FROM KANSAS WITH LOVE(TT)

Ashlyn Lovett had a stellar weekend at the War Eagle Invitational, earning SBC Defensive Player of the Week honors after averaging 5.08 digs per set in the three games. Her 61 digs after the first week led the conference, and is tied for 14th in the NCAA in digs and 26th in digs per set.

Several Eagles recorded double-doubles during the War Eagle Invitational. The list is below.

DAYTONA .500

Two Eagles hit .500 or better, minimum 10 attempts, over the weekend at Auburn. Lydia Seymour hit .563 (9-0-16) against Auburn and Maggie Sale hit .500 (12-1-22) versus North Alabama to become the first two Eagles to do so in the 2024 season.

2023 SEASON RECAP

Volleyball had one of its most successful seasons in recent memory after finishing the year 23-9 (.719) and earning a trip to the Great Eight of the NIVC. It was the team's first 20-win season since 2013 and the first two postseason wins in program history. The team's ten wins in conference play were the most since joining the Sun Belt. The Eagles led the conference in total blocks and hitting percentage, while finishing second in blocks per set.

PRESEASON PROWESS

The Eagles earned some respect heading into the 2024 season following their strong year in 2023. Reagan Barth was named Preseason All-Conference, the first Eagle to do so since 2022, and the Eagles were picked third in the East with 74 vote points behind JMU and Coastal Carolina.

POWER PLAY

For the first time since 2016, and nearly eight years to the day, the Eagles will host a Power 4 opponent at Hanner Fieldhouse when it takes on Clemson on Sep. 7. In 2016, the team hosted both Wake Forest and South Carolina on back-to-back days in the Hampton Inn Invitational on Sep. 9 and Sep. 10, 2016.

BARTH VADER

Sophomore Reagan Barth enters the 2024 season off a spectacular freshman campaign in Statesboro. The Kansas native led the team in kills, kills per set, aces and hitting percentage, recorded seven double-doubles, four 20-kill games and was named All-SBC First Team.

WE LIKE IT, WE LOVETT

Ashlyn Lovett enters her senior season as one of the most prolific liberos in school history. She sits fourth all-time in digs (1,480) and second in digs per set (4.39), one of two players in program history to average over four digs per set in their career. She is 520 digs from becoming the second player to reach the 2,000 dig mark, and 305 digs this season would place her alone in second in the record books. She is currently 32nd among active players in career digs.

KBOOM

After leading the Eagles in assists last season, junior Kirsten Barrett sits 71 assists shy of 1,000 career. Should she record the same number assists as 2024, she would move into ninth all-time while also reaching the 1,500 mark.

WE'RE NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE

The Eagles have two players from Kansas on their roster, and both from the KC area in Ashlyn Lovett (Lenexa) and Reagan Barth (Shawnee). Last season, there was a trio of Kansas natives with middle blocker Ally Barnhart, also from the Kansas City area.

BLOCK PARTY

In 2023, the Eagles were one of six teams to finish the season in the top 12 in both total blocks (eighth) and blocks per set (11th). They joined Wisconsin, Pittsburgh, Oregon, Penn State and Texas—all NCAA Tournament teams—in doing so.

NEW HOME

The Eagles bolstered their roster with two transfers for the upcoming season from Power 4 schools, adding sophomores Kayla Knowles (Houston) and Lydia Seymour (Texas Christian) to the squad.

DIGGING DEEP

In the opening round of the NIVC against Winthrop last season, the Eagles and Ashlyn Lovett were not letting the ball hit the floor. They recorded 102 total digs and Lovett broke the school record with 45 digs in the match. It was the team's first 100-dig output since September 21, 2019, and Lovett broke Alex Beecher's record of 40 digs set on November 3, 2012.

FRESH FACES

The Eagles added three freshmen to the mix this season, welcoming outside hitter Sam Bowron (Florida), defensive specialist Mayte Camacho (Florida) and middle blocker Claire Smith (Ohio).

GS begins the Eagle Invitational next Thursday by hosting North Carolina A&T.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

This year, GS will play against six teams that made either the NCAA Tournament or NIVC. They will take on NCAAT teams in Auburn, Wofford, Coastal Carolina and James Madison in addition to facing Winthrop and Clemson, who appeared in the NIVC.

WHERE THERE'S A WILLIS...

Last year's 23-9 record improved Chad Willis' winning percentage to .527 during his tenure, one of just three coaches to have a .500 or better win percentage in team history. His 68 wins place him fifth in program history, and ten wins this season would push him past Dustin Wood for fourth alltime, while 16 wins would put him third ahead of J.B. Claiborne.

MAGIC NUMBERS

Last season continued what has been an incredible resurgence under Chad Willis and company for Georgia Southern volleyball. The win percentage of .719 was the team's highest since 2013 and highest since joining the Sun Belt. In addition, the team has recorded three consecutive seasons of 17 or more wins for the first time since 2011-13.

ROAD WARRIORS

Since 2021, the Eagles have never finished a season below .500 on the road, playing to an 18-12 (.600) mark away from Statesboro, finishing 8-3 in 2023.

DEADLY DUO

Last season, the duo of Reagan Barth (353) and Jillian Gray (287) combined for 640 kills, the most kills by a Georgia Southern duo since Jamie DeRatt (354) and Kym Coley (310) combined for 664 in 2014.

FANTASTIC FOUR

In 2023, Georgia Southern had four players surpass the 200-kill plateau for the first time since 2014. Reagan Barth (353), Jillian Gray (287), Chamblee Russell (225) and Jordan Christy (209) all reached the mark.

ROARING START

Volleyball won 11 of its first 12 games last season, including a 6-0 start, which was tied for its best start to a season since 1992. It was also the second time in program history the team swept nine consecutive sets to begin a season.

HOME SWEET HOME

Since Chad Willis took over the helm, the Eagles have won at a 60-percent clip at home, going 38-25 (.603). Over the last three seasons, the team is 32-14 (.695) at Hanner Fieldhouse, starting this season 1-0.

REAGAN ADMINISTRATION

After her impressive rookie season, Reagan Barth found herself in the top-100 in two categories in the NCAA: aces per set (78th) and kills per set (87th). She finished 103rd in attacks per set.

HOME IS IN HANNER

2024 is the first of a multi-year transition of Hanner Fieldhouse into a premier volleyball-only facility. With the basketball teams set to move to the new Convocation Center at the end of the volleyball slate, Hanner will undergo renovations to further accommodate the Georgia Southern volleyball team.
