### PROBABLE STARTERS

*Season: 4.9 ppg, 1.1 rpg, 1.5 apg • Last: 3 pts • Made first career start at Troy Jan. 17 and has started last 2 games • Has scored in double figures twice • Has led team in assists twice • Minnesota Mr. Basketball finalist as a senior at Delano • Averaged 31.9 points, 9.6 rebounds, 8.1 assists and 3.6 steals while leading the Tigers to the first state title in school history • Scored 19 in the championship contest and sealed the win with two free throws late to earn Tournament Most Outstanding Player Honors • Played football for the first time in the fall of his senior season and caught 52 passes for 1,251 yards and 13 touchdowns to earn all-state honors.*

*Season: 17.1 ppg, 3.8 reb, 4.9 apg • Last: 26 pts, 3 ast, 2 reb • Named to Lou Henson Award Watch List for Mid-Major Player of the Year • Ranks 7th among active career scoring leaders in NCAA Division I • Scored his 2,000th point at Troy Jan. 17 • 3-time first-team All-Sun Belt, one of 17 in league history and none have earned first-team accolades all four years • Georgia Southern's all-time leading scorer in the Division I era • 7th on the Sun Belt career scoring list • Already the school's leader in career free throws and free throw attempts • Has led the team in assists in 85 career games • Scored in double figures in 100 career games and netted 20-plus points 49 times and 30-plus five times • Led the Eagles in scoring in 61 career games • 111 career starts • Sister, Alexis, is a junior on the GS women's team; the duo have combined for 2,760 career points, the highest total for an active brother-sister combo in Division I basketball.*

## HEAD COACH MARK BYINGTON

► Named Georgia Southern's 13th head men's basketball coach April 1, 2013.

► Signed extension in February of 2018 that will keep him at GS through 2022.

► Has led the Eagles to three top-3 finishes in their four seasons in the Sun Belt.

► His 90 wins in his first five seasons is the most for any coach in the school's Division I era.

► Led the Eagles to a 22-9 mark, a second-place finish in the Sun Belt and the Sun Belt Championship title game in 2014-15. It was the first 20-win season since 2005-06 and the Eagles' first conference championship game appearance since 1992.

► Won the 2015 Whack Hyder Georgia College Coach of the Year Award, joining his mentor Bobby Cremins, and former Eagle coaches Jeff Price and Frank Kerns as recipients.

► Named National Association of Basketball Coaches District 24 Coach of the Year and chosen by NBC Sports as the Sun Belt Coach of the Year.

► Earned his 50th career victory when the Eagles topped ULM 66-51 Jan. 16, 2016.

► Every senior has graduated since Byington joined the Eagles in the spring of 2013.

► Joined the Eagles after a one-year stint at Virginia Tech in 2012-13.

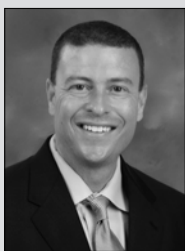
► Coached seven seasons at College of Charleston under legendary coach Bobby Cremins.

► Was named Interim Head Coach at College of Charleston in 2012 for the final 11 games of the season. Earned a 7-4 record over that span, including a victory over Kent State in an ESPN Bracketbusters Game.

► Coached NBA Draft Picks Erick Green (Virginia Tech) and Andrew Goudelock (College of Charleston).

► Played collegiately at UNC Wilmington, scoring more than 1,000 career points while earning All-CAA Honors and a spot on the All-CAA Defensive Team as a senior.

► Named Virginia High School Player of the Year in 1994 as a senior at Salem High School in Salem, Va.

## SETTING THE SCENE

• Georgia Southern returns to Hanner Fieldhouse for a two-game stretch, starting Thursday when the Eagles play host to UTA at 7 p.m. on ESPN+.

• **Promotions:** Blue Out, GATA Game and Student Appreciation Night - Georgia National Guard, Moe's and Dominos will all hand out food and other promotional items!

• It's the second of two meetings against UTA this season. GS won the first contest 77-64 Jan. 5 in the College Park Center. It was the Eagles' first win in the building.

• The Eagles are 4-1 in their last five and coming off an 88-86 overtime win at South Alabama last Saturday.

• Tookie Brown will be honored and given the game ball from UCF Dec. 11 prior to the contest. Brown scored 20 against the Knights to become the Eagles' Division I career scoring leader. He netted 19 at Troy Jan. 17 to surpass 2,000 career points.

• Brown ranks seventh on the Sun Belt career scoring list and seventh on the NCAA active career scoring list.

• Senior Montae Glenn collected 13 rebounds at South Alabama to become the 12th Eagle to reach 600 career carroms.

