THE TOURNAMENT: Georgia State hosts the Georgia State Invitational for the 13th consecutive season beginning Friday.

The four-team, two-day event dates back to head coach Lea Henry's first season at the helm (1994-95) of the Panthers' program and has been held annually during the holiday season in the month of December.

Georgia State is seeking its third Georgia State Invitational crown in four years. The Panthers have won the championship seven times (1996, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2004).

THE SERIES: Georgia State is 5-1 overall against the field heading into the 2006 Georgia State Invitational. The field includes Birmingham-Southern, Mississippi Valley State and Tennessee-Martin. State is also 3-0 at home against its fellow tournament participants. The Panthers have yet to face Birmingham-Southern in the Sports Arena.

The Panthers are meeting Mississippi Valley State on day one of the event for the third consecutive season. State won the two previous meetings on the hardwood by an average margin of victory of 71-44.5. Georgia State topped Birmingham-Southern and Mississippi Valley State last year during the regular season. The last time the Panthers faced Tennessee-Martin was back on Jan. 10, 1993 when State won a thrilling 78-76 overtime contest on the road.

State has won two straight games in the series against Tennessee-Martin and Mississippi Valley State.

LEAGUE RULES: Georgia State is 59-21 (73.8%) overall against the league's represented by the three teams in this year's tournament.

The Panthers have played nine of the 11 current teams in the Ohio Valley Conference (OVC). UT-Martin is the third and last of three OVC schools on the Panthers' schedule that also includes Jacksonville State and Samford. The Panthers are 37-18 versus the overall league, and 2-1 against Tennessee-Martin.

Georgia State is 22-3 overall against teams from the Big South and Southwestern Athletic Conferences. State, which has faced five of the nine current Big South members, is 11-2 versus the league. Birmingham-Southern is the only Big South team on the schedule.

Southwestern Athletic Conference foe Mississippi Valley State is one of six SWAC teams to have faced the Panthers in their history. Georgia State is 11-1 overall against the SWAC and 2-0 against Mississippi Valley State.

ON THE ROAD: Georgia State completed its non-conference road record with a 4-3 mark. The Panthers were 2-3 at actual road venues and 2-0 at neutral sites.

Georgia State last played seven non-conference road games in a season back in 1994-95 and finished 2-5. In 1990-91, the Panthers played 10 non-conference contests and posted a 1-9 mark.

The Panthers' eight total road games before the New Year is the most since 1990-91.

AT HOME: Georgia State is 2-0 at home for the first time since the 2001-02 campaign.

The Panthers are looking to go 3-0 at home for the first time since 2000-01. That season, State started the year 6-0 and completed the season at 12-2 in the Sports Arena.

TOURNAMENT SUMMARY: Georgia State out scored its UCF Holiday Classic opponents, Florida A&M and North Florida, 71.0 to 52.0. All five starters averaged double figures, including sophomore center **Marcquitta Head**, who was named to the all-tournament team and was named the Classic's Most Valuable Player. She concluded the event averaging 12.5 points and 10.0 rebounds per game. Senior guard **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen** was also selected to the Classic all-tournament team.

SHOOTING SLUMP: Senior guard **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen** is in the midst of a shooting slump from beyond the arc. Over the first six games of the season, Roegiers-Jensen made 11-of-35 three-point baskets for 31.4 percent. Since the first contest of December (4 games), she is 1-for-15 for 6.7 percent.

MILESTONE MAKER: Georgia State head coach **Lea Henry**, who is in her 13th season at the helm of the Panthers, won her 200th game as head coach of the Panthers on Dec. 18 in a 66-63 win over Florida A&M. She is already the program's all-time wins leader and owns a record of 201-156 (.563).

Last season, Henry eclipsed another milestone, winning her 250th career game, which she earned with an 89-65 win over Towson on Jan. 15th. Henry is 259-213 overall in 17 collegiate seasons.

FULL THROTTLE: Georgia State has scored 90 points or more in a game twice this season. The last time the Panthers scored 90+ points twice in a season was back during the 2000-01 campaign. The 44-point margin of victory in the win over Savannah State Dec. 9 was the most for the Panthers since winning by 59 points (89-30) over Morris Brown on Dec. 14, 2002.

HAPPY RETURNS: Georgia State is 6-0 this season when 3 or more players score in double figures in a game. By contrast, the Panthers are 0-4 when less than 3 players score in double figures in a game.

