PANTHERS FACE ILLINI IN FIRST ROUND

Georgia State, automatic qualifiers after winning the 2013 Sun Belt Conference Championship, take on No. 26-ranked Illinois in the first round of the 2013 NCAA Men's Tennis Tournament on May 10. The Panthers (15-10) and Fighting Illini (16-10) will meet for the first time ever at 11 a.m. on May 10 in Nashville, Tenn. GSU is making its sixth NCAA Tournament appearance in school history and its first since 2007. The Sun Belt title was the first for the program since joining the conference prior to this season, and the first for first-year head coach **Joerg Barthel**. Georgia State has not won a match in the NCAA Tournament in program history. Georgia State is ranked No. 64 in the ITA National Team rankings heading into the 2013 NCAA Championship Regional. Illinois will be the 11th nationally-ranked opponent for GSU this season, and the first inside the Top 30.

HAIL TO THE VICTOR

Senior **Victor Valente's** 2012-13 season will go down as one of the greatest in Georgia State men's tennis history. He set a school record by earning a No. 54 singles ranking this year, his first career singles ranking. He was also the ITA Southeast Regional Championship singles runner-up in the fall, the first in program history. Recently he became the first GSU student-athlete since 2007, and the second in program history, to earn a bid to the NCAA Singles Championship. Valente owns a 79-23 career singles record, the most singles wins by one student-athlete in GSU men's tennis school history.

A STORYBOOK SENIOR YEAR

The senior duo of **Lucas Santa Ana** and **Victor Valente** made history this year by becoming GSU's first doubles team to earn a bid to the NCAA Doubles Championship. Santa Ana and Valente, both natives of Brazil and roommates on campus, have been nationally ranked since mid-March. They were as high as No. 38 in the rankings on Mar. 12, and most recently came in at No. 58 in the latest ITA National Doubles rankings on May 2. The two seniors each maintain above a 4.0 GPA and helped the Georgia State men's tennis team earn the highest GPA of all men's teams at Georgia State this spring. Santa Ana and Valente will go down as two of the most successful student-athletes to play at Georgia State with a combined 146-46 singles record and 114-47 doubles record.

GSU RALLIES TO SUN BELT TITLE

The Panthers faced the tall task of trying to rally while trailing 0-3 vs. No. 49-ranked MTSU in the Sun Belt Championship Finals on Apr. 20. Seniors **Lucas Santa Ana** and **Victor Valente** began the rally with victories that set up the deciding points on the courts of freshman **Paul Schuette** and junior **Robert Schulze**. Schuette fought off six match points to win his match in a third-set tiebreaker. Schulze dropped the first set, but won the second set to force a deciding third set. Down 5-6 in the third set, Schulze faced a 15-40 deficit and two match points. He won worked the match to deuce then won 10 straight points to win the game, break and take a 6-0 lead in the third-set tiebreaker. He won the tiebreaker 7-1 to clinch the match, and Sun Belt Conference title, for GSU. The match officially lasted four hours and 56 minutes.

A SCHOOL-RECORD DOUBLES WIN

Feb. 28 marked a historic occasion in Georgia State men's tennis program history. GSU's top doubles duo of seniors **Victor Valente** and **Lucas Santa Ana** defeated the No. 3-ranked doubles pair in the nation, Georgia Tech's Juan Spir and Vikram Hundal. It was the highest nationally-ranked doubles victory for a GSU doubles pair in school history. It was also the first nationally-ranked doubles win for a GSU team since the 2009 season.

ALL-SUN BELT HONORS

Georgia State filled up the All-Sun Belt awards list in its first season in the conference. Seniors **Victor Valente** and **Lucas Santa Ana** were named All-Sun Belt First Team Doubles and Valente earned All-Sun Belt First Team Singles. Junior **Robert Schulze** was named to the All-Sun Belt Second Team Singles. Following the tournament, Schulze earned the tournament's Most Outstanding Player and Santa Ana and Valente were both named to the All-Tournament Team.

CONSISTENTLY ON POINT

Georgia State has benefitted from the consistent play of senior **Victor Valente** for the last four seasons. But a newcomer, junior **Robert Schulze**, has joined Valente as one of the most consistent points for GSU this season. Schulze owns a 16-7 record this season in his singles play and a 11-7 mark in his doubles play. He has played anywhere from positions No. 3-6 in the singles lineup and at all three doubles positions.

RALLY CAPS

Georgia State proved its mettle by rallying to a come-from-behind, 4-3 win against Louisiana Lafayette on Mar. 9. Down 3-2 in the team score, senior **Lucas Santa Ana** and junior **Robert Schulze** entered their third sets as the final two singles matches. Both needed to win to clinch the match for GSU. Santa Ana fought back from being down a break in the third set to win his match. Schulze fought off two match points during his second set to win the set and eventually take the third set to finish off his win. It was the first Sun Belt Conference win for GSU since joining the conference prior to the season.

Player of the Week awards on the men's and women's sides. Senior **Victor Valente** joined GSU women's tennis junior **Abigail Tere-Apisah** as a weekly honoree most recently on Mar. 6. The two also took home both awards on Feb. 6. GSU's top singles players are both nationally ranked and were both selected to compete at the NCAA Singles Championships. Junior **Thomas Cook** was the first GSU student-athlete to earn Sun Belt Player of the Week honors on Feb. 6. He began the season 5-0 in singles play to earn the honor.

