THE INBOUND

Georgia Southern meets James Madison for the first time in 2024-25 with a Thursday night matchup.

The Eagles routed Western Michigan to go 2-0 in the MAC/SBC Challenge thanks to Braylhan Thomas' first career double-double.

It was the Eagles' biggest road win since 1/31/05 and the team recorded 26 assists in the win, their most since 11/13/15.

EAGLES BY THE NUMBERS

Nakavieon White and Bradley Douglas became the first Eagles teammates with 7 assists in a game since 1/17/05.

Braylhan Thomas had 13 rebounds and 11 points at WMU, the most by an Eagles freshman since Louis Graham on 3/3/05.

Adante' Holiman averaged 18 ppg in the Eagles' two games last week.

The Eagles' 26 assists at Western Michigan were the most against a D-I opponent since 2/25/10.

All requests for interviews with Charlie Henry and the Georgia Southern studentathletes must be arranged through Tyler Gallo. Advance notice of at least 24 hours is preferred, but every attempt will be made to accommodate all requests. No one will be available for interviews on game day, except for post game interviews.

BRONCO BEATDOWN

On the strength of 14 threes, 26 assists and 45 rebounds, the Eagles walloped Western Michigan 83-57 to go 2-0 in the MAC/SBC Challenge. It was the most assists and the first time the team reached all those numbers in a game since 11/13/15 against Webber, and the first time the team had 26+ assists against a D-I opponent since 2/26/10 against Elon. It was also the team's largest road win since 1/31/05 at Savannah State.

HELPING HAND

Sun Belt

Against Western Michigan, both Bradley Douglas and Nakavieon White both had seven assists. They became the first Eagles teammates to each have seven assists in a game since Donte Gennie (11) and Terry Williams (10) did so against Chattanooga on 1/17/05.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE

At Western Michigan, Braylhan Thomas recorded the first double-double of his career by grabbing 11 points and 13 rebounds in 18 minutes. He's the first freshman to have a double-double since 3/7/24, and the first to reach 11 and 13 since Louis Graham on 3/3/05.

CAJUN BLUES

Trailing at halftime and for nearly 29 minutes of the game, the Eagles used a season-best 52.6% shooting effort to take down Louisiana at home. It was the first time the Eagles won this season when trailing with 2:00 left, and first since Jan. 14, 2024 against Coastal.

HOLIWOOD

Adante' Holiman continues to roll for Georgia Southern, setting new career-bests in threes made (6) and steals (4) in the team's loss at Southern Miss. He is the first Eagle with 24 points, 2 assists, 4 steals and at least 6 threes in a game since Jelani Hewitt on 1/17/15 at Troy.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Tyson Brown notched his third career double-double with a career-best 16 points, grabbing 11 rebounds at Troy. He followed that with a nine-point, 12-rebound effort at Southern Miss. Brown is the first Eagle with consecutive double-digit rebound games since Andrei Savrasov did so on Feb. 9 & Feb. 11, 2023, and the first with 11 or more in two consecutive games since Carlos Curry did it on Dec. 21 & 29, 2022.

BETTER NATE THAN NEVER

Junior Nate Brafford tied his career high with 13 points and set a new career-best with four threes made in the loss to Marshall. He has scored 13 points in a game three times in his career.

COAST GUARD

The Eagles took down Coastal Carolina for the second time in as many weeks in the team's most dominant effort of the season, routing them 85-58. It was the largest win since Dec. 30, 2023 against Southern Miss, and the largest win for the Eagles in the series history.

HOLI MOLY

For the second time this season, Adante' Holiman reached a new career high, scoring 28 points on 10-20 field goals and 5-13 shooting at ODU. It's his third effort of five threes in a game this season and third game with at least 20 points.

REIGN CHECK

Thanks to a career-high 28 from Holiman and a season-high nine blocks, the Eagles improved to 3-0 against ODU during Charlie Henry's tenure. The Eagles won despite surrendering 32 offensive rebounds, the first team to win in regulation since UMass beat Hofstra despite 36 offensive rebounds on 12/20/08.

CHANTS DOWN

Despite letting a nine-point lead with two minutes left slip, the Eagles dug deep for an 88-87 overtime win at Coastal Carolina. Bradley Douglas had 20 and made all eight free throws, Eren Banks had 19 and Tyson Brown grabbed 11 rebounds as the Eagles shot 47.6 percent from the floor. It was the team's first overtime road win since 1/22/21 at South Alabama.

