Opening Kick

Gettysburg makes its home debut against defending national champion and No. 18 Messiah tonight at Clark Field.

The Series

In a series that dates back to 1966, Messiah holds the edge with 24 wins in 39 meetings (24-11-4). The Bullets have not beaten the Falcons since posting back-to-back 1-0 wins in 2002 and 2003.

Last Meeting

Gettysburg went toe-to-toe with top-ranked Messiah for 70 minutes before a three-goal run to end the match gave the Falcons a 5-2 decision last fall. **Ben Tabor** tallied the Bullets' first goal in the 9th minute and **Kyle DeBlois** tied the contest in the 69th minute. Messiah held a 19-7 shot advantage and led in corner kicks 9-5.

Last Time Out

The Bullets fell 3-1 to unbeaten Stevenson last Saturday. The Mustangs opened a 2-0 lead before freshman **Tyler Shaffer** turned in his first collegiate goal in the 60th minute. **Eric Hynes** led Gettysburg with a pair of shots, while **Mike Walmer** made one save in goal.

Clutch is Everything

Junior **Kyle DeBlois** has turned in 13 goals in his career with seven of the game-winning variety. After posting two game-winning goals

in his last six matches as a freshman, DeBlois accounted for a quartet of game-winning tallies in 2009. He logged his first go-ahead score in Gettysburg's first win of 2010 at Misericordia last week.

All in the Family

Gettysburg has had three sets of brothers play for the team over the last four seasons. Sophomore **Ben Tabor** and freshman **Tyler Shaffer** are the younger siblings of **Brad Tabor '08** and **Ryan Shaffer '10**. **Pat Brown '08** and **Chris Brown '10** were the only brothers on the roster at the same time. Each player has scored a goal at Gettysburg, with the Tabors sitting as the highest-scoring tandem with 43 points between them.

Scouting Messiah...

- Messiah opened 2010 with a surprising setback at the hands of Hobart, but the Falcons righted the ship quickly with wins in its last three matches. Messiah had to earn its last victory, sealing a 2-1 double-overtime win over Nazareth with a goal of its 24th corner kick of the contest.

- Its been a well-rounded scoring effort for the Falcons so far in 2010 with eight different players scoring the team's 11 goals. **Josiah Groff** and **Danny Thompson** have scored on both of their shot attempts this season, while **Nick Thompson's** two goals are both game-winners. **Kyle Fulks** has stopped 11 of 15 shots (.733 save percentage) and recorded a shutout against Roberts Wesleyan.
