LAST TIME OUT (L 79-52 at South Alabama)

South Alabama women's basketball hit eight first-half three-pointers to build a 51-24 halftime lead, going on to notch a 79-52 Sun Belt Conference victory over visiting Georgia Southern on New Year's Eve.

The Jaguars (9-4, 2-0 SBC) picked up their fourth win out of their last five contests, while Georgia Southern (3-10, 0-2 SBC) dropped its seventh straight contest.

The two teams traded three-pointers to open up the contest, with Nakol Franks knocking down her team-leading 21st of the season, but South Alabama embarked on an 18-0 run over a four and a half minute stretch to take a 21-3 lead with 5:10 left in the first quarter.

Hailey Dias-Allen scored eight of her career-high 12 points in the first quarter as the Eagles closed the gap to 32-15 at the end of the first quarter. Each team scored just five points in the first five minutes of the second quarter, but South Alabama ended the half on a 14-4 run to take a 51-24 lead at the break. The Eagles and the Jaguars matched each other with 28 second-half points as USA held on for the victory.

Dias-Allen was the only Eagle player to notch double figures with her 12 points, while Nakol Franks had nine points on 2-of-5 shooting from three-point range and 3-of-4 shooting from the foul line.

ABOUT THE RED WOLVES

Arkansas State is 6-7 overall and 1-1 in the Sun Belt Conference coming into tonight's contest against the Eagles. Starting the season with a 93-51 loss at Indiana, Arkansas State has alternated wins and losses ever since, splitting its season-opening weekend of Sun Belt action with a 76-62 win over UL Monroe on Friday, then suffering a 77-75 loss to Louisiana on Sunday.

Arkansas State is led by Akasha Westbrook's 13 points per game and Jada Ford's 10.4 points per game. The Red Wolves have a couple of signature non-conference wins so far this year, beating Florida, 70-69, at Florida as well as UTEP, 76-73.

Arkansas State leads the overall series between the two teams, 6-1, and won both meetings last year, including a 61-54 win in the first round of the Sun Belt Conference tournament in New Orleans.

ABOUT THE TROJANS

Little Rock played one of the most grueling non-conference schedules among any Sun Belt school, and it paid off for the Trojans as the team won both of its conference contests over the weekend, drilling Louisiana, 78-43, and beating UL Monroe, 57-37, to begin the year 2-0 in the league. The Trojans' current schedule strength is 64th among all NCAA Division I schools according to the latest RPI ratings and tops among Sun Belt schools.

Little Rock is one of the top defensive teams in the Sun Belt, giving up just 58.2 points per game, second only to Texas State (57.7) in the league. The Trojans gave up just 40 points in their first two Sun Belt games, following up on last year, when Little Rock averaged giving up just 53.9 points per game in league play.

Ronjanae and Raeyana DeGray lead the Trojans offensively, with Ronjanae averaging 11.8 points per game while shooting 52 percent from the field. Raeyana is averaging 9.4 points per game.

Little Rock leads the overall series between the two teams, 5-0, and won last year's meeting, 57-41, in Arkansas.

ONE BAD QUARTER

One of the keys to this season's results has been that the Eagles have had trouble avoiding the one bad quarter that, in many ways, tips the scales in one direction or another. The Eagles have had at least one quarter of scoring nine or fewer points in 10 of 13 games this season, and Georgia Southern in 1-9 in those games. In the other two wins - at South Carolina State and against Thomas - Georgia Southern was able to score double digits in each quarter. The Dec. 21 loss to Stony Brook was the first time this year that the Eagles reached double digits in each quarter and lost, however in both first-half quarters, GS scored just 10 points. The only game in which the Eagles won while putting up a single-digit quarter was against Coastal Georgia, where the team scored just eight points in the third quarter, but rallied from a double-digit deficit to score 23 fourth-quarter points and earn the victory.

NEW YEAR, NEW OPPORTUNITIES

Heading into the first game of 2018, the Eagles are in quite the familiar territory. At this point last season, Georgia Southern was 4-8 before the Eagles put together a 9-9 mark in Sun Belt competition, finishing sixth in the league standings. Sitting at 3-10 and staring at a seven-game losing streak, the Eagles are ready to put together a repeat performance of last year's successes in the league. Georgia Southern dropped its first three league games last year before finishing the season 9-6 - and it was the game against Troy on Jan. 7 that Head Coach Kip Drown credited as the turnaround point for the Eagles in 2016-17. Starting with last Thursday's game at Troy, the Eagles face four teams picked to finish in the top seven of the Sun Belt to start the 2017-18 league slate.

TAKING THE LEAD

Eight different Eagles have been the leading scorer in Georgia Southern's 13 games so far in 2017-18, showing the balance that head coach Kip Drown talked about at the beginning of the season. Nakol Franks has been the leading scorer in the most games (six) and has the top scoring output so far this year with her 20 points vs. Kennesaw State on Dec. 15. Rhein Beamon has led three times, with Alexis Foulks twice and Hailey Dias-Allen twice. Sarah Moore, Sierra Butler, Alexis Brown and Trellanie English-Lurry have been the leading scorer for the Eagles once this season.

