#### **INTERVIEW REQUESTS**

Advance notice of at least 24 hours is preferred, but every attempt will be made to accommodate all requests. No one will be available for interviews on game day, except for post game interviews.

#### **SETTING THE BAR(TH) HIGH**

Junior Reagan Barth, who has made All-Conference First Team each of the last two years and was an AVCA All-Region Honorable Mention last season, has her sights set on bigger things in 2025. Her 709 kills over her first two seasons were the most through a sophomore season since Bethany Sanford had 789 from 2008-09. And on 10/24 against JMU, she passed the 1,000 kill plateau and now has 1,103 career kills. She is the first player since Cathrine Murray in 2017 to reach 1,000 kills at Georgia Southern and her 1,103 career kills is now 6th all-time. Against Georgia State, she passed Iulia Porumbescu and Erin Martin on the all-time kill list. Her next target is Lauren McClain, who is fifth with 1,144 kills.

#### **MORE WILLIS PLEASE**

Georgia Southern head volleyball coach Chad Willis signed a contract extension last Wednesday that will keep him in Statesboro through the year 2030. Willis has direct the Eagles to back-to-back 20-win seasons and postseason berths and he is on the cusp of becoming the all-time winningest head coach in GS volleyball history. He has 108 career wins, only eight wins shy of GS Athletic Hall of Famer Kerry Messersmith (118 wins).

#### **ALL ABOUT THE HONORS**

Barth became the fifth different Eagle to earn a Sun Belt weekly honor on11/4 as she was named the league's Offensive Player of the Week. Barth averaged 4.0 kills, 3.57 digs and 0.86 blocks per set as Georgia Southern swept Coastal Carolina for the first time in program history. She joins Alex Myers, Kirsten Barrett, Maddie Cugino and Lydia Seymour as weekly award winners this season for GS.

#### **EAGLES IN THE RANKINGS**

The Eagles rank in the Top 25 nationally in two categories - digs per set (16.76, 15th) and opponents' hitting percentage (.169, 23rd). Individually, Reagan Barth ranks 14th nationally in attacks per set (12.01) while Maddie Cugino ranks 24th in digs (4.73) and Kirsten Barrett ranks 36th in assists per set (10.10)

#### **ALEX THE GREAT**

Freshman middle blocker Alex Myers earned Sun Belt Offensive Player of the Week honors on Oct. 21 for her first career honor. Myers hit .364 with 27 kills and was pivotal in the Eagles' come-from-behind 3-2 win over App State on Thursday. Trailing 14-11, Myers had a block for a side out, then served four straight points for the 16-14 victory.

#### **SEYMOUR'S STUFFS**

Junior Lydia Seymour was a blocking machine

against Troy, registering 22 total blocks in the two wins for the Eagles, earning Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Week honors. Her 22 total blocks were as many or more than 11 of the 14 Sun Belt teams last week and she had a career-high 13 on Saturday, her first career double-digit blocking match

#### **NINE TIMES**

Kirsten Barrett recorded her ninth career Sun Belt Setter of the Week honor, and sixth of this season, on Nov. 4, not only extending her own VB record, but she is now has the most Sun Belt weekly honors of any GS student-athlete, regardless of sport. She tallied 66 assists and 24 digs in Georgia Southern's pair of wins over Coastal Carolina, the first sweep for the Eagles against CCU in school history.

#### **OH MYERS**

Freshman middle blocker Alex Myers was nearly unstoppable on Thursday, Sept. 25 against Old Dominion, hitting .769 with 10 kills and no errors in 13 swings. It was the second-highest hitting percentage for an Eagle this season as well as her second career double-digit kills performance of the season

#### LYDICULOUS

During the Bulldog Classic, Lydia Seymour had 32 kills and led the Sun Belt with a .482 hitting percentage in the three games, recording just five errors on the weekend. On 9/13 at Georgia, she had a career-high 15 kills. She also was top ten in the Sun Belt in blocks per set during the tournament.

#### BA-BAM

In her Eagles debut against South Carolina State, Gabby Babinski recorded nine kills on 10 swings, becoming the first Eagle to hit .850 or better on 10 or more swings since Hannah Nelson also did so against the Citadel on 11/15/10, going 12-0-14.

