by Kolby Branch, that keyed a 6-3 win. The Bulldogs hit just .247 in the series, outhomered OU 7-2 and outscored them 22-20. The bullpen notched both victories and Tyler McLoughlin became the seventh different Bulldog with a save this year as he pitched the final 1.2 innings to secure the series.

### Points To Ponder On The 2025 Bulldogs

\*Sizzling Start: Currently, the Bulldogs are enjoying one of their finest season in school history with a 36-11 mark. Last year at this point, Georgia was 35-12.

\*Georgia had a 17-game winning streak this year which was the longest in the modern era of Bulldog baseball. The only longer streak belongs to the 1908 squad that finished a perfect 20-0 against collegiate competition to win the Southern Championship. They did lose a pair of exhibition games that year against professional teams.

\*Fifteen different position players have started a game for the Bulldogs with two starting all 47 this season: Infielders Slate Alford and Kolby Branch.

\*Twenty-one pitchers have seen action, 13 have at least one win, and the innings leaders are junior Leighton Finley (2-1, 5.40 ERA) with 45 followed by junior BrianCurley (2-2, 3.43 ERA, 2 SV) with 44.2.

\*Seven Bulldogs have a save: Curley (2-2, 3.43 ERA, 2 SV), Matt Hoskins (1-1, 3.91 ERA), DJ Radtke (4-0, 4.37 ERA, 2 SV), Jordan Stephens (4-0, 3.32 ERA, 3 SV), JT Quinn (0-1, 2.57 ERA, 1 SV), Kolten Smith (3-2, 5.23 ERA) and Tyler Mc-Loughlin (4-0, 3.44 ERA).

\*The Bulldogs began the game against UIC on Feb. 23 with a "Team Cycle." Ryan Black led off with a Single; Slate Alford smashed a Double; Robbie Burnett followed with a two-run game-tying Triple; and Daniel Jackson cranked a two-run Home Run for a 4-2 lead in an eventual 17-3 rout.

\*Twice this season the bullpen provided 7.2 scoreless innings and allowed just one hit in a game. The first time came in a 6-2 road loss to UNCW and then in a 7-3 road win over Ga. State.

\*Georgia's five walk-off wins (plus five via a run-rule in the seventh) have come on a fielder's choice/E3; a sacrifice fly, and thrice on a home run. Ryan Black provided a two-run walk-off homer to cap the series sweep of Florida Gulf Coast. Then in the next game, he led off the High Point contest with a home run! Daniel Jackson smacked a three-run walk-off homer in the 10th inning to cap a sweep of #11 Auburn. Henry Hunter provided a solo shot for a series-clinching walk-off against #1 Arkansas.

\*The Bulldogs gave up a nine-spot in the third inning against Ga. State on March 5 to fall behind 9-5, and then claimed the lead by the fourth inning following a three-run home run by Ryland Zaborowski that made it 11-9. Georgia would go on to win 16-10 for its 12th straight victory.

\*Georgia ranks among the top defensive teams nationally with a .982 fielding percentage. In school history, the top three fielding marks have been .981 (2023), .980 (2019) and .979 (2018).

\*The Bulldogs have more speed this season, registering 56 stolen bases in 63 attempts. Last year, Georgia finished with 22 SB in 60 games. The school record is 101 in 46 games by the 1980 team.

\*In 2024, Georgia hit a school record 151 home runs in 60 games for an average of 2.52 a game. This season, the Bulldogs have an NCAA-leading 113 home runs, which is 2.40 a game.

\*Have a Week: Robbie Burnett earned SEC Player of the Week honors after a monster series against #23 UK (.667 BA, 8R, 2HR, 9 RBI) to open league action. In mid-March, Ryland Zaborowski was named the NCBWA Dick Howser Trophy National Hitter of the Week and SEC Co-Player of the Week by the league office. In a four-game stretch, he batted .438 with one double, six home runs and 18 RBI. In the sweep of the Gators in late March, Florida native Christian Adams (.318-4-16) posted a 1.429 slugging percentage, batted .571 (8-for-14), tallied three doubles, three home runs and seven RBI.