DUBS DOMINATION

Georgia State started the year 7-for-7 in capturing doubles point. It was the first time since the 2006 spring season (the earliest GSU tennis doubles statistics date back to) that the team has begun its season a perfect 7-for-7 for doubles points. The program's best stretch in the past four seasons came from Feb. 13, 2011 until Feb. 23 when the team won seven-consecutive doubles points.

SHINE ON

Junior **Thomas Cook** earned the Sun Belt Conference's first men's tennis Player of the Week award on Feb. 6. Cook got off to a hot start with a 5-0 record in singles play this season. He clinched three GSU victories with wins at the No. 2 position. He defeated Chattanooga's Roberto Vieira, an all-conference player the past three seasons, in straight sets in GSU's season opener. Then he fought back for a 4-6, 6-4, 6-3 win vs. Norbert Nemcsek to lead GSU to a 4-3 win over UNF. He then clinched the 5-2 victory against Samford with a straight-sets win.

LEGEND OF THE FALL

Senior **Victor Valente** led GSU in the fall with a breakthrough performance at the ITA Regional Championships in Tallahassee, Fla. Valente defeated two nationally-ranked opponents in his run to the finals, including No. 84-ranked Michael Alford (Florida) in the first round and No. 30-ranked Juan Spir (Georgia Tech) in the semifinals. Valente's run at the ITA Regional Championships earned him a spot at the USTA/ITA National Intercollegiate Indoor Championships in Flushing, N.Y. where the top 32 singles players in the country compete for the prestigious indoor title. He battled the No. 1 player in the country, Henrique Cunha (Duke), and another nationally-ranked opponent before his stellar fall season finally came to a close.

GSU ADDS TWO INTERNATIONAL STANDOUTS

The Georgia State men's tennis program added two signees from abroad with one arriving for the 2012-13 season and one joining the team prior to this season. **Andrew Zedde**, a native of Canberra, Australia, joined the team prior to the year and **Eric Baum**, who will enroll at Georgia State University prior to the Fall 2013 semester, both signed NLI's in December.

GSU ADDS ANOTHER HUSKER

The Georgia State men's tennis team announced in September the arrival of a former University of Nebraska standout, **Robert Schulze**, as an addition to the team beginning in the fall. Schulze transferred to Georgia State after a successful two years at Nebraska, the former home of GSU men's tennis head coach **Joerg Barthel**. Schulze brings a successful doubles game and adds a solid singles player to the Georgia State lineup.

BARTHEL ADDS VARGAS TO STAFF

First-year Georgia State men's tennis head coach **Joerg Barthel** announced the hiring of **Cesar Vargas** as assistant coach on Sept. 6. He brings high-level Division I playing experience to the Georgia State men's tennis program after playing collegiately at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. He started in the No. 2 singles and doubles position during his senior season and was the team co-captain his senior year. He was an Academic All-Big 12 selection across various semesters while at Nebraska.

WISE GUYS

The Georgia State men's tennis team earned distinction as an ITA All-Academic Team and two of its seniors were named ITA Scholar Athletes on July 20. Seniors **Lucas Santana** and **Victor Valente**, who each earned President's List honors as students with a 4.0 GPA or higher last semester, earned ITA Scholar Athlete recognition. The men's tennis team posted a 3.55 team grade point average in the fall semester and a 3.25 team grade point average in the spring semester last year. The 3.55 team GPA in the fall was the highest among all men's sports at Georgia State.

GSU TURNS TO BARTHEL

Georgia State announced **Joerg Barthel** as its next head coach on July 20. He came to GSU after serving as the assistant coach at the University of Nebraska. Under Barthel and head coach Kerry McDermott, Nebraska earned the first two NCAA berths in school history in 2010 and 2011 and made its first appearances in the ITA National Men's Team Indoor Championship in 2011 and 2012. The 2010 team earned the highest national ranking ever at #25.

KICKING-OFF THE YEAR RIGHT

The Panthers, who finished 20-5 in 2011-12, elected to travel to the University of Virginia's ITA Kick-Off Weekend regional in Charlottesville, Va. last June. It was the first time GSU qualified for the ITA Kick-Off Weekend in program history. The Panthers finished the 2011-12 season ranked No. 60 in the nation to automatically qualify for the nationally-recognized event.

DOUBLES RANKING HISTORY

The GSU doubles tandem of seniors **Lucas Santa Ana** and **Victor Valente** jumped to No. 38 in the ITA National Doubles rankings on Mar. 12. This marked the first time since the 2006 season that a Georgia State men's tennis doubles team owned a national ranking. The school record for highest doubles ranking is owned by Karl Lindberg and Nicolas Brochu who earned the No. 31 ranking in the 1998-99 season. In the 2006 season, former Panthers Martin Stiegwardt and Anze Cevka advanced as high as No. 58 in the rankings. Santa Ana and Valente earned a victory over the No. 3-ranked doubles team in the nation to set another school record.

BACK TO THE ITA KICK-OFF

The Georgia State men's tennis team jumped to the No. 64 spot in the ITA National Team rankings released on May 2. With the ranking comes a spot in next season's ITA Kick-Off Weekend. The event takes place on the last weekend in January each year and is hosted at 16 regional sites. Each regional site hosts four teams, all ranked inside the Top 64 in the country.