CAREER FAIR: Senior guard **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen** totaled a career-best 12 assists against Florida A&M on Dec. 18, while sophomore guard **Brittany Hollins** also rang up career numbers with 11 assists

versus North Florida (Dec. 19). Sophomore center **Marcquitta Head** tied her career-best with 16 rebounds against Florida A&M.

MAKING HISTORY: Sophomore center **Marcquitta Head** made history Dec. 3 after the posting Georgia's first-ever women's basketball triple-double with 14 points, 16 rebounds and 11 blocked shots at Hofstra. The feat was the first in 32 seasons of collegiate women's basketball at Georgia State.

Head's 11 blocked shots were school and Colonial Athletic Association single-game records. Her 16 rebounds were a career-high.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Sophomore center **Marcquitta Head** was named Colonial Athletic Association Player of the Week Dec. 4 after totaling a triple-double at Hofstra on Dec. 3 (14 pts, 16 rebs., 11 blks).

Head averaged a double-double on the week with 14.0 points and 12.5 rebounds per game. She also made 55.6 percent of her field goals.

WE SIGNED THEM: The Georgia State women's basketball staff signed two players to National Letters of Intent during the NCAA early signing period in November.

Current high school seniors **Chandra Harris** and **Danielle Anderson** have committed to play

collegiate basketball for the Panthers as freshmen beginning in the 2007-08 season.

Harris, who currently attends Northeast High School in Macon, Ga., is a 6-0 forward who was also recruited by Georgia Tech, Miami and Eastern Kentucky.

Anderson, who currently attends Smiths Station High School in Smiths Station, Ala., is also a 6-0 forward who was recruited by Vanderbilt, Troy and Alabama A&M. Anderson averaged 21 points and 15 rebounds per game as a junior.

ROLE REVERSAL: A few lineup changes have reaped huge benefits for the Panthers in their last six games.

By inserting sophomore guard **Brittany Hollins** at the point guard position and moving freshman guard **Tabitha David** into the starting lineup, State has improved its scoring average by more than 20 points per game.

Prior to the lineup change, the Panthers averaged only 52.0 ppg and were 0-3 on the season. Since then, Georgia State is 6-1 and averaging 72.4 points per contest.

Five players are averaging double figures since the switch, led by **David's** 12.9 ppg. Senior **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen** is posting 11.9 ppg, while **Hollins** is registering 11.6 ppg. Sophomore **Marcquitta Head** collects 11.9 ppg and 10.4 rpg. Freshman **Danyieil McKeller** averages 11.3 ppg.

FRESHMEN CONTRIBUTIONS: Georgia State's freshmen contributions have been considerable so far in 2006-07.

Consider this, a freshman has led or tied for the team lead in scoring in four of the 10 games played and has led or tied for the team lead in rebounding in five of the 10.

As a unit, the group has accounted for just under half (44.8 percent -- 297 of 663) of Georgia State's total points and 36.0 percent (157 of 436) of the Panthers' rebounding total.

Two of Georgia State's top three scorers and two of its top four rebounders are freshmen.

ON THE RECORD: Georgia State's nine made 3-point field goals at Norfolk State on Nov. 22, 2006 ranks tied for 5th all-time for team 3-pointers in a game. The

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: Senior guard **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen** ranks in the top 10 of several career records lists. She sits in fifth place on the all-time list with 103 made 3-point field goals and ranks third all-time in free throw percentage at 77.0 percent (181-235). Roegiers-Jensen is 5th on the career assists list with 347.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS II: Senior guard **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen** is 54 points away from becoming the 17th player in Georgia State women's basketball history with 1,000 or more career points. She has started 73 of 98 games played and has scored 946 points in her four-year career.-

REMEMBER DECEMBER: Georgia State is 47-57 in the month of December since the 1990-91 season and 42-34 in December under head coach **Lea Henry**. State is 3-1 so far this month.

The Panthers' of 1999-2000 produced an undefeated 6-0 mark. Over the previous five seasons, State has compiled marks of 4-2 (2005-06), 3-4 (2004-05), 3-3 (2003-04), 4-3 (2002-03) and 3-3 (2001-02).

HONORABLE MENTIONS: Georgia State's first home game on Nov. 28 was a busy one as the Panthers honored three players for outstanding past performances.