• Georgia Southern has trailed by double digits in seven of its last nine contests and came back to win three of those games. The Eagles have come back from double-digit deficits to win five contests this season.

• Georgia Southern is 55-20 in Hanner Fieldhouse in five-plus years under Mark Byington and 30-10 in Sun Belt games. The Eagles are 5-2 in Hanner this season.

• GS ranks eighth in the country in field goal percentage (.503) and 11th in scoring, averaging 85.4 points a game. The Eagles have scored 80-plus 12 times, 90-plus five times and over 100 twice.

• GS ranks 39th in the nation and first in the Sun Belt in turnover margin (+3.2), 17th in the NCAA in turnovers forced (17.3) and 36th in steals (8.2).

• GS finished the non-conference portion of its schedule with an 8-5 record. The slate is rated the 36th most difficult in the country in the latest edition of the NCAA Net (through games Jan. 17), making it the most difficult in the Sun Belt.

• Georgia Southern has finished in the top-3 in three of their four plus seasons in the Sun Belt and has 50 conference victories, the fourth-most since 2014. The Eagles joined Louisiana and UTA as the only three Sun Belt schools to reach double-digit conference wins in each of the last four seasons.

• Tookie Brown has been named to the Lou Henson Award Midseason Watch List. The award is given to the Mid-Major Basketball Player of the Year at the Final Four.

• Brown was named first-team All-Sun Belt and first-team All-District for the third consecutive season last year. He is the 17th player in the 43-year history of the Sun Belt to earn first-team accolades in three seasons and became the first Eagle to accomplish the feat in Georgia Southern history.

• Injuries have kept Georgia Southern from having its full roster available for any game this season, and three opening day starters have missed a combined 14 contests. GS has used eight different starting lineups.

• UTA has won four in a row since falling to the Eagles Jan. 5 and is the hottest team in the league along with Texas State. The Mavericks are coming off an 82-73 home win over Little Rock Saturday.

• The Mavs and Eagles are tied for second in the league standings.

• UTA is 3-7 on the road this season and 2-0 in Sun Belt road games.

## TEAM STORYLINES

• The Eagles have won five games this season in which they trailed by double digits during the contest (George Mason -22, Pepperdine -11, Bradley -13, UTA -10, 14 - ULM).

• Eight GS games have been decided by five points or less this season, and the Eagles are 4-4 in those contests.

• The Eagles are averaging 46.3 points and shooting 52.4 percent in the second half of games.

• GS shot 50 percent or better in its first five games this season and have shot 50 percent or better in 10 contests for the first time since the 2006-07 season. The Eagles have shot 60 percent or better in a half nine times, 70 percent or better twice and shot 77.8 percent in the second half against George Mason, the highest since making 80.8 percent in the second half against UIC Nov. 28, 2005. The Eagles shot 61 percent for the game at Troy Jan. 17, their highest against a Division I opponent since the aforementioned 89-69 win over UIC in Hanner Fieldhouse. GS shot 50 percent or better in four games all of last season.

• Since joining the Sun Belt in 2014, 39 Georgia Southern games against Sun Belt schools have been decided by five points or less, and the Eagles are 24-15.

• The Eagles are 33-7 in Sun Belt games when leading at halftime. GS is 41-4 when leading with five minutes to go.

• The Eagles are averaging 21.2 3-point attempts and 6.8 makes this year. They have made 10 or more five times this season. Georgia Southern's top-5 seasons in 3-pointers made and attempted have all come during Mark Byington's tenure. GS made 10-plus triples in a game 13 times last year.

• Mark Byington is coaching in his 193rd career game and his 182nd at Georgia Southern. He became the fifth coach to win 100 games at Georgia Southern with the Eagles 79-78 victory over ULM Jan. 10. His win total in his first five-plus seasons at Georgia Southern is the best of any coach in the modern era. He posted a 7-4 record at College of Charleston in 2012, filling in as the interim coach for Bobby Cremins.

• Under Byington, Georgia Southern is 67-14 in games when leading at half and 87-11 when leading with five minutes to go.

• GS has six scholarship newcomers on the roster, the most in a season during head coach Mark Byington's tenure. The Eagles returned just five lettermen, but three seniors were starters the last two seasons and the five returners entered the campaign with 3,936 career points among them, the 12th-most in the country.

• Tookie Brown was named Sun Belt Player of the Week Nov. 20 after averaging 20 points, 4.8 assists, 4.3 rebounds and a steal a game while shooting 55 percent from the floor and 76 percent from the free-throw line in four games.

