## **INTERVIEW REQUESTS**

All requests for interviews with Chad Willis and the Georgia Southern student-athletes must be arranged through Tyler Gallo. Advance notice of at least 24 hours is preferred, but every attempt will be made to accommodate all requests. No one will be available for interviews on game day, except for post game interviews.

#### **DEJA VU**

Kirsten Barrett and Ashlyn Lovett - again - were named SBC Players of the Week for the second time this season. Barrett averaged 11.44 assists per set and Lovett averaged over 7 digs per set. The Eagles have had a player on the POTW list for three straight weeks for the first time in program history, and the first by any GS sport since football also did so in 2014, becoming the first team to have two players on the POTW teams in consecutive weeks. Barrett is the first volleyball player to win back-to-back weekly awards since Alex Beecher in 2012.

#### JILL THE THRILL

Jillian Gray has 101 kills through the first eight games of the season. She is the first player in program history to record 100 or more kills through eight games since Meredith Paskert had 102 through eight games in 2012.

#### **CRAZY EIGHT**

For her off-balance, desperation heave to notch a kill, Kirsten Barrett was showcased as the no. 8 play on Friday night's SportsCenter Top 10.

#### **CAN YOU DIG IT?**

Ashlyn Lovett broke the record for digs in a three-set match against North Carolina A&T with 31 digs, shattering the previous mark of 27 set by Moriah Bellissimo in 2011. In fact, it's the secondmost digs by anyone in a three-set match this season.

#### **HELPING HAND**

Kirsten Barrett was named SBC Setter of the Week after recording gaudy assist numbers during the GATA Challenge, averaging a league-best 10.14 assists per set in the two games. Her 71 assists were fourth in the conference. She recorded 30 in three sets on Thursday, followed by a season-high 41 in the win over Clemson.

## **GRAY AREA**

Outside hitter Jillian Gray was named SBC Offensive Player of the Week after averaging 4.43 kills/set and hitting .343 (31-8-67) with 31 kills during the GATA Challenge. She started with eight kills on 18 swings against Maryland Eastern Shore on Thursday before exploding for a careerhigh 23 kills on 49 swings against Clemson, becoming the first Eagles OPOTW since 2016.

#### **POWER PLAY**

For the first time since 2016, and nearly eight years to the day, the Eagles hosted – and beat – an autonomy four opponent at Hanner Fieldhouse when it beat Clemson in four sets. The Eagles hit .248 and Jillian Gray had 23 kills in the team's first P4 win since beating Wake Forest on 9/9/16.

#### FROM KANSAS WITH LOVE(TT)

Ashlyn Lovett had a stellar weekend at the War Eagle Invitational, earning SBC Defensive Player of the Week honors after averaging 5.08 digs per set in the three games. Her 61 digs after the first week led the conference.

#### DAYTONA .500

Two Eagles hit .500 or better, minimum 10 attempts, over the weekend at Auburn. Lydia Seymour hit .563 (9-0-16) against Auburn and Maggie Sale hit .500 (12-1-22) versus North Alabama to become the first two Eagles to do so in the 2024 season.

#### **2023 SEASON RECAP**

Volleyball had one of its most successful seasons in recent memory after finishing the year 23-9 (.719) and earning a trip to the Great Eight of the NIVC. It was the team's first 20-win season since 2013 and the first two postseason wins in program history. The team's ten wins in conference play were the most since joining the Sun Belt. The Eagles led the conference in total blocks and hitting percentage, while finishing second in blocks per set.

#### PRESEASON PROWESS

The Eagles earned some respect heading into the 2024 season following their strong year in 2023. Reagan Barth was named Preseason All-Conference, the first Eagle to do so since 2022, and the Eagles were picked third in the East with 74 vote points behind JMU and Coastal Carolina.

#### **BARTH VADER**

Sophomore Reagan Barth enters the 2024 season off a spectacular freshman campaign in Statesboro. The Kansas native led the team in kills, kills per set, aces and hitting percentage, recorded seven double-doubles, four 20-kill games and was named All-SBC First Team.