BANKS ARE OPEN

Sophomore Eren Banks is now averaging 19.2 ppg in four career games against Coastal Carolina, scoring 19 in Conway on Jan. 16 and another 18 on Jan. 23. He's the first Eagle to shoot .750 in a road game since Carlos Curry on 2/18/23.

TYSON'S CORNER

With 14 rebounds against Georgia State, Tyson Brown set a career-high and Henry-era high in the loss, the first Eagle with 14 rebounds in a game since Carlos Curry on 11/26/22. His seven offensive boards were the most since Andrei Savrasov had eight against Morehead State on 12/14/22.

WAR(HAWK), WHAT IS IT GOOD FOR

Once again trailing by 11 at halftime, Georgia Southern recorded 55 points and 11 three-pointers in the second half en route to a 90-82 win over ULM. Bradley Douglas had 30 points, Eren Banks had a career-high seven assists and freshmen Micah Smith and Braylhan Thomas each recorded their first double-digit efforts of their career as the team topped the Warhawks 90-82 - knocking down a season-high 15 threes.

DOUG DEEP

Against ULM, Bradley Douglas recorded his second consecutive 30-point effort at home and nailed a career-high 8 three-pointers, becoming the first Eagle to do so since Jake Allsmiller on 3/3/18. His 30 points, six rebounds and four assists are the fourth-such effort in program history, and the first since Tookie Brown had 32 pts., 5 reb., and 9 ast, at App State on 2/13/17.

WORLD WIDE WEBB

Against Gardner-Webb, the Eagles used a 55-point second half to overcome a 10-point halftime deficit and 13-point overall deficit to knock off the Bulldogs. The team snapped a 27-game losing streak when trailing by 10 (1/12/23 at App State) and 44-game losing streak trailing at halftime (2/27/21 vs. App State), and had two players score 20 for the second time this season.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

On his birthday, Bradley Douglas went off against Gardner-Webb, scoring a career-best 31 points, grabbing a career-high eight rebounds and going 11-12 from the line. He scored 27 of those points in the second half and recorded the first 30-point effort by an Eagle this season. He's the first Eagle since Tyren Moore last season to have three consecutive 20+ point efforts.

OH-KAY

Nakavieon White had a sensational effort against North Florida, recording a near-triple-double with 20 points, 10 rebounds and six assists. He's the first Eagle to reach those stats in a single game since Eric Ferguson on Dec. 11, 2010 against Brewton-Parker, and the 15th NCAA player in 2024-25 to reach those marks in a single game.

HILL YEAH

In the Jack & Ruth Ann Hill Convocation Center opener, the Eagles won an overtime thriller 93-91 against North Florida - their first-ever win against the Ospreys and first overtime victory since Feb. 25, 2022 against ULM. The team had five players score in double figures for the second time this season, two players score 20+ for the first time since Nov. 26, 2022 against Oglethorpe and grabbed 50 rebounds - their first time reaching 50 in a game since Dec. 7, 2022 against Piedmont and first against a DI opponent since Feb. 18, 2016 against Arkansas State.

HOUSE PARTY

Before moving to The Hill, Georgia Southern went 3-0 at Hanner Fieldhouse. Among schools to open a new arena mid-season, GS is one of three teams to go undefeated at the old venue, joining Hofstra (2-0 at Hofstra Physical Fitness Center) and UMass (6-0 at Curry Hicks Cage).

TB OR NOT TB

Tyson Brown became the first Eagle to record a double-double this season, picking up the second of his career against West Georgia by scoring 10 points and grabbing 12 rebounds.

WHITE NOISE

Nakavieon White broke out in a big way at the Rock Hill Classic, averaging 19 points, 5.2 rebounds and shooting 53.8 percent from the field in the Eagles' 3-1 week. He scored 24 game 1 and 25 game 3, the first Eagle to reach 25 points in a game this season, and led the Eagles in points, rebounds and assists against William & Mary. He averaged 21 points and six rebounds in the MTE.

BREAKING BRAD

As part of 48 bench points against Augusta, Bradley Douglas led the way with a season-high 22. Douglas scored in double figures in each of the first three games of the 2024-25 season.

DONTAE'S INFERNO

At UNCW, Dontae Horne met or surpassed career highs in several categories - points (23), field goals (9), field goal attempts (16) and three-point attempts (6).

PORTAL POWERS

Four Eagles scored in double figures during the win over Northern Illinois, including three players Henry got in the transfer portal - Adante' Holiman (19), Bradley Douglas (15) and Tyson Brown (11).

