Marcquitta Head registered eight points and a team-high nine rebounds. Guard **Monica Thomas** and junior guard **Ashley Strickland** each had eight points.

Paula Muxiri scored 20 points off the bench off 7-for-7 field goal shooting to lead four Old Dominion players in double figures. **Sherida Triggs** recorded 16 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. **Lawona Davis** totaled 10 points and **TJ Jordan** finished with 12.

Georgia State went stride for stride with the Lady Monarchs for much of the first half and trailed 27-23 with 6:04 left after a layup from Head. ODU began to pull away as Muxiri capped a 7-0 run with a layup for 34-23 advantage. State continued to stay tough with the Lady Monarchs and trailed 41-32 heading into halftime.

The Panthers couldn't maintain their rhythm to begin the second period, allowing Old Dominion to stake a 15-point lead, 49-34, in the frame's opening three minutes. **Roegiers-Jensen** pulled State to within 12, but costly turnovers led to six straight points for the Lady Monarchs, who led 60-39 with 13:03 remaining. Old Dominion posted its largest lead of the game, 27 points, on two occasions in the final five minutes of the second period.

ON THE ROAD: Georgia State is 66-83 overall in road games under coach Henry. The team is 54-51 in conference road games under Henry. State is 2-4 (0-1 CAA) on the road this season.

The 1999-2000 team recorded the best overall road mark at 10-2 under Henry's tenure and finished 8-1 in the Trans America Athletic Conference.

DEFENSIVE INTENSITY: Georgia State is ranked 30th nationally in field goal percentage defense and 13th in blocked shots per contest in all games played through Jan. 7, 2007.

Panthers' opponents shoot only 36.0 percent from the floor. State blocks 5.9 field goals per contest.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: Senior guard **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen** ranks in the top 10 of several career records lists. She sits in fourth place on the all-time list with 108 made 3-point field goals and is second all-time in free throw percentage at 77.8 percent (203-261). **Roegiers-Jensen** is 5th on the career assists list with 374.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS II: Senior guard **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen** became the 17th player in Georgia State women's basketball history to

THE SERIES: Thursday's contest is the third meeting on the hardwood between Old Dominion and Georgia State with the Lady Monarchs' holding a 2-0 advantage in the series.

Old Dominion won the first-ever contest between the schools by a score of 89-50 on Feb. 12, 2006 in Norfolk, Va. The Lady Monarchs took the season-series sweep of the Panthers after defeating State at home, 82-56, on Mar. 4, 2006 in the regular season finale for both teams. Sunday's contest is the second meeting on the hardwood between James Madison and Georgia State with the Dukes holding a 1-0 advantage in the series.

Old Dominion is one of Georgia State's five permanent Colonial Athletic Association partners through 2010-11 (for the next five seasons), which means the Panthers play a home-and-home series against the Lady Monarchs. The other partners are UNC Wilmington, Northeastern, Towson and Va. Commonwealth.

score 1,000 or more career points, when she finished with 14 against Northeastern on Jan. 4. She enters Thursday's game versus Old Dominion needing 20 points to move into 15th place all-time, passing Rhian Jones (1,048).

Roegiers-Jensen has started 77 of 102 games played and has scored 1,029 points in her four-year career.

STREAK HALTED: Georgia State saw its six-game win streak snapped after its loss at home to James Madison Sunday. The Panthers, who have now won six of seven and nine of their last 11 games, also lost for the first time at home in six meetings (5-1).

The six-game win streak was the longest of the season and longest since the 2002-03 campaign.

STREAKING: Freshman guard **Tabitha David** has made at least one 3-point field goal in every game she has played this season (12 games). She leads the Panthers in 3-point field goals made (31) and 3-point field goal percentage (.437), ranking 29 and 23rd in the nation, respectively.

HAPPY RETURNS: Georgia State is 9-0 this season when 3 or more players score in double figures in a game. By contrast, the Panthers are 0-5 when less than 3 players score in double figures in a game.

NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP: Sophomores **Brittany Hollins** and **Marcquitta Head** won't go down as "one-hit wonders" following impressive freshmen campaigns.

In 2005-06, the dynamic duo ranked as the Panthers' third and fourth top scorers, averaging 9.0 and 7.8 points per game, respectively. Head was the team's leading rebounder with 6.9 boards per contest, while Hollins led State in steals (80) with a 2.76 average.

As sophomores in 2006-07, Hollins and Head have continued to build on their solid first-year resumes. This season, Head's scoring and rebounding averages have improved to 10.9 and 8.9, respectively. Hollins averages 10.0 points and 3.4 steals per game.