#### **WE LIKE IT, WE LOVETT**

Ashlyn Lovett plays her senior season as one of the most prolific liberos in school history. She sits third all-time in digs (1,561) and second in digs per set (4.44), one of two players in program history to average over four digs per set in their career. She is 439 digs from becoming the second player to reach the 2,000 dig mark, and 305 digs this season would place her alone in second in the record books. She is currently 29th among active players in career digs.

#### **KBOOM**

Kirsten Barrett became the 15th Eagle to reach the 1,000-assist plateau after recording her 30th assist against North Carolina A&T. Should Barrett record the same number of assists as 2023, she would move into ninth all-time.

#### **BLOCK PARTY**

In 2023, the Eagles were one of six teams to finish the season in the top 12 in both total blocks (eighth) and blocks per set (11th). They joined Wisconsin, Pittsburgh, Oregon, Penn State and Texas— all NCAA Tournament teams— in doing so.

#### **NEW HOME**

The Eagles bolstered their roster with two transfers for the upcoming season from Power 4 schools, adding sophomores Kayla Knowles (Houston) and Lydia Seymour (Texas Christian) to the squad.

## **DIGGING DEEP**

In the opening round of the NIVC against Winthrop last season, the Eagles and Ashlyn Lovett were not letting the ball hit the floor. They recorded 102 total digs and Lovett broke the school record with 45 digs in the match. It was the team's first 100-dig output since September 21, 2019, and Lovett broke Alex Beecher's record of 40 digs set on November 3, 2012.

#### **FRESH FACES**

The Eagles added three freshmen to the mix this season, welcoming outside hitter Sam Bowron (Florida), defensive specialist Mayte Camacho (Florida) and middle blocker Claire Smith (Ohio).

#### STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

This year, GS will play against six teams that made either the NCAA Tournament or NIVC. They will take on NCAAT teams in Auburn, Wofford, Coastal Carolina and James Madison in addition to facing Winthrop and Clemson, who appeared in the NIVC.

#### WHERE THERE'S A WILLIS...

Last year's 23-9 record improved Chad Willis' winning percentage to .527 during his tenure, one of just three coaches to have a .500 or better win percentage in team history. His 75 wins place him fifth in program history, and three more wins this season would push him past Dustin Wood for fourth all-time, while 13 wins would put him third ahead of J.B. Claiborne.

### **MAGIC NUMBERS**

Last season continued what has been an incredible resurgence under Chad Willis and company for Georgia Southern volleyball. The win percentage of .719 was the team's highest since 2013 and highest since joining the Sun Belt. In addition, the team has recorded three consecutive seasons of 17 or more wins for the first time since 2011–13.

#### **ROAD WARRIORS**

Since 2021, the Eagles have never finished a season below .500 on the road, recording a 18-12 (.600) mark away from Statesboro, finishing 8-3 in 2023.

#### **DEADLY DUO**

Last season, the duo of Reagan Barth (353) and Jillian Gray (287) combined for 640 kills, the most kills by a Georgia Southern duo since Jamie DeRatt (354) and Kym Coley (310) combined for 664 in 2014.

#### **FANTASTIC FOUR**

In 2023, Georgia Southern had four players surpass the 200-kill plateau for the first time since 2014. Reagan Barth (353), Jillian Gray (287), Chamblee Russell (225) and Jordan Christy (209) all reached the mark.

#### **HOME SWEET HOME**

Since Chad Willis took over the helm, the Eagles have won at a 62-percent clip at home, going 42-25 (.626). Over the last three seasons, the team is 36-14 (.720) at Hanner Fieldhouse, starting this season 5-0.

#### REAGAN ADMINISTRATION

After her impressive rookie season, Reagan Barth found herself in the top-100 in two categories in the NCAA: aces per set (78th) and kills per set (87th). She finished 103rd in attacks per set.

#### **HOME IS IN HANNER**

2024 is the first of a multi-year transition of Hanner Fieldhouse into a premier volleyball-only facility. With the basketball teams set to move to the new Convocation Center at the end of the volleyball slate, Hanner will undergo renovations to further accommodate the Georgia Southern volleyball team.