#### **GAME, SET, MATCH**

Kirsten Barrett, who earned Setter of the Week honors three times in 2024, kicked off 2025 by winning it after leading the conference in aces (11), aces per set (1.22) and assists per set (9.11) during the 2-0 slate. On Friday, she broke the Georgia Southern four-set record by recording nine aces against North Florida, nearing a triple-double with 42 assists and eight digs. She followed with her first double-double of the season on Saturday, recording 40 assists and a career-high 15 digs.

#### IT'S A MAD, MAD, MAD, MAD WORLD

In her first weekend as an Eagle, Maddie Cugino made a strong impact, recording a career-best 25 digs in each game and leading the conference with a 5.56 digs per set mark after the two games.

#### **ACED THE TEST**

In the season opener at North Florida, Kirsten Barrett notched nine service aces, nearing a triple-double and breaking the four-set program record of eight held by Pamela Grosch (1988) & Julie Ciezkowski (1992). It was the first time an Eagle had eight or more in a game since Ashlyn Lovett did on 9/9/22.

#### **EAGLES AT ENMARKET**

On Aug. 23, Georgia Southern took on South Carolina in front of over 1,000 fans at Savannah's Enmarket Arena ahead of November's SEC Championship - sweeping South Carolina and splitting the final two extra sets. All healthy Eagles appeared in the 4-1 win.

#### PRESEASON POINTS

For the first time in program history, Georgia Southern was picked first in the East division in the Sun Belt preseason poll - earning 9 of 14 first-place votes and 87 points overall. Kirsten Barrett and Reagan Barth were named preseason All-SBC - with Barth earning her second consecutive berth on the preseason team.

#### **HOME COOKING**

Since 2023, the Eagles are 21-3 at Hanner Fieldhouse and the .875 home winning percentage in that time frame is the highest in the Sun Belt.

#### **DEFENDED OUR DOMAIN**

In the 2024 regular season, the Eagles went 14-0 at home, finishing with a mark of 15-1 overall the most home wins and their first undefeated home slate since 2003, where the team went 10-0. They were one of two SBC teams to not lose at home in the regular season in 2024, joining Arkansas State, who went 11-0.

#### WHATCHU TALKIN' 'BOUT, WILLIS?

Head coach Chad Willis entered the 2025 season with 90 career wins and, with last Thursday's 3-0 win at ODU, became the third Eagles head coach to surpass the 100-win mark and first since Chad Callihan did it in 2012. Willis' .559 winning percentage also places him third in program history.

#### **WE'RE NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE**

Once again, the contingency of Kansans on the volleyball team is strong. Three players grew up in the Kansas City area: Reagan Barth (Lenexa), Hadley Porter (Olathe) and Alex Myers (Overland Park). The Eagles have had at least one player from Kansas on the team every year since 2021.

#### **GOOD HAIR DAY**

After missing the 2024 season due to an injury, redshirt junior Ailie Hair returns to bolster the middle group for the Eagles in 2025. She recorded 92 blocks in 2023 to finish second on the team, had eight games wiht five or more blocks, and tied both the three-set and four-set record for solo blocks in a game. Those 92 blocks were the most by a sophomore for the team since Baylor Bumford had 93 in 2019.

#### **NEW FACES IN THE CROWD**

Despite having 10 returners, the Eagles added seven newcomers to the team - two transfers in Maddie Cugino (Gonzaga) and Ava Olsen (Texas Tech), and five freshmen - Gabby Babinski (Michigan), Alex Myers (Kansas), Hadley Porter (Kansas), Anna Powell (Kentucky) and Amelia Robinson (Texas).

#### STRENGTH OF (NON-CON) SCHEDULE

During the non-conference schedule, the Eagles will face four teams that finished the season top-100 in RPI: Florida State (31), Mercer (65), UIC (69) and Georgia (76). The team also has an exhibition against South Carolina (40) to start the season.

#### ON NOTICE

The Eagles finished 2024 top-50 in the NCAA in the following categories: digs per set (12), kills per set (20), aces per set (34), assists per set (38), hitting percentage (39) and opponent hitting percentage (43).

#### ON YOUR MARK, GET SET...

From the last set against Clemson on Sep. 7 to the first set on Oct. 11 against Troy, the Eagles won 28 consecutive sets - the longest during the rally scoring era and second-longest in program history behind the record of 29 straight in 1993. This compounded the team's 12-1 start to the year, best in program history.

#### **RP-HIGH**

The Eagles finished last season with an RPI of 53, which was the highest the team has ever finished in a season. They reached as high as 28 at one point during the year, further illustrating the success the team has had in recent years.
