### **NCAA Regional Day Two Notes**

#### **Match-up with #2 Elon (Elimination Game)**

- This will be the first time that the Panthers and Phoenix have met on the diamond.
- Both teams shared several common opponents this season. Elon took 2-of-3 against Auburn, split a series with UNC Wilmington, earned a win over Old Dominion and swept a three-game series with Samford. The Panthers were 5-3 against that group, while Elon was 7-2.
- Georgia State starting pitcher Ryan Moore has pitched back-to-back complete games (Moore was only expected to pitch 2.0 innings against Alabama State). Moore has not lost a start since falling to Xavier (an NCAA Regional participant) on March 6th.
- Moore pitched a complete game to clinch the Panthers a spot in the CAA Championship. He then pitched a complete game against No. 27 George Mason, a 9-3 win, sending the Panthers to the CAA Championship Game.

#### **Notes From Last Night**

- Junior Bradley Logan hit his fifth home run in as many games with a solo shot in the top of the third. It was the 27th home run of his career, moving him into seventh on the all-time Panther list.
- Senior Matt Van Horn appeared in his 59th game of the season, tying the school record set by Paul Schlosser in 2000.
- Senior Marc Mimeault recorded hits in each of his first two at bats and had collected hits in six of his last seven plate appearances dating back to the final game of the CAA Championship.
- The middle third of the line-up (Bradley Logan, Matt Van Horn and Marc Mimeault) went 6-for-12 against the Yellow Jackets, each scoring a run.
- The Panthers entered Friday night's contest 12th in the NCAA in walks drawn with 291, however, the Yellow Jackets did not allow a walk until two outs in the ninth inning.
- Senior Michael McCree extended his hitting streak to 11 games, currently the longest on the team. The Panthers have had nine double-digit hit streaks this season, including two by Marc Mimeault.

Georgia State will look to win its first NCAA Tournament game when it takes on Elon in an elimination game at 3 p.m. The Phoenix fell in a slugfest on Friday afternoon, falling to Southern Miss, 17-15. Elon has now lost two-in-a-row. They only lost three-in-a-row once all year.

The Panthers had their chances against Georgia Tech on Friday night. State led 3-1 heading into the bottom of the fifth inning, but gave up five runs and Tech starter and first team all-american Deck McGuire settled down, as the Panthers only had two runners get to second base the rest of the game.

State's record-tying eight-game winning streak came to an end on Friday night. It is the third time in school history the Panthers have recorded a streak of eight games. The most recent was at the start of the 2008 season as Georgia State opened the season 8-0, before falling to another "Tech" school, Tennessee Tech.

If the Panthers win today, they will face the loser of today's game between Southern Miss and Georgia Tech tomorrow at 3 p.m.