• GS started 5-0 for the second straight season. The last time the Eagles started the campaign 5-0 in consecutive years was in the 1949-50 and 1950-51 seasons.

• The Eagles have opened Sun Belt Conference play on the road in four of their five seasons in the league.

• With a 21-12 record last season, Georgia Southern reached 20 wins for the second time in four years.

## THE SERIES

• This is the 10th meeting in the all-time series, which began in 1972 when the Eagles topped the Mavs, 73-69, in the Claxton Fruitcake Classic in Hanner Fieldhouse.

• The Eagles are 4-4 against the Mavs since joining the Sun Belt in 2014.

• GS is 4-1 against the Mavs in Hanner Fieldhouse.

• **Last Meeting - 1/5/19 - College Park Center:** Quan Jackson tallied 21 points, seven rebounds and three assists, and Georgia Southern held UTA to 31 percent shooting in the second half to earn a 77-64 victory over the Mavericks.

• Isaiah Crawley made 7 of his 10 shots and tallied 15 points and six rebounds, and Elijah McCadden came off the bench to chip in a career high 12 points and five rebounds.

• Georgia Southern scored seven straight points in a minute of game time, and Calvin Wishart's triple from the corner gave the Eagles a 53-43 lead with 11:04 left in the game. UTA missed 5 of 6 shots during the stretch and 4 of 5 from long distance.

• The Eagles pushed the advantage to 17 points on a Tookie Brown driving layup with 2:14 to play, and David Lee Jones Jr. made eight straight free throws inside the last 1:46 to seal the win. Jones Jr. finished with 11 points, four assists and a pair of steals.

• It was the Eagles' first win in the College Park Center, the only building in the Sun Belt GS had not won in before today. GS held UTA to 10 of 32 from the floor and 1 of 13 from long distance in the second half.

l era. His floater in the lane over the 7-foot-6 Tacko Fall with 5:31 to play sent the senior past Julius Jenkins in the school record books. He surpassed 2,000 career points with a 3-pointer from the top of the key 1:46 into the Eagles' game at Troy Jan. 17. He is seventh on the Sun Belt career scoring list and is already the Georgia Southern's leader in career free throws and free throw attempts.

• Brown became the fourth Eagle to reach 300 assists in his junior season, joining C.Y. Young (1989-93), Dwayne Foreman (2004-08) and Terry Williams (2001-05). He became the fifth Eagle with 400 assists in his career, reaching the milestone against ETSU Nov. 27, and is 37 shy of 500.

• Brown is the second Eagle to post 1,500 points and 400 assists, joining C.Y. Young (1,517 pts, 530 asts). He is the first Eagle to score 500-plus points in three straight seasons.

• Brown reached 400 rebounds for his career at Texas State Jan. 3.

• Ike Smith is ranked 13th on the school's career scoring list in the Division I era and needs eight rebounds to reach 500 for his career.

• The senior needs 21 points and eight rebounds to become the fifth Eagle with 1,500 career points and 500 rebounds, joining Jeff Sanders (1,861 pts, 893 reb), Kevin Anderson (1,843 pts, 986 reb), Matt Simpkins (1,684 pts, 642 reb) and Louis Graham (1,581 pts, 908 reb).

• Montae Glenn became the 16th Eagle to surpass 500 rebounds when he corralled 10 in the season opener vs. Carver Nov. 7. The senior became the 12th Eagle with 600 boards in the Division I era after collecting 13 at South Alabama Jan. 19. He is tied for 11th on the GS career list.

## LAST TIME OUT

• Montae Glenn tallied 18 points and 13 rebounds and blocked a game-tying shot attempt late in overtime to lead Georgia Southern to an 88-86 win over South Alabama Saturday afternoon in the Mitchell Center.

• Clinging to a two-point lead, the Eagles forced three missed Jaguar shots in the final 24.1 of the overtime period. The Jags had the ball with 2.4 left and inbounded to Trahe Mitchell who tried a pull-up jumper that Glenn blocked clean. The ball came right back to Mitchell who tried to beat the buzzer with another jumper, but it came up short.

• Glenn finished with four blocked shots in the contest. His 18 points were a career high, and it was the senior's 12th career double-double and fourth this season.

• Tookie Brown scored a season high 26 points, and Quan Jackson finished with 17 points, with seven coming in the extra period, and five rebounds.

• The Eagles led by four following a Glenn free throw with 45 seconds left in regulation, but Herb McGee cut the margin to one with a conventional 3-point play on South Alabama's trip down the floor. The Jags fouled Isaiah Crawley, who made 1 of 2 from the charity stripe with 9.4 seconds remaining. Mitchell made a contested jumper with two Eagles in his face with 2.6 seconds left to send the game to overtime.