Head and Hollins rank fourth and fifth, respectively, in scoring for Georgia State.

Rookie of the Week honor for games ending the week of Jan. 7, the league announced Monday. The award is McKeller's first weekly accolade from the CAA, and it is the third weekly honor from the league for a Georgia State player this season.

McKeller, a 5-10 forward from Fayetteville, N.C. and Westover High School, earned the award after averaging a double-double in the Panthers' two games last week. McKeller was one of five players in double figures in Georgia State's win over CAA foe Northeastern. She posted her third double-double of the season after recording 13 points, scoring on 60 percent of her field goals, and tied her career-high with

11 boards. McKeller also tied her career-best with three steals against the Huskies. Versus James Madison, McKeller led State with a team-high nine rebounds and also chipped in seven points.

McKeller finished the week averaging 10.0 points and 10.0 rebounds for Georgia State. She made 53 percent of her field goals and averaged two steals per game.

COACH SPEAK: Georgia State head coach **Lea Henry** is one of three coaches featured on the CAA Weekly Telephonic Press Conference scheduled on Tuesday, Jan. 23. The teleconference begins at noon and lasts for approximately 20 minutes.

Henry is featured again on Tues., Feb. 13, as the Panthers host Hofstra in the CAA Game of the Week on Sunday, Feb. 18.

SHOOTING SLUMP: Senior guard **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen** is in the midst of a shooting slump from beyond the arc. Over the first six games of the season, Roegiers-Jensen made 11-of-35 three-point baskets for 31.4 percent. Since the first contest of December (8 games), she is 6-for-39 for 15.4 percent.

ROLE REVERSAL: A few lineup changes have reaped huge benefits for the Panthers in their last 11 games.

By inserting sophomore guard **Brittany Hollins** at the point guard position and moving freshman guard **Tabitha David** into the starting lineup, State has improved its scoring average by almost 20 points per game.

Prior to the lineup change, the Panthers averaged only 52.0 ppg and were 0-3 on the season. Since then, Georgia State is 9-2 and averaging 71.3 points per contest.

Five players are averaging double figures since the switch. Senior guard **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen** leads with 15.1 points per game. **David** has 11.9 ppg, while sophomore center **Marcquitta Head** collects 12.5 ppg and 10.3 rpg. **Hollins** is registering 11.4 ppg and freshman forward **Danyiel McKeller** averages 10.4 ppg.

FRESHMEN CONTRIBUTIONS: Georgia State's freshmen contributions have been solid so far in 2006-07.

Consider this, a freshman has led or tied for the team lead in scoring four times and has led or tied for the team lead in rebounding seven times.

As a unit, the group has accounted for 40.2 percent (378 of 940) of Georgia State's total points and 38.4 percent (231 of 601) of the Panthers' rebounding total.

Two of Georgia State's top three scorers and two of its top four rebounders are freshmen.

WE SIGNED THEM: The Georgia State women's basketball staff signed two players to National Letters of Intent during the NCAA early signing period in November.

Current high school seniors **Chandra Harris** and **Danielle Anderson** have committed to play collegiate basketball for the Panthers as freshmen beginning in the 2007-08 season.

Harris, who currently attends Northeast High School in Macon, Ga., is a 6-0 forward who was also recruited by Georgia Tech, Miami and Eastern Kentucky.

Anderson, who currently attends Smiths Station High School in Smiths Station, Ala., is also a 6-0 forward who was recruited by Vanderbilt, Troy and Alabama A&M. Anderson averaged 21 points and 15 rebounds per game as a junior.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Sophomore center **Marcquitta Head** was named Colonial Athletic Association Player of the Week Dec. 4 after totaling a triple-double at Hofstra on Dec. 3 (14 pts, 16 rebs., 11 blks).

Head averaged a double-double on the week with 14.0 points and 12.5 rebounds per game. She also made 55.6 percent of her field goals.

REMEMBER DECEMBER: Georgia State is 49-57 in the month of December since the 1990-91 season and 44-34 in December under head coach **Lea Henry**. State finished 5-1 in December 2006, which is its best December record since the 1999-2000 campaign.

The Panthers' of 1999-2000 produced an undefeated 6-0 mark. Over the previous five seasons, State compiled marks of 4-2 (2005-06), 3-4 (2004-05), 3-3 (2003-04), 4-3 (2002-03) and 3-3 (2001-02).

INVITATIONAL SUMMARY: Georgia State out scored its GSU Invitational opponents, Mississippi Valley State and Tennessee-Martin, 70.0 to 54.0 to capture the Georgia State University Invitational championship for the third time in four years. It was also the Panthers' eighth Invitational championship in 13 seasons hosting the event.

