Opening Statement

"We beat ourselves. We had some guys that busted a few things there at the end. We had a missed tackle in the hole and a pass interference on third down. If it wasn't for that, we're off the field getting the ball back. Then we throw a pick there at the end going for it on fourth down, but we didn't have anything to lose.

Last week we punted it on fourth down and they go down and score and beat us. This week we said going into the game that we were going to go for it. We have nothing to lose. We're 0-6 and on the road. Might as well go for it. And we throw a pick."

On his team's progress

"We're just beating ourselves. But we're playing hard. I'm proud of them. I had a lot of guys out this game and we still were able to put ourselves in position to win. We just have to learn how to get over that hump and quit doing the things that beat ourselves.

We're getting better because we're executing better. It just hasn't shown in wins yet."

On Georgia State defense

"I know our defensive coaches are sick. We had a couple calls there that were perfect and we get a pass interference call. Then we come back later on in that drive on a third down. We knew what they were going to run and called the perfect call. The guy runs out of his gap and another guy misses the tackle in the hole.

You stop those and in a tied game you get the ball and you never know what's going to happen. You go down and get some points on the board and you might win."

On what to correct

"It's ourselves. That's the hard part of the growing process. We have a bunch of young kids out there battling and when it gets down to it sometime they make some mistakes. They're still growing and learning but our kids come to battle every weekend. We're getting closer and closer and we're just going to keep fighting."