HOTEL, MOTEL, HOLIMAN

Against Northern Illinois, Adante' Holiman knocked down five threes en route to an 80-65 win over the Huskies in his Eagles debut. He was the first Eagle to record five or more threes in his debut with the team since at least 2003-04, and the first to have four or more since Jason Burnell did it as a freshman on 11/13/15 against Webber.

HOMEWARD BOUND

The Eagles opened the year at home for the first time since the 2021-22 season, where it took down another MAC opponent in Ball State by a score of 82-71.

EAGLES OF THE CARIBBEAN

Georgia Southern took its first foreign tour since 2019, spending a week from July 22-28 in La Romana, Dominican Republic. The team went 2-0 and scored over 100 points in both games, highlighted by Adante' Holiman's perfect 9-9, 24-point performance against the DR U22 team.

THE TELLTALE HART

Tyson Brown and Bradley Douglas were both Florida Southwestern Bucs while Coach Kente' Hart was on staff there and have reunited at Georgia Southern.

GRAY AREA

Assistant coach Dion Bethea coached Braylhan Thomas at Gray Collegiate Academy in Columbia. They won multiple 2A championships together.

HOME SWEET HANNER

The Eagles held a 57-27 (.678) record at Hanner Fieldhouse over the last five years. Since 2013-14, the team went 105-45 (.700) in the confines of Hanner. All-time, the Eagles won at a .700 clip in the historic arena, going 480-206 (.700).

NEW STAFF

Charlie Henry added two new coaches to his staff in the offseason in Nori Johnson and Dion Bethea. Bethea spent the last decade at the high school ranks and Johnson spent a year at USC Upstate after being the head coach at Spartanburg Methodist for several seasons.

HANG A BANNER FOR HANNER

This was the last season that basketball was played at Hanner Fieldhouse. It served as the home court for GS since 1969. The team opened up the Jack and Ruth Ann Hill Convocation Center on Dec. 7 against North Florida.

GEORGIA ON MY MIND

On the 2024-25 roster, five different players are from the state of Georgia - Braylhan Thomas (Atlanta), Eugene Brown III (Conyers), Luke Keller (Suwanee), Micah Smith (Tyrone) and Eren Banks (Eatonton).

FRESH FACES

Three freshmen joined Georgia Southern this season, Micah Smith (Tyrone, Ga.), Braylhan Thomas (Atlanta) and Dwayne Williams Jr. (Baltimore).

FILE TRANSFER

The Eagles welcomed five transfers this season. Joining the blue & white for the first time are Bradley Douglas (Little Rock), Dontae Horne (Texas State), Adante' Holiman (UTSA), Nakavieon White (National Park) and Tyson Brown (Rhode Island).

LOCKDOWN CLOSER

The Eagles are an impressive 38-1 when leading with 2:00 left over the last three seasons and 12-0 this season.

KUHLIO

HEAD COACH | 2ND SEASON | MADONNA'09

Charlie Henry is in his second season as the head coach of the men's basketball program at Georgia Southern.

During his first season at the helm, Henry guided the Eagles to an 8-10 record in Sun Belt play and a quarterfinal appearance in the Sun Belt Tournament for the third consecutive season. Under his tutelage, the Eagles set program records in three-pointers (309) and free-throw percentage (.732), finishing the season 27th in the NCAA in three-pointers per game. Also under his watch, guard Tyren Moore made the All-Sun Belt Second Team and led the Sun Belt in points per game during conference play.

Henry spent the last four seasons at the University of Alabama and was a key cog in the Crimson Tide's success in 2023 as they entered the NCAA Tournament as the No. 1 overall seed with a 29-5 record. Alabama won the Southeastern Conference regular season and tournament titles.

Henry's impact at Alabama was immediately felt as the Crimson made tremendous strides on both ends of the floor. The Crimson Tide went from finishing 16-15 overall and 8-10 in the SEC during the 2019-20 season to 26-7 overall and 16-2 in the SEC during the 2020-21 historic season. With Henry's assistance, Alabama swept the SEC regular season, the program's first since 2002, and tournament, the first since 1991, championships while becoming the only "Power 5" program to achieve the feat during the 2021 campaign.

The Crimson Tide would go on to finish the year ranked No. 5 in the final Associated Press poll, which matched the famed 1955-56 "Rocket 8" team for the highest final ranking in program history while also matching single-season program records for total SEC wins in a season and highest NCAA seed (No. 2 seed). Furthermore, UA's 26 overall wins were second-most in school history, while the Sweet 16 appearance in the 2021 NCAA Tournament was the first for the Tide in 17 years.