Four players averaged double figures, including senior guard **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen**, who was named to the all-tournament team and was selected the Invitational's Most Valuable Player. She concluded the event averaging 21.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, 6.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game. Sophomore guard **Brittany Hollins** was also named to the all-Invitational team.

NON-LEAGUE NOTES: Georgia State finished its non-conference schedule with an 8-3 record. The eight non-conference wins are the most since posting seven non-league victories in 1999-2000. Four of the eight non-conference victories were at home.

Georgia State completed its non-conference road record with a 4-3 mark. The Panthers were 2-3 at actual road venues and 2-0 at neutral sites. Georgia State last played seven non-conference road games in a season back in 1994-95 and finished 2-5.

In 1990-91, the Panthers played 10 non-conference contests and posted a 1-9 mark.

HONORABLE MENTIONS: Georgia State's first home game on Nov. 28 was a busy one as the Panthers honored three players for outstanding past performances.

Patechia Hartman (2001-05), a two-time Atlantic Sun Player of the Year, had her jersey lifted to the rafters of the Sports Arena. Also, current Panthers' junior **Vatai Smith** was given a game ball for setting the single-season blocked shots record (57) last year. Monica Thomas (2002-06) was also honored for breaking the record for career three-pointers (131), which she set last season

COMING OUT PARTY: Freshman forward **Danyzell McKeller** scored 17 points in the Panthers' first regular season game at Miami on Nov. 10. Her 17 points is the highest debut for a freshman since Monica Thomas (2002-06) totaled 12 points in 16 minutes off the bench in a 72-67 Panthers' victory at FIU on Nov. 22, 2002.

In her first collegiate start and only her second appearance of the season, freshman guard/forward **Tabitha David** scored 18 first half points, going 6-for-6 from 3-point range, en route to a game- and career-high 21 points at Norfolk State (11/21/06).

RARE COMPANY: **RaShay Rawls** and **Danyzell McKeller** are the first Georgia State freshmen to start in the first game of the regular season since Leslie McElrath (1997-2001) did it on Nov. 18, 1997 at home against Georgia Tech.

McElrath debuted with 11 points and eight rebounds in 38 minutes.

MILESTONE MAKER: Georgia State head coach **Lea Henry**, who is in her 13th season at the helm of the Panthers, won her 200th game as head coach of the Panthers on Dec. 18 in a 66-63 win over Florida A&M. She is already the program's all-time wins leader and owns a record of 204-157 (.565).

Last season, Henry eclipsed another milestone, winning her 250th career game, which she earned with an 89-65 win over Towson on Jan. 15th. Henry is 262-214 overall in 17 collegiate seasons.

FULL THROTTLE: Georgia State has scored 90 points or more in a game twice this season. The last time the Panthers scored 90+ points twice in a season was back during the 2000-01 campaign. The 44-point margin of victory in the win over Savannah State Dec. 9 was the most for the Panthers since winning by 59 points (89-30) over Morris Brown on Dec. 14, 2002.

CAREER FAIR: Senior guard **Kelcey Roegiers-Jensen** totaled a career-best 12 assists against Florida A&M on Dec. 18, while sophomore guard **Brittany Hollins** also rang up career numbers with 11 assists versus North Florida (Dec. 19). Sophomore center **Marcquitta Head** tied her career-best with 16 rebounds against Florida A&M.

MAKING HISTORY: Sophomore center **Marcquitta Head** made history Dec. 3 after the posting Georgia's first-ever women's basketball triple-double with 14 points, 16 rebounds and 11 blocked shots at Hofstra. The feat was the first in 32 seasons of collegiate women's basketball at Georgia State.

Head's 11 blocked shots were school and Colonial Athletic Association single-game records. Her 16 rebounds were a career-high.

PANTHERS PICKED 10TH: Georgia State's women's basketball team was picked to finish 10th in its second season in the Colonial Athletic Association in 2006-07, according to a vote of the league's coaches, sports information directors and media.

Old Dominion, which has captured the past 15 CAA women's basketball titles, was picked to repeat as conference champion. The Lady Monarchs were followed in the voting by James Madison, Delaware, Hofstra and William & Mary. Picked sixth was UNC Wilmington, followed by VCU, George Mason and Drexel. Towson and Northeastern were chosen to finish behind State.

The CAA sent four teams to postseason play the first time in conference history and hopes are high for 2006-07 as the league returns 75% of its starters. Included in that group are 12 players who earned all-conference honors last year.