• Jackson scored the Eagles' first points in the extra session on a pair of free throws, and GS never trailed in overtime. The sophomore drilled a triple from the wing with 56.4 seconds to play to put GS ahead 87-84.

## ASSAULT ON THE RECORD BOOKS

• GS overcame a 22-point deficit with 2:16 left in the first half against George Mason, the Eagles' biggest come-from-behind win since erasing a 24-point halftime deficit

in a 91-88 overtime win over Little Rock Feb. 28, 1991.

• The Eagles shot 77.8 percent (21-27) in the second half against George Mason, the highest since making 80.8 percent in the second half against UIC Nov. 28, 2005.

• GS shot 61 percent (36-59) at Troy Jan. 17, their highest against a Division I opponent since Nov. 28, 2005, an 89-69 win over Illinois-Chicago in Hanner Fieldhouse.

• The Eagles shot 58.9 percent (33-56) against George Mason Nov. 13 and shot 58.8 (30-51) percent against Pepperdine Nov. 17.

• Against Carver, the Eagles broke the school record for points in a game in the Division I era with a lay-in by Trey Dawkins off a Daniel Cooper assist with 3:07 to go. The previous mark was 126, set against Georgia State in 1974.

• The Eagles were one point shy of tying the school overall mark of 140, set against High Point Dec. 17, 1955.

• The 88-point margin of victory was also the second-highest in school history to the Eagles' 90-point win over Georgia State Feb. 24, 1951.

• Quan Jackson had eight steals against Carver to tie the school single-game record. He shares it with John Tavous Rucker, who tallied eight against Reinhardt in 2010.

## TOUGH SCHEDULE

• Georgia Southern's non-conference schedule is rated the 36th most difficult in the country by the NCAA Net (through games Jan. 17), making it the most difficult in the Sun Belt.

• Six of the Eagles' games have been against teams with a NET rating under 108.

• The Eagles played three teams who were in the top-100 in the NCAA RPI last season and seven that were inside the top-165. Arizona, Bradley, ETSU and Radford all posted 20-plus wins, and the Eagles defeated 2018 Big Sky Champion Montana, which went 26-8, in the Islands of the Bahamas Showcase.

• The Eagles opened the Sun Belt schedule at Texas State Jan. 3, marking the fourth time in their five seasons in the Sun Belt Conference that they have opened the league schedule on the road.

• GS started its league schedule with four of six on the road but finishes the season with five of seven at home.

## ENJOYING THE ISLAND LIFE

• The Eagles' 80-77 win over Montana Nov. 18 in the Islands of the Bahamas showcase championship game was the first victory over a team from the Big Sky Conference in school history. It's the Eagles' first in-season tournament title since winning the Islander Classic in Corpus Christi, Texas, in 2003.

• Tookie Brown was named the Islands of the Bahamas MVP, and Montae Glenn joined him on the all-tournament team.

• Georgia Southern won three games in three days despite losing Quan Jackson, who was the team's leading scorer at the time, late in the opening game of the weekend, and starting forward Isaiah Crawley missed the second half of the championship game with an injury.

• The tournament in the Bahamas was the second time the Eagles have played regular season games outside the United States in the last six years. GS split two contests in Cancun, Mexico, in 2013, topping Presbyterian 76-66 and falling 67-65 to Oral Roberts.

- Georgia Southern senior guards Tookie Brown and Ike Smith were named All-Sun Belt, and the Eagles were picked in a tie for second in the conference's Preseason Men's Basketball Coaches Poll.
- The Sun Belt poll followed a trend of preseason praise for the Eagles. Athlon, Lindy's, Street & Smith's and The Blue Ribbon College Basketball Yearbook all had Brown on the preseason All-Sun Belt team and the Eagles picked in the top-3 of the conference.

### CAROLINA CONNECTIONS

- Five Eagles hail from North Carolina.
- Redshirt junior Simeon Carter is from Charlotte, junior Trey Dawkins is from Forest City, freshman Elijah McCadden is from Rocky Mount, freshman Will Dillard is from Greensboro and freshman Eito Yuminami is from Mooresville.