FINDING A SCORER

The Eagles are close to one-half of the way through their 2017-18 schedule, and Georgia Southern has not been able to find a consistent scorer to help lead things offensively so far. The Eagles' leading scorer is sophomore Nakol Franks (8.3 ppg), and even though she has five double-digit scoring games this season, she had just two points in the season-opener at NC A&T and in the Eagles' Dec. 21 game against Stony Brook, while failing to score a point in the loss at UCF. In the 44-year history of Georgia Southern women's basketball, the Eagles have never gone an entire season without at least one player averaging double figures - the lowest scoring average to lead the team was Meredyth Frye's 10.4 points per game during the 2011-12 campaign.

THE EXPERIENCE FACTOR

One of the key things for head coach Kip Drown about his 2017-18 squad has been the experience of his returners. The Eagles lost a lot of minutes from last season's squad, and heading into this season, the amount of minutes played by his 10 returners will play a big part into the early season success.

This season, the 10 returners for Coach Drown played 6,113 total minutes, or roughly 30 games of collegiate experience. Compare that to last season's squad, who returned the same number of players (10), but who came into the year with 9,716 minutes of experience, or nearly 50 games of collegiate experience. Every minute played by the young Georgia Southern squad will be crucial in this early season schedule.

HALFTIME ADJUSTMENTS

The Eagles have struggled coming out of halftime through their 13 games this season - Georgia Southern has scored just 162 total points in the third quarter (12.5 points per) and has had four sub-10 point quarters, while its opponents have scored 242 points in the third quarter (18.6 points per). Twice out of 10 games all season have the Eagles have outscored an opponent in the third quarter (vs. Thomas, vs. Kennesaw State), but in the fourth quarter, Georgia Southern has outscored five of its 13 opponents - Mercer, Coastal Georgia, Thomas, South Carolina State and IUPUI.

GROWING UP IN A HURRY

With nine of 14 players on the roster this season either sophomores or freshmen for the Eagles, opportunities have arisen for the underclassmen to make contributions early on. Freshman Tatum Barber did just that on Nov. 21, hitting three free throws with 0.4 seconds left to give Georgia Southern a 61-58 win at South Carolina State. On Nov. 27 against Thomas, freshman Sarah Moore registered 12 points and eight rebounds in the 79-51 win - after she had gone the first five games of the season without a point and only one rebound. Sophomore Hailey Dias-Allen notched back-to-back double-digit scoring games in the Eagles' Sun Belt-opening trip to Alabama, notching a career-high 12 points in Sunday's game at South Alabama.

ALL ABOUT THE THREE

In 2016-17, the Georgia Southern women's basketball team set a new school record by hitting 220 three-pointers, blasting past the previous school record of 192 threes, set during the 2010-11 season. The Eagles returned three

players for 2017-18 who hit 20 or more threes - Alexis Brown, who led the Sun Belt in three-point percentage at 47.6 percent (30-of-63); Nakol Franks (26) and Alexis Foulks (22).

In their season-opener at North Carolina A&T, however, the Eagles uncharacteristically misfired from long range, hitting just 2-of-21 threes (9.5 percent) - the worst three-point shooting performance for the Eagles since they hit just 2-of-22 threes (9.1 percent) at the University of Georgia on Nov. 24, 2015.

Against Kennesaw State on Dec. 18, the Eagles had their best three-point shooting performance of the season, hitting 6-of-11 shots from beyond the arc (54.5%). Thirteen games into the season, the Eagles are averaging 5.2 three-pointers per game, well below last season's average of 7.3 per game.

EAGLES IN THE SUN BELT AND NATIONAL RANKINGS

Georgia Southern has been one of the best teams in the league and in the nation in not sending opponents to the free throw line. The Eagles are tops in the Sun Belt in fewest fouls (197) and fouls per game (15.2), resulting in opponents shooting just 15.9 free throws per game. The Eagles have struggled from the field, with their 31.7 field goal percentage ranking 12th in the Sun Belt and 345th among 345 teams in NCAA Division I.

HOME SWEET HOME

Georgia Southern women's basketball had a solid season in the friendly confines of Hanner Fieldhouse in 2016-17, sporting an 8-6 record at home. It was the best home record for the Eagles since the 2010-11 season, when Georgia Southern went 10-3 at home. This season, the Eagles will play 16 games at home, and host five teams that advanced to postseason play last year (Alabama, IUPUI, Texas State, UT Arlington and Troy).

STOPPING THE SLIDE

The current seven-game losing streak for Georgia Southern is the longest since an eight-game slide for the Eagles at the end of the 2015-16 regular season. This current seven-game losing streak, however, has come in unfamiliar territory as the Eagles have dropped four of the seven at home. The last time Georgia Southern lost four straight games at home came during the 2014-15 season, when the Eagles under then-head coach Chris Vozab lost eight straight at home from Jan. 29 through March 5, 2015.