Henry's primary focus comes on the defensive side of the ball, where he helped turn the Crimson Tide into one of the top defensive teams in the nation during the 2020-21 campaign. Led by SEC Defensive Player of the Year Herbert Jones, the first UA player ever to earn the honor, Alabama finished the year ranked No. 3 in the nation in defensive efficiency. That trend continued in 2022-23 as Alabama ranked third in the country in field goal percentage defense (.372), third

in 3-point percentage defense (.281), first in rebounding (44.4/gm) and first in defensive rebounds (31.6/gm).

Across his time at Alabama, Henry coached four NBA Draft picks, including a pair of NBA Lottery selections in Joshua Primo (Drafted No. 12 overall by San Antonio in 2021) and Kira Lewis Jr. (Drafted No. 13 overall by New Orleans in 2020). Jones was also selected in the 2021 NBA Draft, going to the New Orleans Pelicans with the fifth pick of the second round (No. 35 overall), JD Davidson was selected in the second round in the 2022 draft (No. 53 overall) and forward Brandon Miller was the No. 2 overall pick of the Charlotte Hornets in the 2023 Draft.

Henry also played a significant role in helping sign three consecutive top-10 classes during his time in Tuscaloosa. The 2022 class was ranked third in the country by 247sports.com, the 2021 class was ranked No. 9 by 247sports and No. 10 by Rivals.com and the 2020 class was ranked No. 9 in the nation by Rivals.com and No. 12 by 247sports.com.

Henry went to Tuscaloosa after spending two seasons (2017-19) as the head coach of the Windy City Bulls, the NBA G League affiliate of the Chicago Bulls. During his final season, Henry led his team to a 27-23 (.540) overall record, earning a spot in the playoffs for the first time and its first winning record in the franchise's three-season history. While with Windy City, he coached second-team All-NBA G League honoree Walter Lemon Jr., who would be called up to the Chicago Bulls on March 29. Additionally, Jakarr Sampson earned the team's second call-up on March 31.

His first campaign with Windy City was highlighted by Bulls' two-way player Antonio Blakeney earning G League Rookie of the Year honors. Blakeney and Ryan Arcidiacono were converted to standard NBA contracts after the season.

Before earning his first career stint as a head coach, Henry spent two seasons (2015-17) as an assistant for the Chicago Bulls under Fred Hoiberg. During his two years in the NBA, Henry's responsibilities included player development, opponent game preparation and implementation of offensive schemes, among other duties.

Prior to his time with Chicago, Henry was a member of Hoiberg's coaching staff at lowa State for three seasons, where his tenure was highlighted by three consecutive trips to

the NCAA Tournament (2013-15), a Sweet 16 appearance (2014) and two Big 12 Conference Tournament championships (2014, 2015). During his final two seasons, the Cyclones posted a record of 53-17 (.757), leading the country in wins against top-25 teams. They were also one of two teams in the country to place in the top-15 in offensive efficiency every season from 2013-15.

The highlight of his tenure in Ames came in 2014-15 when lowa State went 25-9 and finished second in the Big 12 with a 12-6 record. The Cyclones won their second consecutive Big 12 Tournament that season and advanced to the NCAA Tournament. ISU, which was ranked in a school-record 37 consecutive polls, came in at No. 9 in the final Associated Press Top-25. Henry also spent time on the staff as the director of player development (2013-14) and graduate assistant (2012-13).

A native of Canton, Michigan, Henry spent the 2011-12 season with the Indiana Pacers as a video intern. The Pacers advanced to the Eastern Conference semifinals that season. In 2010-11, Henry was a graduate manager at Utah, assisting the video coordinator for the Runnin' Utes.

His recent tenure at Alabama marked the second time he has worked with Alabama head coach Nate Oats, who gave Henry his start in coaching as an assistant at Romulus High School in Detroit, Michigan, during the 2009-10 season. Romulus finished the year at 21-2 and was ranked as high as No. 22 in the nation by USA Today.

Henry was a four-year men's basketball team member at Madonna University (Mich.) and graduated in 2009 with a bachelor's degree in journalism and public relations. He received his master's degree in educational leadership and policy study from lowa State in 2014.

Henry is married to the former Teisha Knutson, and the couple has two sons, Nash and Trey, and a daughter, Dixie Grace.