### A BIG MAN!

- Redshirt Freshman center Tyshaun Crawford may be one of the most ballyhooed Georgia Southern recruits in some time simply because of his size. He is a legit 7-footer, and the first on a Georgia Southern roster since Emmett Smith played for the Eagles from 1989-91.
- His high school coach, Willie Reese, and AAU coach, James Forrest, both played four seasons at Georgia Tech for legendary coach Bobby Cremins, who served as Byington's mentor at College of Charleston.
- Byington brought in 6-foot-11 Wyatt Sikora, who transferred after his freshman season from Stetson and was set to play in the 2015-16 season, but he was forced to retire from basketball after a medical condition was discovered during preseason medical testing.
- Krzysztof Janiszewski, who played for the Eagles from 2006-10, was 6-foot-11.

### A STAFF OF HEAD COACHES

- In addition to head coach Mark Byington, assistant coaches Ben Betts and Jon Cremins have experience in the first chair.
- Betts compiled a 52-41 record at South Carolina State from 2003-06. His squad won the MEAC regular-season title after posting an 18-11 record in 2003-04.
- Cremins spent two seasons as the head coach at Spartanburg Methodist College and led the Pioneers to a combined 55-11 record and consecutive appearances in the NJCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship. He was named the Region X Coach of the Year and District X Coach of the Year for the second straight season after guiding Spartanburg Methodist to a top-25 national ranking and 29-4 overall record in 2016-17.
- Byington, Cremins and assistant coach Andrew Wilson all coached together at College of Charleston from 2010-12.

### FREE HOOPS

- Georgia Southern is 38-43 in overtime contests, 6-7 in its last 13 and has won its last two. GS topped Bradley 79-74 in Hanner Fieldhouse Dec. 18, 2018, in its last overtime game at home and won 88-86 at South Alabama Jan. 19, 2019, in its last overtime game on the road.
- The win at South Alabama was also their last overtime game in Sun Belt action.

### HURRICANE RELIEF

- Georgia Southern has played in a charity exhibition game to aid hurricane relief efforts in each of the last

two seasons. GS topped Augusta 88-67 in Christenberry Fieldhouse in 2017 and defeated Charleston Southern 79-61 Oct. 30.

- All proceeds from both contests were donated to the American Red Cross to assist victims of hurricanes. Supported by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC), the NCAA allowed schools to apply for a waiver for a special additional exhibition contest to benefit relief efforts.

### BOARDING THE MOTHERSHIP

- Georgia Southern's home contest against Troy in Hanner Fieldhouse Feb. 15, at 9 p.m. will be broadcast live on ESPN2.
- In addition to its 16 games on ESPN+ as part of the Sun Belt Conference package, GS games at Arizona Nov. 29 (Pac 12 Network), at UCF Dec. 11 (ESPN3), at Dayton Dec. 29 (NBCSN), at Mercer Dec. 8 (ESPN3) and at Radford Dec. 21 (ESPN+) will be broadcast. That gives the Eagles 23 live broadcasts on the ESPN family of networks, the PAC 12 Network and NBCSN.
- Eagle home games not on ESPN+ can be seen live on TrueBlue TV for free.
- The Sun Belt Men's Basketball Tournament will be streamed on ESPN+, and the championship game Sunday, March 17, will air on ESPN2 at 2 p.m. ET.

### GS SIGNS THREE

- Trevion Lamar (Savannah, Ga./Jenkins/Northern Oklahoma), Mackenzie McFatten (Douglas, Ga./Coffee) and Jalen Cincore (Bartlett, Tenn./Bartlett) have signed National Letters of Intent to attend Georgia Southern and compete for the Eagles, beginning in the 2019-20 season.
- Lamar will play out his sophomore season at Northern Oklahoma and join the Eagles as a junior in eligibility. He was named a second-team national JUCO Super Sophomore in Street & Smith's Preseason Preview and named Region 2 Preseason Player of the Year. Lamar averaged 16 points, eight rebounds and three assists as a freshman and was named first-team all-region and first-team All-OCAC. He averaged 20 points and 9.5 rebounds as a senior at Jenkins High School and was named AAA first-team all-state, the Region 3 AAA Player of the Year and *Savannah Morning News* Player of the Year in 2017.
- McFatten averaged 11.8 points, 8.3 rebounds and two assists a game at Coffee High School and played in the Georgia Athletic Coaches Association Junior-Senior All-Star Game. He was named the GHSA Region 1 6A Offensive Player of the Year and first-team all-region as a junior.
- Cincore is rated one of the Top-10 players in Tennessee's class of 2019. He averaged 24.5 points, six rebounds, 4.2 assists and 1.2 steals for the Tennessee Panthers AAU team last summer.

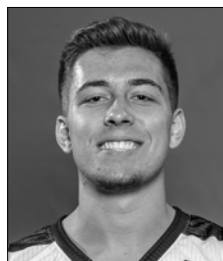