CONFERENCE TURNAROUND

Head Coach Kip Drown's Eagles had a tremendous turnaround in conference play from his first season in Statesboro to the second. Coach Drown's first season with the Eagles, Georgia Southern went 4-16 in the Sun Belt and finished 11th out of 11 teams. In his second season in 2016-17, the Eagles went 9-9 and finished sixth out of 12 teams. The five-game improvement from his first season to the second was the best jump in league play for Georgia Southern women's basketball since 2007-08, when the Eagles went 13-5 in the Southern Conference, a year after going 7-11 in the league. If the Eagles are able to pull off another five-game improvement in league play in 2017-18, the resulting 14-4 mark would be the best league mark for Georgia Southern in nearly two decades. The Eagles were 15-3 in the Southern Conference during the 2000-01 season.

EAGLES PICKED 10TH IN SUN BELT PRESEASON POLL

The Georgia Southern women's basketball squad has been picked to finish 10th in the Sun Belt, according to the 2017-18 Preseason Coaches' Poll released in November

The Eagles compiled a 13-17 overall record in Head Coach Kip Drown's second season at the helm of the GS Women's Basketball program in 2016-17, but fashioned a 9-9 Sun Belt mark to finish sixth in the league standings.

The Eagles did not have a representative on the preseason All-Conference teams.

HEAD COACH DROWN

Head Coach • Third Season

Springfield, MO • Southwest Missouri (1977)

Kip Drown begins his third season at the helm of the Georgia Southern women's basketball program. Introduced as the seventh head women's basketball coach in Georgia Southern history on March 31, 2015 by Athletic Director Tom Kleinlein, Drown enters his 30th season as a collegiate head coach, and his third for the Eagles, heading into the 2017-18 campaign.

Drown and the Eagles showed marked improvement in his second season in Statesboro, going 13-17 overall and 9-9 in the Sun Belt Conference - improvements of six overall and five league wins from his first season in 2015-16. The nine league wins were the most for an Eagle women's basketball team since the 2010-11 season. Georgia Southern earned the sixth seed in the Sun Belt tournament and made its first appearance in the league's postseason. Seniors Patrice Butler and Angel McGowan each earned All-Conference honors on the year and the team enjoyed the friendly confines of Hanner Fieldhouse, going 8-6 on the season at home.

In his first season in Statesboro in 2015-16, Drown's team doubled its Sun Belt Conference win total from the previous year, going 7-22 overall and 4-16 in league action including wins over rivals Georgia State and Appalachian State. Drown's Eagles went 1-1 in overtime games and had eight of their conference losses decide by 10 or fewer points, including five by five or fewer points.

Prior to Georgia Southern, Drown was one of the most successful coaches in the history of the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) as well as NCAA Division II. He departed the Division II ranks 15th amongst active coaches at that level for wins and is currently 38th all-time in NCAA Division II for wins.

Drown led the ThunderWolves of CSU-Pueblo to an overall record of 195-100 (.661) during his tenure which included four RMAC championships (2006, 2008, 2009, and 2010) as well as the 2007 RMAC Western Division crown. Drown also led the program to its first seven NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances (2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2012, 2014 and 2015).

Prior to his successful run in Pueblo, Colo., Drown coached for four seasons at NCAA Division II institution Grand Canyon University where he went 40-69 (.367). While at the helm of the Antelopes' program, Drown led the program back to a winning record (16-12) during his third season (2003-04) as well as a bid into the NCAA Division II Tournament. In just four years, he took the team from only four wins in the year before he arrived to a 16-12 record in 2003-04, earning California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Coach of the Year Honors for his efforts.

Before heading out west, Drown was the head women's basketball coach at then NAIA program Georgia Southwestern State in Americus, Ga. In his seven years as the head skipper of the Hurricanes he posted a record of 151-70 (.683) and took five of his teams to the NAIA National Tournament. His teams were also frequently ranked in the nation's top-25.

In five of his seven seasons in Americus, Drown's teams posted at least 20 wins including his last four seasons when the 'Canes went 92-40 (.697). Drown and the Hurricanes won the Great American Conference (GAC) championship

three times in 1996, 1998 and 1999 and were conference finalists in 1995 and 1997.

Drown began his collegiate head coaching career at Southwest Baptist University in Bolivar, Mo. There, he completed his first turnaround of a program as he turned the Bearcats into proven winners as he helped with the growing pains associated with making the jump from NAIA to NCAA Division II. In six seasons in Bolivar, Drown's teams went 77-87 (.470) including 47-35 (.573) over his last three years with the program. In 2001, his team earned the school's first-ever weekly national ranking (11th).

Before becoming a successful collegiate women's coach, Drown coached varsity high school boy's basketball in his home state of Missouri for five years, ending his time with an overall record of 97-38 (.719) between Licking High School (1979-83) and Rock Bridge High School (1983-84). His 1981-82 Licking HS squad posted a 24-game winning streak and claimed three tournament titles. The following year, his team finished second in the AA - Missouri State Tournament.

Drown earned his bachelor's (1977) and master's (1981) degrees from Southwest Missouri State University.

Drown's wife Gina is a native of Dublin, Ga. Together they have five children - Christie, Cassie, Kyle, Ashlee (a graduate of Georgia Southern) and Laura - as well as nine grandchildren. Gina and Kip reside in Statesboro.
